WEEK FOUR REVIEW

Week Four in the GSC was led by two games that were decided in the closing seconds and three contests that were easy victories for Conference squads.

No. 5 North Alabama and then **No. 21 Valdosta State** treated the Football Game of the Week audience to one of the most exciting finishes in the history of GSC-TV. VSU held a one-point lead with just over two minutes remaining, only to see UNA thrill its capacity crowd when Taylor Pontius kicked the game-winning, 54-yard field goal as time expired. The field goal was the longest in school history and was also tied for the third longest in league history.

Florida Tech traveled to in-state No. 14 DI-FCS foe Bethune-Cookman and nearly pulled the upset in a 34-33 setback. The Panthers saw their seven-point fourth-quarter lead turn into a seven-point deficit with 1:25 left to play, but FIT pulled within one point on Tyler Bass' 43-yard touchdown catch with 19 ticks on the clock. Florida Tech decide to go for win, but its two-point pass attempt was intercepted in the end zone.

No. 11 Delta State hosted its annual "Pig Pickin" celebration by cruising past in-region SIAC foe Central State, 72-8. DSU rolled up 542 yards of total offense and forced five CSU turnovers in the Statesmen's highest scoring output since last year's 77-0 win over Concordia (AL).

No. 22 West Alabama stretched its home winning streak to 12 by running past in-state Concordia, 60-7. UWA scored a school-record eight rushing touchdowns and also set a single-game record with 473 yards on the ground.

No. 24 West Georgia remained perfect in non-conference action, traveling to nearby Clark-Atlanta and notching its third in-region win of the season, 42-2. The Wolves' defense continued to impose their will on the opposition, stretching the number of quarters without giving up a touchdown to 13. The win also pushed UWG into the AFCA Top 25 for the first time since 2001.



OFFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

North Alabama running back Lamonte Thompson

Thompson claims his second all-time honor and is UNA's first winner of the season after leading the Lions to a 31-29 victory over No. 21 Valdosta State in the GSC Game of the Week. The junior recorded his seventh career 100-yard outing, running for a game-best 140 yards and two touchdowns on a GSC season-high 25 carries. The Florence, AL native extended North Alabama's lead to 14-0 in the first quarter, but he saved his best for the second half, compiling 104 yards and giving UNA a 28-22 edge with 5:48 left to play when he ran for a five-yard score.



DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Florida Tech linebacker Chris Stapleton

Stapleton is FIT's second consecutive Defensive winner, spearheading the Panthers' defense in a 34-33 near upset at No. 14 DI-FCS Bethune-Cookman. The sophomore racked up five total tackles led by three solo stops. The Navarre, Fla. native made his biggest impact in BCU's backfield, racking up a game-high two solo sacks for 12 yards.



SPECIAL TEAMS PLAYER OF THE WEEK

North Alabama placekicker/punter Taylor Pontius

Pontius posts his first-ever laurel thanks to a record-setting performance in the UNA's 31-29 home victory over No. 21 Valdosta State. The senior overcame plenty of adversity during the contest capped by the game-winning, school-record, 54-yard field goal as time expired. The Biloxi, MS native was injured during the opening kickoff only to return as the team's placekicker and punter the rest of the game. Pontius' missed PAT with 5:28 to play opened the door for VSU's lead at 2:02, but he redeemed himself with the game on the line, booming the longest field goal in the GSC since 2000. For the night, Pontius also kicked two punts for 65 yards and five kickoffs for 339 yards and two touchbacks.



FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK

Florida Tech quarterback Mark Cato

Cato earns his fourth consecutive Freshman award, leading the Panthers to a 34-33 near-upset at No. 14 Bethune-Cookman. The Alachua, Fla. native completed 20-of-36 passes for a career-high 310 yards and four touchdowns. Cato's became just the third signal caller to pass for four TDs in a game this season, tying his previous effort versus Stetson two weeks ago.

GSC FOOTBALL–THE WEEK AHEAD

Three league clashes and one non-conference battle make up this week’s GSC gridiron slate.

A pair of Thursday contests kickoff the week led by Game Four of the GSC Football Game of the Week Presented by Florida’s Space Coast. The GSC-TV crew travels to Melbourne, Fla. for the first time ever, as **Florida Tech** hosts **No. 11 Delta State** in a 7:00 pm EST kickoff. The game can be viewed exclusively on ESPN3 by accessing

www.gscsports.org/ESPN3 or by downloading the WatchESPN app.

FIT starts its string of seven consecutive Conference games after going 3-1 in non-conference action so far this year. DSU makes its second television appearance of the season after winning at Valdosta State in Game Two on September 20.

Mississippi College and **Shorter** are fresh off their respective bye-weeks and face off on Thursday night in Rome, Ga. for the first time ever.

Saturday is headlined by a Top 25 GSC battle between **No. 22 West Alabama** and host **No. 24 West Georgia**. Both teams seek victories in their first Conference contest of the season. **No. 5 North Alabama** completes Week Five, hosting a non-conference opponent for the second time in three weeks when Great Northwest Athletic Conference foe Western Oregon crosses the country.

Game Breakdown: Florida Tech hosts its GSC opener on Thursday night when **No. 11 Delta State** comes to the Sunshine State for Game Four of the Football Game of the Week Presented by Florida’s Space Coast.

DSU returns to the airwaves for the second time this year after earning a 49-32 triumph at Valdosta State on September 20. Overall, the Statesmen have the best winning percentage in GSC-TV history, going 15-8 (.652) since 2005. Their 15 wins are tied for first with North Alabama. FIT seeks its first television triumph after falling at West Georgia in 2013.

Delta State claimed a 52-31 home win over Florida Tech in the first-ever meeting a year ago. The squads combined for 1,051 yards, as FIT entered the fourth quarter within seven points until DSU scored 21 unanswered points in the first six minutes of the quarter. The Statesmen are 2-0 away from Cleveland this year, while the Panthers were victorious in their lone home matchup two weeks ago.

Game Breakdown: No. 24 West Georgia and No. 22 West Alabama seek to jump start their league schedule with a victory on Saturday.

UWG leads the all-time series, 18-13, but the Tigers have closed the gap recently by winning five of the last six meetings. The Wolves return to the site of their last win in the series, clipping UWA at home in 2009, 10-9. West Alabama's current four-game winning streak marks the longest versus UWG in the series history that dates back to 1983. The Wolves are 11-4 versus UWA at home.

West Georgia has already put together its best season since 2001 when the Wolves started 4-0 and earned a national ranking in the AFCA Top 25. UWG is 2-0 at University Stadium this year and is riding a four-game home streak dating back to 2013. UWA has split its two road trips this year, topping Stillman in its season-opener before falling to DII-FCS Jacksonville State.
