NCAA / Ivy League Championship Notes

- Cornell's winning of the title in 2013 gave the Big Red at least a share of the Ivy crown in 10 of the last 11 seasons. Princeton's winning of the Ivy League crown outright in 2012 snapped Cornell's streak of nine straight titles. Cornell has won four outright titles during that stretch (2005, 2007 & 2011, 2013).
- Dating back to 1956 when Yale won the first Ivy League Championship, Cornell has won the most titles in men's lacrosse with 27. Princeton is close behind with 26 in a League in which each of the seven teams have won at least three championships. Princeton and Cornell are tied for the most outright titles with 18 each.
- With a 6-0 record in 2013, Cornell became 40th squad to post a perfect record in Ivy League play (57 seasons).
- Yale was the first team to record a perfect Ivy slate, posting a 5-0 mark in 1956. With the addition of Brown in 1964, Cornell became the first team to go 6-0 when it did so in 1966. All-time, Cornell has the record for the most perfect Ivy League slates as it has run the table unbeaten and untied 17 times, one better than Princeton's 16. (Princeton had a 4-0-1 mark in 1960 that would give them 17 undefeated seasons.) Brown (4), Penn (1) and Yale (1) have also posted unblemished marks in Ivy play.
- Ivy League teams have made 79 appearances in the NCAA Tournament since 1971 and have a 72-70 mark overall. Cornell has the most appearances with 25 and the most wins with 32.
- Six of the seven Ivy men's lacrosse programs have gone to the Final Four at some point over the last 42 years. Cornell has gone 13 times, while Princeton has gone 10. Princeton has appeared in eight national title games (winning six), while Cornell has appeared in seven (winning three).
