THREE-WAY TIE ATOP GSC FOOTBALL STANDINGS

The Gulf South Conference Football Record Book took a hit after an action packed weekend that resulted in a three-way tie atop the league standings.

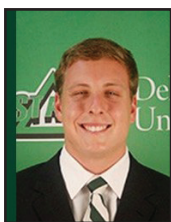
Defending GSC Champion West Alabama entered the weekend in control of its own championship destiny, but when the dust settled, two teams found themselves tied with the Tigers for first-place in the Conference Standings.

Fans have become accustomed to thrilling matchups when **North Alabama** (6-2, 4-1) and **West Alabama** (6-3, 4-1) lock horns, and the rivals did not disappoint inside Braly Municipal Stadium on Saturday when UNA rallied from a 24-10 halftime deficit to outlast UWA in overtime, 30-27. A crowd of 12,526 fans watched the Lions shutout the Tigers in the second half, while forcing an extra period with 14 unanswered points. UWA booted a field goal in the first overtime possession, only to see **UNA signal caller Luke Wingo** run for the game-winning, 16-yard touchdown.

Delta State (6-2, 4-1) and **Valdosta State** (5-3, 3-3) provided plenty of offensive fireworks in front of DSU's Homecoming crowd. The teams combined for 1,177 yards en route to the highest scoring final in GSC history: Delta State 63, Valdosta State 55. The contest was also headlined by record-setting individual efforts as well: **Valdosta State wide receiver Seantavius Jones** set the GSC mark for touchdown catches with six, while **Delta State quarterback Tyler Sullivan** set his school's record for total offensive yards (583).

West Georgia (5-4, 2-3) kicked off the week, putting the brakes on its three-game skid thanks to a 28-14 triumph over Florida Tech (3-6, 1-4) in Thursday night's GSC-TV LIVE Game of the Week. UWG spoiled FIT's first-ever GSC-TV contest, running for a season-high 303 yards and holding the Panthers scoreless in the final 20 minutes.

Provisional GSC member Shorter (1-8, 0-5) achieved new heights en route to its first victory of the season, 58-14 at in-region SIAC foe Clark Atlanta. The Hawks set a school-record for points in a game and gave **Head Coach Phil Jones** his 50th victory at SU. Individually, **quarterback Eric Dodson** passed for 111 yards, making him the school's first signal-caller to surpass 1,000 yards in a season.



CO-OFFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Delta State quarterback Tyler Sullivan (FR, 6-3, 235, Louisville, MS)

Sullivan guided the Statesmen to victory, combining for a school-record 583 yards and six touchdowns. The freshman completed 34-of-48 passes for 520 yards and four scores and also ran for a team-high 63 yards and two TDs on game-high 18 carries. The Louisville, MS native's total yardage placed him third in the GSC record books and his passing mark was seventh. Sullivan tallied his second award in three weeks.



CO-OFFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Valdosta State wide receiver Seantavius Jones (SR, 6-3, 200, Tucker, GA)

Jones also posted record-breaking numbers, collecting nine passes for 143 yards (15.9 average) and a GSC single-game record six touchdown passes. The senior scored all six of the Blazers' offensive TDs, breaking the league's previous record of five TD catches, which was achieved by West Alabama's Matt Carman in 1993. The Tucker, GA native also tied the mark for total touchdowns scored and total points scored in a game (36). Jones upped his career touchdown mark to 32 which is good for third in the league's career list and he secured his second all-time accolade.



DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

North Alabama linebacker Tavarius Wilson (SR, 5-11, 235, Jackson, MS).

Wilson repeats as the Defensive winner, claiming his fourth career laurel and third of the season. The senior linebacker spearheaded UNA's defense in a 30-27, home-overtime upset of No. 20 West Alabama, racking up a game-high 13 total tackles led by eight solo stops and one sack for six yards. The Jackson, MS native also made a huge impact in pass coverage, intercepting two passes deep inside Lions' territory. His first turnover came at UNA's two-yard line midway through the third quarter and his second came on UNA's seven with just 7:54 left to play.



SPECIAL TEAMS PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Delta State's Jarvis York (FR, 6-0, 190, Baton Rouge, LA)

York is the second DSU Special Teams winner this season. The freshman wide receiver stepped in front of a VSU onside-kick attempt with 1:48 remaining, returning it 43 yards for a touchdown and extending the Statesmen's lead to 63-48. The TD proved to be an important insurance score, as VSU pulled within eight points on its final offensive drive at 1:26.

Two teams can wrap up shares of the GSC Football Title this week, while three squads take on non-conference foes.

Last week, North Alabama and West Alabama faced off in a battle for league hardware and NCAA post-season positioning. The rivals enter this weekend tied with **Delta State** atop the Conference standings and both can wrap up shares of the 2013 Crown with triumphs over the sixth and seventh place teams. **No. 24 North Alabama** travels to newcomer **Florida Tech**, while **West Alabama** hosts **Provisional member Shorter** on Saturday.

Valdosta State kicks off the trio of non-conference tilts, hosting its second 2013 GSC-TV LIVE Game of the Week when No. 14 UNC-Pembroke comes to town on Thursday night for a first-ever matchup.

Delta State has to wait a week before it can compete for at least a share of the GSC Title, defending its home turf on Saturday against Concordia College (AL). Last but not least, **West Georgia** journeys to West Texas A&M in the seventh installment of the “GSC-LSC First And Ten Challenge.”

Game Breakdown: Valdosta State hosts its second GSC-TV game against a non-conference foe this season when No. 16 UNC-Pembroke enters Bazemore-Hyder Stadium in the first-ever meeting.

What a difference seven weeks makes as VSU featured a No. 1 national ranking on September 28 in its 37-3 win over Angelo State, but the Blazers take the field on Thursday without a national designation. Valdosta State is 1-1 on television this season after suffering a setback at West Alabama on October 10. UNCP also entertains a TV audience for the third time this year, led by its 25-21 home triumph over Winston-Salem State in the NCAA DII Game of the Week on September 5.

VSU is in the midst of its first losing streak since 2011, having lost two in a row and three of it's the last three. Despite its setbacks, the Blazers are No. 10 in the latest NCAA Super Region Two poll, while the Braves are No. 3 in the region. Valdosta State is 3-1 at home this year, while UNC-Pembroke is 3-1 on the road.

Game Breakdown: No. 24 North Alabama has its eyes on at least a share of its first GSC Title since 2009 when the Lions journey south to league newcomer **Florida Tech**.

UNA enters Saturday in a three-way, first-place tie atop the league standings with West Alabama and Delta State. North Alabama is riding a five-game winning streak which is the longest by a GSC team this season and is the Lions' longest since 2011. North Alabama hits the road for just the fourth time this season, going 2-1, while FIT is 3-1 at home during its first-ever DII season. The Panthers are winners of two of their last three contests, including their first-ever Conference triumph two weeks ago over Shorter. UNA puts its No. 4 Super Region Two record on the line in its GSC finale; the Lions go to Lone Star Conference foe Tarleton State next week.

Game Breakdown: West Alabama may have let its outright GSC Title chances fall to the wayside last week, but the Tigers can sew up at least a share of the 2013 Crown when they host Provisional member Shorter on Saturday.

UWA seeks to sooth the wounds from last week's overtime loss at North Alabama by stretching its all-time edge versus SU to 2-0. A victory would give the Tigers back-to-back GSC Championships for the first time in school history and strengthen its NCAA post-season resume. The Hawks are winless in the Conference this year, but enter Tiger Stadium hot off a record-setting 58-14 win at Clark-Atlanta, which UWA also beat in its 2013 opener (42-6). Shorter set the school record for points in a game and gave Head Coach Phil Jones his 50th win at the helm. West Alabama is 4-0 in Livingston, while SU is 1-3 on the road.

Game Breakdown: West Georgia travels over 1,000 miles to battle West Texas A&M in the seventh installment of the "GSC-LSC First And Ten Challenge."

UWG put the brakes on a three-game skid in last Thursday's GSC-TV Game of the Week, while WTAMU seeks to rebound after falling at home to Eastern New Mexico, 39-38. The Buffaloes lead the series 1-0 after they topped the Wolves in last year's inaugural meeting in Carrollton, GA, 52-28. UWG is 2-2 away from home this year, while West Texas A&M is 3-1 in Canyon, TX.

@ NORTH ALABAMA 30, #20 WEST ALABAMA 27 (OVERTIME)

North Alabama (6-2, 4-1) held visiting **No. 20 West Alabama** (6-3, 4-1) scoreless in the second half, allowing the Lions' offense to force overtime and post a 30-27, come-from-behind victory in front of 12,526 fans.

UWA drew first blood when **Mark Grant** connected on a 28-yard field goal on the game's opening drive, but UNA took a 7-3 edge at 7:52 in the first quarter via **quarterback Luke Wingo's** four-yard scoring scamper. The Tigers did not wait long to respond after **running back Javae Swindle** ran 70 yards for a TD at 6:44. **Will Craig** tied matters, 10-10, with two seconds left in the quarter by booting a 44-yard field goal.

West Alabama ruled the second frame, posting 14 unanswered points in just a 13 seconds span. **Quarterback Kyle Caldwell** ran for an 11-yard touchdown at 12:38 and **wide out Chad Toocheck** collected a 20-yard TD catch following a UNA fumble on a kickoff return. UWA's defense held UNA out of the end zone, resulting in a 24-10 halftime advantage.

North Alabama cut its deficit in half on the first drive off the second half, thanks to **Grant Lake's** two-yard scoring reception at 10:57. Wingo posted the final score of regulation by capping a 97-yard drive via a one-yard touchdown sneak at 12:52 in the fourth quarter.

UWA's offense took the field first in overtime, settling for Grant's 33-yard field goal, but UNA needed just four plays to put the game on ice via Wingo's 16-yard go-ahead touchdown run.

Wingo completed 13-of-26 passes for 275 yards and one score, while also running for a team-high 72 yards and three TDs on 17 carries. Swindle set a UWA single-game record, rushing for 228 yards on 30 attempts, led by the 70 yard touchdown. North Alabama moved to 49-17-1 all-time versus UWA thanks to its second win in three matchups. [Box score](#)

@ DELTA STATE 63, VALDOSTA STATE 55 (HOMECOMING)

Delta State (6-2, 4-1) kept its hopes for at least a share of the GSC Title alive, outscoring **Valdosta State** (5-3, 3-3) in a record-setting, 63-55 Homecoming victory.

The rivals kept the scoreboard operator busy, setting the *GSC record for points scored in a game*. The 118 combined points were one more than the previous record of 117 which came between former members Harding and Arkansas Tech in 2007.

The teams traded scores throughout the first half, but DSU entered the locker room with a 28-21 edge. **Statesmen wide receiver Ricky Hunt** grabbed a 23-yard TD at 12:08, while **VSU's Seantavius Jones** posted an 18-yard scoring reception at 7:51. **Quarterback Tyler Sullivan** gave Delta State a 14-7 lead after a seven-yard touchdown run late in the first frame, only to throw an interception that **Kenny Murphy** returned 30 yards for six points at 11:26 in the second stanza.

Hunt and Jones again traded TD catches from 26 and three yards, respectively, before **Patrick Bethley** gave DSU its seven-point cushion at the break via a 38-yard catch with 4:13 remaining in the first half.

The Statesmen owned the third quarter, 14-0, but the Blazers made things interesting in the fourth frame by exploding for 34 points. Jones grabbed a six-yard touchdown just 38 seconds into the final 15 minutes, but **Delta State's Justin McArthur** ran for a one-yard TD at 11:37. Valdosta State's defense found the end zone again when **Dominique Wheeler** ran back an interception 70 yards at 10:08. Jones cut VSU's deficit to 49-41 at 7:45 via a four-yard touchdown, only to see **running back Richard Freelon** rumble for a seven-yard scoring run at 3:33.

Jones posted his fifth touchdown reception at 1:54, but Delta State returned the ensuing on-side kick for a TD when **Jarvis York** scooped up the ball and ran 43 yards for six points at 1:48. The Blazers did not give up; pulling within eight points thanks to another Jones' TD catch at 1:26, but the Statesmen recovered another on-side attempt, icing the game.

Delta State freshman signal caller Tyler Sullivan combined for a *school-record 583 total yards*, led by 520 yards passing and a game-high 63 yards on the ground. Sullivan's total was also good for third-place in the GSC Record Books. **Valdosta State's Seantavius Jones** scored all six of his team's offensive TDs, breaking the *league record for touchdown receptions in a game (six)*. For the day, Jones caught nine balls for 143 yards. DSU's Ricky Hunt grabbed a game-high 10 passes for a GSC season-best 206 yards. DSU posted its seventh win in the last eight meetings versus VSU, upping its all-time series lead to 19-13-1. [Box score](#)

@ WEST GEORGIA 28, FLORIDA TECH 14 (THURSDAY, GSC-TV)

West Georgia (5-4, 2-3) won its first game in the last four tries in front of its Halloween home crowd, doubling up Florida Tech (3-6, 1-4), 28-14, in Thursday night's GSC-TV Game of the Week.

UWG wide out Bobby Burum provided the lone points of the first quarter when he caught a 13-yard touchdown in the game's opening drive. FIT knotted matters, 7-7, thanks to wide receiver Xavier Milton's three-yard catch at 7:41 in the second quarter. The Wolves took control in the final two minutes of the first half, running for two touchdowns in the final 1:50. **Seth Hinsley** rushed for a four-yarder, while **Quan Jones** added a one-yard plunge with just five ticks on the clock.

Milton's second touchdown reception cut the Panthers' deficit in half at 5:01, but FIT would be held out of the end zone the rest of the way. **West Georgia's Earvin Anumgba** provided some insurance points with 3:28 left to play by hauling-in a 33-yard score.

UWG ran for a season-high 303 yards, led by Jones who led all rushers with 139 yards on 24 carries and Hinsley's 91 yards on 14 attempts. The Wolves earned its first GSC-TV win of the year and they host the final telecast in two weeks. [Box score](#)

SHORTER 58, @ CLARK ATLANTA 14

GSC Provisional member Shorter (1-8, 0-5) earned its first win of the season in impressive fashion, cruising past in-region, SIAC Clark Atlanta on the road, 58-14.

SU opened the scoring when **quarterback Eric Dodson** sneaked a one-yard touchdown in the first possession, but CAU answered with 1:26 remaining in the first quarter. The Hawks owned the rest of the game, reeling off 51 unanswered points headlined by a 27-point second frame.

Dodson added another one-yard TD at 10:36, followed by **Kirk Wilson's** four-yarder at 9:27. **Darius Turner** closed the first half with back-to-back scoring receptions; the first was an 84-yard bomb at 4:53, followed by a 10-yarder with 1:07 left in the second quarter.

Shorter added 24 more points in the second half, before the Panthers closed out the scoring with 5:32 remaining in the game.

Dodson ran for a game-high 111 yards and passed for another 111 yards on four completions. His passing numbers were enough to push him past 1,000 yards for the season, which the most in a season in school history. **Head Coach Phil Jones** also grabbed his 50th career victory at Shorter.
