### LSC SOCCER

The 2012 NCAA Division II Soccer Championship field includes a pair of Lone Star Conference teams with Incarnate Word on the men's side and West Texas A&M qualifying for the women's event.

The Cardinals are the third seed and play at No. 2 Colorado Mines Saturday at 2 p.m. UIW and Mines played earlier this season, with the Orediggers earning a 3-2 win on a goal in the final 30 seconds. UIW is making its eighth all-time NCAA postseason appearance in the last 11 years, with a regional title in 2004. The winner advances to play top seed Regis on a date to be determined at the top remaining seed from the West Region.

On the women's side, WT earned the LSC tournament title over Incarnate Word with a 3-2 double-overtime triumph in the final of the league's women's soccer championship at the Pitch in Canyon, Texas. The Lady Buffs avenged two regular season losses to the Cardinals to earn the league's automatic qualification to the NCAA Regional Tournament.

WT, the sixth-seed, was selected for its ninth appearance in the NCAA postseason and travels to Austin, Texas, to face No. 3 Metro State Friday at 2 p.m. The victor advances to play the No. 2 St. Edward's Sunday at 2 p.m. The Lady Buffs last showing in the NCAA regional was in 2009, when they reached the Elite Eight.

The other side of the South Central bracket is at top-seed Dallas Baptist, with the Patriots facing the winner of No. 4 Colorado Mines and No. 5 Regis.

LSC men's soccer teams are 44-16-9 overall this season. The squads are currently 5-3-1 combined versus Rocky Mountain Athletic Conference teams, and 11-3-1 against the Heartland Conference, which are the other conferences in the NCAA South Central Region.

The women's teams are 65-76-10 overall this season. The squads are currently 2-9-1 combined versus Rocky Mountain Athletic Conference teams, and 2-4 against the Heartland Conference, which are the other conferences in the NCAA South Central Region.

### PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

#### MEN'S OFFENSIVE

**Vincent Bailey, University of the Incarnate Word, JR, Midfielder, Southport, England, Savio**

Bailey led the Cardinals in scoring last week. He scored the game-winning goal in the 79th minute against Eastern New Mexico on Friday. Clark made five saves to complete his fifth clean sheet of the season to help Midwestern State to a 1-0 win over rival West Texas A&M Friday night at the MSU Soccer Field. The junior from Norman then posted 45 scoreless minutes against Eastern New Mexico to lower his LSC leading goals against average to 0.80.

### MEN'S OTHER TOP PERFORMERS

**Idi Camara, Midwestern State University**, spun a free kick just inside the far post with just a second to spare in the first overtime to lift Midwestern State to a 1-0 win over rival West Texas A&M Friday night at the MSU Soccer Field. It was the freshman from Denver's first collegiate tally resulting when a WT defender took down teammate Bryan Santiago just outside of the box with 15 seconds to play.

**Eishu Kanemitsu, Eastern New Mexico University**, tallied his career-best sixth goal of the season on Sunday at Midwestern State. The goal came midway through the opening half and pulled the Hounds even with the Mustangs.

### Midwestern State

Midwestern State closed the season with home victories over West Texas A&M and Eastern New Mexico last weekend at the MSU Soccer Field to close the season at 10-2-5 and 2-2-2... The Mustangs missed the NCAA Division II playoffs for the first time since 2006 when the postseason field was announced Monday night... MSU received votes in the final regular season National Soccer Coaches' Association of America Division II Poll... MSU posted a 5-0-1 home mark since having its 45-match unbeaten streak at the MSU Soccer Field snapped by Incarnate Word on Sep. 21. The Mustangs are 48-1-4 on their home pitch since the start of the 2008 season... Senior forward David Freeland tallied his second goal of the season to help MSU to a 3-1 win over Eastern New Mexico Sunday at the MSU Soccer Field. Freeland ends his career with 20 goals and 10 assists to join MSU's 50-Point Club.... Freshman Idi Camara scored his first collegiate goal on a free kick in the final seconds of the first overtime to lift MSU past rival West Texas A&M 1-0 Friday night in Wichita Falls... Sophomore forward Len Smith tallied his team-leading 10th goal of the season Sunday against Eastern New Mexico... Junior defender Isaac Pile's nice move off of the touch line on the right wing resulted in his first goal as a Mustang in the 30th minute Sunday against Eastern New Mexico... Junior goalkeeper Ray Clark made five saves to claim his fifth shutout of the season in Friday's 1-0 result over West Texas A&M... Sophomore forward Len Smith ranked third in the Lone Star Conference with 0.59 goals and 1.29 points per game... Junior forward VcMor Eligwe was fourth with 0.41 goals and 1.06 points per game... Sophomore midfielder Andrew Power amassed the fourth most assists in the LSC with six while teammates Aaron Douthit and VcMor Eligwe had four each... Junior goalkeeper Ray Clark led the LSC with a 0.80 goals against average, topped the league with 3.62 saves a contest and was second with five clean sheets...

### West Texas A&M

Finished the season with a heartbreaking 1-0 loss to Midwestern State in overtime for just the second shutout loss of the season...Finished 11-4-2 on the year and 2-4 in the Lone Star Conference...The 11 wins is the most since 2010 with an 11-6-1 record...Senior Dominic Furness dominated the conference statistics and ranked highly in national statistics, too...He is fourth in goals with 18, fourth in points with 43 and tied for 38th in assists with seven...Furness is third in points per game at 2.53 per contest, third in goals per game a 1.06 and 44th in assists per game at 0.41...As a team, the Buffs has the 11th-best scoring offense at 2.65 goals per game...Their 45 goals ranked 21st nationally and their 45 assists are fifth-best along with the 135 points which is 11th-best nationally...Senior Abel Olivas and sophomore Daniel Angloher were named Capital One/CoSIDA First Team All-Academic District 6 and will move on to the national ballot...Olivas tied with Furness for the lead-league in assists with seven and ranked tied for 38th nationally in assists and 28th nationally in assists per game at 0.47.
