Game Breakdown

West Georgia will go on the road after a dominant two weeks stretch where they outscored their opponents 70-6. The #25 team in the country and #4 team in the region controls their postseason destiny, but will close out the season with two Florida teams looking to play spoiler. The two running backs in this game (UWG's **Devontae Jackson** and FIT's **Antwan Haynes**) are the top two rushers in the league. They have both been GSC Offensive Players of the Week this season and both have been First Team All-GSC performers. Florida Tech QB **Mark Cato** has scored 10 total touchdowns the last three weeks, while West Georgia QB **Willie Candler** leads the league with 19 touchdown passes this season.

Game Breakdown

Delta State will head to North Greenville for a non-conference bout, but one that is critical for the regional rankings. The Statesmen currently sit seventh in the regional rankings, and while seven teams make the playoffs, the seventh spot is not a guarantee due to the earned access rule. DSU is coming off back-to-back setbacks, but the Statesmen would feel good about their playoff hopes with two wins to close out the season. This is the second of three GSC games for the Crusaders, who will join the GSC next year as an affiliate football member. NGU fell to Florida Tech, Delta State's opponent in next week's season finale, back on October 14, but earned a win over regionally ranked Carson-Newman two weeks ago.

If Valdosta State defeats UWA and wins next week, the Blazers will not only share the title with the Tigers, but leave the door open for a possible four-way split. If Valdosta State, West Georgia, and North Alabama win out, those three schools and UWA will share the 2017 GSC Football Title. The importance of this game resonated nationally, as the NCAA has flexed this game into a nationwide spotlight, making it a Division II Football Showcase that will be streamed on ESPN3 and the ESPN app.

North Alabama will make its first trip to Pensacola for this week's GSC Game of the Week. The Lions have four losses this season, but still have a chance to win their fifth straight GSC Championship if they win out and Valdosta State defeats West Alabama this weekend. The four losses that UNA has suffered this season have all been to teams currently ranked, including Central Washington and Texas A&M Commerce, two teams ranked in the top 10 that defeated the Lions by a combined eight points. UWF is coming off a tough loss in Livingston after a competitive game with the GSC Champion Tigers, but the Argos still have a chance to clinch the first winning record in program history with a victory.
