LSC SOCCER

Lone Star Conference action persists on the women's side, while the men have non-conference games scheduled. West Texas A&M and Incarnate Word are tied atop the women's standing with identical 6-3 records for 18 points. The Cardinals have won four straight matches. On the men's side, UIW extended its winning streak to nine games after a pair of victories last week.

LSC men's soccer teams are 32-8-5 overall this season. The squads are currently 5-3-1 combined versus Rocky Mountain Athletic Conference teams, and 9-2-1 against the Heartland Conference, which are the other conferences in the NCAA South Central Region.

The women's teams are 41-52-8 overall this season. The squads are currently 2-9-1 combined versus Rocky Mountain Athletic Conference teams, and 2-4 against the Heartland Conference, which are the other conferences in the NCAA South Central Region.

PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

MEN'S OFFENSIVE

Carlos Viveros, Eastern New Mexico University, SO, Midfielder, Houston, Texas, Morton Ranch HS

Viveros set team highs, with eight shots and four shots on goal last week. He scored in both games, drawing a penalty kick to seal a 2-0 road win over 18th-ranked Fort Hays State. That contest marked the first road win over a nationally-ranked team, in program history. On Monday, Viveros tallied his sixth goal of the season, in a win over Texas-Permian Basin.

MEN'S DEFENSIVE

Fredrik Widfeldt, Eastern New Mexico University, FR, Yterby, Sweeden, Katrinelundsgymnasiet

Widfeldt registered a perfect goals-against average last week and posted wins against 18th-ranked Fort Hays State and Texas-Permian Basin. The game at FHSU, marked his third shutout of the season, moving Widfeldt into a tie for third on the ENMU single-season list. Monday's win over UTPB was his eighth of the season, moving him into second place on the single-season list.

WOMEN'S OFFENSIVE

Ashley Cottrell, Midwestern State University, FR, Forward, Arlington, Texas, Mansfield Summit HS

Cottrell needed just three shots to tally three goals to power Midwestern State to a split of Lone Star Conference matches last weekend at Eastern New Mexico and West Texas A&M. The freshman from Arlington buried an unassisted equalizer in the 76th minute to force overtime Friday afternoon at Eastern New Mexico. She then finished a pair of crosses from teammate Payton Fookes to tally two goals in a stunning 4-1 defeat of West Texas A&M Sunday in Canyon.

WOMEN'S DEFENSIVE

Heather Kowalik, University of the Incarnate Word, FR, Boerne, Texas, Champion HS

Kowalik was perfect on the week posting a pair of shutouts in wins over A&M-Commerce and Texas Woman's. She had one save in a 1-0 win over the Lions. She had to make four saves in a 3-0 win over the Pioneers. She has three consecutive shutouts and has not allowed a goal in her last 312 minutes in goal.

MEN'S OTHER TOP PERFORMERS

Dominic Furness, West Texas A&M University, had both goals in the Buffs' 2-2 tie at 18th-ranked Fort Hays State on Sunday. It was his fifth multiple goal game of the season as he had nine shots with five on frame. Furness leads the team and the conference with 15 goals, five assists and 35 points. He has a team-high 59 shots (.254) with 37 on goal (.627) for the season. He is first nationally in total points for the year (35) and ranks second in goals (15), goals per game (1.36) and points per game (3.18).

VcMor Eligwe, Midwestern State University, accounted for goals in each of No. 24 Midwestern State's matches last weekend against Southern Nazarene and Northeastern State to become the 33rd member of MSU's 50-Point Club posting 19 goals and 12 assists in his three seasons at MSU. Eligwe volleyed in a crossing pass for the game winner in the 64th minute Friday against Southern Nazarene then powered his way through the Northeastern State defense to give the Mustangs a 2-0 lead in the 41st minute on Sunday. The Mustangs' top producer has accounted for five goals and three assists this season.

Vincent Bailey, University of the Incarnate Word, added to his scoring total this week with a goal and an assist in a win over Southern Nazarene. He also played a strong midfield in a 1-0 win over visiting Northeastern State. He was key to the team's domination in possession in both games. He is now third in the nation in goals per game and fourth in points per game.

Josh Ferona, University of the Incarnate Word, continued his impressive seasons as a starting defender. This week, he was part of a unit that allowed just one goal and 12 total shots in a pair of wins over Northeastern State and Southern Nazarene. In addition, he scored the game-winning goal in each contest. He scored the only goal against NSU off a corner kick situation. In the SNU game, he pounced on a loose ball in front of the net. The Greyhounds picked up wins over #18 Fort Hays State and Texas-Permian Basin, last week. The win over Fort Hays marked the first time the Hounds have posted a road win over a nationally-ranked opponent in team history and moved Fredrik Widfeldt into a tie for third on the single-season list for shutouts. The victory over Permian Basin moved Widfeldt into second on the list for wins in a season and saw Diego Santos tie for the ENMU record for game-winning goals. Eastern has won nine consecutive games, in which Santos has a goal or assist. The Hounds will return to action, next Friday, against Midwestern State.

Incarinate Word

The Cardinals extended their winning streak to nine games after a 1-0 win over Northeastern State and a 6-1 win over Southern Nazarene. They moved up to #13 in the nation and #2 in the region this week. Josh Ferona continued his impressive seasons as a starting defender. This week, he was part of a unit that allowed just one goal and 12 total shots in a pair of wins over Northeastern State and Southern Nazarene. In addition, he scored the game-winning goal in each contest. He scored the only goal against NSU off a corner kick situation. In the SNU game, he pounced on a loose ball in front of the net. He now has four goals on the season with all being game winners. Vincent Bailey added a goal and as assist against SNU raising his total to 13 goals and four assists on the season. He is currently third in the nation in goals per game and fourth in points per game. Freshman Brett Becker got his first minutes in goal this week and fared well with a shutout win over NSU and a second win against SNU. He allowed just one goal and made three saves. The Cardinals have outshot their opponents 232-98 this year and have posted shutouts in 55 percent of their games.

Midwestern State

Midwestern State posted a 1-0-1 mark last weekend at the MSU Soccer Field claiming a 3-1 result over Southern Nazarene on Friday before settling for a 2-2 draw with Northeastern State on Sunday... The Mustangs improved one spot to No. 23 in the latest NSCAA Division II Poll... The Mustangs have appeared in 72 of the last 73 NSCAA national polls in which they were eligible dating back to the 2006 season... MSU has scored multiple goals in each of its last five matches after tallying six goals in its opening five games... Midwestern surrendered a two-goal advantage Sunday against Northeastern State for the first time since Eastern New Mexico rallied to tie a match 2-2 on Nov. 5, 2010 in Portales, but David Freeland scored the game winner in the 86th minute to all MSU to escape two seasons ago... It was the first time MSU surrendered a two-goal lead on its home pitch since Colorado State-Pueblo tallied two second half goals for a 2-2 draw on Oct. 5, 2001... Junior forward VcMor Eligwe tallied goals against Southern Nazarene and Northeastern State to join Midwestern's 50-Point Club with 19 goals and 12 assists... Sophomore forward Len Smith has tallied goals in three consecutive games and has scored five of his team-leading six goals over his last five matches... Eligwe (5 goals, 3 assists) and Smith (6 goals, 1 assist) lead MSU's 39th-ranked scoring offense with 13 points each... Sophomore midfielder Andrew Power accounted for a goal and an assist in Friday's 3-1 win over Southern Nazarene then assisted on a goal Sunday against Northeastern State... Midwestern permitted goals in consecutive matches for the first time this season against Southern Nazarene (1) and Northeastern State (2)... MSU still ranks fifth in NCAA Division II with a 0.60 shutout percentage...

West Texas A&M

The Buffaloes are ranked 20th this week in the NSCAA Poll as one of three LSC teams ranked...The Buffs' 8-1-2 record assures them of their 20th consecutive winning season...Senior Dominic Furness leads the team with 15 goals, five assists and 35 points. He ranks first nationally in total points and second in total goals, while ranking second in points per game (3.18) and goals per game (1.36)...He had two goals against Fort Hays marking his fifth multiple goal match of the season...As a team, WT is ranked ninth nationally in scoring offense averaging 3.0 goals per match, ninth in total goals (33), second nationally in total assists (33) and eighth in total points with 99...Junior Carl Prestidge is 15th nationally in assists with six.

WOMEN'S OTHER TOP PERFORMERS

Sydney Solomon, University of the Incarnate Word, was the Cardinals best player on the field in wins over A&M-Commerce and Texas Woman's. In the 1-0 win over the Lions, she drew a foul in the box that led to a penalty kick for Amber Guenther that provided the margin of victory. She came back with a great performance against TWU by scoring the game-winning goal and dishing out two assists in the second half of a 3-0 win.

Danielle Thurman, Eastern New Mexico University, game winning goal lifted the Zias to a 2-1 double overtime win against Midwestern State. With four minutes left in the second overtime period, Thurman found the back of the net for her second game winning goal, and fifth overall goal of the season.

Leslie Briggs, West Texas A&M University, had the game winner as WT swept Abilene Christian for the first time ever and beat the Wildcats at home for the first time since 2007. She had a team-high eight shots (.125) and three on frame (.375). It was her second game winner of the season. She leads the team and conference with 13 goals, five assists and 31 points. She ranks third nationally in goals (13), sixth in points (31) and 14th in points per game (2.38) and goals per game at 1.0 per contest.

Hanna Horeis, Angelo State University, continues to put pressure on opponents this season with an attacking mentality and broke through with her first goal of the season in ASU's 3-1 win over Texas A&M-Commerce on Sunday. Horeis, who has 38 shots this season, scored off an assist from Lauren Carnes to tie the match at 1-1. She finished the week with six shots and one goal as the Rambelles went 2-1 in a three-game week.

Megan Barnhart, Midwestern State University, played a central role in limiting LSC leading scorer Leslie Briggs to a single shot on frame in Midwestern State's upset win at West Texas A&M Sunday afternoon. The senior from Wichita Falls' determined play helped the Mustangs overcome the loss of two-time All-American Hanna Staley and two-year starter Anna Molen to injury. Barnhart teamed with freshman Morgan Hannon to limit the Lady Buffs to just three shots after Molen exited the game early in the second half.

Caitlyn Conaway, Angelo State University, helped lead a stingy Angelo State defense to a 2-1 record last week, including a 1-0 win over Texas Woman's and a 3-1 victory over Texas A&M-Commerce. Conaway also recorded her career's first goal with a scoring strike against Texas Woman's on Friday. Her defensive approach
