WEEK FIVE REVIEW

All three of the GSC's undefeated squads remained perfect in a Week Five slate that included three Conference clashes and one non-conference battle.

Thursday night featured two league contests led by Game Four of the GSC Football Game of the Week which broadcast for the first time ever from Melbourne, Fla. **Florida Tech** opened its league schedule by hosting **No. 11 Delta State** in a game that featured some of the top offensive talent in the GSC. Both offenses struggled out of the gate, combining for just 14 points in the first 23 minutes only to pick up the pace with 29 total points in final seven minutes. The Statesmen held a three-point lead at halftime and put the game away in second half thanks to 35 unanswered points. **Quarterback Tyler Sullivan** combined for six total touchdowns, throwing for five and running for another while passing for 456 yards.

Shorter defended its home turf for the just the second time this season, earning a win in its GSC opener, 27-14 over **Mississippi College**. MC entered the final 15 minutes with a one-point advantage, but the Hawks closed out the fourth frame with back-to-back touchdowns en route to victory.

For the third week in a row, the GSC featured a Top 25 matchup versus league rivals when **No. 24 West Georgia** hosted a 26-17 triumph over **No. 22 West Alabama**. Neither team led by more than seven points until UWG opened a 13-point edge midway through the third quarter. UWA cut its deficit to six points in the fourth quarter, but **Hunter Heck** sealed the win with a 36-yard field goal at 4:30.

No. 5 North Alabama closed out the weekend by capping its Homecoming with a 30-10 victory over Great Northwest Athletic Conference member Western Oregon. The win increased the GSC's record versus non-conference, Division II opponents to 14-1 and was UNA's 27th non-conference, regular-season win in 30 games. UNA's defense registered nine sacks and back-up **quarterback Jacob Tucker** stepped in for starter Luke Wingo by combining for 190 yards and two touchdowns.



OFFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Delta State quarterback Tyler Sullivan

Sullivan claims his second honor of the season and fourth of his career after leading DSU to a 58-20 win at Florida Tech in Thursday night's GSC Game of the Week. The sophomore completed 24-of-41 passes for 456 yards and five touchdowns, while also adding another TD on the ground. The Louisville, Miss. native bounced back from a 1-for-8 start, completing 23-of-31 passes the rest of the way. His five TD passes were the most in the GSC this season and his six total scores were tied for tops for the year.



DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Delta State linebacker Diego Lubin

Lubin captures his first-ever award after spearheading Delta State's defense in its win over FIT. The senior recorded six total tackles and posted a game-high 3.5 tackles for a loss of 16 yards and two sacks for nine yards. The Winter Haven, Fla. native did not stop there, forcing one fumble and recovering another fumble.



SPECIAL TEAMS PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Shorter placekicker Kenny Langford

Langford earns Shorter's first-ever Special Teams award after helping the Hawks to a 27-14 home win over Mississippi College on Thursday night. The senior accounted for nine of SU's points on the night, hitting two of his three field goal efforts and going 3-for-3 on point-after kicks. The Dallas, Ga. native provided the Hawks' first six points of the game when he booted a 20-yarder with 18 seconds left in the first quarter, followed by a 32-yarder at 8:09 in the second.



FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK

Shorter slot back Aaron Bryant

Bryant is SU's first-ever Freshman award winner after helping the Hawks' claim a win in its GSC opener. The Landrum, S.C. native was penciled-in as Shorter's third-string quarterback, but Bryant ended up seeing action in his first-ever game at slot back where he carried the ball five times for 82 yards. He reeled off the team's longest run of the year via a 67-yard touchdown scamper with 10:40 left to play. He also led the team in receiving when he caught the team's longest pass of the year for 31 yards.

GSC FOOTBALL—THE WEEK AHEAD

This week's slate kicks off with a return trip to the Magnolia State for the GSC-TV crew, followed by Saturday's four-game set that includes two Conference and two non-conference battles.

No. 11 Delta State performs in the GSC Football Game of the Week Presented by Florida's Space Coast for the third time this season, hosting **Shorter**. DSU hosts its first telecast of the season after earning road victories in its two previous TV games. Meanwhile, SU plays its first of two straight televised contests as the Hawks host Game Six next Thursday. All games can be viewed exclusively on ESPN3 by accessing www.gscsports.org/ESPN3 or by downloading the WatchESPN app.

A pair of Conference matchups headline Saturday. **No. 21 West Georgia** travels to Peach State rival **Valdosta State**, putting its 5-0 record on the line and seeking just its second win in the series dating back to 2000. One team will earn their first conference win in Livingston when **West Alabama** hosts **Florida Tech** after each squad dropped their GSC opener last week.

No. 5 North Alabama plays its third and final non-conference opponent when the Lions journey to UNC-Pembroke for an important in-region contest. UNA has won 11 consecutive regular season games dating back to last year and is 27-3 in its last 30 regular-season, non-conference matchups. **Mississippi College** rounds out Saturday, defending its home turf for the first time since September 13 and seeking its first win of 2014 when the University of Faith comes to Clinton.

Game Breakdown: **No. 11 Delta State** seeks to go 3-0 in televised games this season, when the Statesmen host **Shorter** in Game Five of the Football Game of the Week Presented by Florida's Space Coast.

DSU returns to the airwaves for the third time this year and second time in as many weeks. The Statesmen earned a 49-32 triumph at Valdosta State on September 20 and followed with a 50-28 victory at Florida Tech this past Thursday. Overall, Delta State has the best winning percentage in GSC-TV history, going 16-8 (.667) since 2005. Meanwhile, SU seeks its first-ever television triumph after going 0-4 the past two years.

The series lead is also up for grabs on Thursday night as each team has secured a victory in the first two meetings. Thursday marks the first matchup in Cleveland after Shorter served as the host in 2012 and 2013. The Hawks surprised Delta State with a 32-21 win two years ago, but DSU answered with a 38-17 triumph in 2013. A Delta State win will move the Statesmen to 5-0 for the first time since 2007, while Shorter would be 4-1 for the first time since 2008.

Game Breakdown: **No. 5 North Alabama** jumps out of league play for the third time this season, traveling to in-region, DII Independent UNC-Pembroke.

The squads face off in Pembroke for the second year in a row after UNA topped the Braves in the Second Round of the DII Playoffs, 37-13. The Lions intercepted five UNCP passes and returned two for touchdowns to sew up the win in the fourth quarter.

UNA is in search of its first 5-0 start since it opened 2011 with six straight wins. The Lions have claimed 27 of their last 30 regular season games against non-GSC schools and have won 11 in a row versus non-conference competition. North Alabama can even its all-time record versus teams from the state of North Carolina to 4-4.
