### GSC CONTINUES NON-CONFERENCE SUCCESS

The Gulf South Conference continued its impressive start to 2014, stretching its record to 11-1 against non-conference foes with five more victories this past Saturday.

The league also flipped the switch on its 2014 Football Game of the Week slate when **No. 5 North Alabama** shutout future GSC member **Mississippi College**, 58-0. UNA took over the all-time series lead versus MC (15-14-2) by claiming its 12th consecutive win in a season-opener. The Lions entered the locker room with a 45-0 edge led by its defense which held the Choctaws to just 24 yards in the first 30 minutes of action.

**Valdosta State** upset then No. 12 Winston-Salem State on neutral ground at Cantrell Stadium in Powder Springs, Ga. VSU rushed for 229 yards and three touchdowns en route to a 22-17 win that helped vault the Blazers to No. 13 in the AFCA Top 25.

**No. 17 West Alabama's** defense turned-in a record performance in its 30-6, home-opening win over CIAA member Shaw. UWA sacked a pair of Bears' quarterbacks nine times which resulted in a minus-26 yard rushing effort by Shaw. The yardage total with the sixth best effort in league history.

**West Georgia** earned its second straight in-region win by recording its first shutout since 2005. UWG blanked SIAC member Miles College on the road, 26-0, headlined by five sacks and its first safety since 2007.

**Shorter** ran out to a 27-0 lead in the first half and held on in the second to upend in-region Mars Hill on the road, 27-20. The Hawks grabbed five interceptions, led by a school-record three picks by Jordan Shaw. Shaw gave SU a 7-0 lead in the first quarter when he returned an INT 100 yards for a touchdown.

**Florida Tech** earned a mark of revenge thanks to a 42-6 win over NAIA Ave Maria. FIT held a 14-0 edge at intermission, but the Panthers exploded for 28 points in the third quarter.

**OFFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK**

**Valdosta State quarterback/punter Jake Medlock**

Medlock led No. 23 Valdosta State to a 22-17 upset win over No. 12 Winston-Salem State on neutral ground in Powder Springs, Ga. The senior compiled 238 yards of total offense, passing for 162 yards and rushing 14 times for 76 yards. Medlock completed 16-of-27 passes for a 59.3 percentage and also logged an efficiency rating of 109.7. The Jacksonville, Fla. native scored the first points of the game, running in a one-yard TD just three seconds into the second quarter.



**DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK**

**Shorter safety Jordan Shaw**

Shaw became the first-ever Shorter Hawk to win a GSC Player of the Week laurel. The junior spearheaded SU's defense in the Hawks' 27-20 victory at Mars Hill, setting a school record for interceptions in a game nabbing three picks for 115 yards and one touchdown. Shaw's is the 12th player in league history to grabbed three INTs in a game his 115 yards is the third-most in GSC history. The Jasper, Ga. native gave the Hawks a lead that they never relinquished when he reeled off the 100-yard score at 5:08 in the first quarter. Shaw did not stop there, leading the team with 11 total tackles, seven of which came in solo efforts.



**SPECIAL TEAMS PLAYER OF THE WEEK**

**Valdosta State quarterback/punter Jake Medlock**

Medlock also turned-in a stellar performance in special teams work for the Blazers, booming seven punts for 335 yards for a 47.9 average. Two of his punts traveled over 50 yards, led by a 75-yarder which stood as the 8th longest in GSC history. For the day, Medlock forced three touchbacks and landed three more punts inside WSSU's 20-yard line.

**Florida Tech quarterback Mark Cato**

Cato earns his second consecutive Freshman award, leading the Panthers to a 42-6 revenge victory over in-state foe Ave Maria. The Alachua, Fla. native completed 10-of-23 passes for a 43.5 percentage. He threw for 179 yards and three touchdowns led by a 57-yard strike late in the third quarter.

GSC FOOTBALL—THE WEEK AHEAD

For the first time this season, all eight Gulf South Conference schools take the gridiron during the same week.

Saturday's slate includes one league matchup and six non-conference tilts. Game Two of the GSC Football Game of the Week Presented by Florida's Space Coast features the nation's lone Top 25 clash of the week when No. 13 Valdosta State hosts No. 14 Delta State at 7:00 pm (EST). The game is exclusive to ESPN3 and can be accessed at [www.gscsports.org/ESPN3](http://www.gscsports.org/ESPN3) or by downloading the WatchESPN app.

The GSC also puts its impressive 11-1 non-conference mark on the line on Saturday. Florida Tech and Shorter seek to remain undefeated in 2014 as each take part in the 2014 Lone Star Football Festival at AT&T Stadium in Arlington, Tex. SU takes on West Texas A&M at 1:00 pm (CST), followed immediately by FIT versus No. 12 Tarleton State at 5:00 pm (CST).

West Georgia celebrates its Homecoming, entertaining Division II CIAA member Johnson C. Smith. No. 5 North Alabama jumps out of Conference play, opening its home slate versus NAIA Langston. No. 17 West Alabama and future member Mississippi College round out the day facing NCAA Division I-FCS foes. UWA travels to former GSC rival Jacksonville State in their first meeting since 1992. MC also hits the road against Lamar with the Choctaws owning the series edge after taking the only matchup in 1988.

**Game Breakdown:** The second GSC Football Game of the Week has important early season implications when **No. 14 Delta State** journeys to **No. 13 Valdosta State**.

The rivals have provided offensive fireworks in the last two contests, combining for 100 points in 2012 and 118 points a year ago. VSU took a 59-41 decision at home two years ago, but DSU answered with a 63-55 triumph in Cleveland in 2013. Overall, the Statesmen own an 18-14-1 all-time lead thanks to victories in seven of the last eight battles. Delta State has made Bazemore-Hyder Stadium a home-away-from-home, earning nine wins in its past 15 trips to Valdosta, Ga. In fact, VSU's home victory in 2012 was the Blazers first since 2004.

Saturday also marks the team's seventh GSC-TV matchup. Delta State is 5-1 in the previous televised contests, stringing together six in a row after Valdosta State claimed the first meeting in 2005. DSU has the top winning percentage (.682; 15-7) in GSC-TV action dating back to 2005, while VSU is 13-8 for a 61.9 percentage.

**Game Breakdown:** Old in-state rivals clash for the first time since 1992 when No. 17 West Alabama goes to NCAA Division I-FCS Jacksonville State on Saturday.

The UWA/JSU rivalry dates back to 1938 and the squads were both charter members of the GSC from 1972 until the Gamecocks reclassified to Division I after the 1992 season. Saturday's game marks the first meeting since JSU's departure when the Gamecocks won their sixth straight taking a 29-13-1 series lead. GSC teams have gone 2-2 versus JSU since 1992 after West Georgia claimed a 25-22 upset in 1995 and North Alabama won in 2003, 28-16. UNA nearly made it two in a row a year ago, pushing the Gamecocks to overtime before falling 24-21. West Alabama plays a FSC team for the fourth straight year.
