## PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Cornell senior forward **Shonn Miller** (Euclid, Ohio) showed exactly what the Big Red had been missing in splitting a season-opening road trip after missing the 2013-14 season. Miller averaged 20.5 points, 11.0 rebounds, 2.0 blocked shots, 1.0 steals and 1.0 assists in a pair of starts. He shot 41 percent from the floor, 46 percent from three-point range and 80 percent from the free-throw line. He had a monster contest in the win over George Mason in his first game in nearly a year and a half, scoring 21 points, including connecting on a career-high four threes, to go along with 13 rebounds and two blocks. Miller scored the team's final 11 points to close out the decisive first half to help Cornell match its win total against Division I schools in his absence. In a five-point loss to Loyola (Md.), he scored 20 points, grabbed nine rebounds, blocked two shots, stole two passes and dished two assists.

## ROOKIE OF THE WEEK

Penn freshman guard **Antonio Woods** (Cincinnati) opened his career in a Quaker uniform with a solid performance in an overtime loss to Delaware State. Woods posted eight of his 11 points in the first half and was one of just two Penn players to reach double figures in points. He connected on one three-pointer and all four of his free throw attempts, adding four rebounds, two assists and a steal in 36 minutes of play. Only three players came off the bench to contribute for Penn and Woods was one of the three freshmen to do so.

## TEAM-BY-TEAM NOTES

### BROWN

Brown won its season opener for the sixth-straight year, including the last three under head coach **Mike Martin**. Junior F **Cedric Kuakumensah** enters the week just one block short of Brown's all-time record, held by **Matthew Mullery** from 2006-10, and ranks 10th all-time in Ivy League history with 162 career blocks. Kuakumensah established the League's single-season blocks record last year with 93 and ranked sixth nationally with 3.2 blocked shots per game.

### COLUMBIA

Columbia is 81-32 all-time in home openers and have won five of its last six debuts in Levien Gymnasium. Last season, the Lions won 14 games in Levien Gymnasium, the most since the building opened its doors in 1974. With his two rejections at Stony Brook, senior C **Cory Osetkowski** enters the week tied for fifth place on the school's career block list with former teammate **Mark Cisco** (2009-13) with 72 career rejections.

### CORNELL

Over the remainder of the season, Cornell will play 10 games against teams coming off 20-win seasons and 11 against teams who competed in postseason last year (three vs. NCAA Tournament teams, five vs. CIT teams, four vs. CBI teams). In the Big Red's win over George Mason, sophomore G **Robert Hatter** matched senior G **Shonn Miller's** game-high 21 points and added five rebounds, while senior G **Devin Cherry** notched a near triple-double with nine points, 10 rebounds and seven assists.

### DARTMOUTH

After having ACL surgery, senior F/C **Gabas Maldunas** returned to game action for the first time since Jan. 18, 2014 and tallied eight points and nine rebounds in Dartmouth's season-opening loss to St. Bonaventure. Senior G/F **John Golden** had been a mainstay on the court for the Big Green during his first three seasons in Hanover, seeing action in every game and starting his last 58 contests in a row. Golden suffered a preseason injury and is expected to miss the first 4-6 weeks.

### HARVARD

Senior G/F **Wesley Saunders** put up consecutive double-doubles to open the season -- the second and third double-doubles of his career. For the fourth time in his career, Saunders led Harvard in points, rebounds and assists in a game with 15 points, 10 rebounds and six assists vs. MIT. He was named to the John R. Wooden Award Preseason Top 50 as one of the early front-runners for one of the nation's most prestigious awards as selected by the Los Angeles Athletic Club.

### PENN

The season-opening, overtime loss to Delaware State marked just the fourth time that Penn's season-opening game went to overtime. The other seasons when that happened were 1928-29, 1988-89 and 2007-08. Junior G **Tony Hicks** scored 30 or more points for the second time in his career in that game. He took 12 three-point shots, tying a single-game high under head coach **Jerome Allen**.

### PRINCETON

Over Princeton's first two games this season, 224 of 400 minutes have gone to freshmen and sophomores, compared to 147 of 400 minutes going to freshmen and sophomores over the first two games a year ago. Junior F **Hans Brase's** 14 boards at George Mason was a career-high total against a Division I opponent. He had 15 boards vs. TCNJ as a freshman.

### YALE

Yale's double-overtime setback at Quinnipiac featured eight ties and seven lead changes. Junior F **Justin Sears** recorded his 10th career double-double (23 points, 12 rebounds), connecting on 13 of his points in the second half and overtime periods, in that game.

## NOTES

### 59TH SEASON OF IVY LEAGUE BASKETBALL

The 2014-15 season is officially the 59th season of Ivy League men's basketball. Although the League's official founding was February 1954, the first year of athletics competition was the 1956-57 season.

### THE 14-GAME TOURNAMENT

The "14-Game Tournament" is a term used by many who cover and follow Ivy League men's basketball to describe the conference's double round-robin, regular-season schedule as it decides the League's automatic bid representative in the NCAA Division I Men's Basketball Championship as well as the conference's regular-season champion.

The Ivy League is the only Division I conference without a postseason tournament. The bulk of the 14-Game Tournament is played over six weekends generally from late January to early March in a grueling Friday-Saturday format that has tested the League's best over the years.

### POLL HISTORY

Harvard was ranked No. 25 in the Associated Press Top 25 Preseason Poll, marking the first time the Crimson appeared in the poll since also being tabbed at No. 25 on Feb. 6, 2012, and the first time an Ivy League school appeared in the AP's preseason poll since Penn was ranked 20th going into the 1975-76 season. Harvard tied Utah for 25th in the first poll of the 2014-15 season with each team receiving 98 points.

Seven Ivy League teams have been ranked in the history of the AP Poll. During the 2011-12 season, Harvard became the seventh team to be ranked by the AP with four appearances to go along with nine times, including a run of eight-straight weeks, in the *USA Today* Coaches' Poll.

Penn leads the way with 78 all-time AP Poll appearances, followed by Princeton (41), Columbia (31), Dartmouth (5), Harvard (5), Yale (4) and Cornell (3). The Quakers achieved the League's highest-ever AP ranking, No. 3, in the final polls following the 1970-71 and 1971-72 seasons.

### 20-WIN SEASONS

The Ivy League has boasted multiple 20-win teams four times in the last five seasons. Last year, Harvard became the first Ivy League school to register five-consecutive, 20-win seasons since Penn did so a record six times from 1969-70 to 1974-75.

### TITLE HISTORY

Penn and Princeton sit atop the Ivy League with the most championships with the Tigers holding a slim advantage of 26 conference crowns to the Quakers' 25 titles.

Last year, Harvard captured its fourth-straight overall and third-straight outright Ivy League title to become the 18th team to win the conference championship with a 13-1 conference record, joining Penn (eight times -- 1971-72, 1973-74, 1974-75, 1978-79, 1980-81, 1998-99, 2004-05 and 2006-07), Princeton (six times -- 1958-59, 1964-65, 1966-67, 1976-77, 1980-81 and 2003-04), Dartmouth (once -- 1958-59), Yale (once -- 1961-62) and Cornell (once -- 2009-10).

A further breakdown of the League's champions by records reveals 14 teams have won the League title with a 12-2 mark, nine teams have won with an 11-3 mark and four teams have won with a 10-4 record.

Only 13 teams since the League officially formed have gone a perfect 14-0 in Ivy play. Penn has done it seven times (1969-70, 1970-71, 1992-93, 1993-94, 1994-95, 1999-2000 and 2002-03), Princeton five times (1968-69, 1975-76, 1990-91, 1996-97 and 1997-98) and Cornell once (2007-08).

### TITLE STREAKS

In an interesting fact, the Ivy League has had 10 times when a team won the conference crown in three or more consecutive seasons.

Harvard's current championship run is the first by a school other than Penn or Princeton to win four or more titles in consecutive seasons. Title runs of four years or more have happened just five times in conference history -- Penn's six straight from 1969-70 to 1974-75, five straight from 1977-78 to 1981-82 and four straight from 1992-93 to 1995-96, Princeton's four straight from 1988-89 to 1991-92 and Harvard's four straight from 2010-11 to 2013-14.

### TOP OF THE CLASSES

Penn's Class of 1996 tops the list of the Ivy League's best classes with an impressive 54-2 (.964) mark that included three-straight 14-0 seasons and four-straight Ivy League titles.

The Quakers' Class of 1995 sits second on the list with a 51-5 (.911) record with its collective contributions to the three consecutive seasons of perfect marks in conference play. Harvard's Class of 2013, which only featured recently-graduated guard **Christian Webster** who is now an assistant coach with the Crimson, is currently the most successful class in school history with three-straight Ivy League titles and two-straight NCAA Tournament appearances. Harvard's 2013 class compiled a 45-11 (.804) record in conference games over four years, which tied for 20th-best, four-year record for a men's basketball class.

Freshman eligibility began in the League with the 1978-79 season, making the Class of 1982 the first four-year class in Ivy history.

### PRESEASON POLL

The selection was unanimous once again as Harvard garnered all 17 first-place votes (136 points) as the preseason favorite to win the 2014-15 Ivy League men's basketball title by a select panel of media representatives.

Harvard entered the season as the preseason favorite for the third time since the poll began prior to the 1985-86 season and was the first team to get all available first-place votes in back-to-back seasons since Cornell did so going into the 2008-09 and 2009-10 seasons.

### THE COACHES

The 2014-15 roster of head coaches includes just two with Ivy League titles (Harvard's **Tommy Amaker** with four and Yale's **James Jones** with one). Amaker's four titles tie Princeton's **Butch van Breda Kolff** and Penn's **Chuck Daly** for the fourth-most conference crowns in League history.

Jones, Brown's **Mike Martin**, Columbia's **Kyle Smith**, Cornell's **Bill Courtney**, Dartmouth's **Paul Cormier**, Penn's **Jerome Allen** and Princeton's **Mitch Henderson** made their head coaching debut in the Ancient Eight, while Cormier and Amaker are the only two with head coaching experience outside of the League. Cormier is in his 19th year as a head coach (204-290, .413), including seven seasons at Fairfield. Amaker is in his 18th year as head coach (316-211, .599), including four seasons at Seton Hall and six seasons at Michigan.

### IVY LEAGUERS IN THE NBA

**Jeremy Lin**, a three-time, All-Ivy selection for Harvard from 2007-10, stands alone as the only former Ivy League standout on an active roster to open the 2014-15 National Basketball Association (NBA) season.

The Lakers acquired Lin and a future first-round draft pick from the Rockets via a trade on July 12, 2014.

Lin is the 42nd former Ivy to play for an NBA team and the first since Penn's **Matt Maloney** suited up for the Atlanta Hawks and Yale's **Chris Dudley** was a member of the Portland Trail Blazers during the 2002-03 season. Getting his first career start with the Knicks on Feb. 6, 2012, against the Utah Jazz, he was the first Ivy Leaguer to earn a start for an NBA team since Dudley started for Portland on Jan. 11, 2002.

Lin was the first person with Ivy League ties to appear on back-to-back Sports Illustrated covers, gracing the front of the Feb. 20 and Feb. 27, 2012, editions.

The NBA features one head coach with Ivy ties in new Cleveland Cavaliers bench general and Princeton alum **David Blatt**. Blatt is the first Tiger alum to serve as an NBA head coach since **Butch van Breda Kolff** finished his nine-season NBA head coaching career with the New Orleans Jazz in 1977. He has spent the last 20 years coaching in Israel, Italy, Turkey and Russia both with professional clubs and at the national-team level with Russia. Most recently, Blatt coached at Maccabi Tel Aviv in Israel for the last four seasons, winning three Israeli league titles in four league-final appearances and winning the Israeli Cup.

The League also boasts three assistant coaches with Ivy ties this season -- Princeton's **Armond Hill** with the Los Angeles Clippers, Penn's **Taylor Jenkins** with the Atlanta Hawks and Brown's **Stephen Silas** with the Charlotte Hornets.

Washington Wizards head coach **Randy Wittman** is the father of former Cornell star **Ryan Wittman**. Ryan was the 2009-10 Ivy League Player of the Year and a three-time, first-team All-Ivy selection. He led the Big Red to the Sweet 16 in the 2010 NCAA Tournament.

In the front office, former Princeton star **Steve Mills** is in second season with the Knicks as Executive Vice President and General Manager. Mills previously worked with New York for 10 years as President of Madison Square Garden Sports.

### IVIES ON THE NCAA MEN'S BASKETBALL COMMITTEE

The Ivy League boasts two former standouts on the NCAA Division I Men's Basketball Committee for the 2014-15 season. Former Dartmouth co-captain, former Harvard head coach and current Northeastern Director of Athletics **Peter Roby** and former Brown star and current Stanford Director of Athletics **Bernard Muir** are currently serving five-year terms.

Roby and Muir are just the second and third African-American Ivy League graduates, respectively, to be named to the committee, joining Penn's **Craig Littlepage**, who served on the committee from 2003-07 and is the current Director of Athletics at Virginia.

Roby and Muir are the seventh and eighth Ivy alums, respectively, to serve on the 10-person panel that governs the NCAA Tournament, joining Littlepage, Dartmouth's **Dave Gavitt** (1998-82), **Jake Crouthamel** (1991-96) and **Mike Slive** (2005-09), Princeton's **Gary Walters** (2003-07) and Cornell's **Laing Kennedy** (2006-10).

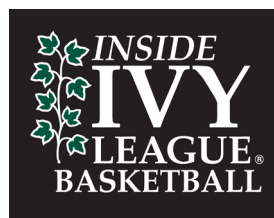

## TRIPLE-DOUBLES

### DID YOU KNOW?

There have been only two triple-doubles in Ivy League men's basketball history. Dartmouth's **Ian McGinnis** recorded the feat on Jan. 17, 2001, vs. Colgate with 10 points, 10 rebounds and 10 assists and Brown's **Jason Forte** did it vs. Dartmouth on Feb. 27, 2004, with 11 points, 12 rebounds and 10 assists.

Harvard's **Kenyatta Smith** came close to the League's third triple-double last season on Feb. 15, 2013, in the Crimson's win over Penn with 20 points, nine rebounds and a school-record 10 blocks. Dartmouth's **Walter Palmer** also came close in his Ivy League record-setting, single-game performance of 12 blocks vs. Harvard on Jan. 9, 1988. He posted 11 rebounds and eight points in the game to go along with the 12 rejections.
