2012 GULF SOUTH CONFERENCE FOOTBALL RELEASE

GSC FOOTBALL EARNS FOUR MORE NON-CONFERENCE WINS

Birmingham, AL—Gulf South Conference football squads racked up a 4-1 record versus non-conference foes with the first weekend of league action looming this Saturday.

No. 18 Valdosta State (2-1) won its second straight over a Division II foe, overpowering Lone Star Conference's Angelo State, 43-10, as part of the Lone Star Football Festival in Dallas Cowboys Stadium. The contest also marked the first installment of the 10-game GSC-LSC First And Ten Challenge.

No. 24 West Alabama (2-1) rebounded from its first loss of the season, returning home for the first time and easing past Division III Mississippi College, 41-3. UWA racked up 353 rushing yards and held MC to just 41 yards on the ground.

North Alabama (2-1) used a record-tying effort by **placekicker Michael Schuster** and a dominating performance by its defense to east past NAIA Kentucky Christian at home, 39-0. Schuster tyed the GSC and UNA single-game records with five made field goals, while the defense pitched its first shutout since 2010.

West Georgia (2-1) fell from the ranks of the unbeaten, surrendering 10 unanswered points in the final 9:41 en route to a 44-37 loss at in-region, SIAC foe Miles. UWG rallied from an 18-point deficit, grabbing a three-point edge with 9:41 left to play, but MC closed the door the rest of the way.

Future GSC member **Shorter** (2-1) completed its three-week road slate by outscoring DII, CIAA member Chowan 21-0 in the second half, resulting in a 28-17 triumph.

Delta State (1-1) was idle last week and hosts UNA in its GSC opener on Saturday. VSU and UWA also open their Conference slates in Valdosta.

2011 GSC FOOTBALL PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

WEEK 4

OFFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Valdosta State wide receiver Gerald Ford (JR, 6-3, 220, New Orleans, LA).

Ford captures his second consecutive honor by sparking VSU's offense to a 43-10 victory over Angelo State at Cowboys Stadium in Arlington, TX. The senior racked up his second straight 100-yard receiving game, hauling in seven passes for 110 yards and two touchdowns. The New Orleans, LA set a career-high for catches in a game while averaging 15.7 yards per catch.

DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

North Alabama defensive back Rod Woodson (SR, 5-11, 199, Olive Branch, MS).

Woodson takes home his first-ever laurel after spearheading the Lions' defense to a 39-0 home shutout of Kentucky Christian. The senior was all over the field for UNA, posting five tackles led by three solo stops and forcing one fumble. The Olive Branch, MS native also intercepted one pass, tipped another pass that was intercepted and block a punt. As a team, UNA held KCU to just 181 yards.

SPECIAL TEAMS PLAYER OF THE WEEK

North Alabama placekicker Michael Schuster (JR, 5-10, 180, Decatur, AL).

Schuster etched his name in the record books in Saturday's win over Kentucky Christian after connecting on 5-of-6 field goal attempts. The junior made field goals of 29, 44, 50, 46 and 37 yards with his 50-yarder marking just the fourth from that minimum distance in school history. The Decatur, AL native also tied the GSC record for made field goals in a game and he was just the fourth player in Conference history to attempt six field goals in a game. He also excelled on punting duties, booming two kicks for 92 yards and landing both inside the opponent's 20-yard line.

The race for the 2012 Gulf South Conference Title starts this weekend as the league kicks off its Conference schedule with two contests.

Two league matchups headline Saturday's three-game slate, led by a Top 25 battle between **No. 16 Valdosta State** and **No. 23 West Alabama**. The squad's battle in Valdosta for the second year in a row after VSU clipped UWA, 22-21, led by a pair of interception touchdown returns by current **Blazers' defensive back Matt Pierce**.

The other league contest features the annual face off versus a pair of GSC charter members when **North Alabama** goes to **Delta State**. The game marks the fifth matchup between the rivals in three seasons as they have faced off in the regular season and in the NCAA Playoffs in 2010 and 2011.

Future GSC member **Shorter** completes Saturday's trio of games as the Hawks defend their home nest for the first time this season. SU hosts Division I-FCS Charleston Southern as part of its Homecoming festivities.

No. 16 Valdosta State has history on its side when it hosts **No. 23 West Alabama** for the second year in a row.

VSU has never lost to UWA at home, posting a 16-0 record dating back to the rival's first meeting in 1982. The Blazers also own a 28-2 series lead with the Tigers' lone triumphs coming in Livingston in 1985 and in 2010. The last two matchups have been nip-and-tuck with West Alabama taking a 24-12 decision in 2010 and Valdosta State grabbing a 22-21 win a year ago. **VSU defensive back Matt Pierce** led the Blazers to victory in 2011 by returning two interceptions for touchdowns. UWA hits the road for the third time this season, holding a 1-1 record, while VSU is 1-0 at home.

Statistical Standouts: The league's top offense meets the league's top defense as Valdosta State averages 491.3 yards per game and West Alabama allows just 216.0 yards per game. UWA also ranks first in scoring defense (12.3), pass defense (119.3) and pass efficiency defense (89.1). VSU leads the NCAA in interceptions (8.00) and is No. 1 in the GSC in pass offense (263.7), pass efficiency (161.1) and No. 2 in scoring offense (43.0).

West Alabama running back Matt Willis places first in rushing (96.0) and rushing touchdowns (3, tied), while **placekicker Ryne Smith** is tops in scoring (10.3). **Quarterback Kyle Caldwell** is third in passing (174.3) and total offense (180.3). Two-time GSC Player of the Week, **Valdosta State wide receiver Gerald Ford**, is No. 1 in receiving (110.3) and touchdown catches (five) and No. 2 in receptions (5.7, tied) and scoring (10.0). **Running back Austin Scott** places third in rushing (88.0).

Delta State returns to the field for the first time in two weeks, hosting longtime GSC rival **North Alabama** for the fourth time in the last five meetings.

For the past two years, DSU and UNA have faced off in the regular season and again in the NCAA Playoffs. The Statesmen trail the series, 30-24-1, but they have reeled-off three straight victories, including two in Cleveland. Delta State holds a 15-13-1 edge at home against the Lions, led by post-season wins in 2010 (27-24) and 2011 (42-14).

Statistical Standouts: North Alabama brings the GSC's top rushing attack to Cleveland, averaging 276.7 yards per game, Delta State ranks fourth in rushing defense (99.00). DSU also places second in pass defense (182.0), while UNA averages 96.3 passing yards per game.

Delta State quarterback Trevor Wooden is tops in the Conference in passing (203.0) and total offense (276.5) and sixth in rushing (73.5). His top targets are **Trevor Downs** who is No. 1 in receptions (6.0) and No. 5 in receiving (66.0) and **Kevin Jackson** who is No. 3 in receiving (55.0) and No. 1 eight in receptions (2.5). North Alabama features four players in the Top 10 of the league's rushing ranks, led by **running back Lamonte Thompson** (fourth, 86.0) and **quarterback Chris Alexander** (fifth, 74.0). Alexander also places fifth in passing (85.7) and total offense (159.7).

Future GSC member **Shorter University** defends its home turf for the first time this season, hosting Homecoming festivities and Division I-FCS Charleston Southern. SU seeks to move its record against DI-FCS foes to 2-0 after the Hawks upended Campbell in its season opener, 31-20. CSU has yet to notch a victory this season and is 0-2 on the road following losses at The Citadel and Illinois.

#18 VALDOSTA STATE 43, ANGELO STATE 10 (@ ARLINGTON, TX)

No. 18 Valdosta State (2-1) used a pair of scoring streaks to pull away from Angelo State (1-2) en route to a 43-10 victory as part of the Lone Star Festival at Cowboys Stadium.

The teams each settled for field goals on their first respective scoring drives. ASU drove inside VSU's 10-yard line, but the Rams were held to three points at 9:05 in the first quarter. The Blazers returned the favor and had three chances at Angelo State's one-yard line, only to settle for **Daniel Andersen's** 18-yard field goal at 12:44 in the second frame.

Valdosta State's offense did not let up, posting two straight touchdown drives. **Running back Austin Scott** made the score 10-3 at 10:01 via a career-long, 62-yard scoring run, while **wide receiver Gerald Ford** followed at 4:08 by collecting a 24-yard TD pass. The score remained, 17-3, heading into halftime.

The Rams snapped VSU's 17-point streak, pulling with seven after a touchdown pass at 10:44 in the third stanza. The Blazers ran away from ASU the rest of the way, tallying 26 straight points.

Andersen booted a 33-yard field goal at 6:10 in the third stanza and Valdosta State's defense added a safety just eight seconds later. Ford closed the quarter via a 26-yard TD grab at 3:12, resulting in a 29-10 advantage. **Running back Cedric O'Neal** pounded home a one-yard score with 10:34 left to play and **Chris Anderson** hauled-in a 16-yard scoring pass at 5:27.

Scott rushed for a game-high 126 yards on 17 carries, while Ford led all receivers with seven catches for 110 yards and two TDs. **Quarterback Cayden Cochran** completed 16-of-28 passes for 173 yards and two scores. VSU remained perfect versus LSC foes all-time, 3-0, and the GSC posted its second straight win in the Lone Star Football Festival. **Box score**

@ #24 WEST ALABAMA 41, MISSISSIPPI COLLEGE 3

No. 24 West Alabama (2-1) celebrated its home opener for 2012 in grand fashion, running past NCAA Division III Mississippi College, 41-3.

UWA hit pay dirt on the game's opening possession when **wide receiver Chad Toocheck** caught an eight-yard touchdown at 11:28 and **quarterback Gary Johnston** closed the first quarter on a four-yard TD run at 3:25. The Tigers entered the locker room with a 27-0 edge thanks to a pair of field goals by **Ryne Smith** from 25 and 18 yards out, and a one-yard scoring jaunt by **running back Matt Willis**.

MC opened the second half with a field goal at 10:12, only to see West Alabama close out the scoring with a pair of quarterback TD runs. **Kyle Caldwell** ran for an eight-yard touchdown at 1:33 and Johnston ran home a three-yarder with 8:04 left to play.

Willis ran for a game-high 101 yards on 18 carries, while Johnston followed with 74 yards on eight attempts. Caldwell compiled 171 total yards by passing for a game-high 101 yards on 10 completions and adding 70 yards on the ground. With the victory, West Alabama tied the all-time series against Mississippi College, 19-19-2, via its third straight win in the series. **Box score**

@ NORTH ALABAMA 39, KENTUCKY CHRISTIAN 0

North Alabama (2-1) recorded its first shutout since 2010 and **placekicker Michael Schuster** set a GSC record for field goals in a game in the Lions' 39-0 home triumph over NAIA Kentucky Christian.

Schuster connected on four first-half field goals, leading the Lions to a 20-0 halftime advantage. UNA lit the scoreboard first on a 29-yard field goal at 10:22 in the opening stanza, followed by **quarterback Chris Alexander's** nine-yard touchdown run at 2:17. The defense got into the act with 13 seconds left in the first quarter when **Dimitri Orr** tackled KCU's quarterback in the endzone for two points. Schuster dominated the second quarter with field goals of 44, 50 and 46 yards and he tallied the lone points in the third frame from 37 yards out at 4:26.

Jamarcus Goodloe ran for a nine-yard TD with 6:28 left to play followed by **Diamond Simmons'** 76-yard scoring scamper at 3:32. The final points of the game came on another safety at 1:47.

Alexander racked up 233 total yards and his 104 rushing yards on 20 carries were the most by a UNA quarterback since 2005. **Running back Chris Coffey** followed Alexander with 98 yards on just eight attempts. The Lions prevented their first back-to-back home setbacks since 2004. **Box score**

@ MILES 44, WEST GEORGIA 37

West Georgia (2-1) traveled away from Carrollton for the first time this season, suffering its first loss of 2012, 44-37 against Miles.

MC jumped on top quickly on an 80-yard touchdown pass in just 15 seconds, and UWG cut its deficit to one point after back-to-back 41-yard field goals by **Davis Brackett** at 10:07 and 4:01, respectively.

The Golden Bears opened the second stanza by posting another TD and the Wolves added another field goal from 33 yards away at 7:58. Miles returned the ensuing kickoff for a score, only to see West Georgia find the endzone for the first time when **quarterback Dallas Dickey** ran for a four-yard TD at 2:39. MC was not done scoring, stretching its lead to 18 points at 10:58 in the third quarter.

The Wolves did not give up, securing their first lead of the game via 21 unanswered points. **Running back Quan Jones** ran for a seven-yard touchdown at 3:03 in the third frame, while Dickey snuck in a one-yarder at 10:47. **Darien Lane** completed the scoring streak when he returned an interception 27 yards for a TD with 9:41 left to play, but Miles blocked and returned the point-after to UWG's endzone for two points. MC erased its one-point deficit for good at 4:18 and the Wolves drove to the Golden Bears' 13-yard line before the drive stalled out.

UWG running back Seth Hinsley ran for a game-high 87 yards on 18 carries, while **wide out Bobby Burum** led all players with eight receptions for 107 yards. **Starting quarterback Austin Trainor** completed 24-of-36 passes for 216 yards. The loss was West Georgia's first-ever against Miles after stretching the series lead to 4-0-0 a year ago. [Box score](#)

SHORTER 28, @ CHOWAN 17

Future GSC member, **Shorter University (2-1)** rallied for 21 points in the second half to upended Division II Chowan on the road, 28-17.

The squads traded touchdowns in the first quarter, capped by **SU wide receiver Kirk Wilson's** 49-yard touchdown catch at 5:58. CU hit for 10 unanswered points the rest of the first half, taking a 17-7 lead into the locker room.

The Hawks used a pair of big plays in the third quarter to grab a 21-17 edge at 4:43. **Running back T.J. Telfair** ran for a 70-yard touchdown at 9:44 and **Brandon Morton** hauled-in a 63-yard TD catch at 4:43. Shorter's defense put the game away early in the fourth frame when **Kendall Lacey** intercepted a pass in Chowan's endzone for at touchdown.

Telfair ran for a game-best 75 yards on just four carries and **quarterback Eric Dodson** completed 3-of-5 passes for 119 yards. [Box score](#)
