2012 GULF SOUTH CONFERENCE FOOTBALL RELEASE

UWA, UNA OPEN GSC FOOTBALL LEAGUE PLAY WITH WINS

Birmingham, AL—The race for the 2012 Gulf South Conference Football Title began this past Saturday with **West Alabama** and **North Alabama** grabbing impressive road triumphs.

No. 23 UWA (3-1, 1-0) made history at **No. 16 Valdosta State** (2-2, 0-1), notching its first-ever victory at Bazemore-Hyder Stadium in 17 attempts, 39-28. The Tigers ran for 332 yards and **placekicker Ryne Smith** set the NCAA record for consecutive field goals made (19) after going 4-for-4 on the night.

North Alabama (3-1, 1-0) remained perfect on the road by denying **Delta State** (1-2, 0-1) its first home win of the season, 20-12. UNA's defense led the way in the fourth quarter, stretching its lead to eight points after a fumble recovery in DSU's end zone at 6:17 and an interception with just over one minute remaining.

Future GSC member **Shorter** (2-2) could not overcome three key turnovers, falling to Division I-FCS Charleston in its Homecoming contest, 23-20. The Hawks held a 14-10 halftime lead, but were outscored in the second half, 13-6.

OFFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

West Alabama running back Matt Willis (SR, 5-8, 205, Collins, MS).

Willis earns his fourth career award and second this season after leading No. 23 UWA's rushing attack in the Tigers' 39-28 victory at No. 16 Valdosta State. The senior ran for a game-high 178 yards on 27 carries for a 6.6 per carry average, while also adding one reception for 18 yards. His rushing total and attempts were the highest by any player in the GSC so far this season. The Collins, MS native enters next week's home contest against West Georgia trailing UWA's all-time rushing mark by three yards.

DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

UWA defensive back Otha Foster (SR, 6-1, 207, Angle, LA).

Foster takes home is first-ever laurel behind a record-tying effort in the triumph over Valdosta State. The senior strong safety had a direct hand in all but one of the West Alabama's interceptions, nabbing three VSU passes and tying the school record for interceptions in a game. The Angle, LA native became just the ninth player in GSC history to tallying three interceptions in a game, first since 2009. Foster returned his three picks for 40 total yards and he also posted three total tackles led by two solo stops.

SPECIAL TEAMS PLAYER OF THE WEEK

UWA placekicker Ryne Smith (SR, 5-8, 180, Madison, MS).

Smith notches his first-ever accolade after etching his name in the record books in Saturday's win over Valdosta State. The senior connected on all four of this field goal attempts, stretching his consecutive field goal mark to a NCAA Record 19 dating back to October, 2011. The Madison, MS native booted field goals of 41, 38, 27 and 41 yards and also made good on all three point-after-attempts in the 39-28 triumph. Smith's consecutive performance also smashed the GSC record of 15 which was set by Southern Arkansas' Jason Williams in 1998.

The game also marks the second matchup of the 10-game, "GSC-LSC First and Ten Challenge," which pits all six GSC teams (including Shorter) versus six of the nine LSC squads throughout the season. The game will be shown live by **CSS**, **Mediacom**, **TV-24** and **ESPN3** and on a tape-delay basis by CoxSports (Sept. 28 at Noon) and the Alabama Cable Network (Sept. 29 at 7:00 pm).

A pair of league matchups and another non-conference battle headlines Saturday. **No. 19 West Alabama** plays its second straight Peach State rival when **West Georgia** comes to Livingston in UWG's league opener. **North Alabama** celebrates Homecoming and hosts the first countable league contest for future GSC member Shorter. **Valdosta State** seeks to get back on the winning track, defending its home turf in non-conference play against NAIA Edward Waters.

GSC-TV returns to Cleveland, MS for the second time this season when **Delta State** hosts Lone Star Conference member Abilene Christian in Game Three of the Game of the Week slate.

The matchup also marks the second matchup of the 10-game, "GSC-LSC First and Ten Challenge," which pits all six GSC teams versus six LSC squads throughout this season. Valdosta State won the first GSC-LSC game last Saturday over Angelo State in Cowboy's Stadium, 43-10.

DSU battles another non-conference foe in front of a GSC-TV audience after the Statesmen fell to Fort Valley State in the season opener on September 1st. In fact, the Statesmen still seek to celebrate their first win at home this season after dropping both previous matchups, capped by last weekend's setback to North Alabama. ACU remains on the road for the third week in a row and the Wildcats are 0-2 away from home this season. The schools face off for the first time ever, but Delta State is 2-3 against current LSC members.

Statistical Standouts: **Delta State** leads the GSC in pass defense (126.7) and pass defense efficiency (85.1) and kickoff returns (36.7). Abilene Christian is tops in the LSC in rush defense (92.8) and punt returns (42.5).

Delta State quarterback Trevor Wooden is tops in the Conference in total offense (233.7), second in passing (168.0) and seventh in rushing (65.7). His top targets are **Levon Downs** who is No. 3 in receptions (5.0) and No. 5 in receiving (43.3) and **Kevin Jackson** who is No. 3 in receiving (64.7) and No. 4 in receptions (tied, 3.3). ACU signal caller Mitchell Gale places second in the LSC in passing (253.5) and third in total offense (256.0).

North Alabama defends its home turf for the third time this season, hosting future GSC member **Shorter**. The game has historical significance for SU, which will be a part of the GSC league schedule starting in 2012 until its official membership status in 2014.

UNA celebrates its Homecoming after going 1-1 at Braly Municipal Stadium this season, while the Hawks have collected both of their victories on the road this season. The Lions dropped their home opener versus Harding on September 8th, but rebounded against Kentucky Christian the next week. Shorter have been road warriors in 2012, opening the season with three road trips and going 2-1. SU opened the year with a triumph over NCAA DI-FCS Campbell and then recorded a win at DII Chowan.

Statistical Standouts: Smash-mouth football will be on display in Florence, as North Alabama leads the GSC in rushing (262.5) and Shorter is averaging 267.5 yards on the ground. Conversely, UNA is fifth in rushing defense (168.2) and SU gives up 129.0 yards rushing.

Lions' freshman running back Lamonte Thompson ranks third in the GSC in rushing (87.2) and fourth in all purpose yards (106.5). **Quarterback Chris Alexander** is sixth in rushing (70.0), passing (67.0) and total offense (137.0). **Hawks' quarterback Eric Dodson** is averaging 128.0 yards through the air and 65.2 yards on the ground, while **running back Bradley Moon** leads the team with 92.5 yards per game.

No. 19 West Alabama seeks to remain unbeaten in league play, while visiting **West Georgia** opens up GSC play in Livingston.

UWG leads the all-time series, 18-11-0, but UWA has made up some ground recently by capturing two in a row and four of the last six meetings. The series lead at Tiger Stadium is up for grabs as both teams have collected eight victories dating back to the very first meeting between the schools in 1983. West Alabama holds a three-game home streak in the series after claiming matchups in 2006, 2008 and 2010. UWA is 1-0 at home in 2012, while UWG seeks its first road decision (0-1).

Statistical Standouts: The GSC's top offense and top defense butt heads for the second week in a row. West Georgia is tops in total offense (469.0) and scoring offense (43.3), while West Alabama is No. 1 in total defense (257.8) and scoring defense (16.2). UWG is also first in the NCAA in fumbles lost (0.00).

West Alabama running back Matt Willis places first in rushing (116.5), rushing touchdowns (3, tied) and all purpose yards (141.0). **Ryne Smith** currently holds the NCAA record for consecutive field goals made (19) and he is also No. 1 in the nation in field goals (2.75) and No. 1 in the GSC in scoring (11.5). **Quarterback Kyle Caldwell** is fourth in passing (156.2) and total offense (156.0). **UWG running back Seth Hinsley** ranks second in the Conference in rushing (91.7). **Signal caller Austin Trainor** is first in passing (176.0), second in total offense (220.7) and 10th in rushing (44.7). **Wide out Bobby Burum** is second in receptions (5.7) and receiving (95.0).

Valdosta State remains at home for the second straight week, moving out the league to face NAIA Edward Waters.

VSU has a sour taste in its mouth after falling to West Alabama last weekend, but can move past .500 overall with a triumph over EWC. The Blazers cruised past Edward Waters in the lone previous meeting, 70-6 at Bazemore-Hyder Stadium in 2009. The Tigers are also 2-2 on the year, thanks to last week's road win over Livingston College, 42-36.

Statistical Standouts: Valdosta State leads the GSC in pass offense (260.2) and is second in scoring offense (39.2), total offense (464.2) and pass efficiency (142.2). **Wide receiver Gerald Ford** is No. 1 in receiving (111.5), receptions (6.2) and touchdown catches (seven). **Freshman running backs Cedric O'Neal** and **Austin Scott** place fourth (84.0) and fifth (79.2) in rushing, respectively.

#23 WEST ALABAMA 39, @ #16 VALDOSTA STATE 28

No. 23 West Alabama (3-1, 1-0) lifted a huge weight off of its shoulders on Saturday, securing its first-ever win at **No. 16 Valdosta State (2-2, 0-1)**, 39-28.

VSU lit the scoreboard on the game's first possession when **wide receiver Gerald Ford** caught a four-yard touchdown at 10:29. UWA dominated the rest of the first half, hitting for 20 unanswered points and entering halftime holding a 20-7 lead.

Running back Malik Lofton tied the score at 3:39 via a 13-yard TD run and **Ryne Smith** booted back-to-back field goals in the second quarter from 41 and 38 yards. **Wide out Stacey Graham** closed the first half, reeling-in a 34-yard scoring pass with just 49 seconds on the clock.

The Blazers retook a 21-20 edge early in the third stanza behind a 31-yard touchdown reception by Ford and **Tyler Josey's** fumble recovery in the Tigers' end zone at 10:37. West Alabama surged ahead again via 16 straight points after **Reggie Hall's** two-yard TD run at 5:50, Smith's 27-yard field goal and **quarterback Gary Johnston's** four-yard scoring scamper. **Valdosta State's Quin Roberson's** five-yard TD grab closed the deficit to eight points with 7:18 left to play, but Smith closed the door for good via another 41-yard field goal at 2:29.

UWA running back Matt Willis led all players with 178 yards on 27 carries, while Johnston added 120 yards on 13 attempts. Ford caught a game-high eight balls for 157 yards in a losing effort. Smith stretched his consecutive field goal mark to a [NCAA Record 19](#) dating back to October, 2011. He also smashed the GSC record of 15 which was set by Southern Arkansas' Jason Williams in 1998. West Alabama snapped its 16-game road losing streak versus Valdosta State behind its second triumph over VSU in three seasons. [Box score](#)

NORTH ALABAMA 20, @ DELTA STATE 12

North Alabama (2-1, 1-0) put the brakes on its three-game losing skid versus **Delta State (1-2, 0-1)** thanks to a 20-12 road win on Saturday.

Neither team lit the scoreboard in the first quarter, but DSU hit pay dirt just 10 seconds into the second frame when **quarterback Trevor Woodson** ran for a 33-yard touchdown. The Statesmen missed the point-after attempt, opening the door for UNA's 7-6 lead at 12:21, following **running back Chris Coffey's** 15-yard scoring scamper. **Andrew Jones** closed the first half by giving the Statesmen a 9-7 lead entering the locker room after a 22-yard field goal.

The Lions settled for a 13-9 lead after **running back Lamonte Thompson's** 79-yard touchdown run was followed by a missed point-after kick at 2:07 in the third stanza. Jones pulled Delta State within one point with 10:10 remaining in the game, but North Alabama's defense provided two big plays to ice the victory. **Taylor Carney** upped UNA's lead to 20-12 after he recovered a fumble in DSU's end zone at 6:17 and **Delvin Ervin** intercepted a pass on DSU's final drive at 1:06.

Thompson paced North Alabama's rushing attack with 91 yards on 12 carries. North Alabama stretched its all-time edge versus Delta State to 31-24-1 thanks to its first win in Cleveland since 2010. [Box score](#)

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN 23, @ SHORTER 20 (HOMECOMING)

Future GSC member, **Shorter University (2-2)** could not record its second win over a Division I-FCS foe this season, falling 23-20 in Homecoming action versus Charleston Southern.

SU scored the lone points in the first quarter when **Bradley Moon** ran for a two-yard touchdown at 2:25, but CSU hit for 10 straight points in the second frame. The Hawks retook a 14-10 edge heading into the locker room thanks to **Brandon Morten's** 49-yard TD catch at 4:51.

Charleston Southern surged ahead for good in the third quarter, 23-14, but Shorter pulled with three points after a pair of fourth-quarter field goals by **Troy Postell**. SU never took the field again after Postell's 26-yarder at 6:53 as CSU's offense ran out the clock by converting three first downs the rest of the way.

Shorter quarterback Eric Dodson combined for 266 yards led by 136 rushing on 19 carries. Morten led all players with 81 yards on two catches. [Box score](#)

2012 GSC RECORD BREAKERS

Valdosta State's Quin Roberson tied the GSC record for longest punt return in a game, reeling off a 94-yard touchdown return versus Forth Valley State. Arkansas-Monticello's Jwyin Ceasar also returned a 94-yarder for a TD in 2010.

North Alabama's Michael Schuster tied the GSC record for made field goals in a game, hitting 5-of-6 attempts in UNA's 39-0 win over Kentucky Christian.

West Alabama's Ryne Smith set the NCAA and GSC record for consecutive field goals after going 4-for-4 on September 22 at Valdosta State. Smith has booted 19 straight field goals since October 2011, snapping the previous NCAA mark of 17 and the GSC record of 15 (SAU's Jason Williams in 1998).
