### LSC SOCCER

All but one Lone Star Conference soccer team began their seasons this past week with non-conference action. On the men's side, Eastern New Mexico, West Texas A&M and Midwestern State remain unbeaten. Angelo State is the lone undefeated women's team.

LSC men's soccer teams are 7-2 overall this season. The squads are currently 1-2 combined versus Rocky Mountain Athletic Conference teams, and 5-0 against the Heartland Conference, which are the other conferences in the NCAA South Central Region.

The women's teams are 4-9-1 overall this season. The squads are currently 1-1-4 combined versus Rocky Mountain Athletic Conference teams, and 1-2 against the Heartland Conference, which are the other conferences in the NCAA South Central Region.

### PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

#### MEN'S OFFENSIVE

**Dominic Furness, West Texas A&M University, SR, Midfield, Middlesbrough, England, St. David's**

Furness had an outstanding opening to the 2012 season as he has scored a team-high seven goals in three matches, including four goals in an 8-0 win over St. Mary's. It was the first four-goal game of his career and seventh in school history. Furness had two goals in the season-opener versus Southern Nazarene and the equalizing goal to help lead the 24th-ranked Buffs to a 2-1 come-from-behind win at Dallas Baptist.

#### MEN'S DEFENSIVE

**Issac Pile, Midwestern State University, JR, Mansfield, Texas, Legacy HS**

Pile played a key role in helping Midwestern State limit a stout Texas A&M International attack to just two shots in the Mustangs' 2-0 win Friday night at the MSU Soccer Field. MSU coach Doug Elder lauded the 5-10 junior from Mansfield's play after he made a surprise start at outside back. Midwestern extended its home field unbeaten streak to 44 matches and is now unbeaten in its last eight regular season games.

#### WOMEN'S OFFENSIVE

**Leslie Briggs, West Texas A&M University, SR, Forward, Carrollton, Texas, Dallas Parish Episcopal/SMU**

Briggs opened the 2012 campaign with a hat trick and all three goals in a 3-3 tie with Colorado Mesa last Friday. Her three goals were all equalizing goals, including a penalty kick was tied the match for good in the 77th minute. It was her first career hat trick and the first since 2008 in team history. It also was the 18th in team history. She then came back with a goal at UC-Colorado Springs in a 4-1 loss. Briggs is one of four players to play all 200 minutes thus far.

#### WOMEN'S DEFENSIVE

**Danielle Edwards, Angelo State University, SR, San Angelo, Texas, Lake View HS**

Edwards opened the season with a shutout in goal against Texas-Permian Basin and recorded two saves in Angelo State's 2-1 double overtime win over New Mexico Highlands.

### MEN'S OTHER TOP PERFORMERS

**Diego Santos, Eastern New Mexico University**, has tallied a team-best four goals, including back-to-back game-winning goals, over the first week of the season. He has scored in all three games, with two in a neutral-site, double-overtime contest against St. Mary's. The game marked Santos' first multi-goal contest, coming on a career-high six shots. His performance has lifted the Greyhounds to their first 3-0 start in program history.

**VcMor Eligwe, Midwestern State University**, breakaway goal in the 61st minute allowed Midwestern State to draw first blood against rival Texas A&M International Friday night at the MSU Soccer Field. The junior from McKinney then assisted on a goal by Len Smith on a cross from the left wing which was volleyed in for the put-away tally.

**William Garrett Cooper, West Texas A&M University**, had an outstanding first week between the posts in a Buffalo uniform as a redshirt freshman. He is 3-0 on the year with a 0.37 goals against average, three saves and 1 and 1/3 shutouts. He has logged 243:34 minutes during the week in three starts helping lead the Buffaloes to a 3-0 start and a No. 24 ranking.

**Fredrik Widfeldt, Eastern New Mexico University**, has posted a 0.40 goals against average and an .833 save percentage, to pick up a pair of wins for the Eastern New Mexico University men's soccer team. His performance has helped the Greyhounds open the season at 3-0, for the first time in team history.

#### Eastern New Mexico

Diego Santos and Michael Stewart have combined for six of the Greyhounds seven goals and lifted the Eastern New Mexico University men's soccer team to a 3-0 record for the first time in team history. The Greyhounds opened with a 2-1 win at Newman, before shutting Adams State out. On Tuesday, Eastern earned the ninth overtime win in the history of the program (9-6-17). This weekend, ENMU will host Colorado State-Pueblo and Adams State.

**Incarnate Word**

The Cardinals dropped their first two games of the year on the road in Colorado. They opened with a 2-1 defeat at #1 and defending national champion Fort Lewis and then suffered a 3-2 defeat to Colorado Mines. The Cardinals led Fort Lewis 1-0 early in the second half and lost on a goal in the final five minutes of the game. In the game with Colorado Mines, the team came back from a one goal deficit on two occasions only to give up the game-winning goal with 28 seconds remaining in the contest. Midfielder Vincent Bailey scored the team's first goal of the season on a penalty kick after FLC was whistled for a yellow card in the box. The Cardinals will look to get back on track this week when they travel to Southern Nazarene and Oklahoma Christian.

**Midwestern State**

No. 14 Midwestern State claimed a 2-0 win over regionally-ranked Texas A&M International Friday night at the MSU Soccer Field... The win extended the Mustangs' home field unbeaten streak to 44 matches dating back to the 2007 season... MSU boasts a 40-0-4 on its home pitch since suffering a 1-0 loss to West Texas A&M on Nov. 4, 2007... During the streak, the Mustangs have notched 31 shutouts and are outscoring the opposition by a 134-14 margin... MSU boasts a 3.05 goals per game average while limiting the opponent to 0.32 goals a contest.. The Mustangs are 8-0-2 against ranked opposition at home during the streak... The four draws have come against No. 11 Sonoma State (11/17/07), #19 West Texas A&M (9/18/09), Texas A&M International (9/25/09) and St. Edward's (10/23/11)... MSU is unbeaten in its last eight regular season matches dating back to last season... Midwestern is now 11-1-1 in season opener during the Doug Elder era and 8-0-1 in season openers played at the MSU Soccer Field... MSU coach Doug Elder remains the winningest active coach in all of NCAA Division II with a 185-41-19 mark (.794) since taking over the program in 2000... Despite the masterful performance against Texas A&M International, the Mustangs fell two places to No. 16 in the NSCAA Division II poll.. Midwestern State has been ranked in each of the last 68 NSCAA polls in which it was eligible... The Mustangs limited Texas A&M International to just two shots - both on goal... MSU junior forward VcMor Eligwe notched a goal and an assist while leading the Mustangs to a 2-0 win against Texas A&M International after the teams battled to a first half draw...

**West Texas A&M**

Dominic Furness' four goals against St. Mary's (TX) is the seventh time in school history a WT player has scored four goals in a game. The last was Martin Fuentes versus Univ. of the Southwest exactly two years ago to the day (Sept. 2, 2010). Buffaloes are ranked for the first time since 2010 (24th) and will be traveling to No. 11 Colorado School of Mines, the team they lost to the last time they were ranked (first match of 2010) and ironically WT was ranked 24th then, too, and the match will be on the same day (Sept. 7) two years later. The 3-0 start this season is the best since starting the 2009 season 3-0. WT finished that season 15-2-2. The offense has been on fire thus far with 12 goals and just one goal allowed as redshirt freshman William Garrett Cooper has just an 0.37 goals against average on the year. 2010 was the last time WT had scored 12 goals in three matches. However, all 12 came against Univ. of the Southwest. The most goals in three games to begin a season was 1993 with 16. In 2000, the Buffs scored 13 goals and allowed just two in the first three matches.

**WOMEN'S OTHER TOP PERFORMERS**

**Brionna Minde, Texas A&M University - Commerce**, continued her solid play, recording a goal and adding three assists as the Lions went 1-1, defeating Ouachita Baptist 2-0 before falling to 10th-ranked Fort Lewis 4-2. Minde assisted on both of the Lions' goals in the season opening victory, then notched a goal and added an assist against the Skyhawks, giving her a hand in each Lion goal this season. She also was called upon to play goalkeeper against Fort Lewis, logging 12 minutes in net after an injury to the starting goalkeeper, proving she is willing to do it all.

**Lauren Carnes, Angelo State University**, assisted in both goals in Angelo State's 2-1 double overtime win over New Mexico Highlands and led the team with five shots in its season-opening win over Texas-Permian Basin.

**Lexi Stirling, Abilene Christian University**, scored the game-winning goal and helped hold Our Lady of the Lake to zero shots in ACU's 1-0 win over the Saints Sunday at the Wildcat Soccer Pitch. The goal was Stirling's first of the year (4th of career) and came off a free kick during the final two minutes of regulation. It was also her first score since her freshman year of 2009.

**Renee Romero, Eastern New Mexico University**, led her fellow defenders to keep Hawaii Pacific University and Brigham Young-Hawaii shots to a minimum. In two games, Eastern's opponents were held to three goals, 11 shots on goal, and 24 total shots.

**LSC WOMEN'S SOCCER NOTES (Submitted by LSC SID's)****Abilene Christian**

Seventh-ranked ACU began 2012 with a 1-1 weekend, first losing 2-0 to Dallas Baptist before winning Sunday 1-0 vs. Our Lady of the Lake. Senior defender Lexi Stirling scored the game-winning goal vs. the Saints off a free kick taken during the last two minutes of regulation, and helped lead a defensive effort that prevented the Saints from even taking a single shot. The loss to DBU was ACU's first during the regular season since Sept. 26 of 2010 and first against Patriots in close to four years. The Wildcats, however, still lead the all-time series 5-2. ACU is 2-0 all-time vs. Our Lady of the Lake and last played the Saints in 2008 - also a 1-0 win for the Wildcats. ACU is in Joplin, Mo., this weekend for matches vs. Nebraska-Kearney and Missouri Southern.

**Angelo State**

Angelo State started the season with a 2-0 record for the first time since 2007 after picking up wins over Texas-Permian Basin and New Mexico Highlands last week. The Rambelles earned a 2-0 shutout win at UTPB before overcoming a 0-1 halftime deficit to take a 2-1 double overtime win over N.M. Highlands with a Sierra Anderson goal. ASU travels to Colorado this week to play Colorado Mesa and Fort Lewis.

### Eastern New Mexico

The Zias struggled offensively in their opening road trip and fell to both Hawaii Pacific University, and Brigham Young University-Hawaii. While only letting up three goals, the Zias were unable to score and were shutout in both contests. Eastern New Mexico will be back in action Thursday, September 6, when they head to Colorado to face Colorado Mines.

### Incarnate Word

The Cardinals were off the first weekend of the year. They open their season playing in Austin against Regis and Metro State on Friday and Sunday.

### Midwestern State

Midwestern State suffered back-to-back defeats to No. 10 Fort Lewis (Colo.) and Colorado Mesa by counts of 3-0 and 3-1 last weekend at the MSU Classic... MSU's 3-0 loss to No. 10 Fort Lewis (Colo.) snapped a string of three consecutive wins in season openers as the Mustangs to 11-7 all time in campaign starters... Midwestern dropped to 5-2 all time in season openers played at the MSU Soccer Field... The Mustangs managed just three shots in Friday's 3-0 loss to Fort Lewis which are the fewest since they were stated for just two total shots against West Texas A&M on Sep. 23, 2010... Freshman Kaila Maxey tallied her first collegiate goal in the first half Sunday against Colorado Mesa on an assist from fellow freshman Kensli Pounds, who was playing in her first collegiate match... Midwestern competes in the UCO's Fischer Classic Friday and Sunday at Tom Thompson Field in Edmond, Okla. MSU takes on No. 15 Central Oklahoma Friday at 4 p.m. before playing unbeaten Southwestern Oklahoma Sunday at noon...

### Texas A&M-Commerce

A&M-Commerce started off the 2012 season by going 1-1 in the opening week. The Lions defeated Ouachita Baptist 2-0 in the home opener, thanks to goals from freshman Sydney Lawthers and junior Eva Brutto as Brionna Minde assisted on both Lion tallies. Against 10th-ranked Fort Lewis, A&M-Commerce fought off an early deficit, rallying to take the lead at 2-1 in the first half before falling to the Skyhawks 4-2 in Wichita Falls. Minde notched her first goal of the season and added another assist on Anitra Wright's first career tally.

### Texas Woman's

The Pioneers opened their 2012 soccer season against #15 Dallas Baptist on Saturday night and flipped the switch to their new field lights in front 471 fans at TWU Soccer Field. DBU, however, spoiled the party as they captured a 3-1 win over TWU. TWU junior Emily Davila found the net in the 84th minute for the only Pioneers' goal. The Pioneers took on Ouachita Baptist on Monday and dropped a 1-0 heartbreaker. OBU scored the only goal of the game in 84th minute. The Pioneers outshot Ouachita Baptist, 23-8, for the day including a 9-2 advantage in shots on goal.

### West Texas A&M

Briggs Brings the Hat Trick - Senior Leslie Briggs opened the season with a hat trick against Colorado Mesa in a 3-3 tie. She then followed that up with the Lady Buffs' lone goal at UC-Colorado Springs. It was her first career hat trick and the 18th in school history. In addition, it was the first hat trick since Elisabeth Markussen accomplished the feat three times in 2008 with the last coming on Oct. 5, 2008, versus Northeastern State. Equalizing Briggs - Each of Briggs' goals in a 3-3 tie versus Colorado Mesa last week were the equalizing goal, including a penalty kick in the 77th minute for the hat trick goal. McHorse Third in Career Points and Goals - Senior Lindsay McHorse is third in career points with 79 and third in career goals with 32. Along with the 32 goals, McHorse has compiled 14 assists, tying her with Katie Henly (2002-2005) for 10th all-time in school history. Bedoy Fifth in Carrer Saves - Junior Yvette Bedoy is fifth all-time in school history in career saves. She tallied 82 saves last season in her first year as the starter between the posts and has 16 so far this season for 98. Her 82 stops in 2011 tied for third-most in school history in a season.
