

LSC Football Season Outlook and Preseason Poll/Awards

Abilene Christian has been picked to repeat as Lone Star Conference football champions, according to the 2011 LSC preseason poll announced in late July.

The league's preseason poll reflects the opinions of LSC head coaches and sports information directors, plus various media representatives from throughout the region.

The 2011 football season kicks off September 1, and the LSC has nine teams set to compete. Each team will play a total of eight conference games.

ACU, who posted a perfect 10-0 conference mark and 6-0 divisional record to claim both the league and South Division titles in 2010, claimed first-place votes on 17 of the 23 ballots to finish with 201 total points.

Texas A&M-Kingsville finished second with 177 points and five first-place nods, while West Texas A&M was third with 162 points.

Midwestern State was fourth with 135 points, followed by Tarleton State fifth (104), Angelo State sixth (84), Eastern New Mexico seventh (70 with one first-place vote), Texas A&M-Commerce eighth (56) and Incarnate Word ninth (46).

The LSC continued its customary participation in the postseason with three teams – ACU, Kingsville and WT – selected to play in the NCAA Division II playoffs last season.

ACU's Gale, Whiteside claim preseason honors
A pair of Lone Star Conference football standouts from Abilene Christian earned LSC Preseason Player of the Year recognition for the 2011 season league officials announced in late July.

ACU quarterback Mitchell Gale was named LSC Offensive Player of the Year, while the Wildcats defensive end Aston Whiteside claimed the Defensive Player of the Year award.

The league's preseason awards were selected by a vote of LSC head coaches and sports information directors, plus various media representatives from throughout the region.

Gale, a 6-2, 220-pound junior from Alva, Okla., recorded the third-best passing efficiency (167.33) in the nation, while tossing 38 TD passes in 2010. He threw for the second-highest single-season total in ACU history with 3,595 yards to earn LSC South Division Offensive Back of the Year honors.

With 20 votes, Gale was the clear choice ahead of Eastern New Mexico's Wesley Wood (two) and Midwestern State's Amini Silatolu (one).

Whiteside, a 6-2, 260-pound senior from Vernon, Texas, was picked as the top defensive returnee for the second straight year. As a junior, he was named the LSC South Division Defensive Lineman of the Year for the second straight season after recording 28 tackles including seven sacks, two forced fumbles and three blocked kicks.

Whiteside picked up the honor with 16 votes to finish in front of Texas A&M-Kingsville's Johnny Tivao (three) and his Javelina teammate Marcus Sanders (two), with two others receiving one vote.

Lone Star Conference teams will be playing football at the greatest stadium in the world this fall as LSC officials revealed plans to implement a Lone Star Football Festival at Cowboys Stadium in Arlington.

Teams from Abilene Christian, Midwestern State, Texas A&M-Commerce, Texas A&M-Kingsville and West Texas A&M have been selected to represent the LSC in a tripleheader of games that will feature two conference contests and one marquee non-conference matchup.

The single-day event is planned for Saturday, Sept. 17, meaning the festival will occur just months after Super Bowl XLV was played at the \$1.2 billion Arlington facility in February.

Pairings for the conference games will be Midwestern State against Texas A&M-Commerce and West Texas A&M versus Texas A&M-Kingsville. The non-conference tilt will see LSC champion ACU tackling three-time NCAA Division II national champion North Alabama of the Gulf South Conference. UNA is coached by former Auburn head coach and TV analyst Terry Bowden.

Game times are set for 12 p.m., 4 p.m. and 8 p.m., with MSU-A&M-C first, followed by ACU-UNA and WTAMU-Kingsville.

Fans can purchase tickets through Ticketmaster or by contacting their campus ticket office. Through Ticketmaster, fans can purchase online at Ticketmaster.com, by phone at 800-745-3000, and at numerous Ticketmaster retail outlets.

A single ticket is good for all three games with general admission seating. Adult tickets are \$25 and students \$10, with children 1-year and older requiring a ticket. To be admitted with a student ticket, bearer must be between 1 and 18 years old or present valid college ID.

The LSC, founded in 1931, has a proud history as one of the nation's greatest small college football leagues. The conference made its mark in the NAIA, especially from 1969 to 1979 when four LSC schools combined to win 10 national titles in that 11-season span. The LSC became affiliated with the NCAA in 1982 and now is annually well-represented in the Division II playoffs, with more than a dozen former players currently on NFL rosters.

Currently, there are two Division II games played annually at NFL stadiums. Northwest Missouri State and Pittsburg (Kan.) State meet each year at Arrowhead Stadium in Kansas City, while



Central Washington faces Western Oregon annually at Qwest Field in Seattle.

Cowboys Stadium is the largest, most technologically advanced sports and entertainment venue in the world. Designed by HKS and built by Manhattan Construction, the \$1.2 billion stadium features two monumental arches, the world's largest HD quality video board, an expansive retractable roof and the largest retractable end zone doors in the world.

Features of the stadium include seating for 80,000 and expandable to 100,000, 300 luxury suites, club seating on multiple levels and the Dallas Cowboys Pro Shop, open to the public year round.

In addition to being the new home of the Dallas Cowboys and the annual AT&T Cotton Bowl Classic, the stadium will host the 2014 NCAA men's basketball Final Four and already served as home to the 2011 Super Bowl XLV, 2010 NBA All-Star Game and 2009 and 2010 Big 12 Championship football games.

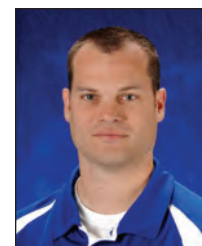

Washburn tops MSU in Kanza Bowl

Midwestern State's Ryan Craven became the school's all-time leading tackler midway through the fourth quarter at the Lower, Inc. Kanza Bowl.

And freshman cornerback Neiko Conway was tabbed the most outstanding player for the Mustangs after returning an interception for 51 yards to set up a score.

That would be a summation of MSU's highlights as Washburn (Kan.) rolled to a 45-14 victory at Hummer Sports Park.

Led by a lethal pass-and-catch combination of Dane Simoneau-to-Joe Hastings, the Ichabods piled up 520 total yards of total offense including 361 through the air and 159 on the ground.

Washburn limited the Mustangs to their second lowest offensive output of the season at 246 yards, while Midwestern permitted a season-high 520 total yards to the Ichabods.

Brandon Kelsey, who was making his second start at quarterback for injured 2009 Harlon Hill finalist Zack Eskridge, paced a 196-yard rushing day for MSU with 70 yards on 13 carries.

Senior Marcus Mathis used a 27-yard rush in the fourth quarter to move past Ross Harrison (2,418 yards from 2003-06) into third place on MSU's all-time rushing chart. The Rockwall High product finishes his career with 2,433 rushing yards.

Craven led the Mustangs' defensive effort with six tackles to finish with 267 career stops which is one more than Teddy Martyniuk, who made 266 tackles from 1988-91.

MSU closed the season with an 8-4 mark as the Mustangs have now posted 11 consecutive winning campaigns.
