### GSC FOOTBALL OPENS UP 2013 LEAGUE PLAY

The race to decide the 2013 Gulf South Conference Champion began last week with a trio of squads securing league victories.

Last week's four-game slate included two televised matchups, starting on Thursday when **No. 15 West Alabama** (2-1, 1-0) eased past **GSC newcomer Florida Tech** (1-2, 0-1) in the NCAA Division II Game of the Week in Melbourne, Fla. **West Georgia** (2-1, 0-0) hosted a Saturday edition of the GSC-TV LIVE Game of the Week, falling at home to Lone Star Conference foe, No. 25 Midwestern State, 38-28.

**Delta State** (2-1, 1-0) hit the road for the third week in a row, earning a win in its GSC opener at **No. 24 North Alabama** (1-2, 0-1), 37-34. DSU scored 10 points in the final 2:45, including **placekicker Vince Sciorrotta's** game-winning, 31-yard field goal with nine seconds remaining in regulation.

**No. 1 Valdosta State** (2-0, 1-0) took to the field after a week off, shutting out in-state **league Provisional Shorter** (0-3, 0-1) at home on Saturday, 41-0. The Blazers ran their winning streak to 12 dating back to 2012 via their first shutout since 2010.



**OFFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK**

**Delta State quarterback Travis Champion** (JR, 6-2, 225, Moreno Valley, Calif.)

Champion is the first DSU Offensive winner of the season, leading the Statesmen's offense in a 37-34 victory at North Alabama. The junior completed 40-of-52 passes for 450 yards and four TDs; all four being the most by a GSC passer so far this season. The Moreno Valley, Calif. native saved his best for the final six minutes of the game, spearheading back-to-back scoring drives. Champion tied the game with 2:45 left to play via an eight-yard scoring strike and he then guided DSU to UNA's 14-yard line where the Statesmen nailed the go-ahead field goal with nine seconds remaining.



**DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK**

**North Alabama linebacker Gabe Poe** (SR, 5-10, 210, Pheba, MS)

Poe is the second consecutive UNA Defensive honoree. The senior linebacker racked up the most tackles by a GSC player this season, posting 21 total stops in the Lions' 37-34 home loss to DSU. Poe led all players with nine solo stops and 12 assisted tackles, while also adding 1.5 tackles for a loss of two yards and one fumble recovery.



**SPECIAL TEAMS PLAYER OF THE WEEK**

**DSU placekicker Vince Sciorrotta** (FR, 5-9, 170, Cumming, GA)

Sciorrotta is the first DSU Special Teams winner of the season. The freshman performed well beyond his years in DSU's come-from-behind triumph at North Alabama, going 3-for-4 on field goal attempts and 4-for-4 on extra-point kicks. The Cumming, GA native's longest field goal gave the Statesmen a 3-0 lead just five minutes into the game, but his second-longest field goal was the most important. Sciorrotta stepped onto the field with nine seconds left in the contest and he booted the game-winning, 31-yarder through the uprights with just nine seconds left to play.

Two Conference clashes and two non-conference matchups highlight this week’s Gulf South Conference Football schedule.

GSC-TV LIVE action remains on Saturday night for the second consecutive week when **No. 1 Valdosta State** hosts Lone Star Conference member Angelo State. The contest marks the fifth straight televised non-conference game, second in a row versus a LSC opponent. VSU and ASU also face off in the third installment of the “GSC-LSC First and Ten Challenge.” Fans can watch the game on CoxSports, ESPN3, ESPN Game Plan, Mediacom, TV-24 (Anniston, AL) and the Alabama Cable Network.

**No. 15 West Alabama** kicks off the week on Thursday night when it plays nearby foe Concordia (Ala.) at Tiger Stadium in Demopolis, Ala. The game marks the second of four consecutive Thursday night battles for UWA.

Saturday is also headlined by a pair of Conference matchups. **Delta State** defends its home turf for the first time this season when **GSC newcomer Florida Tech** invades McCool Stadium. **West Georgia** flips the switch on its league slate, seeking to spoil **Provisional member Shorter’s** Homecoming.

UWA and CC lock horns for the first time in five seasons and the Tigers own a 4-0 lead in the series after four consecutive battles from 2005-08. West Alabama took the first three decisions in Livingston and the lone meeting in Selma in 2008. This year’s matchup marks the first-ever neutral site contest between the squads. UWA is back in Demopolis for the first time since 2010 when the Tigers topped Shorter in the season-opener, 37-7.

The squads clash for the second year in a row after VSU defeated ASU in Cowboys Stadium in the first-ever meeting in 2012. The Blazers are 12-6 in GSC-TV games dating back to 2005 with its last GSC-TV victory coming against LSC for Texas A&M-Kingsville last year, 38-31. Valdosta State has won 12 consecutive games dating back to last year and defends their home ground for the first time this season. Saturday also marks the third edition of the 2013 "GSC-LSC First and Ten Challenge," which LSC leads, 2-0.

**#16 WEST ALABAMA 45, @ FLORIDA TECH 3 (THURSDAY, NCAA DII GAME OF THE WEEK)**

**No. 16 West Alabama** (2-1, 1-0) impressed the Division II world on Thursday night, cruising past **GSC newcomer Florida Tech** (1-2, 0-1) on the road, 45-3, in the NCAA Game of the Week. Thursday marked the first DII game played in the State of Florida since 1989 and FIT's first-ever GSC league contest.

UWA opened with 28 unanswered points, starting with **running back Javae Swindle's** 76-yard touchdown on the second play from scrimmage at 14:33. FIT ignited its sold out crowd by blocking a punt on the Tigers' second offensive possession, but West Alabama's defense held, allowing the offense to grab a 14-0 lead via **running back Kedrick Rhodes'** 11-yard scoring scamper at the three-minute mark.

**Wide receiver Seth Roberts** opened the second frame with back-to-back TD catches; the first going for 16 yards at 7:30 and the second for 30 yards at 1:55. The Panthers were able to dodge a first-half shutout when **placekicker Brion Ashley** booted a 29-yard field goal as time expired.

**West Alabama placekicker Mark Grant** answered with a 38-yard field goal at 12:36 in the third quarter and Swindle added a two-yard touchdown jaunt at 1:28. Back-up **quarterback Gary Johnston** capped the scoring in the final frame when he ran for a three-yard TD at 13:46.

**UWA quarterback Kyle Caldwell** completed 19-of-26 passes for 251 yards and two touchdowns. Swindle ran for 170 yards and two TDs on 10 carries, while Swindle collected six catches for 113 yards and a pair of scores. The Tigers put the brakes on their three-game road skid, dating back to last year.

**DELTA STATE 37, @ #24 NORTH ALABAMA 34**

Last week, 37 points was not enough for a **Delta State** (2-1, 1-0) victory, but Saturday's 37 point-total was just enough as the Statesmen clipped **No. 24 North Alabama** (1-2, 0-1) on the road, 37-34, in the each squad's GSC opener.

The traditional GSC rivals opened up each other's respective league slates for the third consecutive season with DSU claiming its second win. The Statesmen dominated the first half, outscoring UNA, 20-7. **Placekicker Vince Sciorrotta** began with a 32-yard field goal at 10:08 in the first quarter and **wide receiver Casey Osborne** hauled in an 84-yard touchdown bomb at 4:58. The Lions cut their deficit in half at 10:35 in the second frame thanks to a one-yard plunge by **running back Chris Coffey**, only to see Delta State tally 10 more unanswered points. **Wide out Ricky Hunt** caught a 72-yard bomb at 9:56 and Sciorrotta connected from 24-yards out at 2:53.

North Alabama's defense flexed its muscle in the third quarter, tying matters at 20-20 thanks to a pair of interception-for-touchdowns. **Defensive back Philbert Martial** returned a pass 35 yards at 13:53 and **defensive back Brion James** added a 53-yarder at 8:46.

Osborne pushed DSU back ahead via an 11-yard TD reception with 11:16 left in the final stanza, but **North Alabama's Jason Smith** answered with back-to-back touchdowns. Smith collected a 50-yarder at 9:56 and a 36-yarder 6:43, but Osborne responded by tying the game, 34-34, after an eight-yard scoring grab at 2:45. DSU's defense forced a three-and-out on UNA's following possession, setting the stage for the go-ahead, 31-yard field goal by Sciorrotta with just nine seconds on the clock. The Statesmen's defense posted a sack on the Lions' first offensive play, sealing the victory.

**DSU quarterback Travis Champion** completed 40-of-52 passes for 450 yards and 4 TDs, while Hunt also had a career day, catching 13 balls for 146 yards and a score. **Running back Timothy Foy** lead all rushers with 18 carries for 65 yards. The Statesmen recorded their fourth triumph over UNA in the last five matchups.

**@ #1 VALDOSTA STATE 41, SHORTER 0**

No. 1 Valdosta State (2-0, 1-0) did not miss a beat, returning to the gridiron for the first time in two weeks by blanking **Provisional GSC member Shorter** at home, 41-0.

VSU's offense struggled early, as the Hawks kept the Blazers out of the end zone until **wide receiver Seantavious Jones** hauled-in a 22-yard pass at 13:05 in the second quarter. Valdosta State did not wait long to take a two-touchdown edge when **running back Austin Scott** ran for an 18-yard score at 11:17.

The score remained 14-0 entering halftime, but Valdosta State took control in the third quarter with 21 points. **Wide out Regginald Lewis** caught a 65-yard TD just 1:55 into the third frame and Trent McGuire added a two-yard scoring grab at 7:05. **Running back Cedric O'Neal** closed the quarter by reeling-off a 38-yard TD run with 1:42 on the clock. VSU's defense preserved its first shutout in 30 games and Scott capped off the scoring on a 45-yard scoring scamper with 7:33 left to play.

Scott outrushed the entire Shorter lineup, carrying the ball 12 times for 124 yards. **Quarterback Cayden Cochran** completed 11-of-23 passes for 177 yards and three TDs. VSU moved to 2-0 all-time against the Hawks.

**#25 MIDWESTERN STATE 38, @ WEST GEORGIA 28 (GSC-TV)**

**West Georgia** (2-1) could not contain No. 24 **Midwestern State's** vaunted rushing attack, settling for a 38-28 home setback in Saturday's GSC-TV Game of the Week.

The squads traded rushing touchdowns in the first quarter as MSU drew first blood at 9:16, while **UWG quarterback Dallas Dickey** answered on a 10-yard run at 5:23. The Mustangs took a 14-point lead with 7:52 left in the second quarter, only to see the Wolves take advantage of **Midwestern State** miscues to tie matters at the break, 21-21. **West Georgia wide out Bobby Burum** caught back-to-back touchdown passes, the first at 1:17 and the second with just 19 ticks on the clock.

UWG pulled with seven at 3:28 thanks to **Joey Eliezer's** 47-yard scoring grab, but the Mustangs recovered the Wolves ensuing onside kick and iced the win with a field goal at 1:56.

**Quarterback Austin Trainor** led UWG's passing attack, completing 14-of-27 passes for 238 yards and two TDs. Eliezer set a career-high with 124 yards receiving on four catches.
