LSC SOCCER

A full slate of Lone Star Conference action continues on the women's side, while the men have non-conference play on tap. West Texas A&M leads the women's race with 15 points, with Texas Woman's and Angelo State behind them. On the men's side, Incarnate Word and WTAMU are the only teams with league victories.

LSC men's soccer teams are 27-8-3 overall this season. The squads are currently 5-3-1 combined versus Rocky Mountain Athletic Conference teams, and 8-2-1 against the Heartland Conference, which are the other conferences in the NCAA South Central Region.

The women's teams are 31-42-4 overall this season. The squads are currently 2-9-1 combined versus Rocky Mountain Athletic Conference teams, and 2-4 against the Heartland Conference, which are the other conferences in the NCAA South Central Region.

PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

CO-MEN'S OFFENSIVE

Wayne Bruton, West Texas A&M University, SO, F, Carrigaline, Ireland, Carrigaline Community School

Bruton led the team with three goals scored in two matches last week with a 3-0 shutout at Eastern New Mexico and a 4-1 win over Wayland Baptist. Had a at least one goal in both matches. Tallied four shots (.750) with three shots on goal (.750) which were all scores. Had a goal at ENMU as WT snapped a two-match skid in Portales, N.M., for its first win there since 2009 and first shutout there since 2005. Scored the first goal and added the game winner against Wayland Baptist for his first two goal match in his career. As a freshman last season, he had one goal on 12 shots, this season he has three goals on eight shots (.375).

Vincent Bailey, University of the Incarnate Word, JR, Mid, Southport, Eng., Savio

Bailey netted his second hat-trick of the season in a 5-0 win against Ouachita Baptist. He tallied all three of his goals in the second half within 22:29 of each other. He fired a total of seven shots in the game, but all three of his shots on goal found the back of the net. He also assisted on another goal in the second half. He is now second in the nation in goals per game (1.33) and third in the nation in points per game (3.00).

MEN'S DEFENSIVE

William Garrett Cooper, West Texas A&M University, R-FR, Bedford, Texas, L.D. Bell HS

Cooper continued his impressive redshirt freshman campaign as he went 2-0 with a shutout and 11 saves (.917) in two matches last week. Logged all 180 minutes for a 0.50 goals against average. Stopped five shots in a 3-0 win at Eastern New Mexico for the first win there since 2009 and first shutout win since 2005. Had six saves in a 4-1 win over Wayland Baptist on Sunday. Cooper improved to 8-1-1 on the year as the Buffs are ranked 11th nationally and second in the region in the NSCAA poll. He has logged 893:34 minute with just 11 goals against and a league-leading 31 saves (.738). With his performance last week, he dropped his GAA to 1.11 for the year with 3.1 shutouts.

CO-WOMEN'S OFFENSIVE

Amber Guenther, University of the Incarnate Word, JR, Mid, San Antonio, Texas, Johnson HS

Guenther started a pair of games for the Cardinals last week on the road. She was held scoreless in a loss at Eastern New Mexico despite firing three shots. On Sunday, she came back with her first career hat-trick in a 4-1 win at West Texas A&M. She attempted six shots in the game. She leads the team with five goals and 11 points on the season.

Victoria Perez, Eastern New Mexico University, SO, M, Rio Rancho, NM, Rio Rancho HS

Perez led the Zias this week with an offensive explosion against Incarnate Word. Perez collected goals in the 31st and 40th minute to provide the first two scores of the game and the eventual game winning goal. In addition, Perez collected the assist in the Zias third goal of the game. Perez's five points against UIW is good for her career-high and ties her for ninth all-time for individual game records.

WOMEN'S DEFENSIVE

Mallory Whitworth, Northwestern State University, SR, McKinney, Texas, McKinney HS

Whitworth posted a pair of shutouts to lead Northwestern State to its first unbeaten week of the season earning a win against Texas A&M-Commerce and draws against Abilene Christian and Texas Woman's University as all three games extended into double overtime. The senior from McKinney was credited with 15 saves with six coming against Texas A&M-Commerce and eight against then-LSC leading TWU. The clean sheets were her 18th and 19th of her career and just one behind MSU all-time shutout leader Elli O'Dwyer, who notched 20 blankings from 2002-05.

MEN'S OTHER TOP PERFORMERS

Carlos Viveros, Eastern New Mexico University, fired a team-high eight shots last week, with six on goal. He scored twice against Eastern's win over University of the Southwest, which included the game-winning goal, 26:59 into the game.

Len Smith, Northwestern State University, scored a goal and dished out an assist to lead Northwestern State to a 3-0 win over Adams State Sunday in Alamosa. The sophomore forward from Frisco buried a cross from

Nathan Kenyon, Midwestern State University, delivered his second-straight clean sheet leading Midwestern State to a 3-0 win Sunday afternoon at Adams State (Colo.). The sophomore from Dubbo, Australia notched two saves as the Mustangs notched their NCAA Division II-best sixth shutout of the season. Kenyon had permitted one goal in 270 minutes between the posts this season with an .857 save percentage.

Eishu Kanemitsu, Eastern New Mexico University, defensive play allowed the Greyhounds to pick up their second shutout win of the season, coming against University of the Southwest. His defensive play in that contest, helped limit the Mustangs to no shots on goal. Kanemitsu also tallied his first two goals of the season in that game, drawing a penalty kick, which led to the second goal.

Eastern New Mexico

The Eastern New Mexico University men's soccer team split a pair of games last week, falling in their Lone Star Conference opener to West Texas A&M and defeating University of the Southwest. Against USW, the Hounds set a team record with 36 shots, while posting the second-most points (17), goals (6) and assists (5), in team history. Since last season, the Greyhounds have won eight consecutive matches, in which Diego Santos had a goal or assist. This Friday, ENMU will visit Fort Hays State.

Incarnate Word

The Cardinals ran their winning streak to seven games with a 5-0 win over Ouachita Baptist in a neutral site game played at Richland College. Vincent Bailey netted his second hat-trick of the season in a 5-0 win against Ouachita Baptist. He tallied all three of his goals in the second half within 22:29 of each other. He fired a total of seven shots in the game, but all three of his shots on goal found the back of the net. He also assisted on another goal in the second half. He is now second in the nation in goals per game (1.33) and third in the nation in points per game (3.00). Uros Ceglai had a big game for the Cardinals in their 5-0 win over Ouachita Baptist. Midwestern State

Midwestern State returned to the NSCAA/Continental Tire NCAA Division II Poll after a one-week hiatus at the No. 24 position... The Mustangs have received a national ranking in 71 of the last 72 weeks in which it was NSCAA eligible... MSU has recorded clean sheets in four of its last five matches and in seven total games this season to lead all of NCAA Division II in shutout percentage at 0.75... The Mustangs rate fourth in the nation with a team goals against average of 0.48... MSU goalkeepers Ray Clark and Nathan Kenyon has combined for a .862 save percentage which ranks ninth in NCAA Division II... Clark ranks eight individually with in goals against average (0.557) and 13th in save percentage (.850)... Clark has four shutouts in five starts while Kenyon has two clean sheets over three starts... The Mustangs have scored 11 goals over their last three matches after notching six tallies in their first five games... Sophomore forward Len Smith notched a goal and an assist in MSU's 3-0 win Sunday at Adams State. He leads the Mustangs with four goals and nine points... Junior striker VcMor Eligwe added three goals and three assists to match Smith with nine total points... Senior transfer midfielder Aaron Douthit netted his third goal to open scoring against Adams State and has scored goal in each of his last two outings... Freshman midfielder Ben Clarvis scored his first collegiate goal in the 56th minute of MSU's 3-0 win Sunday at Adams State... Midwestern State returns home to face Southern Nazarene Friday night before playing host to former LSC foe Northeastern State on Sunday...

West Texas A&M

Went 2-0 on the week with a shutout win at Eastern New Mexico (3-0) which was the first win in Portales, N.M., since 2009 and first shutout there since 2005... Won 4-1 over Wayland Baptist on Sunday to improve to 8-1-1 on the year... Sophomore Wayne Bruton had three goals, including two scores against WBU and the first goal and game winner. Had four shots for the week with three scores... William Cooper tallied a 0.50 goals against average for the week with one goal and 11 saves and his 3.1 shutout of the season. He is 8-1-1 with a league-best 31 saves and a 1.11 goals against average for the year... WT surpassed last year's goal output of 25 and has 31 goals and 31 assists on the year... Dominic Furness leads the team and conference in points (31) and goals (13) as he is second nationally in goals and leads the nation in points, while ranking third in goals per game (1.3) and second in points per game (3.1)... Carl Prestidge leads the team and conference with six assists, while Furness has five as they rank sixth and 22nd, respectively, nationally in assists... As a team, the Buffs are first nationally in points, third in assists and sixth in goals.

WOMEN'S OTHER TOP PERFORMERS

Brittany Martin, Texas Woman's University, scored two goals, her seventh and eighth of the season, to lead the TWU soccer team to a 2-1 victory over Abilene Christian on Friday. The win was the Pioneers first in school history against ACU. With the Pioneers trailing, 1-0, Martin responded with a game-tying goal in the 30th minute and five minutes later scored the game-winner. It's her second game-winning goal this season. Martin has helped the Pioneers to their best start in the conference (4-1-1) in school history. She is currently ranked second in six LSC statistical categories and tied for first in game-winning goals.

Sierra Anderson, Angelo State University, scored the game-winning goal for the Angelo State Rambelles in their 1-0 win over Eastern New Mexico on Sunday. Anderson scored the goal in the sixth minute of play and put

Lindsey Sisco, Texas Woman's University, posted a 0.45 GAA and .857 save percentage in the net to help the Pioneers to 1-0-1 record last week and their best start in the conference (4-1-1) in school history. She made four saves in a 2-1 win against Abilene Christian on Friday and first-ever victory over ACU in school history. Sisco also made two save against Midwestern State in a 0-0 tie to record her second career shutout.

Renee Romero, Eastern New Mexico University, led her fellow defenders to keep Incarnate Word and Angelo State's shots to a minimum. In two games, Eastern New Mexico's opponents were held to just two goals and 15 shots on goal. In their win against Incarnate Word, the Cardinals were held to just one goal over 20 total shots. In addition to her solid defense, Romero is also a scoring threat in the box. Against Angelo State she headed two shots for near misses in a 1-0 loss.

Jordan Benfield, Angelo State University, continued her strong defensive play last week by helping Angelo State shut out Eastern New Mexico on Sunday and limit West Texas A&M to two goals. Benfield and the Rambelles recorded their third shutout of the season with the win at ENMU.

Katie Miller scored her second game-winning goal of the season against WT. She also had an assist in the game. She now has three goals and two assists on the season. The Cardinals are still looking for their first shutout of the season. They have held four teams to one goal. The team is currently 3-3 in conference play. This week they travel to Angelo State on Wednesday before hosting Texas A&M-Commerce

and Texas Woman's over the weekend.

Midwestern State

Midwestern State battled its way to an unbeaten week with draws against Abilene Christian and Texas Woman's sandwiched around a 1-0 double overtime win over Texas A&M-Commerce... MSU has posted shutouts in each of its last three road games... The Mustangs have scored just seven goals through 11 matches which stands as the lowest scoring output in school history and two goals behind the 2006 squad which tallied nine goals in its first 11 games... The Mustangs have posted three ties this season which are the most since the 2004 squad notched a program-high five draws while going 12-4-5... MSU has factored in to all three draws in Lone Star Conference play this season... The Mustangs played in three consecutive double overtime matches for the first time in the 18-year history of the program last week... MSU has been pushed to double overtime four times this season which is the most since playing six two-overtime games in each of the 2004 and 2005 seasons... More OT: The Mustangs have gone to overtime in five of 11 matches this season after going to OT seven times last season. Midwestern played in a school record nine overtime matches in 2004... MSU is 22-12-18 all-time in overtime matches and 9-6-18 in double overtime contests since the school ushered in women's soccer in 1995... Senior midfielder Maddie Fraser netted her first goal of the season on a side volley for the equalizing goal Tuesday night against Abilene Christian. It was her first goal since notching the game winner on Oct. 23, 2011 at Texas Woman's University... Fraser ranks eighth on the school's all-time assist list with 15... Sophomore forward Payton Fookes has delivered a team-high two goals this season both have come as game winners and both were tallied in the rain at Incarnate Word and at Texas A&M-Commerce... Senior goalkeeper Mallory Whitworth claimed her 39th career win between the posts and needs four more to move past Lindsey Kiser (43 wins from 1997-00) to top MSU's career victories list... Whitworth posted her 18th and 19th career clean sheets and needs one more to match Elli O'Dwyer (20 shutouts from 2002-05) at the top of the program's all-time shutouts list...

The TWU soccer team remained undefeated in its last four games after posting a 1-0-1 record last week. The Pioneers knocked off Abilene Christian 2-1 on Friday for their first-ever win over the Wildcats in school history. TWU also tied Midwestern State 0-0 on Sunday and is off to its best start in the conference (4-1-1) in school history. Senior Brittany Martin scored both goals against ACU, her seventh and eighth of the season. She leads the team in scoring with 19 points. Senior Katy Black is second with seven points on one goal and five assists while sophomore Taylor Maxson is third with six points (2 goals and 2 assists). Sophomore goalie Lindsey Sisco started in nine games in the net and has an 1.25 goals-against average, .750 save percentage and two shutouts.

West Texas A&M

Went 1-1 over the week with a shutout win over Angelo State and a loss to Incarnate Word snapping a four-match winning streak...The Lady Buffs lead the conference with a 5-2 mark in league play and are 6-4-1 overall...Tallied three goals on the week as senior

Leslie Briggs added a score to her conference-leading and fifth-best national count for her 12th score of the year and is sixth nationally in points with 29...She also is tied for the league lead in assists with 5 and ranks 33rd nationally in assists...Junior goalkeeper Yvette Bedoy had 15 saves over the weekend to give her a league-best 64 saves on the year which is good for 19th nationally...She has 149 career saves as she is just five saves from fourth all-time in school history.
