2012 GULF SOUTH CONFERENCE FOOTBALL RELEASE

UWG IS FINAL UNDEFEATED GSC FOOTBALL SQUAD

Birmingham, AL—West Georgia survived last weekend's action as the lone undefeated Gulf South Conference football squad.

The league entered Saturday's slate with three 1-0 teams, but after the dust settled, only UWG preserved its perfect mark.

West Georgia (2-0) hosted Game Two of the GSC-TV Game of the Week, slipping past in-region SAC Tusculum at home, 38-29. The Wolves entered halftime with a 28-13 lead, but they needed 10 fourth-quarter points to secure the win down the stretch. UWG is 2-0 for the first time since 2002.

No. 18 Valdosta State (1-1) and **No. 25 Delta State** (1-1) each avoided rare 0-2 starts with triumphs over Division II opponents.

VSU rebounded from a season-opening setback in a grand fashion, blowing by in-state, in-region rival Fort Valley State at home, 62-14. VSU stormed back from a 7-0 deficit in the first quarter, outscoring FVSU 34-14 in first half. The Blazers dodged their first 0-2 start since 1997.

DSU bounced back from an upset loss at home last week with a 26-7 road win over Elizabeth City State. The Statesmen pitched a shutout in the first half, allowing the offense to build a 20-0 lead at the break. DSU handed first-year **Head Coach Jamey Chadwell** his first-ever as a Statesmen.

North Alabama (1-1) jumped out to a 3-0 lead versus visiting Harding, but the Lions lost four turnovers opening the door for HU's 31-10 victory. The loss was UNA's first against a non-GSC foe since 2002.

No. 23 West Alabama (1-1) could not ignite its highly productive rushing attack as Division I-FCS Samford limited the Tigers to just 21 yards on the ground en route to a 34-6 triumph.

Future GSC member **Shorter** (1-1) outgained home standing Newberry, 382-330, and entered the fourth quarter with a 14-10 lead only to see the Wolves post the go-ahead touchdown with seven minutes left to play.

OFFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Valdosta State wide receiver Gerald Ford (JR, 6-3, 220, New Orleans, LA).

Ford earns the first award of his career after sparking VSU to a 62-14 home blowout over in-state, in-region foe Fort Valley State. The junior led all players with five receptions for 152 yards and a career-high three touchdowns, headlined by a 50-yard scoring strike. The New Orleans, LA native averaged 30.4 yards per catch and his yard and TD totals were the highest in the GSC this season.

DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

West Georgia linebacker Bobby Liggins (JR, 6-5, 305, Hephzibah, GA).

Liggins posts his first-ever accolade, leading UWG's defense in a 38-29 home win over Tusculum. The junior led the Wolves with 11 total tackles and seven solo stops. The Hephzibah, GA native also made an impact in pass coverage, breaking up one pass and interception another.

SPECIAL TEAMS PLAYER OF THE WEEK

VSU punt returner Quin Roberson (JR, 6-0, 175, Moultrie, GA).

Roberson collects his first honor after turning in an impressive special team's effort in VSU's 62-14 win over Fort Valley State. The junior returned four punts for 129 yards (32.3 average) and one touchdown. The Moultrie, GA native tied the all-time GSC record and set VSU's mark for longest punt return when he took back a 94-yard punt for a score with 9:27 left to play. Roberson's 129 yard total was also good for 10th on the all-time GSC single-game list.

Last year, the Gulf South Conference and the Lone Star Conference agreed to a regular-season set of matchups between its football member institutions. The Challenge includes 10 total games and involves all six GSC football squads (including Shorter) and six of the nine LSC football teams. **No. 18 Valdosta State** and **Angelo State** kickoff the Challenge as part of the LSC Football Festival held at Cowboys Stadium in Arlington, Texas this Saturday.

Not only do **No. 18 Valdosta State** and LSC member Angelo State kick off Day Two of the 2012 Lone Star Football Festival on Saturday, but the first-time opponents also pull the curtain on the GSC-LSC First And Ten Challenge.

No. 24 West Alabama opens up its home schedule by rekindling its border rivalry with Division III Mississippi College. The schools were once GSC rivals when MC was a league member from 1972-94 before moving to the DIII ranks. The all-time series lead will be on the line in Livingston as UWA's trails the Choctaws 19-18-2. The Tigers enter with a two-game winning streak after collecting a 38-10 home win in 1997 and a 22-21 road thriller in 1996. Home has not been so sweet for West Alabama versus Mississippi College, trailing 5-7-1 all-time.

West Georgia puts its perfect record on the line, taking on an in-region squad for the second week in a row, going to SIAC member Miles.

UWG ventures away from Carrollton for the first time this season after starting with two home triumphs, capped by last weekend's 38-29 GSC-TV win over Tusculum. UWG owns a 4-0-0 series lead versus the Golden Bears, led by a 23-20 home triumph in front of a GSC-TV audience a year ago. The Wolves are 2-0 in Birmingham via a 49-0 shutout in 1990 and a 37-14 win in 1981. West Georgia is 17-4 all-time against current Southern Intercollegiate Athletic Conference teams.

@ WEST GEORGIA 38, TUSCULUM 29 (GSC-TV GAME OF THE WEEK)

West Georgia advance to 2-0 for the first time since 2002, holding off a second-half charge by visiting Tusculum in a 38-29 win in Game Two of the GSC-TV Game of the Week.

UWG posted the first two scores of the contest, as **running back David Bailey** ran for a seven-yard touchdown at 4:35 in the first quarter and **wide receiver Alex Macauley** grabbed a 32-yard scoring strike just six seconds into the second quarter. TC moved within eight points just over one minute later, only to see the Wolves hit for 14 unanswered points. **Joey Eliezer** collected a 49-yard TD catch at 10:23 and **quarterback Austin Trainor** sneaked in a two-yarder at 2:24.

The Pioneers cut the deficit to 15 points at intermission, and added 10 more unanswered points in the second half. West Georgia notched its first second-half points on **Davis Brackett's** 44-yard field goal at 11:16 in the fourth frame, but Tusculum pulled within 31-29 at 9:32. Trainor reeled-off a 15-yard scoring scamper at 7:45 and the UWG defense held firm the rest of the way.

Trainor accounted for three total touchdowns, completing 16-of-24 passes for 187 yards and adding 44 yards on 10 carries. Bailey led all players with 82 yards on 15 attempts. West Georgia reclaimed the series lead versus TC, 2-1, and moved to 4-9 in GSC-TV play. [Box score](#)

@ #20 VALDOSTA STATE 62, FORT VALLEY STATE 14

No. 20 Valdosta State (1-1) faced its second straight Division II foe this season, returning home to cruise past in-state, in-region rival Fort Valley State, 62-14.

VSU fell behind, 7-0, at 6:35 in the opening quarter, but took control the rest of the way led by 27 unanswered points.

Wide receiver Seantavious Jones caught a 77-yard touchdown at 5:06 in the first frame, while **wide out Gerald Ford** collected a 36-yarder at 2:50. Ford reeled-in a 12-yarder just 12 seconds into the second quarter and **signal caller Graham Craig** completed the scoring streak with a five-yard scoring scamper at 11:20.

FVSU's defense provided the Wildcats' final score at 9:55 in the second stanza, but the Blazers closed the first half with **Cedric O'Neal's** 57-yard touchdown run at 3:55. Valdosta State dominated the second half, 28-0, led by Ford's third TD grab at 11:30 in the third quarter and **Quin Roberson's** 94-yard punt return score with 9:27 left to play. Roberson's return tied for the longest punt return in GSC history.

Craig completed 10-of-22 passes for 314 yards and five touchdowns, while adding another TD on the ground. O'Neal led all rushers with 131 yards on 10 carries and Ford caught five balls for 152 yards and three scores. Valdosta State has won nine in a row over Fort Valley State and has scored at least 56 points in the last three matchups. [Box score](#)

#22 DELTA STATE 26, @ ELIZABETH CITY STATE 7

No. 22 Delta State (1-1) traveled over 1,000 miles to notch its first victory of the season, building a 20-0 first-half lead en route to a 26-7 win at Elizabeth City State.

DSU settled for a six-point advantage at 3:19 in the first quarter after **wide receiver Lavon Downs** capped a 10-play, 99-yard drive with a 16-yard touchdown reception. **Running back Avery Horn's** seven-yard scoring run extended DSU's lead to 13-0 with 2:28 remaining in the first half and the Statesmen took a 20-point edge into the locker room when **Kevin Jackson** caught a 31-yard TD as time expired.

ECSU's defense posted the Vikings' lone points of the day at 7:15 in the third quarter and **DSU quarterback Trevor Woodson's** one-yard plunge at 3:46 closed out the scoring.

Woodson completed 15-of-30 passes for 239 yards and also led all players with 98 yards rushing. Downs led all receivers with five grabs for 43 yards. The Statesmen remained perfect all-time versus ECSU, 3-0, after outlasting the Vikings in overtime a year ago. [Box score](#)

HARDING 31, @ NORTH ALABAMA 10

North Alabama (1-1) could not shake the turnover bug at home versus Harding, suffering its first setback of the season, 31-10.

UNA drew first blood when **Michael Schuster** booted a 39-yard field goal at 5:58 in the opening quarter, but HU grabbed a 14-3 edge heading into the locker room. The Lions closed their deficit to 14-10 via **Lamonte Thompson's** 38-yard touchdown run at 13:05 in the third frame, only to see the Bisons hit for 17 unanswered points the rest of the way.

North Alabama was held to just 192 yards of total offense and gave up four turnovers, while Harding compiled 430 yards. Thompson ran for a game-high 85 yards on 11 carries. The loss was UNA's first in the regular season to a non-GSC foe since 2002 and it also snapped its 19-game regular season winning streak versus non-GSC teams. [Box score](#)

@ SAMFORD 34, #13 WEST ALABAMA 6

No. 13 West Alabama (1-1) saw its potential upset bid at NCAA DI-FCS fall to the wayside, as the Tigers were held to 21 rushing yards in a 34-6 loss.

SU hit pay dirt on the game's opening possession, but UWA mounted a 6:26 drive that culminated in **Ryne Smith's** 22-yard field goal at 4:04. That was as close as the Tigers came to the Bulldogs who closed the first half with 21 unanswered points.

UWA standout running back Matt Willis was limited due to a shoulder injury and ran for 24 yards on 12 carries, but **quarterback Kyle Caldwell** passed for a game-high 207 yards on 16 completions. [Box score](#)

@ NEWBERRY 17, SHORTER 14

Future GSC member, Shorter University (1-1) showed that it belongs in the NCAA DII realm, leading at SAC foe Newberry in the fourth quarter before suffering a 17-14 decision.

NC took a 7-0 lead on its first possession, but SU stormed back with a pair of touchdown runs by **Bradley Moon**. Moon tied matters on a 25-yarder at 5:44 in the first quarter and gave the Hawks a 14-7 lead at the half via a 10-yard score as time expired in the first half. The Wolves provided all of the scoring in the second half, capped by the go-ahead TD with 7:45 remaining. Shorter drove the ball into Newberry territory but the Hawks fumbled the ball away with 1:15 on the clock.

Moon ran for a game-high 128 yards on 20 carries, while **quarterback Eric Dodson** added 73 yards on 15 attempts. [Box score](#)
