GSC FOOTBALL WEEK FOUR REVIEW

Week Four of the 2013 Gulf South Conference Football season featured two league battles and two non-conference victories.

Delta State (3-1, 2-0) became the first team this season to hit the two-win mark in Conference action by outgunning **Florida Tech** (1-3, 0-2) at home on Saturday, 52-31. DSU overcame a third-quarter comeback by the Panthers, scoring 21 unanswered points over a six-minute span in the fourth quarter.

West Georgia (3-1, 1-0) captured its league-opener and moved its road record to 2-0, thanks to a 31-14 triumph over nearby **GSC Provisional rival Shorter** (0-4, 0-2). UWG trailed heading into the second quarter, but the Wolves' defense held the Hawks scoreless the rest of the way and the offense hit for 24 unanswered points.

No. 1 Valdosta State (3-0, 1-0) and **No. 14 West Alabama** (3-1, 1-0) took a break from league action to notch non-conference victories.

UWA opened the week by blowing out Concordia (AL), 71-14, on neutral ground in Demopolis, AL. The Tigers hit the 70-point mark for the second straight year, led by two defensive TDs.

VSU capped off Saturday's action, hosting Game Five of the GSC-TV LIVE Game of the Week package and Lone Star Conference foe Angelo State. Valdosta State's defense held ASU to just 90 yards passing as the Blazers ran out to a 20-0 halftime lead en route to a 37-3 triumph. The win closed the GSC's deficit versus the LSC in the 2013 GSC-LSC "First and Ten Challenge" to 2-1.



OFFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Delta State running back Tim Foy (FR, 5-9,195, Hueytown, AL)

Foy is DSU's second consecutive Offensive winner, leading the Statesmen to a 52-31 home victory over Florida Tech. The redshirt freshman caught six passes for 108 yards and two touchdowns and also ran the ball six times for 39 yards and another score. The Hueytown, AL native posted the first TD of the night, via a five-yard reception at 1:45 in the first quarter. He opened up the third quarter with a bang, hauling-in a 62-yard score just 51 seconds into the second half. Foy capped his three-TD night with 14:16 left in the game, running for a five-yard touchdown.



DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Valdosta State defensive back Dominique Wheeler (SR, 5-8, 177, Stone Mountain, GA)

Wheeler is the first VSU defender to claim laurels this season after spearheading the Blazers' defense to a 37-3 home win over Angelo State. The senior had a direct hand in two key turnovers to start the game, beginning with an interception which halted a Rams' drive at VSU's 34-yard line. The Stone Mountain, GA native struck again on ASU's second drive, returning a fumble 86 yards for a touchdown. The return was the second-longest in VSU history.



SPECIAL TEAMS PLAYER OF THE WEEK

VSU wide receiver/punt returner Regginald Lewis (SR, 614, 183, Forest Park, GA)

Lewis collects his first career award, setting up Valdosta State's offense with a pair of key punt returns against Angelo State. The senior wide receiver set up VSU's first offensive touchdown late in the first quarter when he returned a punt 39 yards to the ASU 25 yard line. Two drives later, the Stone Mountain, GA native posted a 29-yard return to ASU's 38 that led to a Blazers' field goal.

The Peach State hosts three of this week's four Gulf South Conference Football matchups, while GSC-TV returns to Livingston, AL for the second time this season.

The GSC-TV LIVE Game of the Week is back on Thursday night for the first time in three weeks, following the past two Saturday telecasts. **No. 14 West Alabama** hosts the first of two consecutive telecasts and its second overall of this season. The Tigers cruised past Clark-Atlanta in Game Two on Saturday, September 7th. Traditional league-rival **Delta State** invades Tiger Stadium in the 59th all-time meeting and the third overall clash in front of a GSC-TV audience. Thursday's game can be viewed on CSS, CoxSports, Mediacom, TV-24 (Anniston, AL), ESPN3 and newly added, WHCQ-TV 8 in Cleveland, MS.

The Conference's three Georgia members host Saturday's two league contests. **No. 1 Valdosta State** hosts league border-rival **Florida Tech** in the Blazers' Homecoming, while **Provisional member Shorter** entertains **North Alabama** which enters Barron Stadium after a bye-week. **West Georgia** celebrates Homecoming when nearby NAIA foe Point comes to Carrollton.

Game Breakdown: **No. 14 West Alabama** hosts its second 2013 GSC-TV Game of the Week when **Delta State** enters Tiger Stadium this Thursday night in its first TV appearance of the year.

The rivals have battled in front of a GSC television audience two previous times with DSU holding a 2-0 lead thanks to home wins in 2006 (41-14) and 2010 (41-37). The Statesmen are 13-6 in GSC-TV action dating back to 2005 and UWA is 11-8.

Delta State owns the overall series lead at 34-21-3, but the Tigers are coming off a 37-7 win in Cleveland, MS a year ago which was just their second win in the last 10 matchups. West Alabama is 12-10-2 against DSU at home, but the Statesmen have captured six of the last seven battles in Livingston. UWA celebrated a 34-14 home triumph in the last matchup in Tiger Stadium. Each team seeks to remain perfect in league play as DSU boasts a 2-0 record and UWA is 1-0.

Both teams are in search of their first Conference victory of the year with SU holding a 0-2 record and UNA a 0-1 mark. The Hawks hope to copy the Lions' success in last year's series opener when North Alabama celebrated its Homecoming with a 41-0 victory. North Alabama rolled up 436 yards of total offense in that matchup, taking control with 21 unanswered points in the second quarter. Shorter is 0-2 at home in 2013, while UNA is 0-1 away from home.

UWG hosts the Skyhawks for the second year in a row after taking a 55-3 triumph in its 2012 season opener. The Wolves lit the scoreboard for the most points in a game since 2005 and running back Seth Hinsley made the most of his first career starting, running for 110 yards and two touchdowns on 17 carries. West Georgia led from the outset, finding pay dirt on its opening possession and leading by 34 points at the end of the first half. UWG is 1-1 in University Stadium this year.

Game Breakdown: No. 1 Valdosta State jumps back into league action after a week's hiatus, hosting Homecoming and GSC newcomer Florida Tech.

VSU is riding a 13-game overall winning streak dating back last year, led by five straight over GSC squads. The defending NCAA Champions have won seven in a row at Bazemore-Hyder Stadium with its last defeat coming against West Alabama in the 2012 home opener. The Blazers topped Angelo State in their first 2013 home game last week, 37-3. FIT is four games into its inaugural football season and has dropped its two road contests so far this year.

Delta State (3-1, 2-0) defended its home turf for the first time this season, rolling up nearly 600 yards of total offense in a 52-31 win over **Florida Tech** (1-3, 0-2).

DSU posted the lone first-quarter score when **running back Tim Foy** collected a five-yard touchdown catch at 1:45. The Statesmen's defense upped the score 14-0 thanks to **Jeremy Davis'** 20-yard interception return for six points. **Quarterback Bobby Vega** cut FIT's deficit in half, finding pay dirt from one yard out, only to see Delta State answer via **Michael Davison's** two-yard TD rush at 2:55. The Panthers made the halftime score, 21-10, thanks to **Brian Ashley's** 37-yard field goal as time expired in the second frame.

DSU came out firing in the second half, thanks to a 62-yard TD catch by Foy and **Vince Sciorrotta's** 31-yard field goal. Florida Tech did not give up, posting back-to-back touchdowns in two minutes late in the third quarter. **Wide out Xavier Mitchell** caught an 11-yard score at 4:07 and **Dan Masteller** pounded home a one-yard TD at 2:50.

Delta State put the game on ice in the fourth frame by opening the final 15 minutes with a 21 unanswered points. Foy added his third TD of the contest at 14:16, **Patrick Bethley** hauled-in an 81-yard bomb at 10:44 and **Justin McArthur** ran for a three-yard score at 8:10. FIT added a touchdown with 4:08 left to play, but that's as close as the Panthers got.

DSU quarterback Travis Champion completed 29-of-36 passes for 4170 yards and three TDs, while Foy compiled 147 total yards led by six catches for 108 yards. The Statesmen scored the most points in a game since piling up 54 against West Georgia in 2010.

WEST GEORGIA 31, @ SHORTER 14

West Georgia (3-1, 1-0) started league play on a positive note on Saturday, spoiling nearby GSC rival **Shorter's** Homecoming, 31-14.

SU capitalized on a UWG fumble on the Wolves' own eight-yard line when **quarterback Eric Dodson** ran for a one-yard TD at 3:38. West Georgia responded quickly via **running back Seth Hinsley's** 72-yard rushing score on the first play from scrimmage. The Hawks returned to the top behind **running back Devin Helvie's** 24-yard touchdown scamper with 1:14 left in the opening quarter, but **UWG's Quan Jones** tied matters again thanks to a two-yarder at 12:41 in the second stanza.

The rest of the game belonged to the Wolves and its defense which pitched a shutout the rest of the way. **Eric Bridges** recovered a fumble for six points with just 2:22 remaining in the first half and **Joey Eliezer** caught a 63-yard scoring bomb on the first play of the second half. **Mark Bardenwerper** completed the scoring by booting a 24-yard field goal at 6:45 in the third frame.

Hinsley ran for a game-high 134 yards on 12 carries, while **Austin Trainor** passed for 171 yards and a TD. West Georgia evened the all-time series with Shorter, 1-1.

@ #1 VALDOSTA STATE 34, ANGELO STATE 3 (GSC-TV)

No. 1 Valdosta State (3-0, 1-0) hosted Lone Star Conference member Angelo State in Saturday's GSC-TV LIVE Game of the Week. VSU's defense held the Rams high-powered offense in check en route to a 34-3 decision.

Blazers' cornerback Dominique Wheeler impacted the first two ASU drives, intercepting a pass at the VSU 34-yard line at 13:31 and then returning a fumble 86 yards for a TD at 8:25. Valdosta State's offense added its first points when **Seantavious Jones** caught a six-yard touchdown at 3:50.

VSU placekicker Anthony Pistelli provided the lone points in the second quarter by nailing field goals from 30 and 25 yards, respectively. ASU added three points of its own at 7:44, but VSU **wide receiver Willie Downs** caught a 37-yard TD at 6:42. Pistelli stretched the Blazers' edge to 30-3 via a 39-yard field goal with 11:43 left in the game and **running back Austin Scott** completed the scoring at 3:59 via a 10-yard touchdown scamper.

Valdosta State signal caller Cayden Cochran completed 25-of-38 passes for 255 yards and two touchdowns, while Downs caught eight balls for 160 yards and a score. The win was the Blazers' 13th in a row dating back to last year and it's seventh consecutive at home.

#15 WEST ALABAMA 71, CONCORDIA (AL) 14 (THURSDAY IN DEMOPOLIS, AL)

No. 15 West Alabama (3-1, 1-0) jumped out of GSC action for one week, facing Concordia (AL) on neutral ground in Demopolis, AL. UWA amassed 596 yards of total offense and scored two defensive touchdowns in a 71-14 blowout of the Hornets.

The teams combined for 38 points in the first quarter with UWA holding a 24-14 advantage after the first 15 minutes. The Tigers sprinted to a 10-0 edge in the first two minutes thanks to **Mark Grant's** 22-yard field goal in the game's opening possession and **Stephani McNair's** 15-yard fumble recovery for a TD. CC returned the ensuing kickoff for a score but it missed the point-after kick. West Alabama added 14 more points before the Hornets closed their deficit to 10 points right before the end of the first stanza.

UWA dominated the rest of the game as the Tigers exploded for 47 unanswered points. **Seth Roberts** caught a 44-yard scoring strike at 11:02 in the second quarter and **Kedrick Rhodes** closed the first half via a 15-yard scamper at 1:08. **Quarterbacks Kyle Caldwell** and **Gary Johnston** each tossed TD passes in the third quarter and **Jherrone Jones** closed out the game by recovering a fumble in Concordia's end zone for six points.

Caldwell completed 12-of-24 passes for 255 yards and three touchdowns and he also rushed for 56 yards. Rhodes ran for a game-high 122 yards and two TDs on 11 carries. West Alabama ran its series lead over CC to 5-0.
