WEEK 11 REVIEW

There were no surprises in the final week of the 2014 regular season, resulting in a share of the GSC Title and four teams selected for the NCAA Division II Playoffs.

Delta State and **North Alabama** each posted victories over in-state rivals to finish in a tie atop the league standings that also guaranteed NCAA Playoff spots. The GSC Title was shared for the second year in a row after **UNA** tied with **West Alabama** in 2013.

North Alabama kicked off the week, assuring itself at least a share of the GSC Crown thanks to a 24-16 win at in-state rival **West Alabama** in the final GSC-TV Game of the Week. **UWA** outgained **UNA** on offense, 453-326, but the Lions' defense dominated in the red zone en route to victory.

Delta State dusted off its rivalry versus nearby **Mississippi College** in Homecoming action on Saturday. **DSU** held **MC** scoreless in the second half on its way to a 27-3 triumph, which sewed up a share of the league title and allowed the Statesmen to hoist the Heritage Bell trophy.

Valdosta State held its ground in the regional rankings after weathering a late rally at **Florida Tech** to escape with a 31-29 win. **VSU** held a 24-9 lead heading into the fourth quarter and a 31-16 edge with just 8:36 left to play before **FIT** hit for back-to-back touchdowns. The Blazers' defense sewed up the win by denying the Panthers' two-point attempt that would have tied the contest with 2:15 left to play.

West Georgia bolstered its NCAA Playoff resume by topping in-state foe **Shorter** on the road, 31-17. The Wolves and Hawks were tied, 17-17, heading into the final 15 minutes, but **UWG's** defense pitched the shutout and **running back Seth Hinsley** ran for two touchdowns to ice the win in the fourth quarter. **West Georgia** enters the post-season with nine wins for the first time since 2000.



OFFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

West Georgia running back Seth Hinsley

Hinsley collects his first-ever honor and is the UWG's first Offensive winner since 2011, after leading the Wolves to a 31-17 road win at in-state rival Shorter on Saturday. The senior turned-in a career day versus the Hawks, carrying the ball 34 times for a career-best 196 yards and four touchdowns. The Norcross, Ga. native tied UWG's record for rushing TDs in a game and his four scores were also the most by a GSC player this season.



DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Delta State linebacker Rory Island

Island earns the first accolade of his career and he is the second DSU defender to post laurels this year. The senior spearheaded the Statesmen's defense in a 27-3 home victory over in-state rival Mississippi College, racking up a career-best 15 total tackles, including nine solo stops. The Waveland, Miss. native was also active in the MC's backfield, notching 2.0 tackles for a loss of 15 yards and one sack.



SPECIAL TEAMS PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Delta State placekick Vince Sciorrotta

Sciorrotta secures his second career honor and is DSU's first Special Teams award winner of 2014. The sophomore provided a perfect performance in the Statesmen's win over MC, hitting both of his field goal attempts and going 3-for-3 on point-after kicks. The Cumming, Ga. native delivered from 27 yards with 96 seconds in the first half and he capped the fourth quarter with a 31-yarder.



FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK

Florida Tech quarterback Mark Cato

Cato secures his eighth Freshman accolade of the year after leading FIT to a near-upset of West Georgia, 31-29. The Alachua, Fla. native completed 15-of-34 passes for 310 yards and two touchdowns, while also running 11 times for 46 yards and one TD.

GSC MOVES FOUR INTO NCAA FOOTBALL PLAYOFFS

For the first time in its 44-year history, the Gulf South Conference advanced four teams in the NCAA Division II Football Playoff field. The GSC rebounded from just one team in last year's 24-team field with its most-ever post-season participants in this year's Playoff. The selections marked the 24th overall time that the GSC advanced at least two teams and the 10th time with at least three post-season participants dating back to 1975. The Conference has been represented in the post-season in 37 of the last 38 years, missing out in 1976.

Leading the GSC contingent in the six-team Super Region Two field is No. 2 seed Delta State (9-1), which earned a First Round Bye along with No. 1 seed Lenoir-Rhyne (11-0). North Alabama (9-1) secured the No. 4 seed and hosts league rival and No. 5 seed Valdosta State. No. 6 seed West Georgia (9-2) completed the GSC's quartet, earning its first bid since 2000. UNA and VSU face off in Florence, Ala. for the second time this season, while UWG travels to No. 3 seed Tuskegee (9-2) this Saturday. Kickoff for both First Round battles is set for 12:00 pm (CST).

Not to be left out of the post-season conversation is Shorter which was selected to host North Greenville in the 18th annual National Christian College Athletic Association's (NCCAA) Victory Bowl.

A total of 20 different football-playing schools have belonged to the GSC at some point since 1973 and 12 of those have earned at least one Playoff bid. The GSC has compiled 102 wins during that span along with a .630 winning percentage (102-60). In fact, of the last 26 national champions, 11* have come from the GSC, seven from the former North Central Conference, five from the Mid-America Intercollegiate Athletic Association and three from the Great Lakes Intercollegiate Athletic Conference. The GSC holds the playoff record for different schools to win the championship game (6), championship game appearances (17) and different schools to appear in the championship game (6). *--Mississippi College's 1989 national championship was vacated for NCAA infractions.

Game Breakdown: If recent history is any indication, fans inside Braly Municipal Stadium can expect an exciting rematch when **GSC Co-Champions North Alabama** hosts Conference rival **Valdosta State** for the second time in 2014.

The squads return to the scene of one of the most exciting finishes in GSC-TV history on September 27 when UNA's Taylor Pontius booted a school-record, 54-yard field goal as time expired resulting in a 31-29 Lions' victory. North Alabama extended its all-time series lead versus Valdosta State to 22-15-1 via its seventh win in the last nine meetings. Overall, UNA holds an 11-7 advantage at home during the series.

Saturday's clash also marks the 22nd all-time meeting between a pair of GSC members in the NCAA Playoffs dating back to 1989. Six of those previous meetings included VSU and UNA with North Alabama holding a 4-1 record in the previous five contests. The Lions have claimed the two Playoff battles in Florence, Ala. after outlasting the Blazers in overtime, 27-24 in the 1994 Quarterfinals and taking a 37-10 decision in the 2008 Second Round.

North Alabama returns to the post-season for the 10th time in the last 11 years, going 12-8 during that span capped by last year's loss at Lenoir-Rhyne in the Quarterfinals. Overall, UNA is 31-15 in NCAA Playoff contests and are a three-time NCAA Champion after claiming three straight crowns from 1993-95. The Lions have advanced to the Finals four times and the Semifinals nine times.

Valdosta State returns to the post-season for the first time since winning the NCAA DII Title in 2012, giving the Blazers a four-game, post-season streak heading into Saturday. In fact, VSU has captured the Gulf South Conference's last three NCAA Crowns in 2007, 2004 and 2012, and have made it to four Title Games and four Semifinals. Overall, Valdosta State makes its 13th appearance behind a 19-9 record.

Game Breakdown: No. 6 seed West Georgia crosses the state line to play Southern Intercollegiate Athletic Conference Champion and No. 3 seed Tuskegee in the first-ever meeting between the schools.

UWG is no stranger to SIAC opponents after going 2-0 on the road at SIAC members during 2014. The Wolves earned a 26-0 shutout at Miles on September 13 and followed with a 42-2 triumph at Clark Atlanta two weeks later. In fact, West Georgia has a put together a three-game streak versus the SIAC, also topping Miles in 2013. TU takes on a GSC foe in the Playoffs for the second year in a row after the Golden Tigers lost as a No. 6 seed at North Alabama in 2013, 30-27.

UWG returns to the NCAA Playoffs for the first time since 2000 when the Wolves fell in the First Round at Catawba, 28-24. West Georgia seeks to make school history on Saturday by claiming its first-ever post-season victory after going winless in its four previous matchups. All four of UWG's previous Playoff contests have come on the road, dropping decisions to Carson-Newman in 1995, 1996 and 1998 before its setback at Catawba in 2000.

Game Breakdown: Shorter earned the right to extend its season on Sunday when the Hawks were selected to host the 18th annual NCAA Victory Bowl and DII Independent North Greenville.

SU and NGU clash for the second time in Rome, Ga. after Shorter notched a 37-21 home victory over the Crusaders in the first-ever meeting. The teams have a common 2014 opponent with SU winning at Mars Hill in the second game of the year, 27-20, while North Greenville lost at home to MHC, 30-27.

Shorter is 2-3 at home this year and seeks to put the brakes on a six-game skid which started on October 9. North Greenville has won two of its last three games and is 1-4 away from Tigerville, S.C.

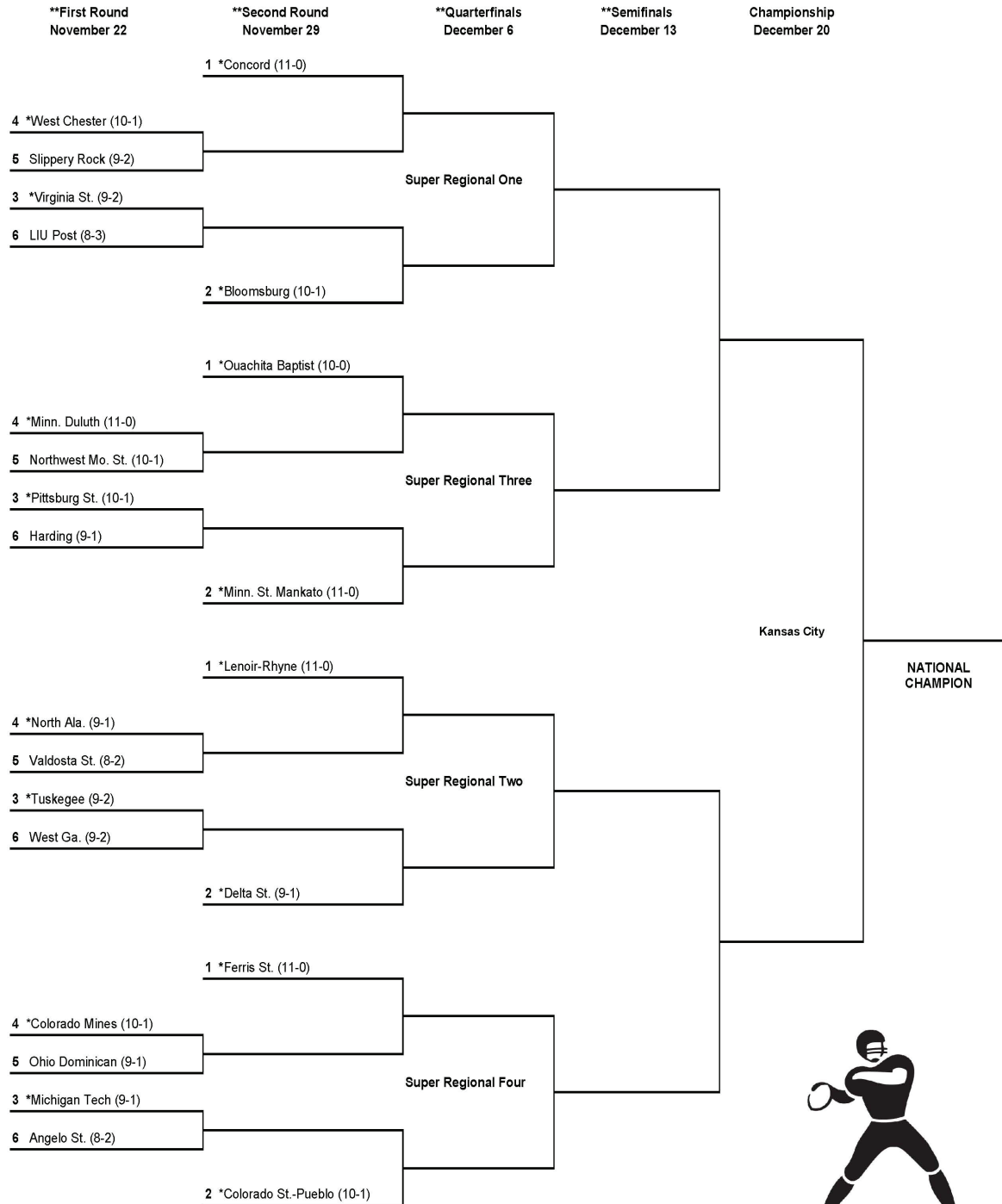
