2014 ALL-GSC BASEBALL HONORS ANNOUNCED

Birmingham, Ala.—The Gulf South Conference is pleased to announce its 2014 All-Conference Baseball Team.

West Florida led all schools with 12 overall members, followed by **Delta State**, with eight. **Alabama Huntsville** turned in five, while both **Valdosta State** and **West Alabama** saw four each make the team. **North Alabama** and **West Georgia** both placed three players, while **Christian Brothers** rounded out the list with one.

2014 SEASON ACCOLADES

West Alabama's **Mitch Holgate**, the 2013 GSC Freshman of the Year, claimed *GSC Player of the Year* honors this year. He closed out the season with a .320 batting average, smacked eight homeruns, hit 12 doubles, four triples and collected 37 RBI.

Jordan DeLorenzo, of West Florida, earned the *GSC Pitcher of the Year* by going 10-1 with an astounding 0.92 ERA and 73 strikeouts. He tossed six complete games and racked up four shutouts over 78.0 innings of work. He placed a season-high five GSC Pitcher of the Week accolades. He also earned three NCBWA Region Pitcher of the Week honors and was also named an NCBWA National Pitcher of the Week.

Walker O'Connor (West Florida) brought home *GSC Freshman of the Year* honors. He turned in a 4-0 record with a 2.37 ERA and 21 strikeouts. He appeared in 12 games, including three starts, and totaled 38.0 innings of service.

After leading West Florida to a 31-9 overall record, including a 22-7 GSC record, **Mike Jeffcoat** was named the *GSC Coach of the Year*. UWF will enter the GSC Baseball Tournament as the three-seed for the second-consecutive season.

ALL-GSC TEAM

The 2014 All-GSC First Team is headlined by both West Florida and Delta State, with five players each. Alabama Huntsville, Valdosta State and West Alabama all turned in three players each, while North Alabama had one to round out the list.

The 2014 All-GSC Second Team saw West Florida turn in seven players, while Delta State and West Georgia both had three each. Alabama Huntsville and North Alabama both had two players make the team, while Christian Brothers, Valdosta State and West Alabama all had one second teamer each.
