Ouachita Baptist's Jamie Scheppmann headlines LSC North Division All-Conference team

RICHARDSON, TEXAS – Ouachita Baptist guard *Jamie Scheppmann* headlines the group selected to the 1999-2000 Lone Star Conference's North Division women's basketball team. The team was chosen by a vote of the league's eight coaches.

Scheppmann, a native of Cove, Ark., made a significant impact on the league after transferring from Louisiana Tech for her senior season. She led the LSC in scoring average (21.6 ppg.) and steals (85). She scored a season-high 38 points in OBU's first-round tournament win against Eastern New Mexico.

Joining Scheppmann on the first team are Southeastern Oklahoma forward Brandy Harris, East Central forward Rachelle Sturdevant, Northeastern State center Melissa Fullmer and Harding guard Rachel Raglin.

Southeastern guard *Vanessa Tice* was voted as the league's top freshman. Tice, a 5-8 guard from Kingston, Okla., was SOSU's second leading scorer at (10.4 ppg) and helped the Lady Savages to the LSC North title.

East Central guard *Mandy Watkins* was chosen as the defensive player-of-the-year. Watkins, a 5-7 senior from Heavener, Okla., started 21 of 27 games and helped ECU earn its second straight LSC Tournament berth.

Northeastern State's *Randy Gipson* was chosen by his peers as the coach-of-the-year. Gipson, took over a team that had finished 6-19 a year ago and turned them into a 15-12 winner and a qualifier for the LSC tournament.

Spencer, a Lockhart, Texas native, led the Lady Buffs in scoring (20.3 ppg) and rebounding (8.4 rpg) while helping WTAMU to the LSC Tournament finals. She scored in double figures all 29 games this season

Joining Spencer on the first team are Abilene Christian's Jackie Bucher, Midwestern State's TeNay Garrett, Texas A&M-Kingsville's Precious Thibodeaux and Angelo State's Kim Moore.

The top freshman award went to Kim Moore of Angelo State. The 6-0 forward from Zephyr, Texas averaged 19.6 points a game and led the Rambelles in scoring 20 of 26 games.
