LSC BASKETBALL

The Lone Star Conference season continues to be spirited, with the Midwestern State men and Tarleton State women both falling for the first time in league play last week. On the men's side, MSU and Incarnate Word both have one LSC loss. Tarleton tops the women's standings at 6-1 but MSU, Abilene Christian and Incarnate Word are right behind them with two conference losses each.

Over the weekend, two Lone Star Conference men's basketball dunks were featured on SportsCenter's Top 10 plays. The No. 2 highlight was Incarnate Word's Lyn'Dale Brown (<http://youtu.be/X6ERMPXt5IE>), while No. 9 showed Midwestern State's Corbin Thomas (<https://www.facebook.com/photo.php?v=705452036880>).

The LSC men have a 81-60 overall record so far this season. In the NCAA South Central Region, the men's teams are currently 14-15 combined versus Heartland Conference teams and 3-1 opposed to the Rocky Mountain Athletic Conference.

The LSC women are 73-77 overall. The women's squads are currently 15-11 combined versus Heartland teams, and 5-1 against the RMAC, which are the other conferences in the NCAA South Central Region.

The LSC champion will be the regular season winner determined by conference games, while the postseason tournament winner is designated as LSC Tournament Champion and earns the league's automatic berth into the NCAA Championship. The top eight teams in the final conference standings qualify for the postseason tournament set for March 6-9 in Allen, Texas.

PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

MEN'S OFFENSIVE

Rashad Basey, Texas A&M University - Kingsville, JR, Guard, Louisville, Ky., Jefferstown HS

Basey scored a career-best 30 points in the win over Eastern New Mexico on 12-of-21 shooting. He was the first Javelina to score 30 points since November of 2011. On Saturday, he led all scorers in a defensive battle versus West Texas A&M with 18 points on 6-of-10 shooting and was 5-of-6 from the foul line. He had five assists in the game including helpers on the game-tying and game-winning buckets in the extra period.

MEN'S DEFENSIVE

Corbin Thomas, Midwestern State University, SR, Forward, Chicago, Ill., Seton Academy

Thomas' play in the paint contributed to one of the best defensive performances in Midwestern State history Saturday night against Tarleton State. The senior transfer from Missouri State outscored the Texans' starters on his own with 16 points while pulling down eight rebounds and swatting three shots. Tarleton's starting five managed just 11 points as the Texans matched the lowest scoring output in school history in the 50-34 loss. Thomas' play was critical in MSU's historic night as the Mustangs set a school record of their own holding TSU to a 16.9-percent shooting night (10-for-59). Thomas also notched his fifth double-double of the season with 18 points and 14 rebounds in a 74-66 loss Wednesday night at Texas A&M-Commerce. For the week, Thomas averaged 18 points and 11 rebounds to go along with five blocked shots and a steal.

WOMEN'S OFFENSIVE

Kirsti Degelia, Midwestern State University, JR, Guard, Denton, Texas, Krum HS

Degelia led the Mustangs in a pair of wins, including Midwestern's 78-71 overtime triumph over Tarleton State that handed the TexAnns their first Lone Star Conference loss of the season. Degelia, the leading scorer in the LSC with 16.6 points a game, scored a career-high 27 to go with six assists in leading MSU past Tarleton for the first time in 14 games or since Jan. 5, 2005. She buried a 30-foot trey at the first half buzzer that gave MSU a halftime lead against the TexAnns. For the week the 5-8 junior from Denton, Texas/Krum averaged 18.0 points with 6.5 rebounds, 5.0 assists and 3.5 steals. She shot 40.0 percent from the floor (10-of-25), 50.0 percent from the 3-point arc (3-of-6) and 76.5 percent from the foul line (13-of-17) as MSU pulled within a half game of the LSC lead.

WOMEN'S DEFENSIVE

Ashlyn Green, University of the Incarnate Word, SR, Guard, Irving, Texas, Irving HS

Green was the leader of a stout Incarnate Word defensive effort last week. The Cardinals allowed just 44.5 points per game in their two victories over West Texas A&M and Eastern New Mexico. With the team trailing WT in the final 30 seconds, Green hit a jumper in the lane with 25 seconds left to make it 51-50 UIW and then she blocked a potential game-winning three-point attempt with seven seconds left to help secure the win. She came back with 11 points and a team high seven rebounds while helping to limit ENMU to 30.8 percent shooting in a 64-39 win. She averaged 10.0 points, 6.0 rebounds, 1.5 blocks and 1.5 steals per game for the week.

MEN'S OTHER TOP PERFORMERS

Dionelle Rucker, University of the Incarnate Word, led the Cardinals to a 2-0 week with wins over West Texas A&M and Eastern New Mexico. He led the team with 18 points and seven rebounds in the 66-62 win over the Buffs. He scored the go-ahead basket with 3:00 to play and then helped seal the win with a blocked shot that led to a fast break layup with 1:30 remaining. On Saturday, he dominated the Greyhounds on the inside with 23 points, eight rebounds and two blocks in a 93-75 win. He went 10-of-15 from the field and reclaimed the scoring lead in the conference.

Parker Wentz, Abilene Christian University, played the role of sharpshooter this week as the Wildcats thumped a pair of non-conference foes at home this week: Arlington Baptist, 87-42, and Southwestern Adventist, 83-48. Wentz went 5-6 from beyond the arc and 7-8 overall for a career high 21 points vs. Arlington Baptist, and then scored seven points against the Knights, but with career high five rebounds and five assists. Wentz' seven FG made and five three pointers vs. Arlington Baptist also were career highs.

Kyle Lantz, Eastern New Mexico University, averaged 13.5 points over two game last week and shot .643 from the floor, with a sizzling .700 three-point percentage. He poured in 12 points and dished out three assists at Texas A&M-Kingsville and followed with a 15-point game at Incarnate Word.

T.J. Brown, Abilene Christian University, gave the Wildcats a boost from the bench this week, helping them coast to a pair of non-conference victories over Arlington Baptist, 87-42, and Southwestern Adventist, 83-48. Brown recorded the first double-double of his career (11 points, 12 rebounds) Tuesday vs. Arlington Baptist in only 23 minutes of play. He went 5-7 from the floor, hit his first career 3-pointer, and had nine boards off the defensive glass. In 25 minutes vs. the Knights, Brown pulled down six rebounds and scored seven points on 3-5 shooting. Browns' 18 rebounds and 9.0 per game average led the Wildcats this week.

Denzel Livingston, University of the Incarnate Word, was a disruptive presence on the court during the Cardinals' 2-0 week. He blocked five shots and had a steal in a 66-62 win over West Texas A&M. The Buffs shot just 38.6 percent from the floor for the game, but are shooting over 47 percent for the season. He had an unbelievable game in a 93-75 win over Eastern New Mexico with seven points, nine rebounds, nine assists, two blocks and a steal. He harassed the Greyhounds into a poor shooting day as they shot only 35.8 percent from the field.

Dennis Hardwell, Eastern New Mexico University, turned in a strong defensive performance for the Greyhounds, with six overall blocked shots, which included three in each game.

Abilene Christian

The Wildcats scored two big wins this week over Arlington Baptist, 87-42, and Southwestern Adventist, 83-48, to climb back to .500 at 7-7 on the season. ACU averaged 85.0 points per game on .626 shooting (16-28, .571 from 3-point range) and pulled down 42.5 rpg to go along with 38 assists, five blocks and 22 steals. ACU's 20 assists Saturday vs. the Knights were a season best. Steven Werner averaged 16.5 points and 8.5 rebounds coming off the bench and each night was just a few rebounds shy of a double-double. Senior guard Eric Lawton extended his double-figures scoring streak to eight games with 11 vs. Arlington Baptist and 13 vs. the Knights. He also had a career high nine assists and three steals vs. the Patriots. Freshman guard T.J. Brown recorded the first double-double of his career vs. the Patriots, coming off the bench to score 11 points and pull down 12 boards. Freshman guard Parker Wentz scored a career high 21 points vs. Arlington Baptist on 5-6 shooting from 3-point range (7-8 overall), and on Saturday had career highs in rebounds (5) and assists (5).

The Cameron University men's basketball team is riding their longest conference winning streak in nearly two seasons after defeating Texas A&M Commerce, 61-56 at the Aggie Gym on Saturday afternoon. After starting the conference season 0-3, the Aggies have won five in a row with wins against Eastern New Mexico, Angelo State, Abilene Christian, and Tarleton State. Asaad Robinson proved to be Cameron's sixth man after averaging 14 points in two games with seven three-pointers. On Wednesday evening's game against Tarleton State, Robinson hit a pair of deep shots from downtown to pull the Aggies away from the Texans and earning their first win in Wisdom Gymnasium since the 1996-97 season. Andrew Thomas was another key contributor for the Ags by putting up nine points and seven boards against the Texans. Thomas then had a career high 19 points on Saturday against Texas A&M-Commerce (previous high 16 points), with five rebounds, and a block. Craig Foster didn't have a major scoring week but did a lot of the little things to spark the Aggies on both ends of the court. However, Foster did have six steals in two games and 11 assists. On Saturday, Foster did tie a career high four steals vs. the Lions. Cameron will be idle this week and will have a home-and-home series with Midwestern State starting on Jan. 23 at the Aggie Gym.

seven points, nine rebounds, nine assists, two blocks and a steal. He harassed the Greyhounds into a poor shooting day as they shot only 35.8 percent from the field. Andre Corley, a mid-season transfer, has had a dramatic impact upon the team. He scored 11 points off the bench in the win over West Texas A&M. On Saturday, he was nearly unconscious from the field hitting 10-of-13 from the field and 4-of-7 from three-point range as he poured in 27 points in just 20 minutes of action. Anthony Horton has been shooting the ball extremely well over his last few games. He is 16-of-24 from the field and 8-of-12 from three-point range over his last three games. Point guard Lyn'Dale Brown had a highlight film dunk in the game against West Texas A&M that earned the ESPN SportsCenter #2 Play of the Night.

Midwestern State

Midwestern State had a 10-game winning streak over Lone Star Conference opponents snapped with a 74-66 setback Wednesday in Commerce. The streak included wins over Texas A&M-Commerce, Cameron and Tarleton State in last season's Lone Star Conference Postseason Tournament. MSU's last loss came by a 60-56 margin at West Texas A&M on Feb. 22, 2012... The Mustangs have snagged at least 53 rebounds in each of its last three games while outboarding the opposition by 21.7 rebounds a game... MSU rank 8th in NCAA Division II and lead the LSC with a +10.7 rebounding margin... Midwestern State held Tarleton State to the fewest points in school history tying the Texans' mark of 34 points scored against Oklahoma Christian in 1988. The point total was the lowest of any Lonn Reisman-coached team... The Mustangs have limited Tarleton State to a total of 54 points in the last 60 minutes of basketball between the teams. The Texans managed 20 points in the second half of the 2012 LSC Tournament Final then scored 12 and 22 points Saturday night at D.L. Ligon Coliseum... The 12-point half was the lowest output for an opponent since Midwestern limited Southeastern Oklahoma to 10 points in the first stanza of a 72-42 win on Dec. 12, 2009 in Durant... Tarleton State's 16.9-percent shooting night was the best field goal percentage defensive effort for an MSU team in the school's 66 seasons of senior college competition... MSU improved to 62-3 (.954) at D.L. Ligon Coliseum since the start of the 2008-09 season...

Tarleton State

The Texans have dropped three consecutive games for the first time since Feb. 4, 2009 after falling 50-34 to Midwestern State in Wichita Falls on Saturday... Tarleton's 34 points ties an all-time low in school history and it is the lowest amount of points scored in the Lonn Reisman era... It marks just the second time a Texan team has scored less than 40 points under Reisman... The Texans will look to bounce back this week with a road game at Eastern New Mexico (1/16/13) and then returning home to host West Texas A&M (1/19/13).

Texas A&M-Kingsville

When junior guard Rashad Basey scored 30 points in the Javelinas win over Eastern New Mexico on Thursday, he became the first player since Ashton Brown to score 30-or-more points in a game. Brown scored 32 points twice last November in back-to-back non-conference games versus St. Edwards and St. Mary's... Basey who is averaging a team-best 15.2 a game and has led the team in scoring on eight

different occasions this season... Entering Saturday's game with West Texas A&M, mid-year addition Dytrell Bracey was 0-of-4 from behind the arc. After hitting a three early in the game, Bracey hit a three-point basket to win the game of West Texas in overtime... Junior wing Jamahl Brown was held without a point against Eastern New Mexico on Thursday. He regained his form on Saturday as he tallied 13 points including a layin that tied the game with the Buffaloes at 61 during overtime in the team's 64-61 victory... The Javelinas won their last two overtime games dating to last season when they handed A&M-Commerce a loss in triple overtime... The Javelinas played in front of nearly 1,000 elementary school students last Thursday as local school districts were invited to participate in "Living the Dream" promotion. Between the women's and men's games students listened to various speakers about the importance of going to school and pursuing a college degree... Since allowing Texas A&M International to hit 51.1% of its shots from the floor in the season opener, the Javelinas have limited their last 12 opponents to 43.1% from the floor or lower. In all seven opponents have been held below 40% including two at below 30%. They entered the weekend fourth in the country in defensive field goal percentage (37%) and 8th in points allowed (59.2)... With three straight wins, A&M-Kingsville has matched its season-best winning streak... With nine three-points baskets against the Buffs, Kingsville matched its season-high for treys set in the second game of the 2012-13 season against Texas Lutheran... With two blocks on Saturday, Marshall Bonds III has 15 blocks this season. He now has 46 this season and is fifth in the program history. Last year, Bonds finished with 31 blocks which is second only to Chip Jones who had 64 during the 2008-09 season.

WOMEN'S OTHER TOP PERFORMERS

Devin Griffin, West Texas A&M University, led the team averaging a double-double with 23 points and 11 rebounds for the week. She tallied two 20-plus point performances with 21 and 25 as the Lady Buffs split two conference matches. She tallied double-doubles in each game and tied her season-high with nine field goals made in each contest. She was 18 of 29 from the field for a .621 average and 8 of 11 from the line for a .727 clip. It was Griffin's fourth and fifth double-double of the season and fourth and fifth game of scoring over 20 points.

Peyton Adamson, Tarleton State University, proved yet again why she has stayed atop the Lone Star Conference in scoring all season, with another 20-point performance against Midwestern State and a double-figure effort against Cameron. With her 22-point effort against MSU Saturday, the junior TexAnn recorded the fifth 20-point game of this season and the eighth of her career. She was a 45-percent shooter from the field this week and was 67-percent shooting from beyond the arc. She also added five assists.

Renata Marquez, Abilene Christian University, was an all-around force this past week as the Wildcats flattened both Texas Woman's on the road, 75-50, and Southwestern Adventist at home, 108-21. Marquez finished the week with her team's highest scoring average (16.0) after she tied her own career best with 25 points dropped on the Lady Knights. Marquez Saturday night also set or tied new career single-game highs for steals (6), field goals made (9) and attempted (18), and 3-point field goals made (5) and attempted (13). Marquez' fifth trey

vs. the Lady Knights was ACU's 17th of the game, which set a new program single-game record. The Wildcats also surpassed team records that night for most 3-pointers attempted (45) and largest margin of victory (87 points). Marquez this week also had the most steals of ACU player with eight, tied Mack Lankford for most assists with nine, and tied Shannon Sanders for second highest rebounding average with 5.5.

Ashley Viera, Texas A&M University - Kingsville, came off the bench to score 14 points against Eastern New Mexico to lead the Javelinas in scoring. The total was the second most of the freshman's career. On Saturday, she came off the bench to tally 10 points in 16 minutes of play.

Rachel Schlosser, Texas Woman's University, led a balanced Pioneer attack with a game-high 14 points in a road win at Angelo State. For the week she averaged 11.0 ppg while shooting .438 and .667 from the three-point range. On the season Schlosser has 7.2 points per game and 5.0 rebounds per game.

Tara Johnson, Eastern New Mexico University, paced the Zias, last week, with 11 points and four rebounds per game, along with a .526 shooting percentage. In Eastern's win at Texas A&M-Kingsville, she connected on 70 percent from the floor, to finish with 15 points, an assist, steal and a blocked shot. Johnson also contributed seven points, five boards and a steal at Incarnate Word.

Kirsti Degelia, Midwestern State University, led Midwestern on both ends of the floor in wins over Texas A&M-Commerce and Tarleton State last week. Degelia posted a season high five steals to go with a blocked shot and eight rebounds at A&M-Commerce. She then added two more steals and five boards in the Mustangs first win in 14 games over Tarleton State dating back to Jan. 5, 2005. Against Tarleton, she helped the Mustangs hold the top field goal percentage team in NCAA Division II (49.1 percent) to just 37.3 percent from the floor. For the week the 5-8 junior from Denton, Texas/Krum averaged 18.0 points with 6.5 rebounds, 5.0 assists and 3.5 steals. She shot 40.0 percent from the floor (10-of-25), 50.0 percent from the 3-point arc (3-of-6) and 76.5 percent from the foul line (13-of-17) as MSU pulled within a half game of the LSC lead.

Devin Griffin, West Texas A&M University, led the team averaging a double-double with 23 points and 11 rebounds for the week. She tallied two 20-plus point performances with 21 and 25 as the Lady Buffs split two conference matches. Griffin helped lead the defense to holding the opposition to 49.5 points and 31 percent shooting for the week, along with just .194 from beyond the arc on 6 of 31. The defense had 18 steals and five blocks for the week as the 13 steals against TAMUK was the second-most this season.

Tabbatha Thurmond, Texas Woman's University, led the team with 14 rebounds and five steals last week. She helped the team hold Angelo State to just 39 points and 26.7 percent shooting in a 22-point win on the road. In the two games last week, Thurmond averaged 10.0 points while shooting a team-best 60.0 percent. On the season she is averaging 8.4 points, 6.0 rebounds and leads the team with 51.6 percent shooting.

Kiara Wright, Tarleton State University, recorded the first 20-rebound game of her career Saturday against Midwestern State en route to a 13.5 rebounds

per game average this week and becoming just the 10th TexAnn in school history to record 600 career rebounds. She also chipped in four assists, two blocks and three steals.

Jaylyn Cooper, Eastern New Mexico University, registered three steals and blocked a shot, as the Zias played to a split at Texas A&M-Kingsville and Incarnate Word. In the victory over the Javelinas, she registered two steals, a block, five defensive boards and 11 points. Cooper followed with five rebounds, a steal and seven points at Incarnate Word.

Abilene Christian

The Wildcats steamrolled both opponents this week as they followed a 25-point win at Texas Woman's with the biggest victory in program history, a 108-21 decision over Southwestern Adventist. Records set in ACU's win over the Lady Knight included most 3-pointers made (17) and attempted (45), fewest points allowed to a four-year university since Texas-Arlington scored 19 in a 37-19 win in 1973, largest margin of victory since beating Howard Payne by 80 in November of 1995. For the week, ACU averaged 91.5 ppg on .459 shooting (.305 from 3-point range) and 50.5 rpg (47 vs. TWU and 54 vs. SWA), to go along with 50 assists, seven blocks and 35 steals. The Wildcats have score more than 30 points in each of their last seven quarters, beginning with the second half vs. Midwestern State on Jan. 3. Head coach Julie Goodenough is one victory away from No. 300 of her collegiate career.

Angelo State

The Belles fell to 6-7 overall and 3-4 in LSC play ... The Belles sit second in the league in field goal percentage defense, defensive rebounds, defensive rebound percentage and blocked shots. The team is ranked third in field goal percentage, rebounding offense, 3-point field goals made and rebounding margin. Junior Leah LeMaire surpassed 500 points for her career this past Saturday. The Belles will host Texas A&M-Kingsville on Wednesday at 5:30 p.m.

Cameron

The Cameron Aggie women's basketball split their Lone Star Conference games falling at Tarleton State 89-50, and beating Texas A&M-Commerce, 67-56. The win for the Aggies was their third in a row at home. Brittany Harris had a Cameron career high 20 points with two steals against Tarleton State. On Saturday afternoon, the Aggies held the Lions to 15 points and held them to 15.4 percent from the field (6-39) in the first half. Additionally, Cameron ended the first half on an incredible 18-0 run to end the half. The Aggies for the first time this season had four players in double-figures with Chelsea Stamp leading the way with 15 points, and three others with 12 points. Lacy Reinke added a career high 11 rebounds with seven points. Cameron will host Texas Woman's University on Jan. 19, at the Aggie Gym.

Eastern New Mexico

The Eastern New Mexico University women's basketball team split a pair of games last week, defeating Texas A&M-Kingsville, before falling at Incarnate Word. Overall, the Zias have split their last four contests. This week, Eastern will host Tarleton State, before visiting Texas A&M-Commerce

Incarnate Word

The Cardinals went 2-0 during the week at home with a 51-50 win over West Texas A&M and a 64-39 win against Eastern New Mexico. Ashlyn Green was the leader of a stout Incarnate Word defensive effort last week. The Cardinals allowed just 44.5 points per game in their two victories over West Texas A&M and Eastern New Mexico. With the team trailing WT in the final 30 seconds, Green hit a jumper in the lane with 25 seconds left to make it 51-50 UIW and then she blocked a potential game-winning three-point attempt with seven seconds left to help secure the win. She came back with 11 points and a team high seven rebounds while helping to limit ENMU to 30.8 percent shooting in a 64-39 win. Rose Whitehead returned from an illness against WT and scored a team-high 18 points off the bench. Lauren McKinney had her best game in nearly two months with 14 points and five rebounds against Eastern New Mexico. UIW leads the LSC in points allowed per game (58.6), steals per game (11.5) and turnover margin (+6.00).

Midwestern State

The Mustangs are 11-3 overall, 6-2 in Lone Star Conference play and sit a half-game behind the LSC lead ... The Mustangs have one game this week, when MSU travels to Texas Woman's on Wednesday. It's one of the last four regular season road games for MSU. The Mustangs have played eight of their 14 games away from D.L. Ligon Coliseum ... Midwestern State picked up a 78-71 overtime win against Tarleton State at Ligon Coliseum on Saturday, extending their current home winning streak to seven ... MSU extended it's one-loss home string to 17 wins in the last 18 games – the second equaling the longest official one-loss streak in MSU history matching one that ran from Feb. 23, 2002 to Jan. 3, 2004 ... Midwestern snapped a 14-game losing streak to Tarleton with the victory. MSU last beat the TexAnns 80-72 in double overtime on Jan. 5, 2005 ... MSU held Tarleton, NCAA Division II's top field goal percentage team at 49.1 percent, to just 37.3 percent shooting from the floor (22-of-59) ... Midwestern State has won four straight games for the second time this season. MSU started the year on a 4-0 run ... After receiving votes in five consecutive poll and attaining a number 25 ranking on Dec. 18, MSU did not receive a vote in the WBCA's USA Today Sports Division II Coaches Poll last week. The next poll is due out on Tuesday (Jan. 15) as the Mustangs look for a record sixth week receiving votes in the same season ... Junior Kirsti Degelia continues to lead the Lone Star Conference in scoring, averaging 16.6 points a game. The 5-8 guard from Denton, Texas/Krum scored a career-high 27 points against Tarleton State and also is sixth in the LSC in assists (3.1), 20th in rebounding (5.1), ninth in free throw percentage (.757) and leads the league in minutes played (34.4) ... Sophomore Andrea Carter posted her seventh double-double of the season with 11 points and 10 rebounds against Tarleton State. The 5-10 forward from Angleton, Texas is second in the LSC in board work with 10.5 per game, ninth in scoring with 12.1 per contest, second in steals with 2.5, and sixth in blocked shots at 0.9 while ranking 10th in field goal percentage (.452) and 12th in free throw percentage (.737) ... Sophomore Lisa Hampton collected a career-high 16 points in last Wednesday's win over Texas A&M-Commerce. The reserve guard from Kennedale/Nolan Catholic hit 5-of-9 from the 3-point arc to go with a free throw.
