LSC BASKETBALL

The holiday break is here, which means seven consecutive days off for Lone Star Conference teams due to the NCAA Division II life in the Balance Initiative. Games resume on Dec. 29 with non-conference and league action through the New Year.

In league play, two men's squads - Midwestern State and Texas A&M-Commerce - and two women's teams - Incarnate Word and Tarleton State - remain undefeated.

The LSC men have a 58-42 overall record so far this season. In the NCAA South Central Region, the men's teams are currently 13-14 combined versus Heartland Conference teams and 3-1 opposed to the Rocky Mountain Athletic Conference.

The LSC women are 48-56 overall. The women's squads are currently 15-11 combined versus Heartland teams, and 5-1 against the RMAC, which are the other conferences in the NCAA South Central Region.

The LSC champion will be the regular season winner determined by conference games, while the postseason tournament winner is designated as LSC Tournament Champion and earns the league's automatic berth into the NCAA Championship. The top eight teams in the final conference standings qualify for the postseason tournament set for March 6-9 in Allen, Texas.

PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

MEN'S OFFENSIVE

Craig Foster, Cameron University, JR, Guard, Lawton, Okla., Lawton HS

Foster led the Aggies was a key contributor in the Aggies three games this week. Against Eastern New Mexico, he was one assist shy of getting a double-double with 12 points and nine assists. Foster was a major factor in the Aggies 17 point comeback against Florida Tech, where he shot an amazing 58.3 percent from the field, on his way to a 21 point game. In the game against Rollins College, he led the Cameron back from a 28 point deficit to get the game to within seven late in the second half. Foster had his career high in points against Rollins with 26, along with five assists and three rebounds. Foster averaged 20.7 points this week with a 50 percent shooting percentage. He was 37.5 percent from behind the arc and 80 percent from the free throw line.

MEN'S DEFENSIVE

Denzel Livingston, University of the Incarnate Word, SO, Guard, Houston, Texas, Waltrip HS

Livingston was outstanding in the Cardinals' 80-59 win over Texas A&M-International. He scored a season high 21 points on 8-of-12 shooting from the floor. He grabbed eight defensive rebounds, dished out four assists, blocked five shots and had three steals in his best all-around game of the season. He scored 15 points in the second half when the Cardinals outscored the Dustdevils, 45-29. He was a key reason why TAMU shot just 33.3 percent from the field.

WOMEN'S OFFENSIVE

Ashlyn Green, University of the Incarnate Word, SR, Guard, Irving, Texas, Irving HS

Green came off the bench to lead the Cardinals to an important 59-52 LSC win on the road at Texas Woman's. The win improved the Cardinals to 3-0 in conference play. She poured in 20 points and grabbed eight rebounds. She scored the final six points of the game to prevent a TWU comeback. She connected on 8-of-10 from the foul line, including four straight in the final 29 seconds.

WOMEN'S DEFENSIVE

Haylee Oliver, Angelo State University, SO, Forward, San Saba, Texas, San Saba HS

Oliver recorded her fourth consecutive double-double of the season in a 80-66 win over Texas A&M-International. The sophomore led all scorers with 22 points and hit four 3-pointers. All 10 rebounds for Oliver came on the defensive end. The Belles held the Dustdevils to 33.3-percent shooting (25-75) on the night. She added two assists and one steal to move the Belles to 6-4 on the season.

MEN'S OTHER TOP PERFORMERS

Eric Lawton, Abilene Christian University, registered a pair of single-game career scoring highs during ACU's 1-1 weekend at the Rollins Las Vegas Classic. The senior guard first dropped 25 points on 8 of 10 shooting in a four-point loss to the Tars and then dropped in 29 on Florida Tech on 11 of 16 shooting. Lawton also was efficient from 3-point range in burying 8 of 12 (.667) attempts and dished out five assists to finish the weekend with nine. ACU beat Florida Tech, 82-72, to snap a season-worst four-game losing streak.

He grabbed eight rebounds, dished out four assists, blocked five shots and had three steals in his best all-around game of the season. He scored 15 points in the second half when the Cardinals outscored the Dustdevils, 45-29.

Corbin Thomas, Midwestern State University, was a beast on the offensive boards while averaging 19 points and 9.0 rebounds as Midwestern State split a pair of non-conference games last week. The senior transfer from Missouri State pulled down 15 offensive rebounds while shooting 54.2 percent from the field to take control of the paint. Thomas notched a season-high 20 points and completed his third double-double of the season with 13 rebounds -- 10 offensive -- to go along with three blocks and a steal in MSU's 75-73 double overtime loss to Arkansas Tech on Saturday. The 6-6 forward notched a game high 18 points with five rebounds -- all offensive -- in 23 minutes Monday to help the Mustangs to an 81-73 win over Mid-America Christian.

De'Andre Upchurch, Tarleton State University, gave the Texans a spark off the bench, scoring a career-high 17 points and playing just 26 minutes in a reserve role. He helped lead the Texans to a 64-53 win over Henderson State, going 6-for-12 from the field and draining five shots from downtown. The Flint, Mich., native pulled down a career-high five rebounds as well and had a pair of steals in the contest.

Rodney Blackmon, Eastern New Mexico University, averaged 17 points and 3.67 games over three games, which included NCAA Division I opponents, Cal Poly and Brigham Young. At Cal Poly, he shot 50 percent from the floor to finish with 22 points and four assists. He followed with a 14-point performance at BYU with a .667 shooting percentage outside the three-point line and six assists.

Stefon Carson, Texas A&M University - Commerce, played a huge role in helping A&M-Commerce to a 2-1 mark on the road this past week, averaging 16.7 points and 4.7 rebounds while shooting 51.5% from the floor, 58.3% from the three-point arc and 90.0% from the free throw line ... In the 92-62 win at Dallas Baptist, Carson had a then-career-high 18 points, hitting 7-of-12 shots and 2-of-4 from three point range with 3 rebounds and 3 steals, helping coach Walker reach his 200th career win ... Carson had 6 points and 7 rebounds in the overtime loss at Ouachita Baptist, but then exploded in the 96-88 win at Southern Arkansas, recording a career-high 26 points while hitting 5-of-7 three pointers and 8-of-12 shots from the floor ... He had four rebounds, five assists and a pair of steals and was 5-of-6 at the free throw line, hitting four key ones down the stretch to preserve the win.

Kevin Grayer's, Midwestern State University, all-around efforts played a big role for Midwestern State who split a pair of non-conference games last week at D.L. Ligon Coliseum. The 6-3 senior guard from Tallahassee, Fla. averaged 14.5 points, 8.0 rebounds, 4.5 assists, 3.5 steals and 1.0 blocks in 32 minutes a game. Grayer played a key role in helping the Mustangs overcome a 16-point deficit to force Arkansas Tech to double-overtime Saturday amassing four steals and two blocks while scoring 14 of his 15 points in the second half. He then notched his first double-double of the season with 14 points and 12 rebounds -- seven defensive -- to go along with six assists in MSU's 81-73 win over Mid-America Christian on Monday.

Davene Carter, Tarleton State University, helped the Texans limit Henderson State's offense to just 53 points en route to an 11-point win over the Reddies on Tuesday. HSU came into the game averaging more than 78 points a game, but Carter and the Texans held the Reddies to just a 27.1 shooting percentage. HSU came into the game shooting 46.4 percent from the field. Carter recorded a team-high six rebounds and tallied a career-high two blocks in the contest as well.

Rafael Love, Eastern New Mexico University, continued to lead the Greyhound defense in a week which saw Eastern play two NCAA Division I opponents and a Cameron team which was undefeated at home. For the week, he grabbed four steals and eight defensive rebounds. At California Polytechnic State, he poured in 12 points and had three steals.

Abilene Christian

The Wildcats remain at .500 (5-5) after splitting a weekend series in Las Vegas. ACU dropped a 65-61 decision to Rollins and topped Florida Tech, 82-72. ACU shot 47.2 percent from the floor (50-106) and 42.1 percent from 3-point range (.421), led by senior guard Eric Lawton who averaged 27.0 ppg. Lawton scored 25 vs. Rollins and a career-high 29 in the win against Florida Tech, finishing with a .731 (19-26) field-goal percentage. He also dished out nine assists and made 8 of 12 treys. Senior center Steven Werner paced the defense with four blocks, nine rebounds and 15.5 ppg.

The Cameron University men's basketball team went 2-1 this week as they won their home game against Eastern New Mexico 66-56, and split their outing in Las Vegas with a win against Florida Tech, 78-70, and a loss to Rollins the next day, 88-76. The Aggies shot 48.2% for the week, going 31.5% from the field and 61.9% from the charity stripe. In the Florida Tech game, the Aggies were down 17 at one point in the first half and overcame that deficit to win by eight. They shot 66.7% in the second half on the way to score 48 points in the half. Craig Foster was Cameron's leading score for the three games point totals of 12, 21, and 26. His 26 points against Rollins was a career high for Foster. He also had nine assists against Eastern New Mexico, four steals against Florida Tech, and five assists against Rollins. CU is now 5-5 and 1-3 in LSC play. Cameron will take a week off from action before the head to El Paso, Texas to take on UTEP in an exhibition game on the 28th of December.

The Greyhounds had a tough road swing, which saw them drop contests at Cameron and against NCAA Division I opponents, California Polytechnic State and Brigham Young. Incarnate Word

The Cardinals won their only game of the week, an 80-59 decision over visiting Texas A&M-International on Wednesday. Denzel Livingston was outstanding as he scored a season high 21 points on 8-of-12 shooting from the floor. He grabbed eight rebounds, dished out four assists, blocked five shots and had three steals in his best all-around game of the season. He scored 15 points in the second half when the Cardinals outscored the Dustdevils, 45-29. Four other Cardinals scored in double figures in the game. The team assisted on 18 of 28 field goals in the game. Freshman Mitchell Badillo led the team with seven assists. Hasani Sumbry had his best game of the season with 10 points and eight rebounds off the bench.

Midwestern State

Midwestern State split a pair of non-conference games to head into the Christmas Break with a 7-3 record... Arkansas Tech snapped MSU's 19-game home court winning streak by defeating the Mustangs 75-73 in double overtime Saturday night at D.L. Ligon Coliseum... The home loss was just the second in the last 62 home games for MSU who posted a 41-game winning streak on its home floors from Nov. 18, 2008 to Feb. 21, 2011... The 19-game home court winning streak was the third longest in school history as Midwestern had won 70 consecutive games under the dome between Jan. 5, 1973 and Jan. 24, 1977... Midwestern State recovered to defeat Mid-America Christian 81-73 on Monday night to claim its 46th consecutive win over a non-D1/D2 opponent and is now 51-2 against said foes since making the jump to NCAA Division II prior to the 1996-97 season... The Mustangs trailed in both games going into the intermission and have trailed at halftime in each of their last seven games... MSU never allowed Mid-America Christian to extend a lead into double digits to end a six-game stretch that the opposition led by 10-or-more points before halftime... Midwestern State has won the battle on the boards in each of its 10 games this season and leads the Lone Star Conference in rebounding margin (+9.5), offensive rebounds (16.9) and offensive rebound percentage (.451)... The offensive board prowess has resulted in 170 second chance points which account for 23 percent of MSU's total scoring output... Senior forward Corbin Thomas paced the Mustangs in scoring in each of their last three games averaging 17.3 points and 9.3 rebounds a game... Senior guard Kevin Grayer notched his first double-double of the season with 14 points, 12 rebounds and six assists in Monday's win over Mid-America Christian... Sophomore guard Derrell Gibbs notched a season-high with 11 points and added five rebounds and three assists Monday against Mid-America Christian... Junior point guard Monzaigo Williams notched double figures in five of his last six games notching 14 points in both games last week against Arkansas Tech and Mid-America Christian... Junior forward Eddie D'Haiti notched as season-high six assists Monday against Mid-America Christian and has accounted for all nine assists this season in the last three games...

Tarleton State

The Texans had a 10-day break between games, but the Tarleton defense came to play in a 64-53 win over Henderson State in Stephenville on Tuesday... Tarleton limited the high-powered Reddie offense to just 53 points and 27.1 percent shooting from the field... HSU came into the game averaging more than 78 points a game and shooting 46.4 percent from the floor... Since allowing its first six opponents

to average more than 62 points a game, the defense has stepped up over the previous three games letting opposing teams score just 53.3 points per contest... DeAndre Upchurch (G, Jr, Flint, Mich.) scored a career-high 17 points in the win and A'Darius Pegues (F, Jr, Louisville, Ky.) added a career-high 12 points on the night... Davene Carter (F, So, Duncanville) and Chuck Guy (G, Jr, Fort Worth) led the team with six rebounds... Three different Texans (Pegues, Carter, Jon Cathey-Macklin [F, Jr, Milwaukee, Wis.]) each had two blocks each in the game.... Guy added a block to give the Texans a season-high seven blocks in the game... The Texans have another 10+ day lay-off with the Christmas break looming... Tarleton will not return to the floor until Saturday, Dec. 29, when the Texans host Ouachita Baptist... Tip-off is set for 7 p.m. in Stephenville.

Texas A&M-Commerce

A&M-Commerce posted a 2-1 mark on the road this past week, routing Dallas Baptist 92-62 on Saturday, followed by an 82-76 overtime loss at Dallas Baptist and a 96-88 win at Southern Arkansas ... In the process, head coach Sam Walker notched his 200th career win (DBU) as well as his 201st career win (SAU), moving into a tie with Jim Gudger as the all-time winningest coach in A&M-Commerce program history ... Against the Patriots, A&M-Commerce dominated the final 30 minutes of the game as Preston Whitley led the way with 22 points, followed by a then-career-high 18 for Stefon Carson and 13 for Kenny Brown ... The Lions then battled Ouachita Baptist, combining for 11 ties and 12 lead changes before dropping a hard-fought 82-76 overtime defeat to the Tigers ... Jason Smith was the hot shooter on the night, finishing with 22 points while Andrew Davis added 9 points and 13 rebounds ... Against the Muleriders, A&M-Commerce put on a three-point clinic, hitting as high as 65% of its three-pointers in the second half and finishing at 53.6% for the game in the 96-88 win at Southern Arkansas ... Carson logged a career-high 26 points, including 5-of-7 from three-point range, with Whitley adding 22 points on 6-of-8 from beyond the arc ... The 9-3 start is the best for A&M-Commerce since starting 9-1 to open the 2009-10 season.

The Buffs were idle this past week as they focused on finals and preparation for their December 29th matchup with Oklahoma Panhandle State at the First United Bank Center in Canyon, Texas.

WOMEN'S OTHER TOP PERFORMERS

Shanae Lowrance, Tarleton State University, poured in a career-high 24 points Tuesday night to lead the TexAnns past Texas-Permian Basin 81-76. The junior forward from Rockwall was an incredible 10-11 shooting from the floor and chipped in four free throws. She also added four rebounds and two assists.

Shatoia Gober, Midwestern State University, paced the No. 25 Mustangs offensively during a 1-1 week, as she scored a career-high 18 points in Midwestern State's 76-61 win over Texas-Permian Basin. She also recorded 10 points in the Mustangs loss to Central Oklahoma. For the week, Gober led MSU with 14.0 scoring average, by shooting 48.0 percent from the floor (12-of-25) and hitting 4-4 from the free throw line. She grabbed 15 rebounds, to average 7.5 for the week and recorded an assists and three steals.

Ashley Viera, Texas A&M University - Kingsville, made her first two starts as a Javelina on the week scoring double figures in both games. She had 10 points on Sunday before netting career-high 15 on Wednesday in Austin.

Whitney West, Abilene Christian University, helped lead ACU to its second-straight undefeated trip to Canyon and the Lady Buff Christmas Classic by averaging 11.5 points per game and dishing out a team-best eight assists in wins over Arkansas-Fort Smith (70-66) and Emporia State (74-67). West came off the bench in both games and finished the Emporia State contest with a career high 14 points on 5 of 6 shooting, and was 3 of 3 from 3-point range. She also provided four assists and pulled down three rebounds. West recorded a career high six rebounds the previous day vs. Arkansas-Ft. Smith. On the season, West is averaging 7.1 points and 2.3 rebounds per game with 18 assists and 8 steals. She is shooting .475 from the floor and .412 from 3-point range. The Wildcats defeated both Shaw and Southwestern Oklahoma at last December's Lady Buff Christmas Classic. ACU has now won five of its last six at WT's First United Bank Center, including last month's regular season win vs. the Lady Buffs.

Taylor Collier, Eastern New Mexico University, finished with a team-high .533 shooting percentage from the field and .833 percent from the free throw line. She also finished second on the team in points (26), points average (6.5) and steals (6). Against California State University- Los Angeles, Collier poured in a season-high 15 points and pulled in six rebounds.

Kaitlyn Lowen, Texas A&M University - Kingsville, continued to be a monster on the board. The senior grabbed 10 boards on Sunday against St. Edwards. She finished two points shy of her fourth double-double of the season. It was the fourth time this season that the guard had double-digit rebounds. She had seven in the rematch of the two teams on Wednesday. She had 15 defensive boards on the week.

Kiara Wright, Tarleton State University, bounced back to dominate the defensive side of the floor in an 81-76 win over Texas-Permian Basin despite playing only four minutes in the first half due to foul trouble. The junior center from Rockwall anchored the defense that held the Falcons to just 48 percent shooting from the floor while posting 7 rebounds, forcing four steals and recording a blocked shot.

Jasmine Johnson, Eastern New Mexico University, had a solid week for the Zias. In the final match of the week, Jasmine led all scorers with 13 points as she led the Zias past BYU-Hawaii to their first win of the season. Johnson also led the team in almost every statistical category, field goals (15), defensive rebounds (14), total rebounds (21), blocks (2), points (32) and average points per game (8).

Abilene Christian

ACU went 2-0 for the second-straight year at the Lady Buff Christmas Classic after beating Arkansas-Fort Smith, 70-66, and Emporia State, 74-67. The Wildcats have now won five of its last six at the First United Bank Center, including last month's regular season win vs. West Texas A&M. The Wildcats' victory against Emporia State was their second in five meetings and first since a 74-64 decision during the 1987-88 season. ACU's Julie Goodenough (295-222) is five wins away from collegiate career coaching win No. 300. The earliest she could reach this milestone is on Jan. 12, 2013 at home vs. Southwest Adventist. The Wildcats this week in Canyon averaged 72 points

per game behind .348 shooting from the floor and were 17 of 57 from 3-point range (.298). They also committed just nine turnovers vs. Emporia State after being forced into 19 the previous day vs. Fort Smith. Renata Marquez led all players in scoring for the second-straight year in Canyon with 13.5 ppg, but ACU also received a huge boost off the bench from freshmen Whitney West and Kynzie Newman. West finished second on the team in scoring (11.5) and posted a career-best 14 points on 5 of 6 shooting vs. the Hornets. Newman, meanwhile, led all Wildcats with 13 rebounds.
