### UNA MOVES ON TO NCAA REGIONAL TWO TITLE GAME

For the 14th straight year, the Gulf South Conference advanced at least one team to the NCAA Division II Football Playoff Quarterfinals.

**GSC Co-Champion and No. 3 seed North Alabama** posted another impressive road victory, upsetting No. 2 seed UNC-Pembroke on Saturday, 37-13. UNA moved on to its 13th NCAA Quarterfinal round, intercepting five UNCP passes and returning two for touchdowns. The triumph was the Lions' 31st all-time post-season victory and was also the 102nd win for the Gulf South Conference in the NCAA Division II Playoffs.

Next up for North Alabama (10-2) is another trip to the Tar Heel State when the Lions journey to South Atlantic Conference Champion and No. 1 seed Lenoir-Rhyne (11-1) on Saturday, December 7 at 11:00 am Central.

**GSC IN THE NCAA DII PLAYOFFS**

A total of 20 different football-playing schools have belonged to the GSC at some point since 1973 and 12 of those have earned at least one Playoff bid. The GSC has compiled 101 wins during that span along with a .631 winning percentage (101-59). In fact, of the last 25 national champions, 11\* have come from the GSC, seven from the former North Central Conference, four from the Mid-America Intercollegiate Athletic Association and three from the Great Lakes Intercollegiate Athletic Conference. The GSC holds the playoff record for different schools to win the championship game (6), championship game appearances (17) and different schools to appear in the championship game (6). \*--Mississippi College's 1989 national championship was vacated for NCAA infractions.



**GSC VS. SAC PLAYOFF HISTORY**

The Gulf South Conference is 15-12 all-time against the South Atlantic Conference in the NCAA DII Playoffs, but the GSC has won 11 of the last 14 meetings since 2002. Below is a list of the previous post-season matchups.

**Game Breakdown:** Conference Champions face off in Hickory, NC on Saturday when **GSC Co-Champion and No. 3 seed North Alabama** journeys to South Atlantic Conference Champion and No. 1 seed Lenoir-Rhyne in the Super Region Two Title Game.

UNA seeks to keep its upset streak alive after dropping No. 2 seed UNC-Pembroke on the road last week. The Lions travel for the fifth time in seven weeks, carrying a five-game road streak and a nine-game overall streak into Moretz Stadium. Lenoir-Rhyne has reeled-off 11 straight victories since falling in its season-opener on September 7 against Concord, 18-10. The Bears are 6-1 at home this year, while UNA is 5-1 away from Florence.

The squads clash for the first time ever, but North Alabama has a long Playoff history versus SAC foes, going 5-2 dating back to 1993. GSC and SAC members have battled in the post-season 27 times with the GSC holding a 15-12 edge thanks to 11 wins in the last 14 meetings.

North Alabama is a NCAA Playoff veteran, tying the all-time record for NCAA appearances (18). UNA is 31-14 in the post-season, advancing to the Finals four times and the Semi-Finals nine times and claiming three straight NCAA Titles from 1993-95. Lenoir-Rhyne is 2-1 in the Playoffs, making their second appearance following last year's first-ever berth.

**#3 SEED NORTH ALABAMA 37, @ #2 SEED UNC-PEMBROKE 13 (NCAA PLAYOFFS—SECOND ROUND)**

No. 3 seed North Alabama stormed back from a three-point deficit in the third quarter, reeling off 27 unanswered points en route to a 37-13 victory at No. 2 seed UNC-Pembroke.

UNCP provided the first quarter's lone score via a touchdown at 1:40, but UNA blocked the extra-point kick. The Lions' owned the second stanza and entered the locker room with a 10-6 advantage. Will Craig booted a 21-yard field goal at 8:43 and running back Lamonte Thompson ran for a 27-yard TD at 4:34. The Braves moved within scoring position at the end of the first half, but UNA forced an interception at the UNA 21-yard line with 1:06 left on the clock.

UNC-Pembroke grabbed a 13-10 lead on its first third-quarter possession at 12:21, only to see North Alabama close the door from by reeling off 27 unanswered points. Wide receiver Jason Smith hauled-in a five-yard touchdown at 7:56 and Thompson found pay dirt again from 16 yards out at 1:27.

The Lions' defense iced the contest in the final 8:18 by returning a pair of the interceptions for touchdowns. Linebacker Tavarious Wilson ran for a 29-yard TD at 8:18 and linebacker Gabe Poe followed with a 52-yard return at 7:38.

Thompson led all rushers with 98 yards and two scores on 14 carries, while quarterback Luke Wingo totaled 163 total yards. UNA stretched its winning streak to nine and moved the GSC's all-time NCAA Playoff record to 102-59. [Box score](#)

**@ #3 SEED NORTH ALABAMA 30, #6 SEED TUSKEGEE 27 (NCAA PLAYOFFS—FIRST ROUND)**

The GSC notched its 101st all-time NCAA Playoff victory on Saturday after No. 3 seed North Alabama held off No. 6 seed Tuskegee's upset bid in a 30-27 home win.

UNA hit pay dirt on the game's opening possession when running back Chris Coffey caught a nine-yard touchdown pass at 10:37, but TU responded with 10 unanswered points in the quarter. The Lions put together a scoring streak of their own to collect a 24-10 edge with 1:32 remaining in the first half. Quarterback Luke Wingo ran in a one-yard score just 46 seconds into the second frame, followed by Will Craig's 20-yard field goal at 9:36. Coffey posted a one-yard TD at 1:32, only to see the Golden Tigers cut their deficit to 24-17 heading into halftime.

Tuskegee knotted the contest, 24-24, on the first drive of the second half. North Alabama responded two plays later after wide out Korey Jones hauled-in a 36-yard scoring strike at 11:27, but the Lions missed the point-after kick resulting in a 30-24 lead. TU moved within three points thanks to a field goal at 2:06, but that's as close as the Golden Tigers came as neither team lit the scoreboard the rest of the way.

Wingo combined for 185 total yards, passing for 127 yards and two TDs, while running for 58 yards and another score. Running back Lamonte Thompson led all rushers with 64 yards on 10 carries. The win stretched UNA's winning streak to eight and preserved its perfect all-time record against Tuskegee (3-0). The Lions also upped their all-time post-season record to 30-14. [Box score](#)

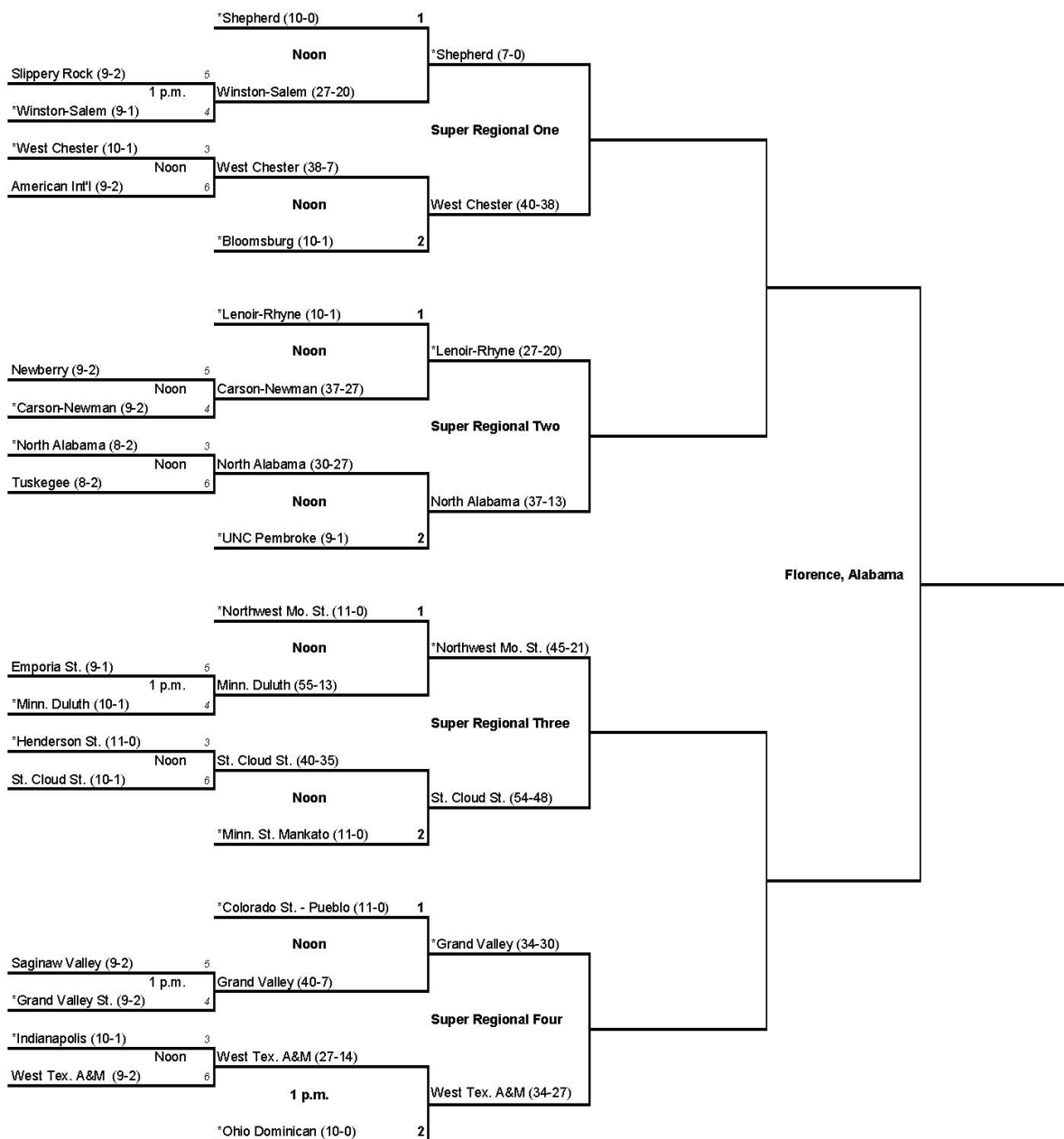
