*Beginning in 1956 if a Heptagonal champion was not an Ivy school, the next highest Ivy finisher was considered to be the Ivy champion.

The first Heptagonal Cross Country Championship was held in 1939 with six of the Ivy League institutions competing. By 1941, seven of the eight Ivies (minus Brown) were competing, along with Army and Navy. Brown joined the fold in 1949 and the 10 teams competed annually until 1993 when Army departed to join the Patriot League. Navy followed suit in 2003, leaving the eight Ivy League institutions.

The meet has been held annually since 1939 with the exception of 1944 when the meet was canceled. Except in 1947, when the meet was held at Princeton University, and in 1979, when the meet was held at Lehigh University, the championship has been contested at Van Cortlandt Park in The Bronx, New York City. The five-mile distance has been standard since 1949, except in 1979 when the distance was 10,000 meters.
