### LSC SOCCER

Lone Star Conference action carries on for both the men and women. Incarnate Word is leading the men's standings after a double-overtime victory over Midwestern State. On the women's side, West Texas A&M has 12 points to top the league, followed by Texas Woman's and Angelo State.

LSC men's soccer teams are 22-7-3 overall this season. The squads are currently 4-3-1 combined versus Rocky Mountain Athletic Conference teams, and 8-2-1 against the Heartland Conference, which are the other conferences in the NCAA South Central Region.

The women's teams are 24-35-4 overall this season. The squads are currently 2-9-1 combined versus Rocky Mountain Athletic Conference teams, and 2-4 against the Heartland Conference, which are the other conferences in the NCAA South Central Region.

### PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

#### MEN'S OFFENSIVE

**Vincent Bailey, University of the Incarnate Word, JR, Mid, Southport, Eng., Savio**

Bailey had a week to remember leading the Cardinals to a pair of victories. He led the team back from a pair of deficits at #13 Midwestern State to lead the team to a 3-2 victory. He tied the game at 2-2 with 1:51 left in regulation and then finished off his hat-trick in the second overtime. It was MSU's first home loss in 45 games. On Sunday, he scored on a penalty kick in a 2-0 win over previously unbeaten Wayland Baptist. He finished with four goals for the week giving him nine on the season.

#### MEN'S DEFENSIVE

**Jarred Kahan, University of the Incarnate Word, JR, Houston, Texas, Clearbrook HS**

Kahan led the Cardinals to a 2-0 week against top competition. First, he made five saves in a 3-2 double overtime victory against #13 Midwestern State. It was the first loss by MSU at home in 45 matches. He came back with his fourth shutout of the season in a 2-0 win at previously unbeaten Wayland Baptist.

#### WOMEN'S OFFENSIVE

**Leslie Briggs, West Texas A&M University, SR, Forward, Carrollton, Texas, Dallas Parish Episcopal**

Briggs led the team with two goals and to a 2-0 record last week with wins at Midwestern State and at Abilene Christian to keep the Lady Buffs atop the Lone Star Conference. Had the game-winner, her first of the season, with 16 seconds remaining in the first overtime (99:44) for a 2-1 win at Midwestern State Friday. It was the first regular season road win at MSU since 2002. She had the game-tying assist in the 74th minute and followed with the first goal and second goal assist on Sunday at Abilene Christian. It was the first road conference weekend sweep for the Lady Buffs since 2009. It also was the first road win in school history at Abilene Christian.

#### WOMEN'S DEFENSIVE

**Yvette Bedoy, West Texas A&M University, JR, Garland, Texas, South Garland HS**

Bedoy paced the Lady Buffs to two huge road wins over the weekend at Midwestern State and at Abilene Christian. Played all 189:44 minutes allowing just two goals for 0.95 goals against average for the week. Had 18 saves, including 10 at Abilene Christian for the second-most in a match for her this season. Bedoy has 134 saves for her career which is fifth-best in school history. It was the first road win at Midwestern State since 2002 and first road win at Abilene Christian in school history. It also was the first road conference regular season sweep since 2009.

### MEN'S OTHER TOP PERFORMERS

**VcMor Eligwe, Midwestern State University**, recorded two goals and two assists to help Midwestern State to a weekend split at the MSU Soccer Field. The junior from McKinney assisted both of teammate Len Smith's tallies in a 3-2 loss Friday night to Incarnate Word before scoring a pair of goals in a 6-0 win over Ouachita Baptist on Sunday afternoon. Eligwe leads the Mustangs with three goals and three assists this season.

**Jose Nieto, Eastern New Mexico University**, tallied his first goal of the season, on Wednesday, against Wayland Baptist.

First, he made five saves in a 3-2 double overtime victory against #13 Midwestern State. He came back with his fourth shutout of the season in a 2-0 win at previously unbeaten Wayland Baptist. The Cardinals only have one game this week. They take on Ouachita Baptist on Friday in a neutral site game being played at Richland College in Dallas.

### Midwestern State

Midwestern State rebounded from a 3-2 overtime loss to Incarnate Word Friday with a 6-0 win over Ouachita Baptist Sunday go improve to 4-1-2 on the season... Incarnate's Word's 3-2 win snapped Midwestern's 45-match unbeaten streak at the MSU Soccer Field which dated back to the 2007 season. The Mustangs' last loss came in a 1-0 decision to West Texas A&M on Nov. 4, 2007. MSU boasted a 41-0-4 record during the run that included 31 shutouts and draws against Sonoma State (11/17/07), West Texas A&M (9/18/09), Texas A&M International (9/25/09) and St. Edward's (10/23/11). MSU boasted winning streaks of 12 and 23 matches during the run that spanned 2,145 days or 5 years and 320 days... Midwestern slipped out of the NSCAA Division II Poll for the first time since Sep. 26, 2006 ending a string of 70 consecutive periods in which was eligible for the poll including 45 weeks in the Top 10 and three weeks at No. 1 in 2008... Sophomore forward Len Smith accounted for each of MSU's two goals in a 3-2 loss to Incarnate Word on Friday. It was first multiple-goal collegiate game as he now has scored three goals this season -- all assisted by junior forward VcMor Eligwe... Junior forward VcMor Eligwe matched career highs in both games last weekend as he notched two assists for the third time in his collegiate career Friday against Incarnate Word before scoring two goals also for the third time in his career... With three goals and three assists through seven matches this season, Eligwe has matched his 2011 season output after recording 11 goals and six assists as a freshman in 2010... Senior forward David Freeland notched his first goal of the season Sunday against Ouachita Baptist while also dishing out two assists. The Midland native upped his career totals to 19 goals and 10 assists... Freshman midfielder Bryan Santiago scored his first collegiate goal in the 11th minute of MSU's 6-0 win over Ouachita Baptist Sunday at the MSU Soccer Field... Redshirt freshman Taylor Brown tallied his first collegiate goal in the 83rd minute Sunday against Ouachita Baptist... Redshirt freshman Kwame Adu-Wusu logged his first two collegiate assists in Sunday's win over Ouachita Baptist... Junior Ray Clark's 10 saves Friday against Incarnate Word were the most by an MSU goalkeeper since Sloane Williams made 17 saves in a 3-0 loss to Sonoma State on Nov. 24, 2002 in the NCAA II national quarterfinals in Rohnert Park, Calif...

### West Texas A&M

Did not play last week...Senior midfielder Dominic Furness is fourth nationally in points per game (3.13), second nationally in total points (25), third in goals per game (1.38) and second in goals (11)...The team is tied with Drury for the most assists nationally on the season with 25...The team ranks 14th in scoring offense at three goals per match. The Buffs are eighth nationally in total goals (24) and fifth in total points (73).

## WOMEN'S OTHER TOP PERFORMERS

**Danielle Thurman, Eastern New Mexico University**, collected goals in consecutive games this week and led the Zias to their first ever win at Midwestern State University. Thurman recorded the only goal for the Zias in a 2-1 loss to Abilene Christian University and then scored the game winning goal the Zias in their next match against Midwestern. ENMU's 1-0 win over MSU was good for the program's first ever win on the road against the Mustangs.

**Brittany Martin, Texas Woman's University**, helped the Pioneers to two wins over the weekend and move into second place in the Lone Star Conference Standings. In a 3-2 win against Incarnate Word, she assisted on TWU's first goal and later scored the game-winning goal. Martin also created numerous scoring opportunities in a 2-1 win over Angelo State and hand the Rambelles their first LSC loss. On the season she leads the team with six goals and 15 points and currently ranked second in six LSC statistical categories including goals and points.

**Lauren Carnes, Angelo State University**, continued being a strong facilitator for the Angelo State offense by assisting in both goals of the Rambelles' 2-1 win over Texas A&M-Commerce last Friday. Carnes first found Selena Alvarez for a goal and then connected with Maggie Schaffer who deposited the game winner. Carnes now has four assists this season.

**Xan Ortiz, Eastern New Mexico University**, collected her third shutout in as many wins. Last week, the Zias faced the top two teams of the 2011 season and went 1-1 on the week. After falling 2-1 against ACU, Ortiz collected four saves and shut out MSU for the program's second career victory against the Mustangs.

**Erin Bolinger, Texas Woman's University**, played a key role on defense in Pioneers' two wins over the weekend. She played all 180 minutes and helped the team move into second place in LSC standings. Bolinger led the back row featuring three freshmen in limiting Angelo State to just three shots on goal while handing the Rambelles their first conference loss. She is a key reason why the Pioneers are off to their best start in the Lone Star Conference (3-1-0) since 2005 season.

**Jordan Benfield, Angelo State University**, was constantly in the middle of the action trying to disrupt the offenses of Texas A&M-Commerce and Texas Woman's last weekend. The junior moved positions to adjust for injuries and played strong defense in both games. Benfield and the Rambelles limited TAMU-Commerce to one goal in their win.

**Sarah Parker, University of the Incarnate Word**, played all 180 minutes of the team's two conference matchups last week. From her defender position she was able to get a shot on goal at Texas Woman's in a 3-2 loss on Friday. On Sunday, she scored a pair of goals, including the game-winner at Texas A&M-Commerce. Her first goal came off a corner kick that she headed in. The second goal also came off a corner kick when she pounced on a loose ball and fired it in from the top of the box.

### Angelo State

Angelo State moved to 2-1-1 in Lone Star Conference play after splitting its road trip to Texas A&M-Commerce and Texas Woman's last weekend. The Rambelles earned a 2-1 win over A&M-Commerce with goals from Selena Alvarez and Maggie Schaffer, while freshman Teegan Courtney scored against TWU. Goalkeeper Danielle Edwards had five saves on the weekend. ASU returns to the road this week with a Friday game at West Texas A&M before playing at Eastern New Mexico on Sunday.

### Eastern New Mexico

Eastern New Mexico went 1-1 on the week and picked up a big win against Midwestern State University. After falling to Abilene, the Zias picked up a 1-0 win off the boot of senior Danielle Thurman. Thurman now leads all Zias with three goals and has score in their last two games. This week the Zias will be hosting University of the Incarnate Word and Angelo State University.

### Incarnate Word

The Cardinals maintained their .500 record in conference play last week. They lost at Texas Woman's, 3-2 on Friday and came back with a 4-1 win at A&M-Commerce on Sunday. Sarah Parker played all 180 minutes of the team's two conference matchups last week. From her defender position she was able to get a shot on goal at Texas Woman's. On Sunday, she scored a pair of goals, including the game-winner at Texas A&M-Commerce. Her first goal came off a corner kick that she headed in. The second goal also came off a corner kick when she pounced on a loose ball and fired it in from the top of the box. Another defender, Jordyn Garcia, scored a goal in each game giving her a team high three goals on the season. Up front, Katie Miller had a goal and an assist against A&M-Commerce while Amber Guenther scored a goal at TWU and had an assist at Commerce. This week the Cardinals stay on the road going to Eastern New Mexico and West Texas A&M.

### Midwestern State

Midwestern State dropped a pair of Lone Star Conference home matches to West Texas A&M and Eastern New Mexico last weekend to fall to 1-6-1 on the season and to 1-2-1 in league play... The Mustangs have lost four consecutive home games for just the second time in school history and for the first time since falling in five consecutive matches at the MSU Soccer Field to start the 2000 season... MSU lost six consecutive matches on its home turf if you count a 2-1 defeat to Texas A&M-Commerce in the 1999 LSC semifinals to go along with the 0-5 home start in 2000... The Mustangs have managed to score just five goals this season -- all by different players... Midwestern is generating fewer shots (11.00) and shots on goal (4.25) per game than any other season in its 18-year history... The Mustangs blasted a combined 44 shots against West Texas A&M (26) and Eastern New Mexico (18) - their two highest outputs of the season - after taking the same number of shots over their previous six matches... Sophomore midfielder Katy Catney notched her first goal of the season in Friday's 2-1 overtime loss to West Texas A&M. It was her third career goal and all have come

against the Lady Buffs as she scored two goals in a 5-0 win on Oct. 7, 2011... Senior goalkeeper Mallory Whitworth made 11 combined saves against West Texas A&M and Eastern New Mexico to move past Erika Shoenrock (214 saves from 1998-01) and into fourth place on MSU's all-time saves list with 225...

### Texas Woman's

The TWU soccer team captured two conference wins to improve its record to 4-3-1 on the season and 3-1-0 in LSC. The Pioneers are off to their best start in the conference since 2005 season when TWU opened with a 3-1-0 LSC record. The Pioneers defeated Incarnate Word, 3-2, on Friday before snapping Angelo State's three-game unbeaten streak and hand the Rambelles their first LSC loss with a 2-1 win. Five different players scored the five goals for TWU over the weekend with the game-winning goals coming from senior Brittany Martin against UIW and freshman Sara Alvarez against ASU. On the season Martin leads the team with six goals, 15 points and 34 shots. She also currently ranked second in six LSC statistical categories including goals and points. Senior Katy Black has handed out four assists this season and is tied for second in the conference.

### West Texas A&M

It was a weekend of first for the Lady Buffs as they scored a goal with 16 seconds remaining in the first overtime (99:44) for a thrilling 2-1, come-from-behind win at Midwestern State. It was the Lady Buffs' first win at MSU in the regular season since 2002...Continuing the theme of firsts, WT won at Abilene Christian on Sunday for the first time in school history, 3-1, marking the first conference road weekend sweep for WT since 2009...The 10 saves by junior goalkeeper Yvette Bedoy at Abilene Christian were the second-most by her this season as she has 134 career assists ranking her fifth in school history... Five players played all 190 minutes including senior Leslie Briggs who had the game-winner Friday at Midwestern State as she had two goals and two assists for the week...Senior midfielder Becky Peth is the lone Lady Buff to play all 840 minutes thus far... With the two goals by Briggs this weekend she tied her output from 2011 with 11 goals.
