LSC SOCCER

Lone Star Conference action continues this week, with the women concluding regular season play. On the men's side, Incarnate Word secured its first LSC championship with a pair of wins. The Cardinals also tied the school record for consecutive wins with 11 to date.

The LSC Championship field has been set for the women, with this week's remaining contests to determine the seeding and host for the event on November 1-2-4. UIW and West Texas A&M are tied atop the standings, with the Cardinals holding the tiebreaker due to two wins over the Lady Buffs. Joining the two teams for the tournament are Angelo State, Midwestern State, Abilene Christian and Texas Woman's.

LSC men's soccer teams are 39-11-7 overall this season. The squads are currently 5-3-1 combined versus Rocky Mountain Athletic Conference teams, and 10-2-1 against the Heartland Conference, which are the other conferences in the NCAA South Central Region.

The women's teams are 57-68-8 overall this season. The squads are currently 2-9-1 combined versus Rocky Mountain Athletic Conference teams, and 2-4 against the Heartland Conference, which are the other conferences in the NCAA South Central Region.

PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

MEN'S OFFENSIVE

Vincent Bailey, University of the Incarnate Word, JR, Midfielder, Southport, England, Savio

Bailey helped spark the Cardinals to a 2-0 week in LSC play. On Friday, he assisted on the team's first goal at #17 West Texas A&M in a comeback, 3-2 victory. He came back with the game-winning goal and an assist in a 2-1 win at Eastern New Mexico that clinched the LSC Title, the first in school history. With the goal and two assists he upped his season totals to 14 goals and six assists.

MEN'S DEFENSIVE

James Nero, University of the Incarnate Word, JR, Charlotte, NC, Olympic

Nero played a key role for the Cardinals in securing the team's first LSC title. He scored his first goal of the season in a 3-2 win at #17 West Texas A&M. Then, he was part of a defensive line that limited Eastern New Mexico to just five total shots in a 2-1 win.

WOMEN'S OFFENSIVE

Sydney Solomon, University of the Incarnate Word, JR, Forward, Schertz, Texas, Randolph HS

Solomon provided the Cardinals with an important victory over West Texas A&M that moved them into a tie for first place in the conference. She scored her first career hat-trick against the Lady Buffs in a 3-0 win on a total of three shots. She also fired two fired two shots on goal in the team's 2-1 win over Eastern New Mexico.

WOMEN'S DEFENSIVE

Heather Kowalik, University of the Incarnate Word, FR, Boerne, Texas, Champion HS

Kowalik recorded her fourth shutout of the season in a key 3-0 win over West Texas A&M. She recorded three saves in the victory that put the Cardinals in a tie for first place in the LSC with the Lady Buffs. On Sunday, she improved to 8-4 on the year with a 2-1 win over Eastern New Mexico. She lowered her season GAA to 1.11.

MEN'S OTHER TOP PERFORMERS

Dominic Furness, West Texas A&M University, tallied two goals for the week and had the double-overtime, golden goal assist in the Buffs' 2-1 win over Midwestern State Sunday. He had 12 shots and four on goal for the week while playing and starting all three matches. Furness logged 241 minutes which was third-best on the team during that span. He ranks second in the nation in goals with 18 and 34th nationally in assist with six and ranks first nationally in points with 42. He had two goals at UT-Permian Basin and then the game-winning assist at the 102:12 mark in double-time versus rival Midwestern State.

Eishu Kanemitsu, Eastern New Mexico University, scored his fourth goal of the season with 22:32 remaining in regulation, to lift the Greyhounds to a 1-1 double overtime tie against Midwestern State, last Friday. The Mustangs currently lead the Lone Star Conference in goals against average.

Michael Stewart, Eastern New Mexico University, helped the Greyhounds limit 21st-ranked Midwestern State to one goal on 14 shots, in a 1-1 tie, last Friday. He also registered an assist against tenth-ranked Incarnate Word.

Carlos Ruiz, West Texas A&M University, played every minute of all three games last week between the posts. He posted a 2-1 record in his first three starts of the year. Logged 282:12 minutes with five goals against (1.59 GAA) and a .706 save percentage. He had a season-high six saves versus Incarnate Word and played all 102:12 minutes in a 2-1 double-overtime thrilling win over rival Midwestern State Sunday.

Incarnate Word

The Cardinals moved up to #7 in the NSCAA Poll this week after going 2-0 on the road in LSC play. The team secured their first LSC title with wins at #17 West Texas A&M and at Eastern New Mexico. They have tied the school record with 11 consecutive wins. Vincent Bailey helped spark the Cardinals to a 2-0 week in LSC play. On Friday, he assisted on the team's first goal at #17 West Texas A&M in a comeback, 3-2 victory. He came back with the game-winning goal and an assist in a 2-1 win at Eastern New Mexico that clinched the LSC Title, the first in school history. With the goal and two assists he upped his season totals to 14 goals and six assists.

Midwestern State

Midwestern State dropped out of the NSCAA Division II Poll for the second time this season after suffering a 1-1 draw at Eastern New Mexico on Friday before falling 2-1 in overtime at West Texas A&M on Sunday... The Mustangs have held leads in each of their two losses this season and have also led in draws to Northeastern State and Eastern New Mexico... MSU has permitted goals in each of its last six matches after recording shutouts in six of its first eight matches of the season... MSU's four draws are the most in a season since the 2002 squad played to four ties on the way to an NCAA Division II national quarterfinal. That team finished the season with a 14-1-4 mark. No Midwestern State team has played to five draws in a season... Sophomore midfielder Andrew Power tallied his third goal of the season in the 50th minute Friday at Eastern New Mexico. It was his first road goal of the season and first since notching a goal and an assist in a 3-1 win over Southern Nazarene on Oct. 5, 2012... Junior forward VcMor Eligwe recorded an assist in Friday's draw at Eastern New Mexico to extend a streak of scoring a point in five consecutive matches. Eligwe had scored goals in four-straight games going into the weekend... Freshman defender Ben Clarvis knocked in his third goal of the season Sunday against West Texas A&M on senior defender Fernando Garza's third assist of the campaign...

West Texas A&M

Went 2-1 over the week with a 3-1 win at UT-Permian Basin, followed by a heartbreaking 3-2 loss to Incarnate Word and followed with a thrilling and very physical 2-1 win in double-overtime over rival Midwestern State Sunday...Senior Dominic Furness leads the nation in total points with 42, while he is second nationally in goals with 18 and is second and third, respectively, in points per game and goals per game...WT was the top ranked team in the South Central Region in the initial NCAA Division II rankings released last week...Senior Colin Bjostad scored his most important goal of his career at the 102:12 mark in the 2-1 win over Midwestern State...Sophomore goalkeeper Carlos Ruiz started his third consecutive game Sunday and went 2-1 for the week with 12 saves...In the 3-2 loss to Incarnate Word on Friday, WT scored its third quickest goal of the season as sophomore Martin Fuentes scored just 2:27 into the contest...Ruiz had a season-high six saves in that match... WT is 18th in the latest NSCAA Rankings and third in the NSCAA region rankings.

WOMEN'S OTHER TOP PERFORMERS

Ashley Cottrell, Midwestern State University, tallied two goals in a span of 60 seconds to lift Midwestern State past Texas Woman's 2-1 Friday night at the MSU Soccer Field. The freshman from Arlington volleyed in a deflection from 8 yards out at the 80:36 mark of the second half then headed in Payton Fookes' corner kick exactly one minute later for MSU's first come-from-behind victory of the season. It was Cottrell's second multiple-goal match in as many weeks. She has needed just 15 shots to produce a team-high seven goals this season.

Leslie Briggs, West Texas A&M University, scored the only two goals for the Lady Buffs as they split two matches on the road last week to stay tied with Incarnate Word for the regular season championship. Briggs had both goals in a 2-0 win at Angelo State Sunday. She logged 134 minutes which was third-most on the team. For the season, Briggs leads the conference in goals and ranks second nationally with 16. She is fifth nationally in points with 37 and is 10th nationally in points per game and goals per game. She also is 18th nationally in game winning goals with four.

Lauren Bateman, Angelo State University, continues to find the back of the nets as the regular season comes to an end for the Angelo State soccer team. Bateman scored the first two goals for the Rambelles in ASU's 5-0 win over Texas A&M-Commerce and now leads the team with five goals this season. Bateman battled injury early in the season but is giving the Rambelles a scoring threat as the postseason approaches.

Jacey Ferrara, Abilene Christian University, scored the first and last goals of ACU's 4-0 win Sunday vs. Texas Woman's, which clinched the Wildcats a berth at next week's Lone Star Conference Championships. Ferrara scored her first goal in the 16th minute off an assist from Krysta Grimm, and then capped the scoring in the 89th minute with sharply hit ground ball that slipped through the defense. Ferrara's multi-goal match was the first of her career. She last scored during overtime of last year's NCAA Championship win over Midwestern State.

Danielle Thurman, Eastern New Mexico University, continues her offensive threat as she collected her sixth goal of the season against University of the Incarnate Word. Thurman now has two more goals than in any of her previous seasons and has 14 goals for her career.

Sarah Schoch, Abilene Christian University, helped anchor ACU's defensive efforts this past weekend as the Wildcats went 2-0 and out-scored their opposition 6-1. Schoch's ability to consistently win balls in the air provided ACU with a bulk of the possession time, and when pressed into defense, she and her teammates allowed the opposition to place only 5-of-24 shots on goal (.208). By comparison, ACU's attackers placed 15 of 24 shots on goal. ACU's shutout of Texas Woman's was its fifth of the year, and the defense hasn't allowed more than a goal since a 2-0 loss at West Texas on Oct. 5 - a span of five matches in which the Wildcats are 4-1.

Mallory Whitworth, Midwestern State University, made a pair of saves -- one on a penalty kick -- in Sunday's win over Texas A&M-Commerce to become Midwestern State's all-time shutouts leader. The senior from McKinney notched her 21st career clean sheet to pass former standout Elli O'Dwyer who had 20 shutouts from 2002-05. Whitworth now has 43 career victories and continues to lead NCAA Division II in goalkeeper

Abilene Christian

The Wildcats extended their season-long win streak to three following a 2-0 home weekend that included wins over Texas A&M-Commerce (2-1) and Texas Woman's (4-0). The victories helped clinch ACU a berth at its fifth-straight Lone Star Conference Championship. ACU's 4-0 win over the Pioneers was its largest margin of victory since Sept. 4, 2011 when it defeated Texas A&M-International by the same score. Jacey Ferrara scored twice against TWU for her first career multi-goal game. The goals were also her first since delivering the golden goal at last year's NCAA Championship win over Midwestern State. Also scoring for the Wildcats this weekend was Julie Coppedge, whose goal vs. the Lions Friday tied her career season high at five. She last scored five goals as a sophomore in 2010. Krysta Grimm scored her fourth goal Sunday vs. TWU, which was the 19th of her career and pushed her past Lyndsey Womack for fourth place on ACU's list of career leaders. Grimm, a senior, needs two more goals to pass Courtney Wilson and Ashley Holton for second. Andrea Carpenter scored her fourth goal of 2012 vs. the Lions, extending her ACU career record to 42. Arielle Moncure's shutout of the Pioneers was her fifth of the season and she needs just two more to tie Elliott London's single-season record of seven set just lat vear.

Angelo State

The Angelo State Rambelles split their final two home games of the season last weekend with a 5-0 win over Eastern New Mexico on Friday and a 1-2 loss to West Texas A&M on Sunday. The results have the Rambelles at 7-5-1 in Lone Star Conference play and in third place with one regular season game remaining. Lauren Bateman scored two goals against ENMU, while Brittany Martinez, Maggie Schaffer and Kayla Gregory each added goals. Hanna Horeis scored ASU's lone goal against WT. The Rambelles complete their regular season schedule with a 5 p.m. game on Friday at Incarnate Word.

Elli O'Dwyer had 20 shutouts from 2002-05 as the previous leader... Senior forward Haley Crandall notched the game winning goal in her first game at the MSU Soccer Field in a 1-0 win over St. Edward's in 2009 then notched the game-winner in Sunday's 3-0 win over Texas A&M-Commerce. Crandall, who had two goals against the Lions last season, scored three of her four career goals against A&M-Commerce... Freshman forward Ashley Cottrell tallied two goals 60 seconds apart to lead the Mustangs to a 2-1 come-frombehind win over Texas Woman's on Friday. It was Cottrell's second 2-goal performance of the season and upped her goal tally to a team-high seven in just 15 shots... Junior midfielder Mickey Brown scored her 10th career goal in the 59th minute of Sunday's win over Texas A&M-Commerce... West Texas A&M

The Lady Buffs are 10-6-1 on the year and 9-4 in conference play tying them with Incarnate Word heading into the final match of the season Friday at Eastern New Mexico...WT can win the outright league, regular season championship with a win or a tie and a Incarnate Word loss or a tie...If both teams tie in their final matches they will share the conference regular season championship...If the teams tie for the regular season, UIW would have the tie-breaker as it defeated WT twice and the Cardinals would host the LSC Championship next weekend in San Antonio... If WT wins the regular season outright, it'd host the conference tournament in Canyon...Senior Leslie Briggs ranks second nationally in goals with 16, fifth nationally in points with 37 and is 10th in points per game and goals per game...Junior goalkeeper Yvette Bedoy has a conference-best 93 saves on the year which is a career-season-high for her...Briggs ranks 18th nationally in game winning goals with four...The 10 wins by the Lady Buffs is the most since 15 in 2009 and is the 14th double-digit win season in the 17-year program history.
