### GSC POSTS 5-0 NON-CONFERENCE MARK IN FINAL WEEK

The final week of the 2013 Gulf South Conference Football regular season came to a close last week, headlined by a league upset and a perfect 5-0 record in non-conference action.

**West Georgia** and **Delta State** put the caps on Conference play in Thursday's GSC-TV LIVE Game of the Week finale in Carrollton, GA. DSU entered University Stadium with a chance to climb into a three-way tie for the league Title, but UWG had other ideas, upending the Statesmen, 38-20. The Wolves ran for 328 yards, while their defense held the DSU to minus-four yards rushing. West Georgia gave outgoing **head coach Darly Dickey** a victory in his final game on the sidelines.

**Future league member Shorter** started the GSC's non-conference success on Thursday night by upending nearby NAIA rival Point on the road, 24-10. The win was the Hawks second road triumph in the last three games of the season.

The Conference flexed its muscle on Saturday, posting four non-conference victories by a combined score of 187-65.

**West Alabama** rewrote the GSC Record Books in a dominating, 91-28 win over in-region, SIAC foe Central State. UWA set the Conference record for points in a game, finishing five points ahead of the previous mark.

**No. 16 North Alabama** and **Valdosta State** gave the Conference the final, 5-4, edge in the "GSC-LSC First And Ten Challenge" thanks to road triumphs. UNA ran past Tarleton State, 44-7, while VSU came from behind to top Texas A&M-Kingsville, 35-27. UNA shutout TSU in the first half, 10-0, and the Lions closed out the second half by scoring 27 unanswered points. VSU entered the final 15 minutes, trailing the Javelinas, 27-21, but the Blazers iced the victory with 14 unanswered points in the fourth frame.

**Florida Tech** wrapped up its inaugural campaign on a positive note via a 17-3 home victory versus in-state, NAIA foe Webber International.

The season continues for North Alabama which was the lone GSC team to advance to the 24-team, 2013 NCAA Division II Playoff field. No. 3 seed UNA hosts No. 6 seed Tuskegee this Saturday in the First Round at 12:00 pm (Central).



**OFFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK**

**West Alabama running back Javae Swindle** (SO, 5-4, 162, Thorsby, AL)

Swindle earns his second consecutive award after leading UWA to a record-setting, 91-28 home victory over in-region, SIAC foe Central State. The sophomore ran for a career-high 280 yards on 19 carries for a 14.7 average and also added three rushing touchdowns. His rushing total was the most in the GSC this season and also ranked third in the GSC's single-game record list. The Thorsby, AL native's longest run of the night came on an 88-yard TD scamper that extended the Tigers' lead to 49-28 just 1:13 into the second half. The 88-yarder also ranked as the sixth-longest in the league history.



**DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK**

**Valdosta State linebacker Jeremy Grable** (SR, 6-0, 216, Alpharetta, GA)

Grable collects his first career laurel and is VSU's second Defensive winner of the season. The senior spearheaded the Blazers' defense in a 35-27 triumph at Texas A&M-Kingsville, racking up a game-high 14 total tackles, led by five solo stops and one tackle for loss. The Alpharetta, GA native also had a hand in three turnovers, forcing a fumble, recovering another fumble and intercepting one pass that he returned 11 yards for a touchdown. The score came with 1:33 left in the second quarter, cutting Valdosta State's deficit to 17-14 at halftime.



**SPECIAL TEAMS PLAYER OF THE WEEK**

**North Alabama punter Michael Schuster** (SR, 5-10, 208, Decatur, AL)

Schuster claims his second accolade of the year and third of his career. The senior had a stellar outing in very windy conditions at Tarleton State, battling 20-mile per hour gusts in Stephenville, TX. The Decatur, AL native booted eight kickoffs for 491 yards (61.4 avg.) and forced five touchbacks. He also made two key plays as a punter kicking one punt for 40 yards that was downed inside the TSU 20 yard-line. With the game tied 0-0 late in the first quarter, a ball was snapped 30 yards over his head. He tracked the ball down, avoided two tacklers and fired an incomplete pass to a UNA receiver in the area that kept the Texans from taking over at the UNA 15 yard-line and they were back at their own 45. UNA then stopped the ensuing drive.

**UNA REPRESENTS GSC IN NCAA FOOTBALL PLAYOFFS**

For the first time since 2002, the Gulf South Conference placed just one team in the NCAA Division II Football Playoff field.

Representing the GSC this year is Co-Conference Champion North Alabama (8-2), which collected the No. 3 seed and returns to the post-season for the eighth time in the last nine seasons. The GSC seeks to repeat history that last it earned just one Playoff squad in 2002 when Valdosta State moved on to claim the National Crown. The league has been represented in the post-season in 37 of the last 38 years, missing out in 1976.

North Alabama hosts a Super Region Two, First Round Playoff contest for the first time in 10 years when the Lions topped Southern Arkansas, 48-24. No. 3 seed UNA faces No. 6 seed, in-state rival Tuskegee at Braly Municipal Stadium at Noon (Central). If victorious, North Alabama travels to No. 2 seed UNC-Pembroke on Saturday, November 30.

A total of 20 different football-playing schools have belonged to the GSC at some point since 1973 and 12 of those have earned at least one Playoff bid. The GSC has compiled 100 wins during that span along with a .629 winning percentage (100-59). In fact, of the last 25 national champions, 11\* have come from the GSC, seven from the former North Central Conference, four from the Mid-America Intercollegiate Athletic Association and three from the Great Lakes Intercollegiate Athletic Conference. The GSC holds the playoff record for different schools to win the championship game (6), championship game appearances (17) and different schools to appear in the championship game (6). \*--Mississippi College's 1989 national championship was vacated for NCAA infractions.

**Game Breakdown:** In-state Division II rivals, **GSC Co-Champion North Alabama** and SIAC West Division runner up Tuskegee match up in the post-season for the first time ever in Saturday's First Round NCAA Playoff contest at Braly Municipal Stadium in Florence, AL.

UNA makes its NCAA record-tying 18th overall post-season appearance, first since 2011 when the Lions fell in the Second Round to Delta State. TU is one of the most tradition-rich programs in all of Division II, but Saturday marks the Golden Tigers' first-ever Playoff contest because they have previously chosen to forgo the post-season due to annual clash with Alabama A&M.

North Alabama is 28-13 in Playoff contests and are a three-time NCAA Champion after claiming three straight crowns from 1993-95. UNA has advanced to the Finals four times and the Semi-Finals nine times, but the Lions have not maneuvered past the Second Round since 2009.

UNA leads Tuskegee 2-0 all-time, thanks to a 26-7 road win in 1979 and a 25-13 triumph in Florence in 1980. The Lions face off against their second in-state, SIAC foe of the year after they topped Miles in the 2013 home opener, 42-7. Conversely, TU fell to MC in its regular-season finale, 41-36, which bumped the Golden Tigers from a spot in the SIAC Title Game. Overall, North Alabama holds a 39-5-1 mark versus SIAC opponents.

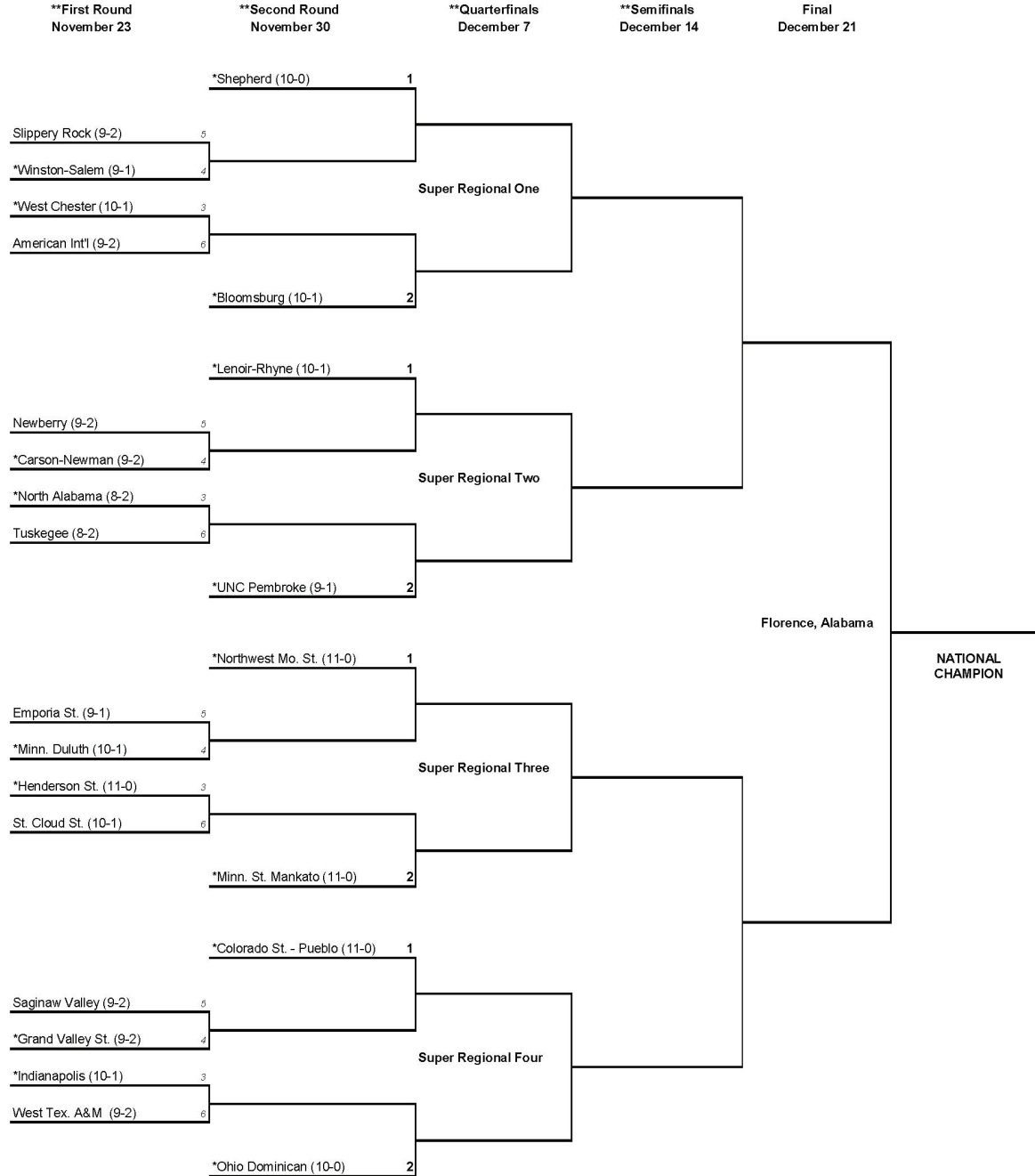
