GET STARTED

Connect with the local high school association to receive initial training and your first assignments.

MOVE ON UP

Perform well in your initial assignments and encourage your local association to recommend you for evaluation by the GSC and local Junior College Coordinators

EVALUATION

Secure your evaluation by the GSC and local Junior College Coordinators at one of your high school games or, even better, get an invitation to the GSC preseason camp and receive your evaluation while working with other GSC officials.

TAKE ASSIGNMENTS

Grow your confidence and skills through live game experiences. Nothing can do that better than repetition and the chance to work games.

ROSTER ADDITION

Get added to the full-time conference roster and pick up a full GSC schedule.
