



## LSC CROSS COUNTRY AND TRACK & FIELD COACHES MEETING

September 10, 2012, Courtyard Marriott, Allen, Texas

1. **USTFCCA REPORT**: Coaches provided an updated on USTFCCA matters, including a reminder to register for the upcoming convention, which is Dec. 17-20 in Orlando.
2. **2012 LSC CROSS COUNTRY MEET**: Cameron officials passed out packets regarding the 2012 meet and reminded coaches of a 5:30 coaches' meeting on the second floor of the field house at the event site. Coaches asked about the availability of course maps, and while not yet available, Coach Kreger said they would be ready and shared soon. Also, it was mentioned that Direct Athletics might be able to accommodate top times and entries this season given their expanded involvement with Division II performance submissions. The LSC Office will coordinate any Direct Athletics involvement with Cameron officials.
3. **FUTURE CROSS COUNTRY DATES**: It was noted that Eastern New Mexico University is scheduled to host the 2013 LSC Cross Country Championships and should confirm its intentions by the October 2012 meeting. Also, the 2013 NCAA regional has yet to be determined but should be in an LSC locale, while the 2013 NCAA nationals is slated for Nov. 23 in Spokane, Wash.
4. **INDOOR TRACK & FIELD MEET**: After discussion of the challenges facing the Conference in the sport of indoor track and field, it was moved (ASU) to not sponsor a conference championship meet in February 2013 as planned. **Motion failed for lack of a second.**
5. **2013 LSC INDOOR T&F MEET**: Coaches reviewed last year's meet schedule and, by consensus agreement, adopted a meet schedule and operating code for the indoor track meet. Commissioner Wagon reported that Texas Tech doesn't foresee any problems for the dates of Feb. 23-24, and Bart Bradshaw has confirmed that South Plains Officials can work those dates. The LSC Office will coordinate top times and entries through Direct Athletics.
6. **INCLEMENT WEATHER**: It was moved (TSU) and seconded (MSU) to add the following policy to LSC Outdoor Track & Field Operating Code: "If the meet schedule is impacted by inclement weather, events will be started as possible through 11:59 PM, at which time coaches will meet to determine the best plan for any remaining events." **Passed unanimously.**
7. **2013 LSC OUTDOOR T&F MEET**: Commissioner Wagon reminded the group the 2013 outdoor meet would be part of the 2013 LSC Spring Championships Festival. He shared the timeline by which the host site would be selected (late October) and assured the coaches of intentions for the event, which is to preserve the quality of the meet while benefitting from the additional presence of baseball and softball student-athletes, coaches, fans and media.
8. **ALL-CONFERENCE AWARDS**: It was moved (TAMUK) and seconded (MSU) to change the method for determining all-conference performers for track and field such that individuals who placed first and second in each event would be recognized as all-conference, while also eliminating the possibility to earn all-conference via point total. **Failed, 2-4.**
9. **ELECTION OF OFFICERS**: It was moved (TSU) and seconded (ASU) to elect Casey Kreger as Vice Chair for LSC Cross Country, effective immediately. **Passed unanimously.**
