## 2012 GULF SOUTH CONFERENCE FOOTBALL RELEASE

### GSC FOOTBALL OPENS 2012 WITH A 4-2 MARK

**Birmingham, AL**—Gulf South Conference squads went 4-2 in non-conference action last week, led by a pair of blowouts and four thrilling contests.

**No. 15 West Alabama** (1-0) sprinted out of the gate on Saturday, traveling to in-region SIAC foe Clark Atlanta and earning its first shutout triumph since 2009, 44-0. Running back Matt Willis led the charge for the Tigers, combining for 236 yards of total offense and posting three touchdowns.

**West Georgia** (1-0) opened the season at home, snapping its four-game skid in season openers by blowing by in-state NAIA foe Point, 55-3. The Wolves lit the scoreboard for the most points in a game since 2005. Running back Seth Hinsley made the most of his first career starting, running for 110 yards and two touchdowns on 17 carries.

Alabama Division II rivals, **North Alabama** (1-0) and Miles, faced off at Legion Field in Birmingham on Sunday night. UNA held off a furious second-half comeback by the Golden Bears, preserving a 31-30 victory when linebacker Tavarius Wilson made the game-saving tackle on MC's two-point conversion attempt with 16 seconds on the clock. The Lions extended their season-opening winning streak to 10 games.

**No. 14 Delta State** (0-1) opened the 2012 GSC-TV LIVE Game of the Week schedule on Saturday afternoon. DSU held a 23-9 halftime edge, but Fort Valley State hit for 22 points in the fourth quarter en route to a 31-23 defeat of the Statesmen. The setback snapped DSU's three-game winning streak in GSC-TV action.

**No. 8 Valdosta State** (0-1) journeyed over 1,000 miles north to battle Saginaw Valley State (1-0) on Saturday. VSU held a three-point advantage heading into the fourth frame and held SVSU out of the endzone until the Cardinals caught the go-ahead TD with 1:01 remaining in a 28-24 final.

Future GSC member **Shorter** (1-0) kicked off the week, upsetting NCAA Division I-FCS Campbell on the road, 31-20. Quarterback Eric Dodson set a new SU single-game record with 191 yards passing, while running back Bradley Moon added 102 yards rushing. The game marked the first for the Hawks as a NCAA Candidacy Year-Two designee.

**WEEK 2**

**OFFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK**

**West Alabama running back Matt Willis** (SR, 5-8, 205, Collins, MS),  
Willis earns his third career honor after leading UWA to a 44-0 shutout at in-region, SIAC foe Clark Atlanta. The senior combined for 236 total yards and three touchdowns in just three quarters of action. The Collins, MS native ran for 163 yards and two TDs on 15 carries (10.9 average) and he also hauled in two passes for 73 yards and another score. Willis' rushing efforts moved him into fifth place in the UWA record books and just 104 yards away from fourth place.

**DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK**

**North Alabama linebacker Tavarius Wilson** (JR, 5-11, 225, Jackson, MS)  
Wilson claims his first-ever accolade, spearheading UNA's defense in a 31-30 triumph over in-state, in-region foe Miles at Legion Field in Birmingham, AL. The junior led the Lions with 13 total tackles and a game-high tying nine solo stops, while also breaking up two passes. The Jackson, MS native sealed the victory for UNA by posting the game-winning tackle on Miles' two-point conversion attempt with 16 seconds left to play.

**SPECIAL TEAMS PLAYER OF THE WEEK**

**West Georgia return specialist Denarius Appling**  
(SR, 5-8, 155, Griffin, GA)  
Appling notches his fourth Special Teams honor of his three-year career. The junior gave UWG the field position advantage in its 55-3 home win over in-state, NAIA foe Point, returning six punts for 125 yards and a 20.8 average. The Griffin, GA native's longest return was 50 yards and his 125 yards ranked 10th all-time in GSC single-game history.

**West Georgia** has plenty of motivation when in-region South Atlantic Conference foe Tusculum comes to University Stadium for the second GSC-TV telecast of the season. The game will be shown live by **Comcast/Charter Sports Southeast, Mediacom** and **TV-24** and on tape-delay by **Cox Sports TV** on September 9th at 4:00 pm.

Not only would a UWG victory serve as sweet revenge for last year's season-opening 20-10 setback at TC, but the Wolves would post their first 2-0 start since 2002. The schools have met two previous times with West Georgia taking the first-ever meeting in 1996, 62-0. UWG is 5-10-1 all-time against present SAC opponents.

UWG is 3-9 all-time in GSC-TV action and went 1-1 in two television games a year ago led by a 23-20 non-conference triumph over Miles College. The Wolves have won two straight dating back to 2011, closing last season with an upset of Delta State and posting a victory at home last week against Point.

**West Alabama** remains on the road for the second straight week, battling in-state, NCAA Division I-FCS rival Samford. Both teams opened up their respective campaigns with triumphs last weekend. UWA blanked Clark Atlanta on the road, 44-0, while SU celebrated a 24-21 home win over Furman. Saturday's matchup marks the 17th all-time meeting between the squads with the Bulldogs owning a 9-6-1 edge. The Tigers have dropped three in a row in the series with its last victory coming at home in 1989, 35-28. Samford squeaked past West Alabama in the latest matchup in 2007, 23-21. UWA trails SU at Seibert Stadium, 7-2, but a win would give the Tigers their third 2-0 start in four seasons.

**#15 WEST ALABAMA 44, @ CLARK ATLANTA 0**

**No. 15 West Alabama** (1-0) turned in an impressive performance on both sides of the ball, blanking in-region Clark Atlanta on the road, 44-0.

UWA held a 16-0 lead at intermission, led by three field goals by **Ryne Smith**. Smith booted a 36-yarder with 1:18 left in the first quarter followed by **running back Matt Willis'** 10-yard touchdown rush at 13:34 in the second stanza. Smith completed the first half scoring with two more field goals in the final 1:08 (47 yarder and 33 yarder).

The Tigers did not let up in the second half, pouring on 28 more points. Willis hauled in a 62-yard TD pass at 9:12 in the third quarter and added a 55-yard scoring run at 2:20. **Wide receiver Malik Lofton** grabbed a 36-yard touchdown pass at 13:01 in the fourth stanza and **Dakota Daniel's** 14-yard TD run closed out the scoring with just 56 seconds on the clock. UWA's defense held CAU to just 78 yards of total offense and 22 yards on the ground.

Willis combined for 236 total yards, rushing for 163 and catching for 73 and moved into fifth-place in UWA's all-time rushing list. **Quarterback Kyle Caldwell** completed 12-of-19 passes for 215 yards and two scores. West Alabama recorded its first shutout since 2009 and captured its fourth season-opening victory in the last five seasons. [Box score](#)

**@ WEST GEORGIA 55, POINT 3**

**West Georgia** (1-0) put the brakes on its four-game losing skid in season openers, blowing past in-state NAIA foe Point at home, 55-3.

UWG found pay dirt on its opening possession and never looked back, leading by 34 points at the end of the first half. **Quarterback Austin Trainor** sneaked-in the first touchdown from one-yard out at 9:05, while **running back David Bailey** ran for a three-yard score at 4:38. **Wide receiver Bobby Burum** hauled in a 18-yard TD pass just 47 seconds into the second frame and **running back Seth Hinsley** stretched the lead to 28-0 via a one-yard plunge at 7:21. The Wolves completed the first half scoring on **Joey Eliezer's** 23-yard reception with 1:10 on the clock. West Georgia stretched its lead to 48-0 and held the shutout until Point kicked a field goal with 14:51 left to play.

Hinsley rolled up a game-high 110 yards rushing on 17 carries in his first career start, while Burum led all players with 84 yards receiving. Trainor completed 11-of-15 passes for 151 yards, while back up **Dallas Dickey** was 3-for-3 through the air with two TDs. [Box score](#)

**NORTH ALABAMA 31, MILES 30 (SUNDAY @ LEGION FIELD, BIRMINGHAM, AL)**

**North Alabama** (1-0) and in-state DII rival Miles thrilled the 22,268 fans inside Legion Field in Birmingham, AL in Sunday's Labor Day Golden Classic. UNA took a seven-point lead with just over a minute left and then stopped MC's game-winning two-point conversion attempt with 16 seconds on clock, preserving the Lions' 31-30 win.

North Alabama had the game well in hand in the first half, running out to a 21-0 lead. **Running back Lamonte Thompson** scampered for a one-yard touchdown on the Lions' opening possession. **Luke Wingo** added another one-yard TD run at 13:57 in the second quarter followed by **Chris Alexander's** three-yard plunge at 3:47. Miles posted its first seven points at 2:08, only to see UNA stretch its halftime lead to 24-7 via **Michael Schuster's** 44-yard field goal with 57 ticks on the clock.

MC responded in the second half, reeling off 21 unanswered points and tying matters, 24-24, with 3:09 left in the game. North Alabama marched down the field and retook the lead after **wideout Brian Sutherland** collected a 40-yard touchdown pass at 1:05. The Golden Bears pulled within one point, engineering a six-play, 73-yard scoring drive, but UNA iced the victory by stopping MC's two-point conversion attempt.

Thompson ran for a game-high 102 yards on 21 carries, while Alexander passed for 109 yards and added 69 yards on the ground. The victory extended UNA's regular season winning streak versus non-GSC schools to 20 and upped its all-time record versus Miles to 7-0. [Box score](#)

**FORT VALLEY STATE 31, @ #14 DELTA STATE 23 (GSC-TV GAME OF THE WEEK)**

**No. 14 Delta State** (0-1) failed to start the **Jamey Chadwell** Era with a win, suffering a 31-23 home upset against Fort Valley State in the first GSC-TV Game of the Week.

DSU lit the scoreboard on its first possession via **Avery Horn's** 13-yard touchdown run at 11:51, but the Statesmen missed the point-after kick. **D.J. Jarrin** booted a 30-yard field goal just 12 seconds into the second quarter, but FVSU cut the deficit to seven after a team safety. Delta State took a 23-9 lead into halftime thanks to a 19-yard touchdown catch by **Kevin Jackson** at 8:10 and **Reed Faulkner's** 17-yarder at 1:34. Neither team scored in the third quarter, but the FVSU caught fire in the fourth, scoring 22 unanswered points.

**DSU signal caller Trevor Wooden** led the offense in his first career start, passing for 167 yards and adding a team-high 49 yards rushing. The loss snapped the Statesmen's three-game winning streak in Game of the Week action. [Box score](#)

**@ SAGINAW VALLEY STATE 28, #8 VALDOSTA STATE 24**

**No. 8 Valdosta State** (0-1) traveled to University Center, MI to face Saginaw Valley State and held a three-point lead late in fourth quarter until the Blazers gave up the go-ahead touchdown with 1:01 left to play in a 28-24 final.

The squads traded touchdowns in the first half. VSU drew first blood at 5:02 in the opening frame via **quarterback Cayden Cochran's** 24-yard touchdown scamper, only to see the Cardinals answer at 10:07 in the second quarter. Valdosta State **running back Austin Scott** ran in a four-yard TD at 4:16 and Saginaw Valley notched the neutralizer with just 33 seconds on the clock.

SVSU grabbed a 21-14 edge at 8:40 in the third quarter, but the Blazers struck back quickly after Seantavious Jones received a 70-yard TD bomb just 33 seconds later. Valdosta State went up 24-21 with 24 seconds remaining in the third frame via **Daniel Andersen's** 32-yard field goal. The defense held firm until late in the fourth quarter when the Cardinals tossed the game-winning score with 1:01 left to play.

**VSU running back Austin Scott** led all players with 95 yards on 18 carries, while **wide out Gerald Ford** led the team with five catches for 69 yards. The Blazers fell to 0-2 all-time against GLIAC foes. [Box score](#)

**SHORTER 31, @ CAMPBELL 20 (THURSDAY)**

**Future GSC member, Shorter University** (1-0) opened its NCAA Candidacy Year-Two campaign with a bang on Thursday, upsetting NCAA DI-FCS Campbell, 31-20.

SU accounted for all of the points in the first quarter, jumping out to a 10-0 lead behind **quarterback Eric Dodson's** two-yard run at 11:15 and Troy Postell's 28-yard field goal at 2:16. CU scored 17 unanswered points capped by a touchdown run at 12:18 in the third quarter, but the Hawks responded with **running back Bradley Moon's** two-yard scoring scamper at 3:27.

The Camels retook a 20-17 lead at 12:11 in the fourth quarter, but the rest of the game belonged to Shorter. **Brandon Morten** caught the go-ahead, 61-yard TD at 7:32 and Moon closed the door at 4:42 thanks to a 61-yard scoring run.

Dodson commanded the offense, setting a school record with 191 passing yards on nine completions. Moon posted a game-high 102 yards on 19 carries, while Morten led all players with 107 yards receiving. [Box score](#)
