NORTH ALABAMA NAMED GSC PRE-SEASON FOOTBALL FAVORITE

Birmingham, AL—The Gulf South Conference Football Title banner was predicted to stay in Florence, Alabama after **North Alabama** finished atop the 2014 GSC Pre-Season Coaches' Poll.

UNA enters the year as the Pre-Season favorite for the first time in four years, compiling 35 total points led by five first-place votes. **Delta State** recorded its highest finish since 2010, taking second-place via 30 points behind the final two first-place nods. **Valdosta State** and **West Alabama** followed in third (26) and fourth place (21), respectively. Fifth-place **West Georgia** tallied 17 points, followed by **Florida Tech** (12) and **Shorter** (six), which enters the 2014 campaign as an official GSC member after two years as a Provisional member.

CLOSER LOOK AT THE GSC COACHES' POLL

Lions Back On Top...

North Alabama returned to the top of the Pre-Season Poll for the first time since 2010. UNA claimed first-place in the Pre-Season and at the end of regular season in the same season on four previous occasions. The Lions were voted No. 1 from 1993-95 and also in 2006 and held that spot until season's end.

First-place By The Numbers...

North Alabama increased its lead for the number of first-place GSC Pre-Season Coaches' Poll rankings to 11. The Lions hold a comfortable lead in the all-time standings with Valdosta State and Troy State sharing second place with eight No. 1 rankings.

Fulfilling the Prophecy...

Out of the past 39 Pre-Season Coaches polls on record, 14 first-place teams have gone on to hoist the GSC trophy in November. West Alabama is the most recent Pre-Season favorite to go on and win the Title, sharing the trophy with North Alabama in 2013.

How Have Newcomers Faired?...

Dating back to 1973, there have been 13 new additions to the GSC football ranks. Shorter officially becomes No. 14 in 2014 and enters the season in last place in the Coaches' Poll. Five previous first-time members also began their league membership in the final poll position (Nicholls State in 1972, Mississippi College in 1973, Henderson State in 1993, Ouachita Baptist in 2000 and Florida Tech in 2013). The good news for SU is that only one of those five teams finished the year in last place (Florida Tech).

INSIDE THE GSC HUDDLE

THE WAIT IS OVER FOR SHORTER

The long wait is finally over for **Shorter University** which enters 2014 as an official GSC member. SU has competed in the league for the past two years as part of its transition into league membership, but the Hawks were not eligible for the GSC Championship, Conference awards or the NCAA Playoffs.

Shorter's official membership marks the second consecutive year that the Conference has added a new school into the fold after Florida Tech became the league's first football-only member in 2013.

MISSISSIPPI COLLEGE RETURNS

Former member **Mississippi College** takes another step to returning to NCAA Division II and the GSC by playing a full Conference schedule as part of its transitional process from Division III. MC was a GSC member from 1972-94, earning Conference Crowns in 1979, 1988 and 1990. The Choctaws will compete as a "GSC First-Year Candidacy Member" in 2014-15, followed by "Second-Year Candidacy" in 2015-16 with hopes to become an official member in 2016-17. Starting this season, results versus MC count towards the league standings, but the Choctaws will not be eligible for post-season awards.

CHANGE IN LEADERSHIP FOR UWA AND UWG

West Alabama and **West Georgia** have new Head Coaches directing from the sidelines in 2014. Will Hall moved inside the Conference ranks, accepting the UWG job after coaching at UWA from 2011-2013. The former North Alabama quarterback was 25-11 in Livingston, leading the Tigers to back-to-back league Titles in 2012 and 2013.

West Alabama turned to one of its Hall of Fame member to keep the Tigers' program on track, tabbing former record-setting quarterback Brett Gilliland as its head coach. Gilliland returns to Livingston after a two-year stint as Quarterback's Coach at Kennesaw State and two years on the offensive staff at Georgia Southern from 2010-12. Gilliland was a regional finalist for the Harlon Hill Trophy in 2003 and concluded his career as the school's leader in single-season (3,213) and career passing yards (6,689).

SHORTER AND FLORIDA TECH TO PLAY IN LONE STAR FOOTBALL FESTIVAL

For the first time ever, the GSC will send two teams to the fourth-annual Lone Star Football Festival when **Florida Tech** and **Shorter** play inside AT&T Stadium in Arlington, TX. This year's event features four NCAA DII clashes on Saturday, September 20. SU plays the second game versus West Texas A&M at 1:00 pm (Central), followed by FIT at 5:00 pm against 2013 Lone Star Conference Co-Champion Tarleton State.

The GSC provided one team in the festival the past three years, going 2-1. North Alabama and Valdosta State claimed victories in 2012 and 2013, while Delta State lost in a shootout a year ago.

2014 PRE-SEASON ALL-GSC TEAM

The 2014 Pre-Season All-GSC Football Team includes 34 total members and is led by seven returning Pre-Season players and 13 All-Conference First Teamers spanning the past two seasons.

Delta State and **West Alabama** led the way with seven total Pre-Season members, followed by six from **Florida Tech** and **West Georgia**. **North Alabama** (five) and **Valdosta State** (three) closed out the list of winners.

UWA quarterback **Kyle Caldwell** headlines the Pre-Season offense after garnering the 2013 GSC Offensive Player of the Year. **VSU** running back **Cedric O'Neal** returns to the Pre-Season list for the third year in a row and is also a two-time First Team standout. **West Alabama** wide out **Chad Toocheck** and tight end **Ty Morgan** earned back-to-back Pre-Season appearances.

UNA defensive lineman **Taylor Carney** collected Pre-Season Team laurels for the third straight season and heads the list of three returning 2013 First Team All-GSC defensive standouts. Four sophomores made the defensive squad led by **North Alabama** defensive back **Philbert Martial** and **FIT** linebacker **Chris Stapleton** who shared the 2013 Defensive Freshman of the Year.

West Alabama and West Georgia make up the Pre-Season Special Teams list. **West Georgia** return specialist **Denarius Appling** returns for the fourth time in his career, while long snapper **Matt Humphries** is a three-time Pre-Season honoree. **UWA** placekicker **Mark Grant** made the 2013 First Team All-GSC Team as a freshman and **UWG** punter **James Dugan** is back after a Second Team designation a year ago.

2014 GSC-TV LIVE SCHEDULE

The Gulf South Conference's television package has a new home for 2014 after the league officially announced an exclusive agreement with ESPN to broadcast its GSC-TV content.

The agreement marks the fourth consecutive year that the GSC and ESPN have collaborated to bring GSC-TV to fans around the globe, but this year the parties signed their first-ever exclusive agreement. ESPN3 and live access on WatchESPN will host every contest with no blackout restrictions.

"GSC-TV has been a ground-breaking project since its inception," stated GSC Commissioner Matt Wilson. "By reaching an exclusive distribution agreement with ESPN on its ESPN3 and WatchESPN platforms, the Gulf South Conference continues to be a leader in NCAA Division II. We appreciate the opportunity and look forward to working closely with the ESPN team as we bring you the first season of GSC-TV on ESPN."

Leading the way will be the 10th edition of the GSC-TV Football Game of the Week package. The Conference is set to deliver 11 games for 2014 with all contests available live on ESPN3. The agreement also includes live coverage of the 2015 GSC Men's and Women's Basketball Title Games which are scheduled for Saturday, March 7 at the Hanna Center on the campus of Samford University.

This year's GSC-TV football slate includes six Saturday games and five Thursday telecasts and also marks the first time that the package features all league contests since 2010.

Defending GSC Co-Champions North Alabama and West Alabama lead the way with four total appearances. Delta State and Valdosta State will be featured three times, while Florida Tech, Shorter, West Georgia and future member Mississippi College follow with two appearances.

Play-by-play commentator Don Russell and color commentator Rick Rhodes will continue to lead the broadcasts from the booth, while Gulf Coast Mobile, L.L.C. will produce the package for the third year in a row.
