LSC ANNOUNCES ALL-ACADEMIC AWARDS FOR SOFTBALL

RICHARDSON, Texas -- Southeastern Oklahoma pitcher Christina Cearley repeated as Lone Star Conference North Division Academic Player of the Year to highlight the league's annual softball academic awards that were announced Wednesday by LSC officials.

Cearley, a senior standout who owns several Southeastern and LSC pitching records, earned her second straight nod as the North's top achiever on the field and in the classroom, while Eastern New Mexico second baseman Tracy Jordan earned the South Division's Academic Player of the Year award.

Cearley was placed alongside eight other standouts on the LSC North Division All-Academic Team, while Jordan was joined by 10 others on the South Division All-Academic Team. Additionally, 19 more softball players were named to the LSC Commissioner's Honor Roll.

To be eligible for LSC academic honors, student-athletes must carry at least a 3.20 grade point average and have reached sophomore status both athletically and academically. The Academic Player of Year award and All-Academic Team are selected from the list of academically qualified players, with the league's sports information directors voting on the basis of both academic and athletic achievement. All qualifying student-athletes not selected for the All-Academic Team are then named to the Commissioner's Honor Roll.

In all, 39 softball players were recognized through the league's academic awards program, including at least one from 13 of the 14 softball-playing member institutions.

Joining Cearley on the North Division All-Academic Team were SOSU teammate Emily McNamara, Central Oklahoma's Alli Blake, Lindsay Mitchell and Meagan Campbell, Cameron's Jen Morse, East Central's Melissa Stewart, Midwestern State's Kristen Stonecipher and Southwestern Oklahoma's Sarah Hamilton.

On the South All-Academic Team along with Jordan were ENMU teammates Danielle Flores and Amanda Nightingale, Texas A&M-Kingsville's Jennifer DeMay and Kenna Gipson, Tarleton State's Meredith Ward, Abilene Christian's Jessica Johnson and Claudia Stephens, Angelo State's Whitney Meeks and Rhonda Sherman and Amanda Arnold of Texas Woman's.
