2014 ALL-GSC MEN'S GOLF TEAM RELEASED

Birmingham, AL—The Gulf South Conference is proud to announce the 2014 All-GSC Men's Golf Team as selected the league's coaches.

Three schools provided at least one honoree on the five-member squad, led by **North Alabama** and **GSC Champion West Florida** which placed two standouts apiece. **West Georgia** completed the team via one winner.

GSC INDIVIDUAL AWARDS

North Alabama earned its second consecutive *GSC Player of the Year* when **Conner Godsey** collected this year's laurel. Godsey is UNA's fifth all-time winner and he follows former teammate Ricky Stimets. The senior finished the regular season ranked No. 39 in the GolfStat Standings thanks to an average score of 72.96. The Rogersville, AL posted two rounds of 68 and finished in the Top 10 in six tournaments, winning one outright during the fall.

Esteban Castro claimed the *GSC Freshman of the Year*, becoming **West Florida's** second winner in three years. The Bogotá, Colombia native entered last week's GSC Tournament as one of three freshmen ranked in the Top 30 of the GolfStat Standings. His 72.71 scoring average was also the highest on the squad. Castro won one tournament this season and he led UWF with 10 rounds of par or better before entering the GSC Championship.

West Florida's Steve Fell increased his record for *GSC Coach of the Year* honors to 12 dating back to 1995. Fell's selection also marked his second consecutive accolade and third in four years after leading UWF to back-to-back GSC Titles earlier this week. The Argonauts enter the NCAA post-season ranked No. 12 in the GolfState Team Rankings and the *Golf World/Nike Golf Top 25 Poll*.

ALL-GSC TEAM

The 2014 All-GSC Team is headlined by two returning members from last season's squad and just one upperclassman.

West Georgia sophomore **Corey Evans** and **North Alabama** junior **Trent Alexander** are back from a year ago, while **UNA's Conner Godsey** is the lone senior on the squad. **West Florida** rounded out the list by placing junior **Juan Miguel Heredia** and freshman **Esteban Castro**. Four of this year's All-GSC members also won GSC All-Tournament honors led by Heredia who *set the league record for the lowest 54-hole score in Conference history (203)*.
