# We're the One.

A majority of Lone Star Conference basketball teams played last week, with nine squads still undefeated early in the 2012-13 season.

The LSC men have a 9-4 overall record so far this season. In the NCAA South Central Region, the men's teams are currently 3-3 combined versus Heartland Conference teams and 0-0 opposed to the Rocky Mountain Athletic Conference.

The LSC women are 5-6 overall. The women's squads are currently 3-2 combined versus RMAC teams, and 1-0 against the Heartland, which are the other conferences in the NCAA South Central Region.

#### **PLAYERS OF THE WEEK**

#### MEN'S OFFENSIVE

Dionelle Rucker, University of the Incarnate Word, SR, Forward, San Antonio, Texas, New Life Christian Acad. Rucker was named the St. Edward's Shootout MVP after averaging 24.5 points per game and shooting 67.7 percent from the field for the weekend. He poured in a career-high 28 points, grabbed seven rebounds and blocked three shots while connecting on 13-of-17 from the field in an 80-77 win over UT-Permian Basin. He came back with 21 points, six rebounds and four steals in a 84-81 win at St. Edward's.

#### MEN'S DEFENSIVE

#### Ryan Marsh, Angelo State University, JR, Forward, Burleson, Texas, Burleson HS

Marsh blocked six shots, the third most in a single game in Ram program history, and grabbed nine rebounds to lead the Rams to a 71-65 victory over Lubbock Christian. Marsh scored a season high 14 points including eight from the free throw line.

#### **MEN'S OTHER TOP PERFORMERS**

Rodney Blackmon, Eastern New Mexico University, hit 40 percent from the floor and all eight of his free throws, to lead the Greyhounds with 27 points and five assists in the season opener at Texas A&M-International. Corbin Thomas, Midwestern State University, poured in 17 points and pulled down eight rebounds a game leading 22nd-ranked Midwestern State to a pair of wins last weekend at the Southwestern Oklahoma Classic. The 6-6, 220-pound senior forward notched 17 points and seven rebounds including 9-of-12 effort from the charity stripe in a 94-65 season opening win over Louisiana State-Shreverport. The transfer from Missouri State fell just shy of a double-double with 17 points and nine rebounds while playing a key role in helping the Mustangs erase an 8-point deficit to come away with a win Saturday against Southwestern Oklahoma State. Thomas connected on 11-of-17 shots for a solid .647 field goal percentage.

Ryan Marsh, Angelo State University, scored a season high 14 points, including eight from the free throw line, to lead the Rams to a 71-65 victory over Lubbock Christian. Marsh went 3-5 from the floor and 8-13 from the charity stripe. He grabbed nine rebounds in 32 minutes on the court. He blocked six shots which is tied for the third most in a single game in Ram program history.

Donald Sims, West Texas A&M University, wasted no time getting back into the groove this season, averaging 13.5 points per game and seven rebounds as the Buffs went 2-0 at the SWOSU Classic with wins against Southwestern Oklahoma State and LSU-Shreveport. The Chester, South Carolina native went 11-of-17 from the floor to shoot an impressive .647 on the weekend including going 5-of-9 from the free throw line with one assist and three steals. The senior forward tallied six offensive and eight defensive rebounds on the weekend.

Andrew Davis, Texas A&M University - Commerce, played a key role in helping A&M-Commerce to a 1-1 split at the St. Edward's Shootout in Austin this past weekend. Against St. Edward's, Davis finished with 13 points and 11 rebounds, hitting 6-of-8 from the floor with a block and a steal. Against UT-Permian Basin, Davis matched his total with 11 rebounds and 10 points, recording a steal as well. Davis was named to the St. Edward's Shootout

## WOMEN'S OTHER TOP PERFORMERS

Kiara Wright, Tarleton State University, put on a dominating performance by scoring 20 points and grabbing 10 rebounds for her 14th career double-double. The junior center connected on 54 percent of her shots from the floor and was 6-8 from the charity stripe.

In making her first career start, Sadie Dickinson, Abilene Christian University, recorded the first double-double of her collegiate career Saturday, leading ACU to a convincing 94-66 victory over Texas A&M-International at Moody Coliseum. Dickinson's 12 rebounds are a career high, while her 16 points matched a personal best she set last year at Angelo State. She made 6 of 10 shots from the floor Saturday, including 3 of 6 from 3-point range though 31 minutes

Ify Mora, University of the Incarnate Word, was named the St. Edward's Shootout MVP after leading the Cardinals to a 2-0 weekend. They opened the season with a 67-52 win over Tiffin. She had 10 points, five rebounds, five assists and four steals in the game. She came back with 18 points, four boards, five assists and three steals in a 58-47 win over New Mexico Highlands. She connected on 10-of-11 free throws for the week.

Lacee Logan, West Texas A&M University, led the Lady Buffs in scoring at 10.7 points for the week. Was one of three players to play and start all three games. She led the team with 13 field goals made in attempts (.464), while knocking down a team-high five triples. She was third on the team in rebounds with 13 (4.3 avg.), while logging a team-high 93 minutes (31.0 avg.) She had six assists along with one steal and one block.

Hannah Altheide, Eastern New Mexico University, scored eight of her 10 points in the second half of Friday's season-opener at Oklahoma Panhandle. She also recorded three steals.

Kiara Wright, Tarleton State University, put on a defensive showcase for the TexAnns in a season-opening win against Texas Wesleyan. The Rams entered the game with a 2-1 record and shooting nearly 40 percent from the floor. Wright held them to 29 percent shooting from the floor and just 16 points in the paint. She grabbed seven defensive rebounds en route to her 14th career double-double (20 points and 10 rebounds) and recorded three steals and a pair of blocked shots.

Ashlyn Green, University of the Incarnate Word, spearheaded a strong Incarnate Word defensive effort over the weekend at the St. Edward's Shootout. Despite struggling on offense, the guard led the team with three blocks and seven steals in the tourney. She had two blocks and four steals in a 67-52 win over Tiffin.
