^Each year the College Sports Information Directors of America (CoSIDA) select Academic All-America® teams in the sports of football, men's and women's soccer, women's volleyball, men's and women's basketball, baseball, softball and men's and women's track/cross country. Also, men's and women's at-large teams – comprised of athletes from all sports not listed above – are chosen. To be eligible as an Academic All-American, an athlete must maintain a 3.30 grade point average and be a starter or key reserve on his or her team.
