

LSC SOCCER

West Texas A&M is set to host the Lone Star Conference Women's Soccer Championship Tournament after claiming the league title. The championship is set for November 1-2-4 at The Pitch in Canyon, Texas.

WTAMU, 11-6-1 overall and 10-4 in the LSC, is the top seed for the six-team, single elimination conference championship. The Lady Buffs earned their sixth LSC championship and first since 2008.

Incarnate Word claimed the No. 2 seed and first-round bye with a 9-5 mark in league play.

The championship begins on Thursday, Nov. 1, at 12 p.m. with No. 3 Angelo State playing No. 6 Texas Woman's. The 2:30 p.m. game matches No. 4 Midwestern State against No. 5 Abilene Christian.

The ASU-TWU winner advances to play UIW at 5 p.m. Friday, while the MSU-ACU victor plays WTAMU at 7:30 p.m. The Friday winners get a day off before playing on Sunday at 1 p.m. for the LSC Tournament crown and automatic bid into the NCAA Division II championship field.

Each of the women's soccer championship games will be aired live via video streaming online at www.LoneStarConference.org. Webcasts of each game are available free of charge. Each webcast includes both video and audio, with viewers needing only a computer with a high-speed DSL or cable modem connection to the internet. Veteran broadcaster Chris Needham has the call for all the games.

The regular season concludes this week on the men's side with three league contests and two non-conference match-ups. UIW had its 11-game winning streak stopped by Midwestern State, but remains unbeaten in its last 12 matches after a 1-1 tie.

LSC men's soccer teams are 40-12-9 overall this season. The squads are currently 5-3-1 combined versus Rocky Mountain Athletic Conference teams, and 10-2-1 against the Heartland Conference, which are the other conferences in the NCAA South Central Region.

The women's teams are 61-72-8 overall this season. The squads are currently 2-9-1 combined versus Rocky Mountain Athletic Conference teams, and 2-4 against the Heartland Conference, which are the other conferences in the NCAA South Central Region.

PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

MEN'S OFFENSIVE

Cantu Palombo, Eastern New Mexico University, JR, Midfield, Albuquerque, N.M., Sandia HS/Otero JC

Palombo registered a three-point game, to lead the Greyhounds past 18th-ranked West Texas A&M. His corner kick late in the first half led to ENMU's first goal and he tallied the game-winning goal, 3:34 later. The performance marked his fourth match of the season with at least three points and moved him into a tie for sixth in the Lone Star Conference in goals scored.

MEN'S DEFENSIVE

Fredrik Widfeldt, Eastern New Mexico University, FR, Yterby, Sweden, Katrinelundsgymnasiet

Widfeldt made six saves, including four in the second half, to lift the Greyhounds to a 2-1 win at 18th-ranked West Texas A&M. He had to turn in an exceptional second-half performance, as the Buffaloes held a 10-0 advantage in shots, during the final 45 minutes of play. The victory tied Widfeldt for the ENMU record for goalkeeper wins in a season and gave Eastern its second road win over West Texas A&M.

WOMEN'S OFFENSIVE

Kayla Gregory, Angelo State University, R-FR, Forward, Stephenville, Texas, Stephenville HS

Gregory scored the game-winning goal in Angelo State's 1-0 overtime win over Incarnate Word in the final game of the regular season last Friday. Gregory's goal was her second of the season and secured the Rambelles the third seed in the conference tournament.

WOMEN'S DEFENSIVE

Dani Edwards, Angelo State University, SR, San Angelo, Texas, Lake View HS

Edwards recorded her seventh shutout of the season in helping lead the Angelo State Rambelles to a 1-0 overtime win over Incarnate Word last Friday. Edwards had seven saves against the Cardinals to help solidify ASU as the third seed in the conference tournament. Edwards now has 72 saves this season and leads the LSC in saves percentage.

MEN'S OTHER TOP PERFORMERS

Alex de la Garza, University of the Incarnate Word, scored the game-tying goal against Midwestern State with 1:20 remaining in the regulation. His goal allowed the #9 Cardinals to maintain a 12 match unbeaten streak with a 1-1 tie. He also led the team with four shots in the game.

James Nero, University of the Incarnate Word, nearly headed in the game-winning goal against Midwestern State in the first overtime, but his shot was saved at the last moment. On defense, he helped limit the visiting Mustangs to a total of nine shots in 110 minutes.

LSC MEN'S SOCCER NOTES (Submitted by LSC SID's)**Eastern New Mexico**

The Greyhounds registered their second-ever road win over West Texas A&M, charging to a 2-0 lead on first-half goals from Eishu Kanemitsu and Cantu Palombo. Fredrik Widfeldt turned in a strong game in net, holding the ENMU lead, as the Buffaloes outshot the Hounds by a 10-0 margin in the second half. With the win, Widfeldt has tied the ENMU single-season record, set last season by Matt Malak. This weekend, the Greyhounds will close the 2012 season at Midwestern State and Incarnate Word.

Incarnate Word

The #9 Cardinals had their 11-match winning streak snapped by Midwestern State on Friday, but maintained a 12-match unbeaten streak when they pulled out a 1-1 tie. MSU scored in the 60th minute and the Cardinals had a number of chances to score, including a penalty kick that was saved. However, they finally broke through when Alex de la Garza took one touch on a ball that had been cleared out of the box off a corner kick and blasted it into the top corner to tie the game with 1:20 left in regulation. The Cardinals were ranked #2 in the NCAA South Central Regional rankings last week and are awaiting this week's rankings. The team travels to St. Edward's on Wednesday before returning home on Friday against Eastern New Mexico and Sunday against St. Mary's to close out the regular season.

Midwestern State

Midwestern State settled for its program record fifth draw of the campaign knotting No. 7 Incarnate Word 1-1 Friday night in San Antonio... The Mustangs snapped UIW's 11-match winning streak with the draw... MSU has yet trail in regulation play this season as it has settled for two scoreless ties and held leads in draws against Northeastern State (2-2), Eastern New Mexico (1-1) and Incarnate Word (1-1)... The Mustangs also held leads in its only losses against Incarnate Word and West Texas A&M before surrendering equalizing and golden goals to take negative results in overtime... MSU is 1-2-4 in seven overtime performances this season... MSU has allowed goals in seven consecutive matches which is the longest stretch without a shutout since the 2005 squad let in goals in 11 consecutive matches from Sep. 2-Oct. 16... MSU's five draws this season are the most in program history upping the previous high of four set in 2002... Sophomore forward Len Smith gave the Mustangs a 1-0 lead with a goal in the 60th minute Friday night at Incarnate Word. Smith has tallied each of MSU's three goals against the Cardinals this season... Smith ranks third in the Lone Star Conference and leads MSU with nine goals this season... Junior forward VcMor Eligwe rates fourth in the LSC with seven goals... Sophomore midfielder Andrew Power boasts the second most assists in the LSC with six... Junior goalkeeper Ray Clark tops the LSC in goals against average (0.90), saves (42), saves per game (3.82) and is second with four shutouts... Midwestern needs two wins to post 10 wins for the 14th consecutive season...

West Texas A&M

A time span of 3:34 in the first half put the Buffaloes' NCAA Tournament chances in doubt as ENMU upset the 18th-ranked Buffaloes 2-1 on Friday...WT outshot the Greyhounds 14-4 and 7-2 in shots on goal, but two of the four shots by ENMU went in...WT outshot the Greyhounds 10-0 in the second half...Senior Abel Olivas scored his third goal of the season early in the second half on an assist from senior Dominic Furness, but the Buffs had to play the final 34:39 of the match down a man...Furness tallied his seventh assist of the season pulling even on the team with Olivas.

WOMEN'S OTHER TOP PERFORMERS

Erin Bolinger, Texas Woman's University, scored the only goal of the game to lead the Pioneers to a 1-0 win over visiting Texas A&M-Commerce in the final regular season game of 2012. She fired a point blank shot into the net after finding a rebound just inside the 18-yard box for her first collegiate goal.

Lindsay McHorse, West Texas A&M University, had the lone goal just 3:18 into the 1-0 win at Eastern New Mexico on Friday. With the win, the Lady Buffs clinched their sixth Lone Star Conference championship outright as ASU beat UIW in overtime. It was McHorse's second goal of the season, second game winner and the 35th of her career as she has 35 goals for her career, 16 assists and 88 points. She ranks third all-time in school history in points, third in goals and sixth in assists.

Lindsey Sisco, Texas Woman's University, made two saves in the Pioneer net for her fourth shutout of the season in a 1-0 win over Texas A&M-Commerce in the final regular season game. Both of Sisco's saves came in the second half in the 53rd and 56th minutes. On the season she is 7-8-1 with 1.49 GAA and has 54 saves.

Yvette Bedoy, West Texas A&M University, played all 90 minutes at WT clinched the Lone Star Conference regular season championship with a 1-0 win at Eastern New Mexico on Friday. She tallied her sixth shutout of the season and improved to 10-5-1 on the year. She had two saves in the match giving her a career, season-high 95 for the season which is tops in the conference. Her 180 career saves ranks her fourth in school history.

Xan Ortiz, Eastern New Mexico University, made five saves, to keep the Zias within one goal of Lone Star Conference champions West Texas A&M, in the season finale. As a freshman, she earned five wins, this season.

Eastern New Mexico

The Eastern New Mexico University women's soccer team concluded its 2012 season, with a 1-0 setback against West Texas A&M. The Zias generated a few strong scoring opportunities, including a near breakaway by leading goal-scorer, Danielle Thurman. Xan Ortiz notched a strong performance in net, keeping the game close, with five saves. Ortiz concluded her first season as a Zia with five wins, while Danielle Thurman finished her career with six goals for the season.

Incarnate Word

The Cardinals had a chance to secure the top seed in the Lone Star Conference with a win over Angelo State last Saturday, but were unable to pull it off. The Belles scored six minutes into overtime for a 1-0 win. The Cardinals had many chances to score throughout the match with 15 shots, including seven on goal. They head to the LSC Tournament as the #2 seed with a first round bye after missing the tournament last year. They will play the winner of the Texas Woman's-Angelo State match on Saturday. The team is seeking its first LSC title.

Midwestern State

Midwestern State closed the regular season at 6-9-3 overall... The Mustangs will make their 17th appearance in the Lone Star Conference Postseason Tournament Thursday afternoon when they open against Abilene Christian in Canyon... MSU is the only team to appear in every LSC Postseason Tournament since its inception in 1996... The Mustangs have posted a 15-13-1 mark (.534) in 16 tournament appearance claiming LSC titles in 1996, 1998 and 2012... MSU is 5-1-1 in quarterfinal round play with its lone loss coming by a 1-0 count to West Texas A&M in 2007... Midwestern and Abilene Christian will meet in tournament play for the fourth consecutive season. The Mustangs claimed a 2-1 win in the 2009 quarterfinals as the teams advanced to the championship rounds in each of the last two seasons. ACU defeated the Mustangs 2-0 in the 2010 finals at Wichita Falls before MSU retaliated with a 2-1 victory over the Wildcats last season in Abilene... MSU is 7-8 (.467) in semifinal round play and is 3-4 (.429) in seven title game appearances... The Mustangs against the field in LSC Postseason Tournament play: vs. West Texas A&M (5-3), vs. Incarnate Word (0-0), vs. Angelo State (2-0-1), vs. Abilene Christian (2-1), vs. Texas Woman's (0-0)... MSU senior defender Hanna Staley, junior midfielder Mickey Brown and sophomore forward Payton Fookes have each tallied a goal each in the LSC Postseason Tournament...

She fired a point blank shot into the net after finding a rebound just inside the 18-yard box for her first collegiate goal. Sophomore Lindsey Sisco made two saves in the Pioneer net for her fourth shutout of the season. Senior Brittany Martin leads the team with 23 points and 10 goals. She set

a new single-season record for points and goals this season. Senior Katy Black is the leader in assists with five. She also set a new single-season record for assist and is the career leader at TWU with eight assists. Sophomore Lindsey Sisco has started in 17 games in the net and has a 1.49 GAA and 54 saves.

West Texas A&M

With a 1-0 win at Eastern New Mexico and a loss by Incarnate Word on Friday, the Lady Buffs clinched the Lone Star Conference regular season championship Friday...Marks the fifth regular season conference title for the Lady Buffs and the first since 2008...Will host the 2012 LSC Tournament next week in Canyon...
