UNA, UWA LOCK UP SHARES OF GSC FOOTBALL TITLE

Results went as expected this past weekend as **No. 20 North Alabama** and **West Alabama** played their way to a share of the 2013 Gulf South Conference Football Title.

UNA cruised to a 55-28 victory at **newcomer Florida Tech** on Saturday, while UWA breezed past **Provisional member Shorter** at home, 63-17. The results gave the Tigers a piece of their second consecutive league crown, while the Lions finished at the top for the first time since 2009.

West Alabama became the second school in four years to repeat as GSC Champions. Delta State was also involved in a three-way tie in 2010, but rebounded to win outright in 2011.

North Alabama earns its 10th all-time GSC Crown: the most in league history. The Championship is UNA's first since it won outright in 2009. Valdosta State and Delta State are currently tied behind the Lions in the number all-time crowns at six.

The 2013 Championship could be broken into a third piece on Thursday night if **Delta State** upends **West Georgia** in the GSC-TV LIVE Game of the Week finale and the last Conference clash of the season. A DSU win would result in a three-way for first-place; the first since 2010 and the fourth all-time dating back to 1988. The Statesmen disposed of NAIA Concordia College (AL) at home on Saturday, 77-0, in its first shutout since 2006.

Two GSC Peach State members suffered a pair of setbacks versus non-conference foes last week.

Valdosta State hosted UNC-Pembroke in Thursday's GSC-TV Game of the Week. VSU trailed 20-0, but fought back in the second half only to see an interception on the final drive ice the final score for the Braves, 34-29.

West Georgia traveled over 1,000 miles to face West Texas A&M in a GSC-LSC "First And Ten Challenge" clash. UWG pulled within a touchdown at 10:27 in the second half, but the Buffaloes reeled off 35 unanswered points en route to a 63-23 triumph.



OFFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

West Alabama running back Javae Swindle (SO, 5-4, 162, Thorsby, AL)

Swindle takes home his first-ever award while also becoming the third different UWA Offensive honoree of the season. The sophomore sparked the Tigers in their 63-17 home victory over Shorter, rushing 13 times for 182 yards (14.0 average) and three touchdowns. The Thorsby, AL native was pulled from the game with five minutes left in the third quarter and he became just the third player in school history to run for 1,000 yards in a season (1,106). His first score of the game came from 43 yards and gave UWA a 14-7 lead with 4:35 left in the first quarter.



DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

North Alabama linebacker Gabe Poe (SR, 5-10, 210, Pheba, MS)

Poe collects his second laurel of the season and is UNA's third straight honoree. The senior spearheaded the Lions' defense in a 55-28 road triumph over Florida Tech, racking up a game-high 11 total tackles, including five solo stops and one-half of a tackle for loss. The Pheba, MS native did not stop there, intercepting his first pass of the year and logging two pass breakups.



SPECIAL TEAMS PLAYER OF THE WEEK

UNA kick returner Philbert Martial (FR, 5-10, 175, Mobile, AL)

Martial earns his first-career accolade after leading UNA's kick return squad against Florida Tech. The freshman returned three kickoffs for 115 yards and a 38.3 average. FIT closed its deficit to 34-21 on the first drive of the second half, but the Mobile, AL native helped set up a UNA score on its next possession by reeling off a 64-yard return.

@ WEST ALABAMA 63, SHORTER 17

West Alabama (7-3, 5-1) defended its GSC Title in impressive fashion, outgunning **Provisional member Shorter (1-9, 0-6)** at home, 63-17.

SU drew first blood when **quarterback Eric Dodson** scored a one-yard rushing touchdown on the game's first possession at 11:38. UWA closed the first quarter with 21 unanswered points. **Seth Roberts** caught a 48-yard TD at 9:54, **running back Javae Swindle** ran for a 43-yarder at 4:35 and **wide out Chad Toocheck** collected a 38-yard reception as time expired.

The Hawks cut the Tigers lead to 21-17 thanks to 10 straight points to open the second frame. **B.J. McCoy** found the end zone from two yards out a 12:41, while **Guy Hunt** nailed a 48-yard field goal at 9:46. West Alabama dominated the rest of the contest, scoring the final 42 points.

UWA held a 35-17 halftime lead via **Gary Johnston's** two-yard touchdown run and Toocheck's 19-yard scoring reception with 23 ticks on the clock. The Tigers poured on 28 more points in the final 30 minutes, led by a pair of Swindle TD runs in the third stanza.

Swindle ran for 182 yards and three touchdowns on 13 carries, while **signal caller Kyle Caldwell** completed 18-of-24 passes for 299 yards and three scores. Roberts caught seven balls for 140 yards and Toocheck added six receptions for 121 yards. The victory gave UWA its first-ever back-to-back Conference Championship and its third overall crown. NORTH ALABAMA 55, @ FLORIDA TECH 28

North Alabama (7-2, 5-1) claimed a share of its first GSC Title since 2009, finding pay dirt on its first five offensive possessions in a 55-28 victory at **newcomer Florida Tech (3-7, 1-5)**.

UNA sprinted to a 14-0 lead less than five minutes into the contest, thanks to a pair of touchdown runs by **running back Lamonte Thompson**. Thompson capped the game's opening possession with a 31-yard TD scamper at 12:32 and followed with a 19-yarder at 10:28. FIT cut its deficit in half via **Aaron George's** 31-yard scoring reception at 5:07, but the Lions outscored the Panthers in the second quarter, 20-7.

Jacob Tucker gave North Alabama a 21-7 advantage, thanks to a one-yard TD plunge at 13:42 in the second frame and **wide out Jason Smith** grabbed a 23-yard touchdown pass at 8:37. **Florida Tech wide receiver Xavier Milton** caught a six-yard score at 4:22, but **quarterback Luke Wingo** gave UNA a 34-14 halftime lead after a 36-yard TD scamper at 2:56.

North Alabama did not take its foot off the throttle in the second half, outscoring FIT, 21-14. Thompson ran for a game-high 117 yards and three touchdowns on nine carries, while Wingo added 178 total yards. Wingo passed for 107 with one TD and ran for another 71 yards and a score. UNA sewed up at a share of its all-time GSC leading 10th Championship. The 2013 crown marked the first time the Lions have shared the top honor. [Box score](#)

@ DELTA STATE 77, CONCORDIA (AL) 0

Delta State (7-2, 4-1) stepped out of the conference to record its first shutout since 2006 thanks to eight turnovers in a 77-0 domination of Concordia College (AL), 77-0. DSU clicked on both sides of the ball, scoring a touchdown in all three phases of the game en route to the second-most points in school history.

The Statesmen tallied 28 points in each of the first two quarters. **Jarvis York** lit the scoreboard first, hauling-in a 10-yard touchdown pass at 8:44 in the first frame, while **Ken Gray** returned a blocked punt for six points at 6:56. **Michael Davison** ran for a three-yard TD at 3:09 and **Casey Osborne** closed out the opening 15 minutes with a 21-yard scoring grab with 10 ticks on the clock.

Ricky Hunt posted a 29-yard touchdown reception just 33 seconds into the second quarter and the defense got into the act when **Dandrick Jackson** returned an interception 18 yards for a TD. **Richard Freelon** rumbled for a four-yard score at 6:43 and **Timothy Foy** completed the first-half scoring by running for a four yarder at 1:21. Delta State did not attempt a pass in the second half, rushing for three more touchdowns and the defense continued to dominate the Hornets en route to the shutout.

Quarterback Tyler Sullivan completed 7-of-13 passes for 178 yards and three touchdowns, while Osborne caught five passes for 115 yards. **Justin McArthur** led all rushers with 77 yards on 11 attempts. DSU blanked its opponent for the first time since 2006 when it topped Arkansas-Monticello, 53-0. Its 77-point total was the second all-time behind an 84-0 win over Illinois-Chicago in 1969. #14 UNC-PEMBROKE 34, @ VALDOSTA STATE 29 (THURSDAY, GSC-TV)

Valdosta State (5-4, 3-3) faced its second non-conference foe in front of a GSC-TV audience this season, falling late in the fourth quarter to No. 14 UNC-Pembroke, 34-29.

VSU fell behind, 20-0, in the second quarter before **wide out Seantavius Jones** caught a 69-yard scoring bomb with 3:14 remaining in the first half. The Blazers cut the score to 20-14 at 11:53 in the third stanza when **running back Cedric O'Neal** galloped 37 yards for a touchdown, only to see the Braves answer at 8:21.

Valdosta State's defense pulled the hosts to within 27-23 at 3:29 following a team safety and **Dominique Wheeler's** 12-yard interception return for a TD. UNCP pushed its lead back to 34-23 right before the end of the quarter and held that edge until late in the fourth quarter. **VSU wide out Regginald Lewis** caught a five-yard scoring pass with just 43 ticks on the clock, but the Blazers missed the two-point try. Valdosta State made good on the ensuing on-side kick attempt, but backup **quarterback Kaleb Nobles** tossed an interception, sealing the game for the Braves.

VSU starter Cayden Cochran passed for 169 yards and one score, while Nobles threw for 118 yards and another TD. Jones caught a game-high nine balls for 130 yards, while O'Neal ran for 90 yards on 11 carries. [Box score](#)

@ WEST TEXAS A&M 63, WEST GEORGIA 23

West Georgia (5-5, 2-3) ran for nearly 300 yards, but could not overcome costly turnovers in a 63-23 setback at West Texas A&M in a GSC-LSC "First And Ten Challenge" matchup.

WTAMU led 14-0 in the second quarter, post the lone touchdown in the first 15 minutes and another just 1:30 into the next period. UWG cut the score to 14-7 at 10:27 via **wide receiver Derick Seward's** five-yard TD catch. The Buffaloes controlled the rest of the game from there, hitting for 35 unanswered points which extended into the third quarter. **UWG running back Quan Jones** added a two-yard rushing TD in the third quarter and a one-yard in the fourth frame. Jones led the team with 97 yards and two scores on a game-high 19 carries. [Box score](#)
