•The Blackbirds are still searching for their first victory of the season after a 72-56 loss to New Hampshire on Wednesday evening.

•The game marks the second of five in the borough of Brooklyn for the Blackbirds in the month of December.

•The LIU-Lehigh game will be broadcast live and free of charge on the NEC Front Row Digital Network, with Ray Martel calling all of the action.

#### SCOUTING REPORT

•Lehigh has won three straight games, including an 86-74 road win at DePaul on Nov. 26.

•The Mountain Hawks also downed Northeast Conference member Saint Francis U., 61-59, in their last outing on Dec. 3.

•Tim Kempton, who was named Patriot League Rookie of the Year last season, leads the team at 14.3 points per game and is also pulling down 8.9 rebounds per contest.

•Austin Price, who earned a spot next to Kempton on the Patriot League's All-Rookie Team a year ago, is the only other player averaging in double figures at 12.9 ppg.

#### BLACKBIRDS AGAINST PATRIOT LEAGUE COMPETITION

•LIU has faced nine of the 10 Patriot League teams in its history, with Bucknell standing as the lone team that the Blackbirds have not played.

•Loyola (Md.) is a former member of the old ECAC Metro Conference (1981-88) that became the Northeast Conference in 1988. Before withdrawing from the league in 1989, the Blackbirds had met with the Greyhounds 16 times.

•LIU played two games against Patriot League opponents last season, falling to both Lehigh and Boston University.

#### LAST TIME OUT

•The Blackbirds struggled offensively in a 72-56 loss at the Steinberg Wellness Center. The scoring output was four shy of the lowest by an LIU team in a game held at the Steinberg Wellness Center (52 vs. St. Francis Brooklyn - 1/8/07).

•The Icelandic duo of Elvar Fridriksson and Martin Hermannsson combined to score 23 points, hitting five of their nine attempts from three-point range. The rest of the Blackbirds shot just 1-for-14 from deep.

•Redshirt freshman Nura Zanna had six points and six rebounds in eight foul-plagued, first-half minutes, before finishing with nine points and a career-high 12 rebounds.

•LIU Brooklyn did connect on 18 of its 22 free-throw attempts and currently leads the NEC and ranks in the top 50 nationally (47th) in free throw shooting (73.9%).

**ALL-TIME SERIES vs. LEHIGH**

- The Blackbirds had taken the first two games of the series against Lehigh before falling to the Mountain Hawks on the road last year in Bethlehem, Pa., 76-69.
- Landon Atterberry registered a team-high 15 points in the game while point guard Jason Brickman had 10 points, 12 assists and just two turnovers.
- Now-sophomore Glenn Feidanga had a then-career high 10 points in 15 minutes of action.
- The last and only game between the two squads to take place in the borough of Brooklyn came on Nov. 21, 2004, when LIU defeated Lehigh at the Schwartz Center, 66-56.
- James Williams and Aubin Scott each had 13 points in the victory, while Jose Olivero led the Mountain Hawks with 14 points.

**YOUTH MOVEMENT**

- Over LIU Brooklyn's first five games, 558 out of a possible 1,025 minutes (54.4 percent) have been played by freshmen.
- Icelandic guards Elvar Fridriksson and Martin Hermannsson have played 150 and 147 minutes, respectively, while redshirt freshman Nura Zanna has totaled 135 minutes.
- All told, 76.1 percent of the minutes for the Blackbirds this season have been doled out to underclassmen.

**ELVAR ELEVATES GAME**

- LIU Brooklyn freshman point guard Elvar Fridriksson was a maestro with the ball over the season's first five games.
- The 6-0 guard dished out 21 assists while committing just six turnovers while averaging 30.0 minutes a game.
- The Icelandic frosh had a career-high 12 points including two critical three-pointers down the stretch of a heartbreaking overtime loss at Saint Joseph's.
- Fridriksson finished with eight points and registered a season-high eight assists while committing just one turnover in a loss against Temple that saw the Blackbirds carry a lead well into the second half.
- Fridriksson currently leads the NEC in assist/turnover ratio at 3.5 and is fourth in assists at 4.2 per game.

**NURA BACK IN ACTION**

- The frontcourt will be bolstered this season by the return of redshirt freshman Nura Zanna, who missed all of last season due to a wrist injury sustained prior to the season.
- In his first game of action for LIU, he had 10 points and six rebounds against fellow Nigeria native Chris Obekpa, who ranked in the nation's top 20 in shot blocking last year.
- For his efforts he was named Northeast Conference Rookie of the Week for the Week ending Nov. 23.
- Zanna registered a new career high in his second game against Saint Joseph's, scoring 14 points and grabbing eight boards before fouling out with 1:06 remaining in the second half.
- The 6-7 post player currently leads the team in both scoring and rebounding, ranks third in the NEC in rebounding at 7.4 per game, and had a career-best 12 boards against UNH on Wednesday.
- The last LIU Brooklyn player to lead the team in scoring or rebounding as a freshman was Jamal Olasewere (6.8 rpg - 2009-10).

**JERSEY DUO PRIMED FOR TIME**

- Sophomores Iverson Fleming and Joel Hernandez figure prominently into head coach Jack Perri's plans this year.
- Against Saint Joseph's, the duo combined for 24 points on 8-for-16 shooting. Fleming connected on a trio of three-pointers while Hernandez grabbed five rebounds and dished out two assists.
- Fleming played in all but one game last season and was named NEC Rookie of the Week after scoring 22 points in a wild 96-93 win over NJIT.

- The North Brunswick, N.J. native also had 18 points in a road loss to eventual NEC champion Mount St. Mary's.
- Hernandez, who added a team-high 15 points against Stony Brook on Thanksgiving, suffered through an injury-plagued freshman year but did come on down the stretch.
- The powerful 6-3 guard averaged 10.8 points and 5.5 rebounds over the final four games of the 2013-14 season.

**MARTIN MAKES MARK**

- Senior Gerrell Martin is the team's leading returning scorer and connected on 44.0 percent of his three-point attempts in 2013-14.
- Martin continued his assault from deep, hitting on four of his eight attempts from downtown at St. John's. The 6-3 wing hit his 100th career three-pointer in the opening minute against Temple.
- The sharp-shooting Martin finished with a flurry over the final weekend of last season, averaging 22.6 points per game over the final three contests including a career-high 31 in an overtime loss to Central Connecticut.
- Martin is the final player remaining on the roster from the run of three consecutive Northeast Conference championships that the Blackbirds had from 2010-13.

**HOME-LAND**

- Also back for LIU is senior Landon Atterberry, who played out of position most of last season at center.
- Despite this, Atterberry still managed to average in double figures at 10.8 points per contest.
- The 6-6 forward ranks fifth in the NEC in rebounding at 6.2 per game.
- Atterberry was active on the boards at St. John's, registering his first double-double with 12 points and 11 rebounds.
- Seven of the Detroit native's rebounds came at the offensive end against St. John's, and he pulled down eight boards in the loss at Temple.

**COMING TO AMERICA**

- LIU Brooklyn picked up a pair of impact freshman from Iceland for the 2014-15 season.
- Elvar Fridriksson signed with the Blackbirds during the early signing period in November 2013, while fellow countryman Martin Hermannsson decided to bring his talents to Brooklyn in the spring.
- Both players have played significant roles in LIU's first five games this season. Fridriksson ranks first on the team at 30.0 minutes played per game, while Hermannsson is third at 29.4 per game.
- Against Saint Joseph's, Fridriksson had 12 points including a pair of big three-pointers in the second half and overtime that kept the Blackbirds on pace to pull out the win.
- Hermannsson got it going at the end of regulation, hitting back-to-back hoops to give LIU one-point leads each time.
- The duo helped Iceland's National Team to its first-ever qualification into the FIBA EuroBasket this past summer.
- The two youngest members of the squad had an impact, as

- Fridriksson scored six points and added five rebounds in a 72-62 loss to Bosnia and Herzegovina.
- Hermannsson scored 22 points to lead Iceland to a qualifying round victory over England, and averaged 9.5 points per game over the four games.
- Fridriksson averaged 20.8 points and 7.3 assists last season for Njardvik in Iceland's Dominos League.
- Hermannsson was named Player of the Year in the Dominos League, leading KR Reykjavik to a Dominos League championship.

**TWINNING!**

- LIU Brooklyn continued to reach into the great state of Texas for talent, as Trevin and Trevon Woods enter the fold in 2014-15.
- Trevin played a large role in LIU's overtime loss at Saint Joseph's, scoring seven points and grabbing eight rebounds in 22 minutes.
- Five of those rebounds were offensive, and Trevin added two blocked shots.
- The Woods twins both signed National Letters of Intent during the early signing period in November 2013.
- Both players bring versatility to the Blackbirds' squad, standing 6-6 and each possessing long wingspans.
- The duo joins recent graduates Jason Brickman, Julian Boyd, Kenny Onyechi and Brandon Thompson as players who have made their way to LIU from the Lone Star State.

**HOOD FINDS HOME IN BROOKLYN**

- Another freshman on the roster for LIU Brooklyn this season is 6-1 guard Jamil Hood.
- The ultra-athletic guard had five points and a team-high five rebounds at Madison Square Garden against Stony Brook on Thanksgiving Day.
- Hood was named New York State Class AA Tournament MVP after leading Green Tech to its first-ever state championship.
- Hood was also named Third Team All-State after averaging 16.1 points, 8.1 assists, and 2.5 steals as a senior.

# HEAD COACH JACK PERRI

## Third Season at LIU Brooklyn • Bentley '98

Jack Perri returns for his third season as head men's basketball coach at LIU Brooklyn in 2014-15. Perri, who helped the Blackbirds make history in his first season as head coach, took over as head man in April 2012 after spending seven seasons as an assistant coach at the downtown Brooklyn campus.

In his first season at the helm, Perri guided the Blackbirds to an unprecedented third straight Northeast Conference Tournament title in 2013 and became just the second recipient of the Joe B. Hall National Coach of the Year award, handed out annually to the top first-year head coach at the NCAA Division I level.

In 2012-13, Perri led the Blackbirds to their third consecutive 20-win season and another trip to the NCAA Tournament. The three-straight years of 20 victories marked the first time the LIU program had accomplished the feat since 1981-84.

Sixteen of the 20 triumphs came following the loss of 2012 Northeast Conference Player of the Year Julian Boyd to a season-ending injury just eight games into the year. Perri restructured the high-powered LIU offense following the midseason loss and boosted the unit into the top five nationally in scoring (fifth at 79.5 ppg). The Blackbirds registered 90 or more points on eight times during the season, and failed to hit the 70-point plateau just three times.

The Manalapan, N.J. native mentored the 2012-13 NEC Player of the Year Jamal Olasewere to career highs in scoring and rebounding, as well as junior point guard Jason Brickman to a LIU single-season record in assists. Brickman led all NCAA Division I players in assists per game (8.5).

His second season was undercut by a slew of injuries that limited the team to just eight available scholarship players at times, but did include a near-upset victory over defending Big Ten champion Indiana at Assembly Hall. LIU Brooklyn led for much of the game and had a pair of shots to take the lead in the closing moments but fell just short.

Playing in a friendly offense designed by Perri that utilizes ball screens and ball movement, Brickman once again led the nation in assists at a remarkable 10.0 per game, becoming just the second player in NCAA history to average double-figures in the category for an entire season.

Since joining the Blackbirds, Perri has helped the team steadily move up the ladder in the NEC. With Perri serving as associate head coach in 2011-12, LIU went 25-9 this season en route to a second appearance in the NCAA Tournament Second Round.

The Blackbirds matched their 16-2 league mark from the year before to set an NEC record for two-year conference winning percentage (32-4, .889) and won at least 25 games in back-to-back seasons for the first time since 1941-42.

The Blackbirds ranked second in the country in scoring (81.4 ppg) and compiled the nation's second-longest active home winning streak at 27 games. Junior Julian Boyd became the fourth player in LIU history to be named NEC Player of the Year and was joined on the all-conference teams by junior Jamal Olasewere and sophomore Jason Brickman.

The 2010-11 season saw LIU compile a 27-6 record and an appearance in the NCAA Tournament for the first time since 1997. The Blackbirds recorded their most overall wins since the 1936-37 team coached by Hall of Famer Clair Bee and set a program-record with a 16-2 mark in the NEC.

The team ranked fourth in the nation in scoring (82.7 ppg) and set a program record for conference wins (16). The Blackbirds also led the nation in road wins (13), entered the NCAA Tournament with a country's best 13 straight wins. LIU's 13-win improvement over the previous season was also the best in the nation.

In his time at LIU, Perri has seen 10 players earn All-NEC honors, including Boyd, who was named conference player of the year in 2011-12 after earning rookie of the year accolades in 2008-09. For his efforts, Perri was tabbed as the top assistant in the NEC by Jeff Goodman's FoxSports.com blog prior to the 2010-11 season.

Before joining Jim Ferry's staff at LIU, Perri served as the head men's basketball coach at Division III Rhode Island College in 2004-05. In his lone season at Rhode Island College, Perri took the Anchoemen to the final of the Eastern College Athletic Conference Tournament after posting a 20-9 record. Under Perri's direction, Rhode Island College captured the program's first Little East Conference co-regular season championship and he was named the league's coach of the year in his first season at the helm.

Following his graduation from Bentley College, the Manalapan, N.J., native moved to the sidelines as the top assistant coach at his alma mater. As the top assistant from 1998 to 2004, he was responsible for all aspects of recruiting and helped build a squad that went on to earn the No. 1 national ranking in 2004-05 and a No. 2 ranking in 2006-07. During his time on the staff with the Falcons, he helped the team return to the NCAA Tournament for the first time in eight seasons in 2002.

A 1998 graduate of Bentley, Perri was a two-year captain and helped the Falcons post four winning seasons while playing in 99 career games. He was recruited to Bentley by Ferry, whom he subsequently replaced as assistant coach upon his graduation.

Perri and his wife, Julie, currently reside in Manalapan, N.J., with their three children, Sean Patrick, Jackson Richard, and Charlotte Taylor.

history while playing for the Knicks.

- Charles Jones won back-to-back national scoring titles in 1996-97 (30.1 ppg) and 1997-98 (29.0 ppg). Carey Scurry was the NCAA's leading rebounder in 1984-85 with 14.1 boards per game.
- Recent graduate Jason Brickman led the nation in assists in back-to-back years, including 10.0 per game in 2013-14 to become just the second player in college basketball history to average double-figure assists in a season.

### WHY THE BLACKBIRDS?

- According to Dr. Elliott S.M. Gatner, an early historian of LIU, the first student-athletes representing the university in intercollegiate competition in the late 1920's and early 1930's were known as the Blue Devils. The teams earned the moniker because of blue in their uniforms.
- In LIU's earliest days, the basketball players were called "Beemen," after their legendary coach, Clair F. Bee, a member of the Naismith Basketball Hall of Fame.
- Sometime between February and October of 1935, the uniform color was changed to black and the Blue Devils became the Blackbirds. A reporter for the borough's famed Brooklyn Eagle observed the players in their black uniforms running down the court dribbling the basketball, reminded him of blackbirds back home, bobbing up and down as they fed in the cornfields.
- In filing his story of the game, the writer who came to New York from the Midwest used "Blackbirds" and it has stuck ever since.

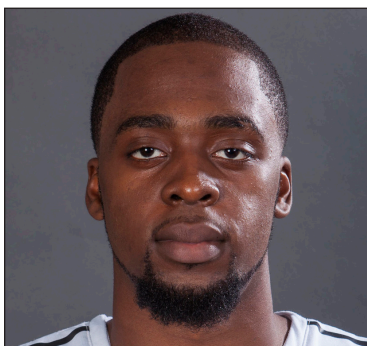
