## KU-KSU-WSU TRIANGULAR

**Date:** Friday, Jan. 15      **Location:** Lawrence, Kan.

Kansas track & field will welcome in-state rivals Kansas State and Wichita State to Lawrence for the KSU-KU-WSU Triangular Friday inside Anschutz. Each squad will be scored based on its top-two finishers in each event with the winner being announced following the day's events. The meet will kick off with field events at 3 p.m., while the track events will start at 5 p.m.



## OFF THE BLOCKS

- The Jayhawks will meet Kansas State and Wichita State for the second-straight year in the triangular meet format. At the meet held at KSU's Ahearn Fieldhouse in 2015, the KU teams combined to score 202 points, finishing third behind Kansas State's 261 points and Wichita State's 217 points. Jayhawks claimed wins in four events and saw runner-up finishes in 12 of the day's competitions.
- Junior sprinter Zainab Sanni has yet to lose a competition this season. After victories in the 60 meters, 200 meters and 4x400-meter relay at the season-opening Bob Timmons Challenge in December, Sanni claimed titles in the 60 meters and 4x400-meter relay at the Bill Easton Classic on Jan. 8.
- Senior thrower Anastasiya Muchkayev won the shot put competition at the Bill Easton Classic with a mark of 14.49 meters (47'6½"). Muchkayev has now been the top collegiate finisher in all eight of her shot put outings inside Anschutz Pavilion in her four seasons at KU.
- Both the Jayhawks' men's and women's 4x400-meter and distance medley relay teams are ranked among the NCAA top-10 following the first two meets of the season. The women's 4x400-meter relay team, which posted a time of 3:41.75 on Dec. 6, is the highest-ranked of the KU relay squads, checking in at No. 4 on the latest NCAA list.
- Freshman Dylan Hodgson took first in the 3,000 meters at the Bill Easton Classic last week, his first career race in a collegiate track meet. Hodgson was also a winner in his first collegiate cross country outing last fall, taking the 6K victory at the Bob Timmons Classic on Sept. 1.
- In her first outing in a Kansas uniform, junior transfer Allannah McCorkle claimed a runner-up finish in the long jump at the Bill Easton Classic with a career-best mark of 5.98 meters (19'7½"). The leap was a personal record and ranks the Davenport, Iowa product 11th in the NCAA this season.
- After arriving on campus for the first time just six days prior, freshman LaTyria Jefferson won the women's long jump at the Bill Easton Classic Friday. The Desoto, Texas product topped the bar at 1.70 meters (5'7") for the win, a mark that ranks her third among Big 12 high jumpers.
- Twin sisters Malika and Nashia Baker both claimed individual wins at the Bill Easton Classic. Malika won the 1,000 meters in a personal best 2:57.52, while Nashia took the mile title in 5:03.60. It was the first time in the juniors' careers that both sisters were individual event winners at a single meet.

### ZAINAB SANNI

SPRINTS • JUNIOR • 5-0

The junior has had a fast start to her 2016 campaign, boasting five event titles, an NCAA top-10 mark, and a National Athlete of the Week honor already under her belt following the first two meets of the season. The KU women will surely expect some more victories from Sanni this weekend when points will be at a premium in the triangular with in-state rivals Kansas State and Wichita State.

Only two individuals per institution can score in each event and only one relay per institution can score in the 4x400m relay. The points issued per event are as follows:

### TRI-MEET TRIVIA

This weekend's meet marks the second-straight year Kansas, Kansas State and Wichita State will meet in their current triangular series. Last year's event marked the first triangular the Jayhawks competed in since Kansas, Kansas State and Missouri ended their annual Tri-Meet in 2006. The three schools competed in 17-straight triangulars from 1990-2006, with the Kansas men winning four of those encounters and the Jayhawk women winning one.

The Jayhawks, Wildcats and Shockers will battle for state supremacy and the triangular trophy with the program's men's and women's squads being scored collectively to determine a winner. The scoring scale will award points to only the top-two finishers per school in each event. The scale will award seven points to the winner, five points to the runner-up and 4-3-2-1 points until all schools in the event have been represented.

Before last year, Kansas had previously met the Wildcats in Tri-Meet action in 2006, when Missouri filled the third spot. The highlight of the day was Sheldon Battle's wins in both the shot put and weight throw with NCAA Championship qualifying marks. Several meet records fell at the hands of the Jayhawks as well. Tiffany Cherry won the 60-meter dash in a time of 7.55, beating the meet record by .08. Aaron Thompson broke two meet records of his own, one in the 60-meter dash (6.75) and the other in the 60-meter hurdles (7.94).

### QUICK OVERVIEW

Within its 2016 men's and women's rosters, Kansas returns three First Team All-Americans, including senior long jumper Sydney Conley, who garnered First Team All-America honors three times in the last two years. Senior Daina Levy is back after a breakthrough season in 2015, one which saw her claim runner-up conference finishes in the weight and hammer throws. The KU duo is included on a women's team that returns over 70 percent of the scorers that led the squad to sixth and fourth-place finishes at last year's Big 12 indoor and outdoor meets, respectively.

On the men's side, pole vaulter Casey Bowen returns for his final year in the Crimson and Blue looking for his third conference championship in the event and leads perhaps the deepest pole vault group in the nation. Both the KU men's and women's rosters are full of new faces as nearly a third of the teams are made up of newcomers.

## LAST TIME OUT

The Kansas track and field teams combined for 22 event victories including 15 of 19 events on the women's side as the Jayhawks kicked off 2016 at the Bill Easton Classic Friday inside Anschutz Pavilion. The KU women were nearly perfect on the track, claiming wins in 11 of the 12 running events, while 11 Jayhawk men turned in career best marks in their first outing of the New Year.

After arriving on campus for the first time just six days prior, freshman LaTyria Jefferson wasted little time getting her first collegiate victory in the high jump. The Desoto, Texas needed two tries at 1.70 meters (5'7") but cleared the bar, which eventually earned her the victory. The clearance moved Jefferson into the top-25 of the latest NCAA rankings and to No. 2 on the Big 12 performance list.

All-American Sydney Conley got her year off to a good start by claiming the title in the long jump. Conley only took one attempt in the competition, but it was good enough to get the gold. On her first trip down the runway, the senior flew to a mark of 6.02 meters (19'9"), a distance no other competitor could match. Conley's teammate, junior Allannah McCorkle, came close after she posted a top leap of 5.98 meters (19'7½") on her third attempt, but was forced to settle for a runner-up finish behind her senior teammate.

Conley returned to the track later in the day to take part in the final of the 60 meters. The event marked a rematch between Conley and her junior teammate, Zainab Sanni, who came out on top in the KU duo's first matchup of the season last month at the Bob Timmons Challenge.

### JAYHAWKS ADD THREE AT SEMESTER

The Jayhawks saw three additions to the squad over the winter break as the team added freshmen Ivan Henry, Al Hazim Hussain and LaTyria Jefferson to the 2016 roster. Henry is an accomplished sprinter from Jamaica who is coming off a solid 2015, one which saw him take fourth in the 400 meters at that Pan Am Junior Games. Hussain comes to Lawrence as one of the top junior pole vaulters in the world. He holds the Saudi Arabian national record and also at one time held the U14 and U15 world records in the event. Jefferson joins the Jayhawks as one of the top high jumpers out of Texas. She was the 2014 state runner-up in the event and also tallied a victory at the Texas Relays that same year.

### SANNI NAMED NCAA ATHLETE OF THE WEEK

After having a hand in three NCAA-leading marks at the season-opening Bob Timmons Challenge on Dec. 4, junior Zainab Sanni was named the National Female Athlete of the Week by the U.S. Track & Field and Cross Country Coaches Association (USTFCCA) in its first weekly announcement of the season. The weekly honor is the first of Sanni's career and the first claimed by a Jayhawk female since Paris Daniels was given the award in May of 2013.

Sanni, who hails from Aurora, Colorado, had a stellar season debut last week at the Bob Timmons Challenge. She kicked the day off with a win and a personal-record time in the 60 meters after she clocked in with a time of 7.41. The time moved the junior to No. 4 on the school's all-time performance list. She picked up another individual win two hours later, this time in the 200 meters. Sanni out leaped former teammate and Olympic gold medalist Diamond Dixon with her time of 24.18.

She closed out her meet running the leadoff leg for the Jayhawks' 4x400-meter relay squad. Kansas passed the baton around in 3:44.69 to take the win by over five seconds. The time was the fastest by a KU 4x4 squad in the seven-year history of the season-opening meet and put the quartet atop the NCAA list after the first week of the indoor season.

### NEW BLOOD

The Kansas track & field program will see a major youth resurgence this year, especially on the women's side. Both teams feature a combined 40 athletes who will don the KU singlet for the first time, which includes nearly a third (20 of the 55) currently listed on the women's team roster. Twenty newcomers also comprise the 58-person men's roster.

The two were separated by .06 seconds in December but managed to shorten that gap in the event final Friday. The two entered the final five meets neck-and-neck but Sanni managed to outpace her senior teammate my centimeters in the photo finish. Sanni crossed the finish in 7.43, just .01 ahead of Conley, who came across in a personal-record-tying 7.44.

Sophomore Tre Daniels continued his solid start to the indoor campaign by posting a personal record in the 200 meters for the second-consecutive meet. Daniels outdueled senior teammates Drew Matthews and Jaime Wilson for the win, sprinting through the finish in 22.11, a time that shaved .25 seconds off his previous best. Matthews wasn't far behind with his runner-up clocking of 22.29, also a personal best, while Wilson came across third in 22.32.

For the men, Paulo Benavides, Erik Harken, Cain Hassim, Dylan Hodgson, Braden Klainschmidt, Joel Long, Lane Macari, Connor McMullen, Bryce Richards, Alex Wilson and Tanner Wilson are scheduled to suit up in the Crimson and Blue, while the women's team will see freshmen Riley Cooney, Gabbi Dabney, Deanna Dougherty, Emily Downey, Kayla Funkenbusch, Morgan Griffiths, LaTyria Jefferson, Hayley Krumwiede, Kelly McKee, Nicole Montgomery, Wumi Omare, Caraline Slattery and Hannah Swift all competing in their first or second meet as Jayhawks.

### STANLEY'S SUCCESS

Head coach Stanley Redwine has taken Kansas track & field to a level it hasn't seen in quite some time during his first 15 years at the helm. Over Redwine's tenure, he has seen 103 indoor and outdoor Big 12 Champions, 153 First Team All-Americans and 15 NCAA Champions come through his program at KU.

Redwine's teams have also collected a combined seven top-10 NCAA team finishes, including coaching the 2013 women's team to the program's first National Championship at the NCAA outdoor meet.

### AT HOME IN ANSCHUTZ

The 30-year indoor home facility for the Kansas track & field team, Anschutz Pavilion, has hosted dozens of collegiate and high school meets since 1984. In August of 2011, the facility got a major facelift when a new six-lane track (eight lanes on the sprint straightaway) was installed, which replaced the original track installed in 1984.

### HOME GROWN

Both the men's and women's teams in 2016 will feature a large batch of home-grown talent as the majority of the athletes on each roster hail from the Sunflower State. Twenty-eight KU men and 19 Jayhawk women call Kansas home, with the next-most prolific state, Texas, boasting a combined nine natives.

Kansas also has a handful of international athletes. On the men's side, senior sprinter Jaime Wilson hails from Old Harbour, Jamaica, freshman Cain Hassim (Ontario, Canada), junior Mitch Cooper (Queensland, Australia), junior Daniel Koech (Eldoret, Kenya) and sophomore Nicolai Ceban (Camenca, Moldova) welcome in international freshmen Ivan Henry (Jaimaca) and Al Hazim Hussain (Saudi Arabia). For the women, senior Anastasiya Muchkayev (Be'er Sheva, Israel)

### ROCK CHALK PARK TO HOST 2017 JR OLYMPICS

Rock Chalk Park, the home of Kansas track & field, has been selected to play host to the 2017 USA Track & Field National Junior Olympic Championships it was announced Dec. 5. The meet, which will be held in Lawrence July 23-30, 2017, will welcome the nation's top athletes between the ages 7-18.

USA Track & Field youth chairs selected Lawrence over Des Moines, Iowa, Dec. 5 at their convention in Houston. The bid for the event was made in conjunction with eXplore Lawrence, the city's tourism bureau. Kansas athletics director Sheahon Zenger, associate athletic director Doug Banks and head coach Stanley Redwine made a special trip to Houston to assist in the presentation made by Sanner of eXplore Lawrence. Rock Chalk Park opened in the spring of 2014 and has twice played host to the Kansas Relays, one of the largest and longest-running high school and collegiate meets in the Midwest, and is set to be the site of NCAA West Preliminary Championships in May of 2016. The Junior Olympics will be the first USATF event held at Jayhawks' two-year-old facility.

### FORMER KU COACH BOB TIMMONS PASSES

Legendary Kansas track & field and cross country coach Bob Timmons, who led his Jayhawk teams to four NCAA titles and 31 conference championships, passed away Aug. 4, 2015 at the age of 91. He is survived by his wife, Pat; children, Susan (Tammie), Rebecca, Priscilla and Dan, as well as two grandchildren.

Timmons served as the head coach of the Kansas track & field and cross country squad for 22 seasons from 1966-88. "Timmie's" teams captured 13 Big Eight indoor titles, 14 outdoor titles and four cross country league titles. He led the Jayhawks to three NCAA indoor championships in 1966, 1969 and 1970. Timmons' 1970 outdoor team tied for the national championship to give him four titles in five years. To this day, Timmons' four NCAA Championships are the most among any head coach in Kansas Athletics' history. Timmons took over the Kansas program for the future Hall of Famer, Easton, in 1966 and continued to take the Jayhawk program to new heights over the next 22 years. In addition to all the team's success, he oversaw the coaching and development of seven Olympians,

16 world record holders, 77 NCAA All-Americans and 24 NCAA Champions. Included on his highly impressive résumé was being named the U.S. Track & Field Coach Association (USTFA) Coach of the Year in 1975 as well as being tabbed as the District V Coach of the Year in 11 of his 22 seasons at KU.

Timmons' coaching career also included teaching one of the world's best track athletes in Jim Ryun. In 1964, at the age of 17, Ryun became the first high schooler to run a sub-four-minute mile. In fact, his high school mile mark of 3:55.3 stood for 31 years. With Timmons leading the way in Lawrence, Ryun put together a spectacular stint at KU from 1965 to 1969, as he owned world records in the 880 yards, 1,500 meters and mile run and added an additional four American records during his time under Timmons. Ryun was a five-time NCAA champion and, to this day, still holds 13 Jayhawk school records.

Timmons handed off the reins of the KU track program in 1988, but continued to maintain his close ties to the team. He remained a loyal supporter at Jayhawk home meets and continued to make appearances at the Kansas Relays for many years after his retirement.

### KU ANNOUNCES STANDOUT SIGNING CLASS

Kansas track & field head coach Stanley Redwine and his staff announced the addition of 13 new members to the KU's 2015 signing class. The Jayhawks' 2015 recruiting class features several high school standouts who boast a long list of achievements at the state and national levels:

- The Jayhawks bring in one of the Midwest's top sprints in **Chloe Akin-Otiko**. The Bellevue, Nebraska product became the second female in Nebraska history to win four all-class gold medals at the state meet, winning the 100 meters, 200 meters, 400 meters and anchoring the 4x100-meter relay team. She is a 10-time state champion in those four events as well as the long jump.
- **Catherine Liggett**, a distance specialist out of Colorado, will call Lawrence home. She finished third at the Colorado State cross country meet in October, a week after she also claimed regional title. On the track, she claimed a bronze medal in the 800 meters at the 2014 state meet when she clocked in at 2:13.69.
- **Cameron Gueldner** has signed with the Jayhawks from nearby Olathe, Kansas. Gueldner claimed the Kansas 6A State title in the 3,200 meters two years ago as a freshman. Earlier in her freshman campaign she also tallied a win in the 3,200 meters at the Kansas Relays.
- The Kansas women added one of the top sprinters out of

Minnesota in **Jedah Caldwell**. A state title winner in the 100 meters and 200 meters last spring, Caldwell also won the AAU Junior Olympic 200-meter title in August, clocking in at 23.90 for the gold.

- **Allie Twietmeyer** signs with Kansas in the midst of a strong throwing career at Cheney High School. She earned a bronze medal in the javelin at the Kansas state meet earlier in 2015. She also tallied top-five finishes in the event at each of the two previous state meets. She boasts a career-best mark of 144'0", which ranked fifth in the state in 2015.
- The Jayhawks bring in an accomplished sprinter and relay specialist in **Mariah Kuykendoll**. The Judson, Texas product has claimed a pair of state titles on her 4x400-meter squad. She was also a member of the state bronze medalist 4x100-meter relay team in 2014.
- Another leg from that Converse Judson state-title 4x400-meter relay team has joined the Jayhawks. **Zantori Dickerson**, along with Kuykendoll, helped her team to two-straight state 4x400-meter relay championships. She's also posted several seedy times in the open 400 meters, holds a personal best of 55.98 and turned in the fastest time (56.73) at the AAU Junior Olympic Qualifier in July.
- **Andrea Willis** has taken each of the last two Colorado state pole vault titles. Earlier in 2015 she won her second state championship by the way of a state championship record clearance of 12'7". Her career-best came in September at the Colorado State Fair Street Fair Street Vault when she got over 12'11½", ranking her among the top-35 vaulters in the nation this year.
- The Jayhawks have added a premier thrower out of Pleasant Hill, Illinois in **Rachel Clowers**. She has posted four top-five finishes in the state championship meet in the discus and shot put, which includes a runner-up finish in the shot put in 2014. She also tallied a throw of 129'3" in the discus en route to a third-place finish at the 2014 state championship.
- The Kansas men picked up a one of the top middle distance runners out of Texas with the signing of **Bryce Hoppel**. The 2015 state runner-up in the 800 meters, Hoppel claimed gold in the event at the Junior Olympics with a personal-best time of 1:52.97. His time at the Junior Olympics was the third-fastest by an athlete out of the state of Texas in 2015.
- The two-time reigning Georgia state champion long jumper **Denzel Harper** will call himself a Jayhawk. Harper holds the No. 2 mark in 2015 in the state of Georgia at 23'11". He also claimed the 2014 Junior Olympic championship in the long jump before taking the silver medal in 2015. Harper earned his way to compete at the IAAF World Youth Championships in July after a runner-up finish at the trials.

## UP NEXT

The Jayhawks will return to action for their final home meet of the indoor season when the teams play host at the Jayhawk Classic Thursday-Friday, Jan. 28-29. The event is slated to begin with the first four events of the men's heptathlon on Jan. 28 at 2 p.m., with the first events on Jan. 29 kicking off with the women's weight throw at 9 a.m., and concluding at 8:05 p.m., with the men's 4x400-meter relay. ## 2016 NCAA INDOOR Championship Qualifying

Automatic qualifying standards no longer exist. Fields will be fixed to 16 participants per gender in individual events and 12 relays per gender.

Across all divisions a new "indexing" formula will be used to convert performances based on track size and composition. Banked and oversized (over 200 meters) tracks will be considered the same for qualification purposes (which had not been the case prior in Division II). For the first time, the same factor will be used across the three divisions to convert for qualification. Instead of a set addition or subtraction factor per event, starting this year, performances for track size will be multiplied by a factor for converted seed time needs.

# HC STANLEY REDWINE

Arkansas, 1985 • 16th season at Kansas • 22nd season overall

Already a member of the Kansas Athletics Hall of Fame, Stanley Redwine is a living legend in Jayhawk country and one of the most well-respected coaches in the United States. A former All-American himself at the University of Arkansas, Redwine has coached 98 individual conference champions, 153 athletes to All-America honors, 15 individual national champions and two teams to Big 12 titles. After the historical season for the 2012-13 women's track & field team, Redwine was named the NCAA's Women's Head Coach of the Year for the first time in his career. Redwine has coached 17 individual National Champions (15 at Kansas), 168 All-Americans (153 at KU), four Olympians (all at KU) and 23 National Championship teams between his years as head coach at Kansas and Tulsa and an assistant coach at Arkansas.

Davis, three-time 400-meter and 500-meter NCAA champion Robbie Haley and seven-time All-American sprinter Jimmy French.

His success as an assistant earned him the head coaching position at the University of Tulsa in 1994. In six years at Tulsa, Redwine's athletes broke more than 70 school records, most on multiple occasions. He produced 11 NCAA qualifiers and Tulsa's first-ever All-American.

On May 25, 2000, Redwine was rewarded for his efforts by being hired as the head coach at the University of Kansas. The Jayhawks' track & field program has prospered ever since, as he has restored the tradition of KU's illustrious past.

The last three seasons marked perhaps the most successful stretch in Redwine's Kansas coaching career, mentoring the women's track & field team to numerous individual accolades with the most notable being the program's first NCAA team championship in 2013. Lindsay Vollmer became Kansas first female NCAA Champion with her win in the heptathlon as 16 other Jayhawks earned Outdoor All-America honors in 2013. Pupil Diamond Dixon not only claimed a national championship, four conference titles and four more All-American honors in 2012, but also won a gold medal at the Olympics in London as part of the 4x400-meter relay team.

Professionally, Redwine retired from competition in 1996 after he finished fifth in the 800-meter run at the U.S. Olympic Trials in Atlanta, Georgia. He was a U.S. Olympic Trial qualifier five-consecutive times from 1980 to 1996 and was a two-time silver medalist in the 800-meter run at the Goodwill Games in 1986 and 1994. He won bronze medals at the Pan American Games in 1983 and 1987. Redwine was also a World Championship team member in 1985, 1987, 1989, 1991 and 1993 and a two-time U.S. 800-meter champion.

Redwine earned his bachelor's degree in administrative management from the University of Arkansas in 1985. He and his wife, Jacqueline, have three children: Crysta, Stanley Jr., and Alexa.

In 2008, Redwine coached 12 track & field All-Americans, which was then the most he had coached in one season in his time at Kansas.

In the summer of 2008 in Beijing, China, Redwine athletes Scott Russell and Nickesha Anderson represented their respective countries in the Games of the XXIX (29th) Olympiad. Russell finished in 10th place for Canada in the men's javelin, while Anderson was an alternate on Jamaica's women's 4x100-meter relay team.

In the 2008 indoor track & field season, Kansas was just one of 10 schools to have both its men's and women's teams finish in the top 25 at the NCAA Championships. At the NCAA Outdoor Championships, senior Crystal Manning (long jump and triple jump) and junior Nickesha Anderson (100 meters and 200 meters) each won two All-America honors. Only one other woman (Candace Mason) had previously accomplished the feat in KU history.

As an athlete, Redwine placed his name in the Arkansas history books as a 400-meter, 600-yard and 800-meter runner from 1980-83. Redwine was a four-time All-American and was named UA's Outstanding Track Athlete all four of his years in Fayetteville. Redwine went on to spend nine years as an assistant coach at his alma mater.



During his tenure, the Razorbacks captured nine consecutive NCAA Championships and 22 titles from 1985 to 1994 in both track & field and cross country. He helped produce 14 All-Americans and two NCAA Champions in the hurdle and sprint events. Among those All-Americans were two-time 400-meter NCAA indoor and outdoor champion Calvin
