2012 GULF SOUTH CONFERENCE FOOTBALL RELEASE

GSC GOES 2-1 AGAINST LSC FOES LAST WEEK

Birmingham, AL—The Gulf South Conference got the best of the Lone Star Conference in three Conference face offs last week.

The three match ups were part of the 10-game series tabbed the GSC-LSC First And Ten Challenge. The LSC drew first blood on Thursday when No. 13 Midwestern State won at **No. 18 West Alabama** (4-2) in GSC-TV action, 42-27. UWA led at halftime, 24-14, but the Tigers could not corral the Mustangs who ran for 348 yards and six touchdowns.

The GSC fared much better on Saturday, going 2-0 on the road against the LSC and extended its lead in the “Challenge” to 3-2. **Delta State** (2-3) eked past Tarleton State thanks to the game-winning, 33-yard field goal by **Andrew Jones** as time expired. DSU’s offense caught fire in the fourth quarter, rolling up 23 points capped by Jones’ field goal. **North Alabama** (5-1) also notched an impressive road win, holding off Texas A&M-Kingsville, 21-16. The Lions never trailed the Javelinas and **defensive back Caleb Massey** iced the decision when his school-record, 93-yard interception return for a touchdown gave UNA a 21-13 lead late in the third quarter.

Meanwhile, in GSC league play, **Valdosta State** (4-2, 1-1) and **West Georgia** (2-3, 0-2) wrote another chapter in their long-standing, in-state rivalry which saw VSU spoil the Wolves’ Homecoming behind a 42-7 victory. Neither team scored in the first quarter, but the Blazers used 21 points in the second and 14 more points in the third to run away with the contest.

Future GSC member **Shorter** got back on the winning track at home on Saturday, topping in-state NAIA rival Point, 35-13.

OFFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Delta State quarterback **Trevor Wooden** (JR, 6-2, 225, High Springs, FL).

Wooden is the first DSU Offensive honoree of the season and he also collects his first-ever award by leading the Statesmen to a 38-35, come-from-behind triumph at Tarleton State. The junior accounted for 310 total yards and three touchdowns, as DSU lit the scoreboard with 23 points in the fourth quarter. The High Springs, FL native completed 12-of-18 passes for 223 yards and one TD and also led all players with 87 yards and two more touchdowns on 21 rushing attempts.

DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

North Alabama defensive back **Caleb Massey** (JR, 6-0, 226, Sulligent, AL).

Massey is UNA's third Defensive winner of the season, spearheading the Lions' defense in a 21-16 road triumph over Texas A&M-Kingsville. The junior racked up a team-best 13 total tackles, including six solo stops, and broke up one pass attempt which he returned, 93 yards for a touchdown. The Sulligent, AL native set the school record for the longest interception return for a score, surpassing the previous mark by three yards. Massey gave North Alabama a 21-13 lead with 38 seconds left in the third quarter.

SPECIAL TEAMS PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Delta State punter/placekicker **Andrew Jones** (SR, 6-0, 185, Kossuth, MS).

Jones earns his third all-time award, first in 2012, providing terrific efforts at placekicker and punter in Delta State's win at Tarleton State. The senior booted five punts for 235 yards and a 47.0 average, while also booming a 62-yarder and dropping another inside the 20-yard line. The Kossuth, MS native did not stop there, kicking the game-winning, 33-yard field goal as time expired in the fourth quarter.

All six GSC schools take the field this week, led by two important Conference matchups.

North Alabama puts its 2-0 league record on the line when it hosts long time rival **Valdosta State**. One team will pick up their first Conference win of the season in the other league matchup when **Delta State** celebrates Homecoming against **West Georgia**.

In non-conference action, **West Alabama** seeks to rebound from its first home loss of 2012 last week by hosting College of Faith. Future GSC member **Shorter** defends its home turf for the second consecutive week, locking horns with NAIA foe Ave Maria.

Delta State hopes to cap its Homecoming celebration at **West Georgia's** expense as both teams vie for their first Conference triumph of the season.

DSU has history on its side, leading UWG all-time, 17-8, while also holding a 10-3 edge in Cleveland. West Georgia upended the Statesmen last year in Carrollton, 38-35, snapping Delta State's seven-game winning streak in the series. A Wolves' victory would secure their first back-to-back triumphs in the series since 1994-95. DSU is also 0-3 at home this year, while UWG is 0-2 on the road.

Statistical Standouts: Delta State is tops in the GSC in rushing defense (116.8) and second in total offense (409.6), total defense (300.6), pass offense (197.4) and pass efficiency (132.8). West Georgia is No. 2 in scoring offense (31.4) and No. 3 in pass offense (177.2). The Wolves also lead Division II in fumble lost (0.00).

Delta State quarterback Trevor Wooden leads the league in total offense (271.8) and passing (197.4) and is third in rushing (74.4). His top targets are **Levon Downs** (No. 2 in receptions, 4.8; No. 4 in receiving, 54.4) and **Kevin Jackson** (No. 2 in receiving, 77.6; No. 4 in receptions, 3.8). **UWG signal caller Austin Trainor** places third in total offense (152.6) and fourth in passing (125.2). **Running back Seth Hinsley** lists fifth in rushing (68.8) and **wide out Bobby Burum** is No. 3 in receptions (4.0) and receiving (64.2).

North Alabama puts its perfect Conference record on the line and seeks to extend its winning streak to five, hosting **Valdosta State**.

The rivals have faced off at least once every year dating back to 1982 with UNA holding a 20-14-1 advantage. VSU returns to the site of its last win over the Lions when the Blazers claimed a 5-0 decision during the 2010 regular season. Since then, North Alabama has won two straight in the series and has built five wins in the last six meetings. UNA is 2-1 in Florence this season, while VSU is 2-1 away from Valdosta, GA.

Statistical Standouts: The GSC's top scoring offense meets the No. scoring defense on Saturday. Valdosta State is best in the Conference in scoring offense (42.8), total offense (483.2), rushing offense (244.2), pass offense (239.0) and pass efficiency (147.8). North Alabama ranks first in scoring defense (14.8) and second in rushing offense (237.2).

VSU wide receiver Gerald Ford is No. 1 in receiving (95.2), receptions (5.6) and touchdown catches (eight). **Quarterback Graham Craig** is tops in pass efficiency (171.1), while **Cayden Cochran** is second in passing (129.2) and total offense (175.2). **Freshman running back Austin Scott** places second in rushing (91.0) and **Cedric O'Neal** is sixth (65.6). **Freshman running back Lamonte Thompson** ranks fourth in rushing (70.5) and **quarterback Chris Alexander** is sixth in total offense (119.5) and sixth in passing (73.3).

West Alabama remains at home for the third week in a row, hosting the College of Faith.

UWA suffered its first home loss of the season last Thursday when the Tigers could not hold on to a first-half lead en route to a 42-27 setback against No. 13 Midwestern State. West Alabama is 2-1 at Tiger Stadium after collecting a 41-3 win over Mississippi College and a 24-20 decision over West Georgia. COF is 0-2 after falling at Division II Arkansas-Monticello and NAIA Concordia College (AL).

Statistical Standouts: West Alabama places No. 1 in the GSC in pass defense (128.2), total defense (281.2) and pass efficiency defense (82.4). **Running back Matt Willis** leads the Conference in rushing (110.4) and all purpose yards (133.0). **Ryne Smith** currently holds the *NCAA record for consecutive field goals made (22) and he is also No. 1 in the nation in field goals (2.33)*. **Quarterback Kyle Caldwell** is third in passing (127.5) and fourth in total offense (138.8).

SU got back on the winning track last Saturday and moved to 3-3 on the year by topping NAIA Point, 35-13. Saturday's contest will be Shorter's last home game until a tough three-game road stretch versus GSC foes before the Hawks wrap up the season at home against Delta State on November 10.

DELTA STATE 38, @ TARLETON STATE 35

Delta State (2-3) rebounded from a home loss last week at the hands of a Lone Star Conference team by inching past Tarleton State on the road 38-35.

DSU entered the fourth frame trailing, 28-15, but the Statesmen hit for 23 points in the final quarter capped by **Andrew Jones'** game-winning, 33-yard field goal as time expired.

Delta State's special teams recorded the first points of the game when **Rondreaus Truesdale** recovered a blocked punt in TSU's end zone at 10:16, while **quarterback Trevor Wooden** followed with a two-point PAT rush. The Texans rallied with two unanswered touchdowns, but **Erick Clayton** gave DSU a 15-14 halftime lead after hauling-in a 50-yard TD with just three ticks left in the first half.

Tarleton State dominated the third quarter, adding 14 more unanswered points and taking a 28-15 lead heading into the final 15 minutes. Wooden ran for a 13-yard TD just 12 seconds into the fourth quarter, and Truesdale tied matters via a 34-yard scoring rush at 11:37. Wooden gave DSU a 35-28 edge at 6:13, only to see TSU knot the score at 2:58. **Statesmen defender Kenny Barnes** returned an interception to the Texans' 22-yard line with less than one minute left, setting up Jones' field goal attempt.

Wooden combined for 310 yards and three touchdowns, led by a game-high 87 yards on 21 carries. He was also 12-of-18 passing with 223 yards. Jones also excelled in punting duties, averaging 47.0 yards on five kicks including a 62-yarder. Delta State closed its all-time record against LSC foes to 3-4. [Box score](#)

NORTH ALABAMA 21, @ TEXAS A&M-KINGSVILLE 16

North Alabama (5-1) never trailed at Texas A&M-Kingsville, but the Lions held off a late rally to boost its winning streak to four, 21-16.

UNA hit pay dirt on its opening drive when **quarterback Chris Alexander** ran for a two-yard touchdown at 9:46. TAMUK answered with a field goal with 57 seconds remaining in the first quarter, only to see **Lions' running back Lamonte Thompson** run for a four-yard TD at 11:29 in the second frame. The Javelinas pulled within 14-6 before intermission via a field goal at 1:43.

Texas A&M-Kingsville recorded its first touchdown of the game just 2:15 into the second half, but Delta State's defense kept the hosts out of the end zone the rest of the way. **Defensive back Caleb Massey** extended DSU's lead to 21-13 with 38 seconds on the clock in the third frame when he returned an interception 93 yards for a TD. Massey's return marked the longest in UNA history. TAMUK closed its deficit to 21-16 behind a field goal at 4:14, but the Lions' offense was able to run out the over four minutes on their ensuing possession.

Thompson led all rushers with 63 yards on 17 attempts. North Alabama preserved its perfect all-time record against the Javelinas at 5-0 thanks to its second win in Kingsville. [Box score](#)

VALDOSTA STATE 42, @ WEST GEORGIA 7 (HOMECOMING)

Valdosta State (4-2, 1-1) picked up its first GSC win in grand fashion, blowing past in-state rival **West Georgia (2-3, 0-2)** at UWG's Homecoming, 42-7.

Neither team lit the scoreboard in the first quarter, only to see VSU reel-off 42 unanswered points. The Blazers' caught fire in the second frame, scoring 21 points starting with **wide receiver Gerald Ford's** six-yard touchdown grab at 14:19. **Wide out Seantavious Jones** collected a six-yard TD pass at 2:24, while **running back Austin Scott** ran for a 27-yarder at 1:18.

Scott accounted for the first two Valdosta State scores in the third quarter, finding the end zone from two yards out at 10:58 and adding a six-yarder at 5:12. **Quin Roberson** closed out the Blazers' streak with 11:57 left to play when he grabbed a 10-yard score. UWG was able to deny the shutout when **Quan Jones** crossed the goal line at 2:11.

Scott ran for a career-high 132 yards on 18 carries, while also catching one ball for nine yards. **Quarterback Cayden Cochran** completed 12-of-19 passes for 141 yards and added 65 yards on the ground on 10 attempts. The triumph was VSU's 20th all-time against UWG in 29 contests. [Box score](#)

#13 MIDWESTERN STATE 42, @ #18 WEST ALABAMA 27 (GSC-TV GAME OF THE WEEK)

No. 18 West Alabama (4-2) could not hold on to a 24-14 halftime lead, falling 42-27 to No. 13 Midwestern State in Thursday night's GSC-TV Game of the Week.

The squad's traded touchdowns during the first 25 minutes of play. **Running back Danny Hobbs** capped the game's opening drive by giving UWA a 7-0 lead on a one-yard touchdown plunge at 8:32. MSU answered a 1:04, only to see the Tigers retake the lead via **Marcus Brown's** 65-yard TD grab as time expired in the first frame. The Mustangs tied matters at 4:06, but West Alabama closed the first half with 10 points in the final 19 seconds. **Tyler O'Neal** caught a four-yard score and Ryne Smith connected on a 40-yard field goal as time expired after the Tigers forced a fumble on the ensuing kickoff.

The second half belonged to Midwestern State which opened the third quarter with back-to-back touchdown runs. Smith closed the deficit to 28-27 thanks to a 33-yard field goal with 12:17 left in the game, but MSU pulled away in the final eight minutes.

Hobbs led UWA with 109 yards on a game-high 24 carries, while **Gary Johnston** passed for a game-best 106 yards and two TDs. Smith stretched his consecutive field goal mark to a NCAA Record 22 dating back to October, 2011. [Box score](#)

Future GSC member **Shorter** put the brakes on a two-game losing skid, topping in-state NIAA rival Point, 35-13. SU held a 21-0 lead at intermission and never looked back. **Caleb Collins** scored the first two touchdowns at 10:20 and 1:08 in the first quarter before **Bradley Moon** added another score with 4:03 left in the first half. Moon led all players with 132 yards rushing and two TDs on 17 carries, while Collins grabbed three passes for 68 yards. [Box score](#)

2012 GSC RECORD BREAKERS

Valdosta State's Quin Roberson tied the GSC record for longest punt return in a game, reeling off a 94-yard touchdown return versus Forth Valley State. Arkansas-Monticello's Jwyin Ceasar also returned a 94-yarder for a TD in 2010.

North Alabama's Michael Schuster tied the GSC record for made field goals in a game, hitting 5-of-6 attempts in UNA's 39-0 win over Kentucky Christian.

West Alabama's Ryne Smith set the NCAA and GSC record for consecutive field goals after going 4-for-4 on September 22 at Valdosta State. Smith has booted 22 straight field goals since October 2011, snapping the previous NCAA mark of 17 and the GSC record of 15 (SAU's Jason Williams in 1998).

GSC-LSC FIRST AND TEN CHALLENGE
