VSU AND UWA VICTORIES SET UP GSC FOOTBALL CLASH

The Gulf South Conference's top ranked team's notched league wins last week, setting up a much-anticipated GSC-TV matchup this Thursday.

No. 14 West Alabama (4-1, 2-0) kicked off last week, hosting Thursday's GSC-TV LIVE Game of the Week. UWA turned-in a dominate performance on both sides of the ball, scoring 45 unanswered points en route to a 48-14 home victory over **Delta State** (3-2, 2-1). The Tigers held DSU to minus-seven yards rushing route to their first-ever GSC-TV triumph versus the Statesmen.

No. 1 Valdosta State (4-0, 2-0) remained perfect on the season, celebrating Homecoming by cruising past **Florida Tech** (1-4, 0-3) on Saturday, 52-14. VSU found the end zone in all three phases of the game, scoring four offensive touchdowns, two more on defense and one more on special teams. The Blazers stretched their winning streak to 14 dating back to 2012.

All eyes will be trained towards Livingston, AL on Thursday when Valdosta State and West Alabama lock horns in Game Seven of the 2013 GSC-TV Game of the Week.

North Alabama (2-2, 1-1) secured its first Conference victory of the season, traveling to post its second straight shutout of **Provisional member Shorter** (0-5, 0-3). UNA earned its first road decision of the season by posting a 41-0 final against SU for the second year in a row.

West Georgia (4-1, 1-0) stepped back out of league action, celebrating Homecoming at NAIA member Point University's expense, 49-3. The Wolves moved to 4-1 for the first time since 2001, rolling up over 600 yards of total offense for just the second time in school history. **Denarius Appling** recorded his fifth career punt return for a touchdown, which is tied for second in the GSC Record Books.



OFFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Valdosta State running back Austin Scott (SO, 5-7, 174, Columbus, GA)

Scott collects his first career award and is VSU's first Offensive winner this season after leading the Blazers to a 52-14 Homecoming triumph over Florida Tech. The sophomore averaged 20.5 yards per carry by posting 123 yards on six attempts. The Columbus, GA native also ran for two touchdowns, highlighted by a career-long, 72-yard TD with 2:38 left in the third quarter.



DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

West Alabama linebacker Ryan Jones (JR, 6-2, 250, Irondale, AL)

Jones earns his first-ever accolade and UWA's first Defensive laurel of the season, spearheading UWA's defense in a 48-14 home victory on Thursday night over Delta State. The junior racked up six total tackles, led by five solo stops, 3.5 tackles for a loss of 19 yards and 2.0 sacks for a loss of 18 yards. The Irondale, AL native also forced two fumbles, one that was scooped up and returned for a touchdown.



SPECIAL TEAMS PLAYER OF THE WEEK

UWA placekicker Mark Grant (FR, 5-7, 160, Panama City, FL)

Grant notches UWA's first Special Teams award of the year, posting a perfect performance in the Tigers', 48-14 win over Delta State. The freshman nailed all two of his field goal attempts, booting a 37-yarder and a career-long 42-yarder. The Panama City, FL native also made good on all six of his point-after-kicks and he averaged 61.9 yards on kickoffs including two touchbacks.

The most anticipated matchup of the 2013 Gulf South Conference Football season is just one day away!

All eyes will be on Livingston, AL this Thursday when **defending NCAA Champion** and **No. 1 ranked Valdosta State** travels to **defending GSC Champion** and **No. 14 West Alabama** for Game Seven of the GSC-TV LIVE Game of the Week package.

Last year, the rivals split a pair of contests in Valdosta with UWA earning a 39-28 regular-season decision before VSU ended the Tigers' season in the Second Round of the Division II Playoffs, 49-21. West Alabama snapped the Blazers' 24-game series streak in the lone GSC-TV meeting between the schools in 2010 at UWA, 24-21.

Saturday's slate is headlined by the only other Conference battle this week when **North Alabama** hopes to celebrate its Homecoming versus **West Georgia**. **Provisional member Shorter** seeks its first win of the season when No. 18 South Atlantic Conference foe Carson-Newman comes to town. **Florida Tech** also steps out of GSC action, traveling to in-state NAIA rival Ave Maria.

Game Breakdown: The matchup that GSC fans have pointed during the pre-season before the season even started is on tap this Thursday when **defending NCAA Champion, No. 1 Valdosta State** goes to **defending GSC Champion, No. 14 West Alabama** in the seventh 2013 GSC-TV LIVE Game of the Week.

Thursday marks just the second all-time GSC-TV meeting between the schools after UWA celebrated a 24-21 triumph the last matchup inside Tiger Stadium in 2010. West Alabama hosts its second straight GSC telecast, and third of the season, after topping Clark-Atlanta on September 7 and Delta State last Thursday. VSU returns to GSC-TV for the second time this year after clipping Angelo State at home on September 28. The Blazers own the best GSC-TV win-loss record of any league member (13-6), while UWA is 12-8.

Valdosta State leads the all-time series, 29-3, but the rivals have traded victories in the last five meetings. They faced off twice in Valdosta in 2012 with UWA earning a 39-28 decision during the regular season, only to see VSU record a 49-21 win in the NCAA Playoffs. The Blazers are also 12-2 inside Tiger Stadium dating back to 1983.

No. 14 West Alabama (4-1, 2-0) held **Delta State** (3-2, 2-1) scoreless for nearly three quarters en route to a 48-14 Thursday night, GSC-TV home triumph.

UWA forced a DSU fumble on the game's opening drive and the offense grabbed a 7-0 lead at 11:10 when **quarterback Gary Johnston** ran for a two-yard touchdown. **Tyler O'Neal** gave the Tigers a 14-0 edge at 1:06 via a 21-yard scoring reception. West Alabama kept the scorekeeper busy in the second quarter by scoring 24 additional points. **Placekicker Mark Grant** booted a 37-yard field goal at 7:30 and **running back Javae Swindle** ran for a 29-yard TD at 6:02. **Wide out Seth Roberts** hauled-in a 79-yard scoring strike at 1:24 and the defense capped the first half when Dereck Jordan returned a fumble, seven-yards for six points with 52 seconds on the clock.

West Alabama stretched its lead to 45-0 thanks to **Malik Lofton's** four-yard TD catch at 2:40 in the third frame, only to see DSU deny the shutout via **Justin McArthur's** one-yard jaunt with 25 ticks on the clock. Grant nailed a career-long, 42-yard field goal with 8:57 remaining in the game and Statesmen **wide receiver Patrick Bethley** closed out the scoring by collecting a 27-yard TD catch at 2:21.

Starting UWA quarterback Kyle Caldwell completed 11-of-22 passes for 186 yards and two TDs, while **Reggie Hall** came off the bench to lead all players with 123 yards on 11 carries. The contest marked the Tigers' first back-to-back wins over DSU since 1991-92. [Boxscore](#)

@ #1 VALDOSTA STATE 52, FLORIDA TECH 14 (HOMECOMING)

No. 1 Valdosta State (4-0, 2-0) used standout performances in all three phases to cruise past **Florida Tech** (1-4, 0-2) in Homecoming action, 52-14.

VSU held a 17-0 halftime lead without scoring an offensive touchdown. **Willie Downs** lit the scoreboard just 1:11 seconds into the going when he returned a punt 62 yards for a TD and **placekicker Anthony Pistelli** closed the first-quarter scoring via a 42-yard field goal at 9:57. The Blazers' defense upped the lead to 17-0 at 10:40 in the second stanza when **Tevin Davis** returned a fumble, 56 yards for a TD.

Valdosta State used back-to-back rushing touchdowns to stretch its lead to 31-0 before FIT was able to deny the shutout at 3:01 in the third quarter. **VSU running back Austin Scott** ran for a 16-yard score at 9:42, followed by **Cedric O'Neal's** 63-yard scamper at 4:39. **Aaron George** posted the Panthers' first points by hauling-in a 13-yard catch at 3:01.

Scott galloped for a 72-yard touchdown with 2:38 left in the third and **Jeremy Grable** returned an interception, 27 yards for six points. **Nick Davis** capped VSU's scoring thanks to a one-yard TD run at 14:19 in the final frame and Florida Tech added seven more points with 31 ticks on the clock.

Scott ran for a game-high 123 yards and two scores on just carries, while O'Neal added 97 yards on seven attempts. Valdosta State stretched its overall winning streak to 14 games and its home streak to eight. [Boxscore](#)

NORTH ALABAMA 41, @ SHORTER 0 (HOMECOMING)

It was déjà vu all over again for **North Alabama** (2-2, 1-1) as the Lions captured a 41-0 win over Homecoming host **Shorter** for the second year in a row.

UNA opened its scoring at 8:39 in the first quarter when **wide receiver Jason Smith** caught a 55-yard scoring strike, followed by **Will Craig's** 42-yard field goal at 2:42. **Quarterback Luke Wingo** closed out the first-half by running for a two-yard TD as time expired.

Running back Chris Coffey provided the lone points in the third frame, pounding-in a two-yard touchdown at 11:34. Craig added a 30-yard field goal with 13:26 left in regulation and **Jacob Tucker** rounded out the quarter with a rushing scores from six and three yards out.

Tucker led all players with 82 yards on eight carries, while Coffey added 79 yards on 10 attempts. Wingo completed 8-of-15 passes for 129 yards and one touchdown. The victory marked the first shutout by the Lions since they blanked Shorter by the exact same score a year ago. [Boxscore](#)

@ WEST GEORGIA 49, POINT 3 (HOMECOMING)

West Georgia (4-1, 1-0) faced its fourth non-conference foe of the season, celebrating its Homecoming by topping Point, 49-3.

UWG sprinted to a 21-0 lead in the first quarter, sparked by **Denarius Appling's** 68-yard punt return for a touchdown at 12:29. **Running back Quan Jones** added a six-yard rushing TD at 7:21 and then reeled-in an 83-yard scoring pass at 2:42. **Wide out Bobby Burum** completed the first-half by grabbing a four-yard TD with 2:04 remaining.

Running back Seth Hinsley found pay dirt on the opening drive of the second half, running for a six-yarder. PU spoil the potential shutout with a field goal at 6:47, but the Wolves closed the door via **Derick Seward's** one-yard touchdown run and Adam Holly's 12-yarder.

Jones compiled 181 all-purpose yards, led by 102 receiving and 79 on the ground. Appling recorded his fifth career punt return for a touchdown, which is tied for second in the GSC Record Books. [Boxscore](#)
