### LSC VOLLEYBALL

The last week of the 2012 regular season is here with the top eight Lone Star Conference teams advancing to the LSC Championship set for Nov. 15-17 at the No. 1 seed. Angelo State tops the standings and with one more triumph clinches the No. 1 seed and right to host the championship tournament. The following six teams - ASU, West Texas A&M, Texas Woman's, Tarleton State, Texas A&M-Commerce and Texas A&M-Kingsville have secured a berth in the tournament. The final two spots are up for grabs between Incarnate Word, Abilene Christian and Cameron.

LSC volleyball teams are 165-140 overall this season. The squads are currently 10-17 combined versus Rocky Mountain Athletic Conference teams, and 14-13 against the Heartland Conference, which are the other conferences in the NCAA South Central Region.

### PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

#### OFFENSIVE

**Viktorija Jablonska, Texas Woman's University, SR, Daugavpils, Latvia, Daugavpils 16 Secondary**

Jablonska led the team on offense with 38 kills and 46.5 points in three wins last week. She averaged 3.80 kills per set while posting a .403 hitting percentage. Jablonska also added 14 assists, five service aces, 13 digs and five total blocks. On the season she is a team-leader on offense with 336 kills and 392.0 points.

**Stormi Lancaster, West Texas A&M University, SR, Mobeetie, Texas, Fort Elliott HS**

Lancaster stepped up big this past week as the #10 Lady Buffs went 3-0 with sweeps against Dallas Baptist, Cameron and Midwestern State. The Mobeetie, Texas native registered 33 kills for an average of 3.67 per set to go along with 10 assists, one service ace, and nine block assists on the week. The senior outside also registered 24 digs for an average of 2.67 per set.

#### DEFENSIVE

**Julisa Ocasio, Cameron University, SR, Guaynabo, Puerto Rico**

Ocasio shattered a Cameron University match digs record with 44 against Eastern New Mexico. The previous record was 36 held by Ocasio twice previously this season and the original mark was set in 2003. This came one day after Ocasio crossed the 1,000 Cameron career dig mark against West Texas A&M. Over the last week she recorded 87 digs averaging 8.7 digs per set. Despite missing the first few weeks of the season she has 453 digs and is averaging 6.29 digs per set. Additionally, she is on pace to break both of Cameron's season and career marks in digs per set. So far during the 2012 season she has passed 30 digs in seven matches. Ocasio also had seven assists and four aces.

**Shelby Wilt, Angelo State University, SO, Dalhart, Texas, Dalhart HS**

Wilt helped the Angelo State volleyball team limit Incarnate Word and Texas A&M-Kingsville to a .155 combined hitting percentage in wins for the Belles. Wilt started her weekend with 18 digs against UIW before adding 21 more in a win over TAMUK. Wilt had 5.57 digs per set for the ASU defense.

#### SETTER

**Lacy Hayes, West Texas A&M University, SR, Cypress, Texas, Cy-Fair HS**

Hayes continued to shine as one of the top setters in the South Central Region this past week as the #10 Lady Buffs went 3-0 with sweeps of Dallas Baptist, Cameron and Midwestern State. The senior from Cypress, Texas tallied an impressive 135 assists in nine sets on the week for an average of 15.0 per set. Hayes had an incredible 53 assists on Halloween night as the Lady Buffs rolled Heartland Conference member Dallas Baptist.

**Sarah Fountain, Texas A&M University - Kingsville, SO, Las Cruces, NM, Las Cruces HS**

Fountain had 42 assists in matches against Tarleton and St. Mary's to start the week. She followed that with 40 in four sets against Angelo State. She had double-doubles in the two Lone Star matches with 13 digs against Tarleton and 16 versus Angelo. She added 16 kills on the week with a .326 hitting percentage.

## OTHER TOP PERFORMERS

Dedra Brown, Texas A&M University - Kingsville, led the team with 41 kills in three matches. She responded in a big way in the conference matches with 13 in four sets against Tarleton and 21 against Angelo State as she hit .300 versus the Belles.

Caitlin Wallace, Midwestern State University, averaged 3.67 kills and 1.17 blocks per set while hitting a solid .348 to lead Midwestern State to a split of home matches against Eastern New Mexico and West Texas A&M last weekend at D.L. Ligon Coliseum. The junior middle blocker from Amarillo notched 12 kills with just three errors to hit .450 in Friday's 3-0 win over Eastern New Mexico to go along with six digs and three blocks. Wallace then battled to slam down 10 kills with just three errors to hit .269 against 11th-ranked West Texas A&M.

Lindsey Barron, Eastern New Mexico University, paced the Zias with 3.57 kills per set, at Midwestern State and Cameron. At Cameron, she finished with 16 kills, to reach double figures for the 14th time in 22 matches. Barron also had nine kills against Midwestern State and added a combined 12 digs over the two matches.

Nikki McNorton, Tarleton State University, was the bright spot in the TexAnns rough road trip to Texas A&M-Kingsville and Incarnate Word. The senior from Houston recorded a team-high 23 kills in eight sets and led the team - by far - with a .383 hitting percentage. McNorton also led the team in points (30.0) and total blocks (10, 4 solo). McNorton also chipped in seven digs for the TexAnns.

Emily Booth, Angelo State University, helped lead the Angelo State volleyball to two wins last weekend with 18 kills and six blocks. The senior had 10 kills and a .529 hitting percentage in a win over Incarnate Word before adding another eight kills against Texas A&M-Kingsville. Booth finished the week with a .405 hitting percentage.

Stephanie Bonura, University of the Incarnate Word, was the team's top attacking player against #9 Angelo State and Tarleton State. She had 12 kills and a .391 attack against Angelo State and then came back with nine kills and a .192 attack in a 4-set win over Tarleton State. She averaged 3.0 kills and posted a .286 attack for the week.

Emily Klein, Tarleton State University, made her mark in the games and in the Tarleton volleyball record books last week for the TexAnns. The junior libero led the team with 48 digs in eight sets, which allowed her to pass Shea McBrearty on Tarleton's all-time single-season digs list.

Lauren Beville, West Texas A&M University, continued to move up the ranks of the top liberos in West Texas A&M history this past week as she registered 46 digs for an average of 5.11 per set. The defending LSC Defensive Player of the Week tallied 46 digs on the week to move her career total to 2,233 which pushes the Hereford native to 15 digs shy of Sara Contreras (2,248) for the all-time lead in WT history.

Morgan Wilson, Texas Woman's University, led the team on defense with 50 digs in the three wins last week. She posted a game-high 14 against Texas A&M-Commerce on Tuesday and then added a team-best 19 against St. Edward's and 17 against Abilene Christian. On the season Wilson has 391 digs and 4.25 digs per set.

Hayley Couch, Eastern New Mexico University, averaged an impressive 5.0 digs per set in road matches at Midwestern State and Cameron. She also registered a .963 reception percentage, with just two errors. Couch turned in a 28-dig performance at Cameron after posting a perfect reception percentage in 22 chances at Midwestern State. For the season, she has reached double-digits in digs in 23 of 26 matches.

Kelsey Washington, Texas A&M University - Kingsville, had a solid all-around week and was huge in the Javelinas 3-1 win over Tarleton State. Washington had 10 kills, 21 digs and three blocks versus the TexAnns. For the week she had double-digit digs in the team's three matches. She had 10 in a non-conference sweep of St. Mary's and added 14 in four-sets against Angelo State. The sophomore finished the week with 2.55 kills a set and an impressive 4.09 digs per set from her outside hitter position.

Lydia Werchan, University of the Incarnate Word, was strong on the back line for the Cardinals in a 1-1 week. She led the team with 15 digs in a three set loss to #9 Angelo State. She came back and led the team with 19 digs and added five assists and a kill in a four set win over Tarleton State. She averaged 4.9 digs per set for the week.

Alex Woolsey, Angelo State University, is only three assists away from becoming the all-time leader in Angelo State history after adding another 93 assists to her stellar career last week in wins over Incarnate Word and Texas A&M-Kingsville. The senior had 41 assists on Friday in a win over UIW and then added 52 against TAMUK. She averaged 13.29 assists per set in the matches and helped ASU to a .262 team hitting percentage. Woolsey enters the final week of the regular season with 1,093 assists on the season and 4,784 in her career.

Danielle Barker, Tarleton State University, continued her dominance as the primary setter for the TexAnns. The junior from Amarillo recorded 82 assists over the last eight sets, giving her 10.2 assists per set. She also recorded double-doubles in both of Tarleton's games last week. Barker recorded 38 assists and 11 digs at Texas A&M-Kingsville and 44 assists and 13 digs at Incarnate Word. Her 82 assists also gave her 1,003 for the season making her the fifth TexAnn all-time to record 1,000 assists in a single season.

Kennedi Catano, Eastern New Mexico University, dished out 51 assists in matches at Midwestern State and Cameron, last week. She had 13 against MSU and followed with her 11th double double of the season, with 38 assists and 18 digs at Cameron.

Kayla Rivero, Texas Woman's University, posted 73 assists in the three wins last week for TWU. She averaged 7.30 assists per set while guiding the Pioneers to a .291 hitting percentage. Rivero had 20 against Texas A&M-Commerce and then added 32 against St. Edward's and 21 against Abilene Christian. On the season she leads the team with 654 assists in a 6-2 offense.

Danielle Suarez, University of the Incarnate Word, had a great week for the Cardinals dishing out at least 20 assists in both matches. She had 20 assists and three digs in a three set loss to #9 Angelo State. She came back with 22 assists, 10 digs and two aces in a four set win over Tarleton State. She averaged 6.0 assists out of a 6-2 formation.

### Angelo State

The Angelo State Belles extended their season-long winning streak to 11 matches with a pair of road wins over Incarnate Word and Texas A&M-Kingsville last weekend. The Belles are now 17-1 in Lone Star Conference play going into the final weekend where they'll play at Texas A&M-Commerce and Texas Woman's. ASU, which also improved to 24-3 overall with last week's wins, had a team hitting percentage of .262 against UIW and TAMUK while limiting those opponents to a .155 percentage. Shelbi Goode and Maddie Huth racked up 28 and 25 kills, respectively, while Alex Woolsey had 93 assists and Shelby Wilt 39 digs in the two matches. Kaelen Valdez added 32 digs and 15 kills for the Belles who enter the final week of the season needing only one win to claim their first LSC title since 1992.

### Cameron

Cameron went 2-1 over the last week beating Southeastern Oklahoma in straight sets on Tuesday night and defeating Eastern New Mexico, 3-1 on Saturday afternoon. The Aggies were swept by #11 West Texas A&M on Friday night. The win over Eastern New Mexico snapped 15 straight set losing streak in conference play and ended a four match losing streak. The Aggies top performer was on the defensive end with Julisa Ocasio earning 87 digs over 11 sets during the last week, averaging 8.7 per set. She also broke 1,000 career digs at Cameron against West Texas A&M and shattered a single match digs record at Cameron with 44 vs. Eastern New Mexico. The previous record was 36 set by Ocasio twice this season with the original record being set in 2003. Offensively, freshman Kat Evans had 32 kills on 110 attempts, hitting .218 for the week. Evans had 14 kills against Southeastern Oklahoma and Eastern New Mexico bringing her season total up to 407 kills. She is averaging 3.63 kills per set. Cameron has two matches remaining on their schedule traveling to nearby Midwestern State on Tuesday and hosting Abilene Christian on Friday night.

### Eastern New Mexico

The Zia volleyball team concluded its final road trip of the season, but had setbacks at both Midwestern State and Cameron over the weekend. Lindsey Barron registered 3.57 kills per set, over the two matches, while Macy Mitchell finished with a team-best .294 attack percentage. Hayley Couch and Dallas Russell combined for 55 digs. This week, Eastern will close the season, with a three match home stand, against West Texas A&M, Incarnate Word and Texas A&M-Kingsville.

### Incarnate Word

The Cardinals went 1-1 during the week. They lost to #9 Angelo State 25-19, 31-29, 25-11 on Friday, but came back with a 25-20, 16-25, 25-21, 25-21 win over Tarleton State on Saturday. They have a key matchup with Texas A&M-Kingsville on Tuesday. Danielle Suarez had a great week for the Cardinals dishing out at least 20 assists in both matches. She had 20 assists and three digs in a three set loss to #9 Angelo State. She came back with 22 assists, 10 digs and two aces in a four set win over Tarleton State. She averaged 6.0 assists out of a 6-2 formation. Stephanie Bonura was the team's top attacking player against #9 Angelo State and Tarleton State. She had 12 kills and a .391 attack against Angelo State and then came back with nine kills and a .192 attack in a 4-set win over Tarleton State. ### Midwestern State

Midwestern State split a pair of home matches as the swept Eastern New Mexico on Friday before falling 3-0 to No. 11-ranked West Texas A&M on Saturday to go to 6-22 on the season and 4-14 in Lone Star Conference... The Mustangs are officially eliminated from LSC Postseason Tournament consideration and will miss the postseason for the first time since 2006... MSU has qualified for the LSC postseason tournament six times in Venera Flores-Stafford's nine seasons at the helm of the program after failing to advance to the tournament in its first eight seasons of LSC play... The Mustangs claimed their second sweep of the season in Friday's win over Eastern New Mexico and are 2-14 in three-set matches this season... Senior outside hitter Shelbi Stewart became the seventh player in program history to amass, 1,000 kills on her first kill Saturday against West Texas A&M. Stewart ranks fifth on MSU's all-time kills list with 1,010 and needs four to pass Joni Martin, who had 1,013 from 2000-03... Junior middle blocker Michelle Blount notched her third double figure match of the season with 10 kills to go along with five blocks Friday against Eastern New Mexico... Junior middle blocker Caitlin Wallace tallied 12 kills against Eastern New Mexico then had 10 more against West Texas A&M for her 11th and 12th 10-plus kill performances of the season... Senior outside hitter Shelbi Stewart put down 11 kills with just one error to hit .343 Saturday against West Texas A&M... Stewart notched her fifth double-double of the season against the Lady Buffs with 11 kills and 10 digs... Junior outside hitter/setter Courtney Haney has double-doubles in five of her last six outings... Junior middle blocker Caitlin Wallace ranks 13th in the LSC with a .247 attack percentage while teammate Shelbi Stewart is 17th at .232... Stewart jumped to 17th in the LSC with 2.67 kills per set and 20th with 2.97 points per set... Sophomore setter Kristan Aduddell rates fourth in the LSC with 0.31 service aces per set and is 10th with 5.88 set assists per set... Sophomore libero Casey Fletcher ranks ninth in the Lone Star Conference with 3.95 digs per set...

### Tarleton State

Tarleton dropped a pair of road games last week to Texas A&M-Kingsville and Incarnate Word. TexAnn juniors Emily Klein and Danielle did, however, found some personal success. Klein became the all-time, single-season digs leader while Barker became just the fifth TexAnn all-time to record 1,000 assists in a season.

### Texas A&M-Kingsville

The Javelinas went 2-1 a week ago with a non-conference win over St. Mary's for its Dig Pink game and a win over Tarleton on Friday night. The dropped a tight match with conference leader Angelo State on Saturday on Senior Day...In the win over St. Mary's the Javelina middle blockers had a stellar game. Sophomore Stephanie Johns had a team-high 13 kills for a season best, and Bethany Friesenhahn had 10 kills. The two middles combined for 23 of 52 kills for the javelinas...Sarah Fountain had 42 assists in the

three-set win over St. Mary's which is a personal best...Kelsey Washington had a season-best 21 digs in Friday night's 3-1 win over Tarleton State. She added 10 kills for a double-double and had three blocks. She was joined in the 20-dig club in the match by Kalinda Graves...Graves had another stellar week recording 54 digs in 11 sets for 4.91 digs per set average. After just 13 against St. Mary's she had 20 versus Tarleton and 21 against ASU...Saturday's match was the final home game of the season for A&M-Kingsville. The Javelinas finished with an 11-4 record at home on the season. It was the final home game for Lakeshia Craft, Cady Mercer, Ali Insell and Kalinda Graves...With 15 wins, the team has matched their total of 15 from season ago in the debut season for head coach Tanya Allen. The team last won more than 15 in 2009 with they had 17 victories. Since 2001, the 2002 season is the only other season with ore than 15 wins which was accomplished in 2002 when the team won 16.

### Texas Woman's

The Pioneers won all three games last week to extend their win streak to six games while improving their record to 21-6 on the season and 14-4 in the Lone Star Conference. TWU won 20 games in a season for the first time since 2008 season when the Pioneers posted a 20-13 record. The 14 conference wins ties the school record for the most LSC wins in a season. The 1996 Pioneer volleyball squad posted a 14-4 record in LSC play. Senior Viktorija Jablonska leads the Pioneers on offense with 336 kills and 392.0 points. She also has a team-best 22 service aces. TWU will close out the regular season at home with a weekend series against Tarleton State and Angelo State.

### West Texas A&M

The #10 Lady Buffs went 3-0 this past week with sweeps of Dallas Baptist, Cameron and Midwestern State to move their overall record to 24-4 with a 14-3 mark in the Lone Star Conference. Defending LSC Defensive Player of the Week Lauren Beville tallied 146 digs on the week to move her career total to 2,233 which pushes the Hereford native to 15 digs shy of Sara Contreras (2,248) for the all-time lead in WT history.
