#### BLOWOUTS HEADLINE GSC LEAGUE FOOTBALL RESULTS

Lopsided results dominated last week's Gulf South Conference Football action.

Saturday's trio of contests were decided by an average of 38 points, led by **North Alabama's** (5-2, 3-1) dominate, 57-7, victory at then **No. 11 Valdosta State** (5-2, 3-2). UNA handed the Blazers their worst defeat in school history, which previously came versus UNA in 1982 (53-7). North Alabama forced six turnovers and passed for a season-high 304 yards, running its GSC-best winning streak to four.

**No. 20 West Alabama** (6-2, 4-0) celebrated Homecoming at **West Georgia's** (4-4, 1-3) expense, 45-14. UWA galloped for 335 yards rushing as the Tigers preserved their perfect Conference record at 4-0. Quarterback Kyle Caldwell combined for 321 yards and three touchdowns, led by a game-best 146 yards on the ground.

**Florida Tech** (3-5, 1-3) capped off its first-ever Homecoming game by easing past in-state NAIA foe Warner, 37-3. FIT's defense set the tone for the night, holding the Royals to minus-11 yards rushing. The Panthers also secured their first-ever consecutive victory in its inaugural Division II season.

**Delta State** (5-2, 3-1) kicked off the week by topping **Provisional member Shorter** (0-8, 0-5) on the road in Thursday's GSC-TV Game of the Week, 38-17. DSU turned three SU turnovers into 21 points, led by back-to-back fumbles to start the second half. The win was sweet revenge for the Statesmen who were upset in Rome, GA by the Hawks last year.



**OFFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK**

**West Alabama quarterback Kyle Caldwell** (JR, 5-7, 165, Dadeville, AL).

Caldwell posts the second award of the season and his career, after leading UWA to a 45-14 home victory over West Georgia. The junior combined for 321 total yards, led by a game-high 146 yard on 15 carries. The Dadeville, AL native also completed 14-of-19 passes for 175 yards and three touchdowns. His three TD tosses moved him into second place in the Tigers' all-time career TD pass list.



**DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK**

**North Alabama linebacker Tavarius Wilson** (SR, 5-11, 235, Jackson, MS).

Wilson claims his third career laurel, second of the season, spearheading UNA's defense in a 57-7 road triumph over No. 11 Valdosta State. The senior led all tacklers with 11 total stops, including a game-high eight solo tackles. The Jackson, MS native also forced a fumble and blocked VSU's 44-yard field goal attempt with 1:44 left in the first half.



**SPECIAL TEAMS PLAYER OF THE WEEK**

**West Alabama placekicker Mark Grant** (FR, 5-7, 160, Panama City, FL).

Grant records his second Special Teams accolade of the season, keeping his perfect field goal record alive in the Tigers', 45-14 win over West Georgia. The freshman combined for nine total points, going 6-for-6 on point-after kicks and connecting on his lone field goal attempt when he booted a 32-yarder at 5:11 in the fourth quarter. The Panama City, FL native also boomed eight kickoffs for 448 yards (56.0-yard average) and two touchbacks.

**Game Breakdown:** One team will earn its first GSC-TV win of the season when **West Georgia** hosts **Florida Tech** in Game 10 of the Game of the Week slate.

UWG is 0-1 in GSC telecasts this year, following a 38-28 home setback versus Midwestern State in Game Four. FIT plays its first-ever GSC-TV contest on Thursday, but the Panthers return to television for second time in 2013 after losing at home to West Alabama in the NCAA Division II Game of the Week on September 19. Overall, the Wolves are 5-11 in GSC-TV clashes dating back to 2005. West Georgia is 2-2 at University Stadium, while Florida Tech is 0-4 away from home. The schools face off for the first time ever.

**Game Breakdown:** One of the top rivalries in Division II writes another chapter this Saturday when **No. 20 West Alabama** travels to Florence, AL for the 67th meeting versus **North Alabama**.

UWA holds a one-game lead over UNA for the top spot in the GSC standings and the No. 4 Tigers are also ranked two spots ahead of UNA in the regional rankings. West Alabama could lock up at least a share of the league title with a win, while the Lions could improve their regional resume and put themselves in great position for at least a share of the crown.

North Alabama owns a commanding lead in the all-time series, 48-17-1, but West Alabama has gained some ground the last four years by winning three of the last five battles. If recent history is any indication, fans can expect a thrilling contest as the last two battles inside Braly Municipal Stadium have been decided by four total points. UWA outlasted UNA in four overtimes in 2009, 31-28, followed by the Lions' 24-23 squeaker in 2010. North Alabama is 29-7 all-time over the Tigers at home.

**Game Breakdown:** Delta State hosts Homecoming and seeks to get back on the winning track in its series versus Valdosta State.

Last year, VSU put the brakes on a six-game skid versus DSU in an offensive shootout, 59-41. Overall, the Statesmen hold an 18-13-1 series lead and are 9-7-1 at home. The Blazers' last triumph in Cleveland, MS came in 2005 (24-23).

The result of Saturday's face off will have ripple effects throughout the league and Super Region Two. Delta State is tied for second in the GSC standings and is one position ahead of Valdosta State in the regional rankings at No. 8. Neither team can afford a loss if they hope to extend their campaigns to the post-season. VSU is ranked No. 22 nationally by D2Football.com, while DSU continued to receive votes in the AFCA Top 25.

Delta State turned three Shorter University turnovers into 21 points to come away with a 38-17 victory in Rome, Ga. at Barron Stadium on Thursday, Oct. 24. Trenton Warren recorded six tackles, one pass break up and two of the key fumble recoveries.

DSU (5-2, 3-1 GSC) found balance in the game with the rushing racking up 182 yards and four different rushers finding the end zone. Tyler Sullivan continued to improve completing 22-of-28 passing for 214 yards and a touchdown. Rory Island led the Statesmen defense with 10 tackles on the night.

Warren, the senior defensive back, jump-started the Statesmen defense recovering a Shorter (0-8, 0-5 GSC) fumble on the opening possession of the game to give the Delta State offense an opportunity to strike first.

Freshman signal caller Tyler Sullivan and company marched down the field for 69 yards on 12 plays, finishing with a 3-yard pass to Reed Falkner to go ahead 7-0 with 9:49 remaining in the first quarter.

The Statesmen offense struck again quickly, following a great stand by the defense unit, putting together a four play 36-yard drive to go ahead 14-0 with 3:10 remaining. Justin McArthur punched through the goal line for the Green-and-White on a 3-yard scamper.

After being held scoreless the first quarter of action, the Hawks put together a seven play 78-yard drive to close the gap 14-7 with 9:20 left in the second quarter. The drive culminated in a Bradley Moon 4-yard rush up the middle after two SU fourth down conversions.

The half closed with Delta State rushing for 55 yards on 13 carries and 110 yards passing. Timothy Foy led Statesmen rushing attack with 26 yards and with Sullivan going 13-of-17 passing and a score. Casey Osborne recorded four receptions for 47 yards.

Eric Dodson led Shorter in both the rushing and passing categories carrying the ball eight times for 45 yards and completing 6-of-8 of his pass attempts for 55 yards.

Delta State stalled on the opening possession of the second half after entering the Shorter red zone, but the defense quickly put the ball back into the offenses hands by forcing a fumble on Hawks' first offensive play. Freshman linebacker Landry Tullo recovered the fumble and Richard Freelon crashed into the end zone from 7 yards out to give the Green-and-White a 21-7 with 12:04 on the clock.

Turnovers plagued the Hawks in the contest and on the ensuing kickoff the Statesmen forced yet another, recovering the ball on the Shorter 20 yard line. Sullivan capped off a quick 3-play drive on a 2-yard rush up the middle to put DSU ahead 28-7 with 11:18 left in the second quarter.

The Hawks offense found some cohesion and put together an 8 play 60-yard drive that culminated in a Guy Hunt 40-yard field goal to notch the score at 28-10 with 4:17 left in the third quarter.

Vince Sciorrotta responded in kind for the Statesmen, booting through a 25-yard field goal to give the Green-and-White a 31-10 advantage with 00:39 ticks on the clock in the third quarter.

The Hawks did not go away as Kirk Wilson put SU into the end zone on a 23-yard rush around the right end 31-17 13:32 remaining, putting the score at 31-17.

The Statesmen salted away the game after a Foy rushing touchdown to go up 38-17 with 1:51 on the clock in the final period of play.

Shorter racked up 236 yards rushing on 55 attempts with Eric Dodson completing 11-of-15 passing for 136 yards. Jordan Shaw was the leading tackler on the night with 10 total tackles.

**NORTH ALABAMA 57, @ #11 VALDOSTA STATE 7**

North Alabama got its fourth consecutive win in impressive style, routing 11th ranked Valdosta State 57-7 at Bazemore-Hyder Stadium. It was the worst loss in VSU football history, topping a 46-point defeat at the hands of North Alabama in 1982, 53-7.

Trailing 7-3 in the first quarter, North Alabama took control, scoring 54 unanswered points. The Lions led 19-7 at the half and scored on all but one of their offensive possessions in the second half. The UNA defense, meanwhile, picked off four Valdosta State passes and also returned a fumble for a touchdown.

The 50-point victory margin for UNA tied for the seventh biggest win in school history.

North Alabama has won its last four games in Valdosta by a combined score of 192-77 and has an all-time winning record in Valdosta, 11-8-1. UNA extended its lead in the all-time series with VSU to 21-15-1.

UNA gained 536 total yards, throwing for a season-high 304 and rushing for another 232. VSU gained 426 yards but turned the ball over six times. UNA's Luke Wingo was 10-for-13 passing for 226 yards. Jacob Tucker was four-of-five for 78 yards. Valdosta State quarterback Cayden Cochran was 24-of-45 for 249 yards and threw four interceptions.

North Alabama still has not allowed a single point this season in the third quarter, outscoring its opponents 61-0 in the period.

North Alabama got on the scoreboard first midway through the first quarter on a 20-yard field goal by Will Craig. The drive began at UNA's 13 yard line where Lamonte Thompson gained 20 yards on first down. Luke Wingo then hit Jason Smith with a 62-yard pass to the Blazers' five-yard line. UNA was unable to push it in from there and Craig's field goal made it 3-0 at the 6:30 mark of the first quarter.

The Blazers marched 56 yards in six plays for their first score. Cochran passed 38 yards to Chris Anderson for a touchdown with five seconds left in the quarter. Anthony Pistelli's PAT gave VSU a 7-3 lead.

UNA answered with an impressive 12-play, 80-yard drive to regain the lead. Wingo hit Grant Lake for a 35-yard gain to get the Lions in scoring position. Wingo then hit Korey Jones in the right corner of the end zone with a 20-yard scoring pass. Craig missed the extra-point but UNA led 9-7 with 12:42 left in the second quarter.

A Valdosta State scoring threat was averted when Caleb Massey picked off a Cochran pass in the end zone at 8:21 of the second quarter. UNA then marched 80 yards in seven plays to extend its lead. A 31-yard pass from Wingo to Chris Simpson move the ball to the VSU 8 and a 22-yard run by Thompson set UNA up inside the five. Wingo closed the drive with a three-yard TD run and Craig's PAT made it 16-7 with 5:01 left in the half.

On the first possession of the second half, VSU drove quickly to the UNA 17-yard line before Lamar Smith picked up a Blazer fumble and returned it 83 yards for a touchdown. Craig's PAT made it 26-7 with 11:43 left in the third quarter.

UNA's fourth interception of the day setup another score as Levi Fell took a Cochran pass 46 yards to the Blazers 37. The Lions drive stalled and Craig booted a 27-yard field goal to extend UNA's lead to 29-7 at 6:48 of the third quarter.

After stopping Valdosta State on downs, UNA scored again just four plays later on a 37-yard run by Chris Coffey. A 22-yard pass from Wingo to Lee Mayhall on third down to set up the score. Craig's PAT made the score 36-7 with 2:59 left in the third quarter.

After again stopping VSU on downs, UNA drove 65 yards in just four plays to score again. Jacob Tucker threw for a 41-yard gain to Korey Jones and finally scored the touchdown on a five-yard run. Tucker passed to Jones for the two-point conversion and UNA led 44-7 with 13:23 left in the game.

UNA scored on its fourth straight possession of the half when the Lions drove 55 yards in 12 plays for another touchdown. Tucker scored on a six-yard run but also had a key 19-yard run for a first down on the possession where he bulldozed over a VSU defender in the open field to get the first down. Craig's PAT followed Tucker's TD run and UNA led 51-7 with 8:07 left in the game.

The final UNA score came on a 31-yard Diamond Simmons run around left end with 2:02 left in the game. Craig missed the PAT to make the final count 57-7. [Box score](#)

Kyle Caldwell combined for 321 yards and passed for three touchdowns as West Alabama crushed West Georgia, 45-14, in Gulf South Conference action Saturday at Tiger Stadium.

West Alabama improved to 6-2 overall and 4-0 in GSC action heading into next week's game at rival North Alabama (5-2, 3-1). West Georgia lost its third straight, dropping to 4-4 and 1-3.

Caldwell ran for 146 yards in addition to completing 14-of-19 passes for 175 yards, but the junior from Dadeville, Ala., said this Homecoming victory was sealed long before the Tigers ever stepped on the Tiger Stadium turf.

Chad Toocheck, who had a touchdown reception as one of his four catches for 49 yards, agreed with Caldwell. Seth Roberts led Tiger receivers with five catches for 70 yards and a score. Tyler O'Neal hauled in Caldwell's other TD pass.

West Alabama rang up 520 yards of total offense, while holding West Georgia to just a pair of scores after building a 35-0 lead. The Tigers had 31 first downs and rushed for 335 yards, including 130 from Javae Swindle.

The West Alabama defense allowed two West Georgia quarterbacks to complete just 11-of-27 passes for 155 yards while intercepting the Wolves three times. Demetrus McNeal had a pair of interceptions and Malcolm Butler added another for UWA.

Tied with Marty Washington (92-93) coming into the game, Caldwell moved into second place on the West Alabama career touchdown pass list in the first quarter, tossing his 41st and 42nd to Toocheck and O'Neal, for 16 and 19 yards, respectively.

Gary Johnston added to his career rushing touchdown record with his 24th and 25th TD runs on 1-yard plunges in the second and third quarters.

West Georgia threatened late in the first half, but McNeal intercepted Wolves quarterback Dallas Dickey in the end zone to end the threat and West Alabama took a 21-0 lead into the half.

The Tigers stretched the lead to 35-0 with just over 10 minutes left in the third quarter on Johnston's second touchdown and a 15-yard scoring pass from Caldwell to Roberts. The TD reception was the ninth of the year for Roberts.

West Georgia got on the scoreboard with 5:50 left in the third period on an 11-yard scoring pass from Dickey to Bobby Burum, cutting the UWA lead to 35-7.

The Wolves then recovered an onside kick to retake possession, then converted a fourth-down try at the UWA 47 to set up a 23-yard scoring pass from Dickey to Denarius Appling to cut the UWA lead to 35-14 with 3:37 left in the third period.

McNeal's second interception of the game set the Tigers up at the West Georgia 36, where Caldwell navigated his way for a 36-yard score, and then a 1-yard touchdown run, only to have both called back for holding.

Swindle scored for the third time on the five-play, 36-yard drive, this time from 10 yards out on an untimed play, to give West Alabama a 42-14 lead at the end of third quarter.

Mark Grant capped off West Alabama scoring with a 32-yard field goal with 5:11 left to play, leaving him a perfect 5-for-5 this season. Grant was also perfect on all six PAT kicks.

Robert Jones led West Alabama defenders with 10 tackles. Mario Gainer had five stops, including one sack and one tackle for loss. Tyrell Adams had seven tackles for West Georgia, who recorded eight stops behind the line of scrimmage for minus 33 yards.

Dickey led UWG rushing with 69 yards on 12 carries. Burum caught five passes for 80 yards. [Box score](#)

**@ FLORIDA TECH 37, WARNER 3 (HOMECOMING)**

It went just the way a homecoming game is supposed to go: A big crowd. An electric atmosphere. And a few hours later ... a big win by the home team.

It was the first homecoming game in Florida Tech history, and with a number of alumni on hand for the first time, it gave the Panthers a second chance to make a good first impression.

Florida Tech's defense certainly took advantage, limiting Warner to just 130 yards of total offense — including minus-11 yards rushing — on 77 plays for an average of just 1.7 yards per play.

Though the players tried to treat it as a regular game, there was no doubt this one had a different feel to it.

Ferguson, for instance, said he usually has a few butterflies and feelings of nervousness before a game. Not this time.

Cadore noted how much the number of fans in the stands had grown from the time the Panthers went into the locker room following their pre-game warm-ups until the moment when they came onto the field to start the game.

From this day forward, football and homecoming will go hand-in-hand at Florida Tech, and Panthers players are excited to know that they have now become part of the school's traditional celebration.

Winning the game Saturday, well, that marked another first in this inaugural Florida Tech season.

As a number of players said, the homecoming tradition only figures to get bigger from here.

Quarterback Sean Ashley, who missed the past four games with an injury, celebrated his return to the lineup by coming off the bench to score three rushing touchdowns.

Not only was his first Florida Tech homecoming game one to remember, he plans on being a part of the homecoming tradition even after his playing days for the Panthers are over.

With a short week before the Panthers travel to face West Georgia in a Gulf South Conference contest, a dominating win like Saturday's was just what Florida Tech head coach Steve Englehart was looking for.

After all, as he said earlier in the week, homecoming game results are usually magnified whether you win, or lose. [Box score](#)
