LSC SOCCER

Lone Star Conference games dominate the men's and women's schedules this week. West Texas A&M holds a narrow lead on the women's side with 24 points, with Incarnate Word (21) and Angelo State (19) just behind them. WT plays at both UIW and ASU this week as all three teams strive for the top spot.

The women have just two weeks of play remaining as teams compete for one of six spots in the LSC Championship to be hosted by the top seed November 1-2-4.

On the men's side, UIW's winning streak remains at nine games after an idle week and Midwestern State ran its unbeaten streak to six matches with a pair of wins.

LSC men's soccer teams are 35-8-5 overall this season. The squads are currently 5-3-1 combined versus Rocky Mountain Athletic Conference teams, and 9-2-1 against the Heartland Conference, which are the other conferences in the NCAA South Central Region.

The women's teams are 49-60-8 overall this season. The squads are currently 2-9-1 combined versus Rocky Mountain Athletic Conference teams, and 2-4 against the Heartland Conference, which are the other conferences in the NCAA South Central Region.

PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

CO-MEN'S OFFENSIVE

Lukas Garcia, West Texas A&M University, SR, Midfield, Odessa, Texas, Permian HS

Had a team-high two goals and one assist in a 4-2 win at Ouachita Baptist last week. He tallied six shots (.333) and four on goal (.667) in the win. It was his first two goals of the season and his second assist on the year. It was his first multi-goal match of his career. In the match he scored the first two goals for the Buffs and assisted on Dominic Furness' game winner in the second half. His score at the 0:25 mark in the match was the quickest goal of the season and one of the fastest in school history as the Buffs have two goals within the first 90 seconds of matches this season.

Len Smith, Midwestern State University, SO, Forward, Frisco, Texas, Wakeland HS

Smith tallied goals in each match to lead 24th-ranked Midwestern State to positive results over Houston-Victoria and Ouachita Baptist. The sophomore from Frisco hustled to knock in a rebound goal in the fourth minute of Friday's win over Houston-Victoria then finished on a Ben Clarvis assist in the 52nd minute Sunday at Ouachita Baptist. Smith has now tallied goals in each of his last five outings and has accounted for seven goals in his last seven games.

MEN'S DEFENSIVE

Carlos Ruiz, West Texas A&M University, SO, Bogata, Columbia, Universidad del Futbol

Had his first start of the season earning his first win in the Buffs' 4-2 win at Ouachita Baptist on Friday. He had two saves in the match. He has played in three matches this season with one start and has 0.1 shutouts.

WOMEN'S OFFENSIVE

Julie Coppedge, Abilene Christian University, SR, Midfield, Amarillo, Texas, Amarillo HS

Coppedge struck the game-winner in Sunday's 1-0 win over Incarnate Word. Coppedge scored the goal in the 86th minute from about 18-yards back after a deflected corner kick was played back to her. Coppedge's goal was her team-leading fourth of the year and 14th of her career. Coppedge also helped defensively this weekend as the Wildcats outshot their opposition 34-19 and didn't allow more than one corner kick.

WOMEN'S DEFENSIVE

Yvette Bedoy, West Texas A&M University, JR, Garland, Texas, South Garland HS

Tallied two shutouts in the Buffs' two key road wins at Texas Woman's and Texas A&M-Commerce last week helping WT regain sole possession of first place in the league standings with three matches remaining. She stopped seven shots recording her fourth and fifth shutouts of the season. She improved to 8-4-1 on the year in 13 matches and 1199:44 minutes of work for the year. She has a conference-best 80 saves and 165 for her career which is good for fourth-best in school history. Bedoy helped WT shutout a conference road weekend series for the first time since 2009.

Incarnate Word

The Cardinals were idle this past week. They return to action this weekend when they travel to West Texas A&M and Eastern New Mexico for a pair of conference matches. The 13th-ranked Cardinals remain highly ranked in a number of national statistical categories. They are fourth in scoring offense (3.36 goals/game), seventh in total goals (37), 10th in shutout percentage (0.55), 12th in total points (101) and 14th in win-loss percentage (.818). They are currently on a nine-match winning streak. Junior Vincent Bailey is ranked in the top 5 nationally in points, points per game, goals and goals per game. Midwestern State

Midwestern State ran its most recent unbeaten streak to six matches with wins over Houston-Victoria and Ouachita Baptist (Ark.) ... The Mustangs have scored multiple goals in seven consecutive matches to bring their scoring average up to 2.42 goals per game which ranks 24th in NCAA Division II... The MSU defense has let in goals in four consecutive matches after shutting out the opposition in six of its first eight matches this season... The Mustangs rank 16th nationally with a 0.71 goals against average and 18th with a .500 shutout percentage... Sophomore forward Len Smith has tallied goals in each of his five matches and has scored seven times in his last seven games... Junior forward VcMor Eligwe has scored a goal in each of his last five outings and six goals over last six games... Smith (8 goals, 2 assists) and Eligwe (7 goals, 3 assists) have accounted for just over half of MSU's 29 goals this season... Senior midfielder Aaron Douthit has accounted for a goal or an assist in five of his last six games in which he has delivered four goals and two assists... Senior forward/midfielder David Freeland remains two points away from joining Eligwe in the MSU 50-point Club. The Midland native has accounted for 19 goals and 10 assists for 48 points during his three-year career at MSU... Freshman midfielder Andrew Power capped off a productive four-match stretch with two assists against Houston-Victoria Friday night. The Waterford, Ireland product accounted for a goal and five assists during the run...

West Texas A&M

Won its ninth game of the year with a 4-2 win at Ouachita Baptist on Friday...Improved to 4-1-2 on the year on the road for the most road wins since 2010...Lukas Garcia's goal at the 0:25 mark in the match was the quickest goal of the season and one of the quickest goals in school history as the Buffs have two goals within the first 90 seconds of matches this season...Conference and team goal-leader Dominic Furness scored his 16th goal of the season and his fourth game winner at Ouachita Baptist...Head coach Butch Lauffer goes for his 260th win of the men's program and 450th win overall at WT Tuesday at UT-Permian Basin...Furness ranks first nationally in total points (37), second in points per game (3.08), second in goals (16) and second in goals per game (1.33)... Junior Carl Prestidge is 26th in both assists (6) and assists per game (0.5)...As a team, the Buffs are sixth in scoring offense averaging 3.08 goals per game, seventh in total goals with 37, fourth in assists with 37 and sixth in points with 111...Senior Colin Bjostad leads the team in minutes played as he has played 1105 of the 1120 minutes thus far as no other Buff player has played more than 1000 minutes.

WOMEN'S OTHER TOP PERFORMERS

Maggie Schaffer, Angelo State University, scored the game-winning goal for the Rambelles in their 1-0 win over Abilene Christian last Friday in Abilene. Schaffer now has three goals this season for ASU and nine in her career.

Amber Guenther, University of the Incarnate Word, scored the game-winning goal for the Cardinals in sudden-death overtime at Midwestern State to propel the team to a 2-1 win. It was the team's fifth straight victory. She led the team with four shots at MSU and three in a 1-0 loss at Abilene Christian.

Candice Davies, Texas Woman's University, helped the Pioneers snap a four-game losing streak on Sunday against Eastern New Mexico with the game-winning goal in the second half. Her goal came on a blast that went through the goalies hands off a rebound. Davies led the team on offense over the week with four shots. On the season she has four points on two goals off of seven shots on goal.

Leslie Briggs, West Texas A&M University, tallied her conference-leading 14th goal of the season as the Lady Buffs won a pair of 1-0 shutouts on the road to regain sole possession of first place in the conference with three matches remaining. She leads the team and conference with 14 goals, five assists and 33 points and added her team-high third game winner of the year. Briggs has a conference-best 90 shots with 35 on goal for the season. Her 33 points is good for eighth in school history in a season and her 14 goals are tied for sixth-best in a season. She ranks fourth nationally in goals with 14, sixth in points with 33 and 13 in points per game (2.2) and goals per game (0.93).

Whitley Lindholm, Abilene Christian University, served several different roles this weekend all over the pitch for the Wildcats, who went 1-1 in matches vs. Angelo State (L, 0-1) and Incarnate Word (W, 1-0). Lindholm, traditionally a midfielder, placed two of three shots on goal, but also helped ACU slow down the opposing offenses as they averaged 9.5 shots per match and took no more than one corner kick. The shutout win over UIW was ACU's fourth of the season.

Sara Deeb, Texas Woman's University, led the Pioneers' defense that allowed just five shots on goal. For the second time this season she shutdown the conference leading scorer, Leslie Briggs (1 shot). Briggs has not scored in only four games (out of 15 games) this season including two against TWU. Deeb also matched up against the Zias' leading scorer Danielle Thurman and did not allow her to take a shot. The freshman defender helped the Pioneers snap a four-game losing streak with a shutout victory over Eastern New Mexico.

Mallory Whitworth, Midwestern State University, clinched her 20th career shutout to help Midwestern State to a 1-0 win over Angelo State Sunday afternoon at the MSU Soccer Field. The McKinney native finished with six saves - many of the spectacular variety - to match Elli O'Dwyer (2002-05) for the most clean sheets in program history.

ACU begins the week in last place at 3-7-1, but is only two points behind sixth-place Eastern New Mexico and Commerce. ACU began its weekend with a 1-0 loss to Angelo State, but rebounded Sunday with a 1-0 win over then first-place Incarnate Word. Senior Midfielder Julie Coppedge struck the game-winner during the closing minutes and Arielle Moncure made five saves in pitching her fourth shutout of the season. The Wildcats outshot the opposition 34-19 and held a 9-1 advantage in corner kicks.

Angelo State split a pair of games last weekend against Abilene Christian and Midwestern State. The Rambelles opened the weekend with a 1-0 win over Abilene Christian, earning the win with a Maggie Schaffer goal that came off an assist from Kara Edwards. ASU returns to action at 4 p.m. on Friday against Eastern New Mexico at home before playing its final game of the regular season at the ASU Soccer Field at 1 p.m. on Sunday against West Texas A&M.

Eastern New Mexico

Last week, the Zias suffered setbacks against Texas A&M-Commerce and Texas Woman's. They will look to rebound this week, as they conclude their Lone Star Conference road trip at Angelo State and Incarnate Word.

Incarnate Word

The Cardinals extended their winning streak to five games with a dramatic 2-1 overtime victory at Midwestern State on Friday. After falling behind, 1-0, Sarah Johnson tied the game 18 seconds later. Then, Amber Guenther gave the team a victory with 12 seconds remaining in the first overtime. The team saw its winning streak snapped on Sunday in a 1-0 loss at Abilene Christian. Freshman Karly Brightwell started both games in goal for the team. She had a season-high six saves against ACU. UIW has been a second half club this year. They have scored just three goals in the first halves of games, but have put in 21 in the second half or overtime. Guenther leads the team with seven goals and two assists for 16 points. She is third in the LSC in both goals and points. The team closes out the regular season with three straight home matches.

Midwestern State

Midwestern State split a pair of Lone Star Conference matches last weekend taking a 1-0 overtime loss to Incarnate Word on Friday before rallying for a 1-0 victory over Angelo State on Sunday... The Mustangs claimed their first home win over the season in a 1-0 decision over Angelo State Sunday afternoon and are now 1-5-1 at the MSU Soccer Field this season... Freshman forward Ashley Cottrell accounted for her fourth goal in three matches converting a header off of a Payton Fookes' free kick in the 55th minute Friday to give MSU a 1-0 lead over Incarnate Word... For the first time this season, Fookes did not score in an MSU win but definitely played a key role producing four shots and taking five corner kicks Sunday against Angelo State... Junior midfielder Emily Saville tallied her first goal of the season when she followed Katy Catney's carom off of the crossbar on a free kick in the 32nd minute against Angelo State on Sunday... It was Saville's fifth career goal and first since tallying a goal in a 4-0 win over Incarnate Word on Sep. 18, 2011... Senior goalkeeper Mallory Whitworth notched her 20th career shutout Sunday against Angelo State to match Elli O'Dwyer (2002-05) for the most in program history... Whitworth continues to lead the nation goalkeeper minutes played this season with 1,465:16... Whitworth has played every minute MSU has played between the posts this season...
