WEEK SEVEN REVIEW

It was home-sweet-home in Week Eight action, as three GSC Football squads gave their respective home crowds something to cheer about in Saturday's four game slate.

No. 3 North Alabama thrilled the GSC-TV audience for the second time this season via a 31-28 home triumph over **West Georgia**. UNA found itself down by four points with two minutes left in the game, but the Lions put together a seven-play, 80-yard, game-winning drive capped by **Delvon Carpenter's** nine-yard TD reception with 44 ticks on the clock.

Valdosta State closed out its Homecoming festivities by collecting a 37-6 victory over in-state rival **Shorter**. VSU increased its winning streak to three games and the Blazers' defense ran their streak of quarters without allowing a touchdown to 12 straight.

Florida Tech pushed its all-time Homecoming record to 2-0 after cruising past **Mississippi College**, 44-9. **Mark Cato** tossed a school-record five touchdown passes to four different receivers and sparked the Panthers to a single-game record, 599 yards of total offense.

No. 19 Delta State posted the week's lone road victory, spoiling **West Alabama's** Homecoming, 45-24. DSU recorded its first win inside Tiger Stadium since 2007, as **Eddie McCadney** rushed for three rushing touchdowns and the Statesmen scored 21 points off UWA miscues.

OFFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

North Alabama quarterback Luke Wingo

Wingo takes home his first-ever award and is UNA's second Offensive winner of the season after leading the Lions to a 31-28 come-from-behind home win over West Georgia in Saturday's GSC-TV contest. The junior completed 25-of-33 passes for 316 yards and two touchdowns, while also rushing for 21 yards and another TD. The Tuscaloosa, Ala. native tossed UNA's lone score of first half and opened the third quarter with a go-ahead, one-yard TD run at 11:54. He saved his best for the Lions' last possession, leading a seven-play, 80-yard drive in the final two minutes. Wingo completed back-to-back passes, capped by the go-ahead, nine-yard strike with 44 seconds left to play.



DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

West Georgia defensive end Darrius Caldwell

Caldwell is the second consecutive UWG defender to claim accolades and the Wolves' third overall winner this year. The junior spearheaded the Wolves' defense versus UNA with nine total tackles, while also racking up a game-high five solo stops. The Atlanta, Ga. native was active in the Lions' backfield, leading all players with 2.5 sacks for 11 yards and added one forced fumble.



SPECIAL TEAMS PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Valdosta State placekicker Anthony Pistelli

Pistelli records his second honor of the season after putting together a perfect performance in VSU's 37-6 home victory over Shorter. The sophomore connected on all three of his field goal attempts, while also going 4-for-4 on point-after kicks. The Thomasville, Ga. native provided the Blazers' first points of the day, tying the score at 3-3 with a 33-yard field goal at 9:17 in the first frame. He added a 40-yarder in the third quarter and closed out the game's scoring via a 42-yard with one tick on the clock in the third frame.



FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK

Florida Tech quarterback Mark Cato

Cato secures his sixth Freshman accolade of the year after leading FIT to a 44-9 road decision over Mississippi College. The Alachua, Fla. native completed 29-of-39 passes for 304 yards and five touchdowns, leading the Panthers to a school-record 599 total yards. Cato became just the second GSC passer to throw for five scores in a game this season.

GSC FOOTBALL—THE WEEK AHEAD

Monday's release of the first set of NCAA regional rankings added another level of interest in this week's GSC Football action. Four GSC teams enter the week ranked in the Top Six of the 10-team rankings that are used to determine the participants in the NCAA Playoffs.

Valdosta State will be the first regionally ranked squad to take the field this week, when the No. 5 Blazers travel to **West Alabama** in the GSC Football Game of the Week Presented by Florida's Space Coast. UWA hosts VSU in GSC-TV action for the second year in a row after the Tigers upset the then No. 1 Blazers, 49-30. The game can be viewed exclusively on ESPN3 by accessing www.gscsports.org/ESPN3 or by downloading the WatchESPN app.

All eyes will be on Cleveland, Miss. on Saturday when **North Alabama** travels to **Delta State**. UNA is No. 1 in Super Region Two and puts its undefeated mark on the line at the No. 3 ranked Statesmen. No. 6 **West Georgia** seeks to remain in the post-season mix, hosting **Mississippi College** on Saturday, while **Shorter** hopes to celebrate Homecoming when **Florida Tech** journeys north to Rome, Ga.

Game Breakdown: **West Alabama** and **Valdosta State** battle in front of a GSC-TV audience in Livingston for the second year in a row in Game Eight of the Football Game of the Week Presented by Florida's Space Coast.

UWA is a perfect 2-0 versus VSU in televised contests after the Tigers upset then No. 1 VSU a year ago before claiming a 24-21 triumph in Tiger Stadium in 2010. The squads each entered 2014 with 13-9 GSC-TV records, but West Alabama pushed its mark to 14-9 via a win at Shorter two weeks ago. Valdosta State seeks to put the brakes on a four-game TV losing skid led by a pair of setbacks in this year's package.

National rankings may not be on the line in this year's matchup, but VSU cannot afford a loss after entering the first set of NCAA DII regional rankings at No. 5. Conversely, a UWA-win on Thursday night would serve as a signature triumph for first-year Head Coach Brett Gilliland.

Valdosta State owns a comfortable, 29-4 lead in the all-time series, but three of West Alabama's wins have come in the last five meetings. In fact, the rivals have traded victories in the last six contests dating back to 2009. The Blazers are 12-3 all-time in Livingston, but UWA has won the last two in 2013 (49-30) and 2010 (24-21).

Game Breakdown: **Mississippi College** rekindles a past rivalry versus a GSC Peach State member for the second time in three weeks when the Choctaws travel to **West Georgia** on Saturday.

UWG can ill afford a second straight loss to a Conference squad, entering the weekend ranked No. 6 in the first set of NCAA DII regional rankings. The Wolves and MC face off for the first time since 1995 when UWG finished the series with three consecutive wins, two of which came in Carrollton, Ga. Mississippi College leads all-time, 8-5, as both teams were GSC members from 1984-95. They have split the six previous contests at UWG with the Wolves taking the first matchup in 1985, 30-25, and final two in 1994 and 1995.

Game Breakdown: National and regional rankings are on the line in Cleveland, Miss. when **Delta State** hosts **North Alabama** for the fifth time in the last six meetings.

UNA enters McCool Stadium ranked No. 1 in the region and No. 3 in the nation, while DSU is No. 3 and No. 19, respectively. The Lions are the GSC's lone undefeated team behind a 3-0 road mark, but the Statesmen have won six straight at home dating back to 2013 led by a 2-0 record this year.

North Alabama holds a 31-25-1 series advantage, but Delta State has claimed four of the last five battles. UNA has had recent road success with its final two wins in the series coming at DSU (2012, 20-12; 2010, 31-7). Overall, the Statesmen hold a slim edge at home versus the Lions, 15-14-1.

CHASING GSC RECORDS

Shorter safety Jordan Shaw is currently tied for third in the GSC single-season list for interceptions in a season. Through seven games, the junior has stepped in front of eight passes which has been accomplished 10 previous times. Three players currently sit at nine INTs, while only two players have nabbed 10 in a season (Blake Farris, UNA in 2005; Stanley King, UWA in 1975).

West Georgia return specialist Denarius Appling currently ranks third on the GSC career list of punt return yards in a career with 972. He is 99 yards from second-place and is well behind the record of 1,760. Appling is also second all-time in punt return touchdowns (5) and can tie the record with one more score.
