WEEK THREE REVIEW

GSC-TV took center stage on Saturday when then **No. 13 Valdosta State** hosted **No. 14 Delta State** in the nation's only Top 25 Division II game in Week Three.

DSU continued its success in Valdosta, upending the Blazers by rolling up 622 yards of total offense. The Statesmen held a two-point lead at halftime, but the defense allowed just six points in the second half allowing its high-powered offense to sew up the victory. **Quarterback Tyler Sullivan** had a hand in four DSU touchdowns, while completing 41-of-64 passes for 502 yards.

The Conference continued to rack up wins in non-conference action, adding three more victories.

The GSC went 1-1 in the Lone Star Football Festival held at AT&T Stadium in Arlington, Texas. **Florida Tech** earned its first-ever triumph over a ranked opponent, topping No. 12 Tarleton State, 37-31. **Panthers running back Trevor Sand** ran for 152 yards and three scores, while **freshman signal caller Mark Cato** tossed the go-ahead TD with just 3:56 left on the clock.

Shorter also participated in the Festival, suffering its first setback of the year, 27-19 against West Texas A&M. The Hawks built a 12-point lead at halftime only to see the Buffalos score 20 unanswered points in the second half en route to a 27-19 final.

West Georgia celebrated its Homecoming by going is 3-0 for the first time since 2001 thanks to its second straight shutout versus a Division II opponent. UWG's defense continued its dominance, giving the Wolves their first back-to-back shutouts in 35 years by blanking CIAA member Johnson C. Smith, 49-0.

No. 5 North Alabama jumped out of Conference play, kicking off its home schedule by breezing past Langston, 56-7. UNA continued its impressive first-half success, sprinting to a 35-7 halftime lead by scoring on five of its first six possessions.

The Conference wrapped up the week facing a pair of Division I-FCS members on the road. **No. 21 West Alabama** came up short at former in-state GSC rival Jacksonville State. UWA closed the final 15 minutes with 20 unanswered points, but time ran out on the Tigers resulting in a 45-34 setback. **Future member Mississippi College** journeyed to Lamar, coming away with a 55-10 loss. The Choctaws challenged the Cardinals for the majority of the first half, but the hosts used 14 unanswered points in final two minutes of the second quarter to sew up the win.



OFFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Delta State quarterback Tyler Sullivan

Sullivan collects his third career weekly award after guiding No. 14 DSU to a 49-32 upset at No. 13 Valdosta State in the GSC-TV Game of the Week. The sophomore hit for four touchdowns and 528 yards on 74 plays, which ranked him eighth in the GSC record books in total yards and fifth (tied) in total plays. Sullivan completed 41-of-64 passes for a 64.1 completion percentage and threw 502 yards and three touchdowns. The Louisville, Miss. native's passing yards were the seventh-highest in league history and he was just the 10th player to complete at least 41 passes in a game.



DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Florida Tech linebacker J.J. Sanders

Sanders is FIT's first-ever Defensive winner, spearheading the Panthers' defense in a 37-31 upset over No. 12 Tarleton State in Arlington, Texas. The junior took the field for the first time this season, racking up a GSC season-high 12 total tackles led by seven solo stops. He was also active in TSU's backfield, posting 3.5 tackles for a loss of 19 yards, one sack for 12 yards and two quarterback hurries. The Columbus, OH native helped ice the game when he forced a fumble late in the fourth quarter, allowing the offense to run out the clock and sew up the victory.



SPECIAL TEAMS PLAYER OF THE WEEK

West Georgia return specialist Denarius Appling

Appling records his fifth Special Teams laurel in his career, first since 2012, by sparking the Wolves in their 49-0 home shutout of Johnson C. Smith. The senior combined for 120 yards on four returns, led by a 96-yard touchdown on his lone kickoff attempt. The return was the first kickoff score of his career and first UWG return since 1985. The Griffin, GA native also added three punt returns for 24 yards which placed him in third-place on the GSC's all-time punt return yardage list.



FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK

Florida Tech quarterback Mark Cato

Cato earns his third consecutive Freshman award, leading the Panthers to a 37-31 upset win over No. 12 Tarleton State in Arlington, Texas. The Alachua, Fla. native completed 24-of-37 passes for a career-high 296 yards and two touchdowns, while also running for 44 yards on 13 carries. He provided some late-game heroics when he tossed the go-ahead, seven-yard TD with just 3:56 left to play.

GSC FOOTBALL—THE WEEK AHEAD

For the second consecutive week, the GSC Football Game of the Week Presented by Florida's Space Coast features a Top 25 battle.

Saturday's five-game slate is headlined by Game Four of the GSC-TV package between **No. 5 North Alabama** and **No. 21 Valdosta State** in Florence, Ala. Kickoff is set for 6:00 pm (CST) and the game can be viewed exclusively on ESPN3 by accessing www.gscsports.org/ESPN3 or by downloading the WatchESPN app.

Both squads return to the airwaves for the second time this season. UNA flipped the switch on GSC-TV, earning a victory at Mississippi College on September 13th, while VSU plays to rebound from a home TV setback to Delta State last Saturday.

Rounding out Saturday are four non-conference contests. **No. 12 Delta State** and **West Georgia** seek to bolster their resumes versus non-conference, in-region opponents as both take on SIAC rivals. DSU opens up its home schedule by hosting Central State, while UWG travels to nearby Clark-Atlanta.

Florida Tech hopes to build on its perfect 3-0 record when the Panthers play at NCAA DI-FCS and MEAC member Bethune-Cookman. **No. 23 West Alabama** returns to Tigers Stadium for the second time in three weeks, hosting Concordia College (Ala).

Game Breakdown: **No. 21 Valdosta State** returns to GSC-TV for the second week in a row, attempting to bounce back from last week's setback when the Blazers travel to **No. 5 North Alabama**.

GSC-TV features a Top 25 matchup for the second straight week after then No. 14 Delta State moved past No. 13 VSU, 49-32, last Saturday. This Saturday marks the third all-time GSC-TV clash versus UNA and VSU with the Blazers holding a 2-0 edge thanks to a 26-23 home win in 2005 and a 5-0 triumph in Florence in 2010. Valdosta State is 13-9 in GSC-TV contests, while North Alabama is 9-8 dating back to 2005.

The Lions own a 21-15-1 lead in the all-time series, thanks to six wins in the last eight meetings, but VSU's two victories during that span came at Braly Municipal Stadium in 2010 and 2012. North Alabama last celebrated a home win over the Blazers in 2008 when the Lions took the regular season matchup and an NCAA Playoff contest. UNA holds a 10-7 advantage at home during the series.

Game Breakdown: West Georgia plays its fourth contest versus a Division II foe this and third against in-region competition when the Wolves travel to SIAC member Clark Atlanta.

UWG owns a 4-2 series lead, but the squads have traded victories the last four meetings. The Wolves took the first three games of the series in 1986, 1987 and 1991 before CAU clipped UWG at home in 1992 (28-26). West Georgia returned to Atlanta in 2007 to grab 23-11 triumph before the Panthers exited Carrollton with a 28-3 decision in 2008.

UWG has a put together a two-game streak versus SIAC foes, topping Miles in 2013 and in Week Two of 2014. The Wolves seek to go 4-0 for the first time since 2000 when they put together a 10-0 record before finishing the year at 10-2.
