#### UWA TAKES CONTROL OF GSC FOOTBALL RACE

**No. 8 West Alabama** won the battle of Gulf South Conference titans last Thursday, giving the defending league champions control of their own destiny in the 2013 Title race.

Both Alabama GSC members notched Conference victories last week, led by UWA (5-1, 3-0) which upset then **No. 1 Valdosta State** (4-1, 2-1) at home, 49-30, in the Thursday night's GSC-TV LIVE Game of the Week. **Quarterbacks Kyle Caldwell** and **Gary Johnston** combined for five passing touchdowns as the hosts totaled 558 total yards and snapped VSU's 14-game winning streak.

**North Alabama** (3-2, 2-1) won its second straight league contest, celebrating Homecoming via a 38-21 triumph over **West Georgia** (4-2, 1-1). UNA's offense ran for 294 yards, while the defense forced five UWG turnovers.

**Florida Tech** (1-5, 0-3) and **Shorter** (0-6, 0-3) each suffered setbacks in non-conference action.

SU defended its home turf for the third week in a row, trailing No. 18 Carson-Newman by just three points with less than 10 minutes left to play only to see the Eagles close the game with 14 unanswered points in a 45-28 final.

FIT traveled to in-state NAIA foe Ave Maria, holding a 10-point lead with 3:16 remaining, but AMU exploded for 14 points in the final 38 seconds, resulting in a heartbreaking, 45-41 final.



**OFFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK**

**West Alabama running back Kedrick Rhodes** (SR, 5-11,200, Ocala, FL)

Rhodes is the second different UWA Offensive winner this season after he led the Tigers to a 49-30 home upset of No. 1 Valdosta State in Thursday night's GSC-TV Game of the Week. The senior combined for 180 yards and three touchdowns, headlined by a game-high 157 yards rushing and two scores on 21 carries. The Ocala, FL native also caught one pass for a 23-yard touchdown, which knotted the score at 7-7 at 12:20 in the opening quarter.



**DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK**

**North Alabama linebacker Tavarius Wilson** (SR, 5-11, 235, Jackson, MS)

Wilson claims his second career laurel, first this season, thanks to an impressive performance in the Lions' 38-21 home triumph over West Georgia on Saturday. The senior led all defenders with 13 total tackles, thanks to a game-high nine solo stops. The Jackson, MS native also had a hand in two turnovers, forcing one fumble and returning an interception 30 yards for a touchdown with 8:03 left to play.



**SPECIAL TEAMS PLAYER OF THE WEEK**

**UNA punter Michael Schuster** (SR, 5-10, 208, Decatur, AL)

Schuster earns the second honor of his career, first in 2013, thanks to a standout effort in UNA's win over UWG. The senior punted four balls for 170 yards and a 42.5 average, while placing one punt inside UWG's 20-yard line. UWG only returned one punt, which was fumbled and led to a Lions' touchdown. The Decatur, AL native was also a weapon on kickoffs, booming seven kicks for 445 yards and three touchbacks. UWG was held to an 11.2 yard average on kickoffs, fumbling one which led to another UNA score.

Two league battles and three installments of the GSC-LSC “First and Ten Challenge” headline this week’s action as all seven Gulf South Conference squads take the field this Saturday.

Peach State rivals **No. 12 Valdosta State** and **West Georgia** lock horns for the 31st straight season when UWG hosts the VSU for the third year in a row. One thing is for sure when **newcomer Florida Tech** hosts **Provisional member Shorter**: one squad will earn their first Conference triumph of the season.

The GSC-LSC “First and Ten Challenge” restarts after a three-week hiatus with the GSC seeking to bounce back after a 2-1 deficit so far this season. The Gulf South Conference and the Lone Star Conference agreed to a set of regular-season games between its football member institutions for the second year in a row, including nine matchups in 2013.

**North Alabama** hosts Texas A&M-Kingsville in Game Eight of the GSC-TV LIVE Game of the Week package. The contest will be shown live by ESPN3, ESPN Game Plan, Mediacom, TV-24 in Anniston, AL, the Alabama Cable Network and WHCQ-TV 8 in Cleveland, MS. **No. 8 West Alabama** heads to the Lone Star State, facing its second consecutive nationally ranked foe, No. 24 Midwestern State. Last but not least, **Delta State** returns from its bye-week by hosting undefeated No. 14 Tarleton State.

**Game Breakdown:** For the third consecutive year, University Stadium is the stage for annual rivalry between GSC Peach State members **West Georgia** and **No. 12 Valdosta State**.

In fact, the rivals face off in Carrollton for the fourth time in last five matchups with VSU winning in 2009, 31-20, and 2012, 42-7, and UWG taking a 23-20 decision in 2011. The Blazers own a 21-9 edge in the all-time series and are winners of six of the last seven battles. Valdosta State has also posted nine wins in the 15 matchups in Carrollton. Both teams seek to bounce back from setbacks versus Alabama GSC rivals last week. UWG is 2-1 at home, while VSU is 0-1 on the road following last week’s loss at UWA.

**Game Breakdown:** North Alabama remains home for the second straight week, hosting its second GSC-TV telecast of the season when Lone Star Conference member Texas A&M-Kingsville comes to Florence.

UNA leads the all-time series, 5-0, going 3-0 at home dating back to the first contest in 1993. The Lions defended their home turf versus TAMKU in the NCAA Playoff Semifinals in 1993 (27-25) and in the 1994 Title Game (16-10) before taking a regular season decision in 1997, 17-12. North Alabama also posted triumphs in Texas in 1996 (24-7) and in 2012 (21-16).

UNA returns to the GSC-TV airwaves for the second time this season after topping Miles in Game One, 42-7. The Javelinas are back on GSC-TV for the second year in a row after falling to Valdosta State in 2012, 38-31. The Lions are 8-9 all-time in GSC-TV contests dating back to 2005. Saturday marks the third GSC vs. LSC televised clash of the season after Midwestern State defeated West Georgia on September 21 and Valdosta State topped Angelo State, 37-3.

DSU comes of a bye-week after falling at then No. 14 West Alabama two weeks ago, 48-14. Meanwhile, TSU sits atop the LSC standings with a perfect 5-0 overall mark. The Statesmen recorded an exciting 38-35 road win over the Texans in last year's first-ever meeting, but they have struggled versus the Lone Star Conference all-time, compiling a 4-14 mark. Delta State fell to Texas A&M-Commerce earlier this season in the Lone Star Football Festival in Arlington, TX, 45-37. DSU is 1-0 at McCool Stadium this year, while TSU 4-0 away from home.

**No. 14 West Alabama** (5-1, 3-0) exploded for 35 points in the second half, cruising past **No. 1 Valdosta State** (4-1, 2-1), 49-30, in Thursday night's GSC-TV home contest.

Special teams played a huge part in the first 16 points of the contest, starting with **VSU wide out Willie Downs** who returned the opening kickoff 97 yards for a touchdown. **UWA's Jake Walker** set up the Tigers' offense nicely in their opening drive, returning a kickoff 63 yards followed by a 23-yard TD reception by **running back Kedrick Rogers** with 12:20 left in the first quarter.

VSU's special teams struck again at 6:42 when **D'Amonte Ridley** blocked a punt in West Alabama's end zone, resulting in a two-point safety. UWA claimed its first lead at 12:32 in the second stanza via Rhodes' eight-yard scoring scamper, only to see **wide out Tyre Waiters** answer with a 16-yard touchdown grab at 6:10. Both defenses stiffened the rest of the way en route to a 16-14 halftime edge for Valdosta State.

The Tigers started the second half by scoring 14 unanswered points. Rhodes ran for a 15-yard TD at 11:55, followed by **wide receiver Malik Lofton's** 91-yard bomb at 9:22. **Wide out Seth Roberts** reeled-in a 29-yard score with 2:15 left in the third frame and **Chad Toocheck** followed with a 10-yarder at 12:06 in the final quarter. **Valdosta State signal caller Cayden Cochran** ran for a 15-yard score at 9:46, but the Tigers slammed the door as **tight end Tyler O'Neal** capped a 10-play, 75-yard drive with an 18-yard TD catch.

Rhodes ran for a game-high 157 yards and two TDs on 21 carries and also added 23 yards through the air. **UWA quarterback Kyle Caldwell** completed 9-for-18 passes for 252 yards and three scores, while Lofton led all players with 100 yards on just two catches. The victory was UWA's second in a row at home over VSU and third regular season win in the last four seasons.

**North Alabama** (3-2, 2-1) handed **West Georgia** (4-2, 1-1) its first GSC loss of the season, celebrating Homecoming, 38-21.

UWG won the first quarter, posting the lone score when **quarterback Austin Trainor** ran for a two-yard touchdown at 4:54. UNA tied matters just 39 seconds into the second quarter thanks to **quarterback Luke Wingo's** one-yard scoring sneak, but the Wolves responded at 9:36 via **wide receiver Denarius Appling's** six-yard TD grab.

**GSC Provisional member Shorter** (0-6, 0-3) put a scare into No. 18 Carson-Newman, but the visitors closed the game with 14 unanswered points en route to a 45-28 win over SU.
