LSC BASKETBALL

Lone Star Conference teams are set for Rivalry Week, during they will play each other twice in home-and-home contests.

Midwestern State leads the men's standings, while there is a three-way tie between Abilene Christian, MSU and Tarleton State on the women's side.

On the men's side, the top four teams - MSU and Cameron along with Incarnate Word and Texas A&M-Kingsville - will face each other as part of Rivalry Week.

The competition on the women's side matches teams from the top and bottom of the standings.

The LSC champion will be the regular season winner determined by conference games, while the postseason tournament winner is designated as LSC Tournament Champion and earns the league's automatic berth into the NCAA Championship. The top eight teams in the final conference standings qualify for the postseason tournament set for March 6-9 in Allen, Texas.

The LSC men have a 89-68 overall record so far this season. In the NCAA South Central Region, the men's teams are currently 14-15 combined versus Heartland Conference teams and 3-1 opposed to the Rocky Mountain Athletic Conference.

The LSC women are 83-87 overall. The women's squads are currently 15-11 combined versus Heartland teams, and 5-1 against the RMAC, which are the other conferences in the NCAA South Central Region.

PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

MEN'S OFFENSIVE

Bryan Hammond, Angelo State University, JR, Guard, New Orleans, La., St. Augustine HS

Hammond continued his offensive surge last week with a pair of great performances against Texas A&M-Kingsville and Incarnate Word. Hammond scored 17 points in an 81-67 win over the Javelinas on Wednesday before pouring in a career-high 26 points in a loss to Incarnate Word on Saturday in San Antonio. The junior guard is averaging 9.8 points per game for the season and has led the Rams in scoring the past four games. His mentality to attack the basket has translated into getting to the free-throw line where he has shined. He made 13 free throws against the Javelinas and 10 against the Cardinals.

MEN'S DEFENSIVE

Jon Cathey-Macklin, Tarleton State University, JR, Forward, Milwaukee, Wis., Washington HS

Cathey-Macklin averaged 6.0 boards a game this week and was a huge part in the Texans allowing opposing teams to less than 55 points a contest and just 39.0 percent shooting from the field. The junior forward dominated opposing team's post players to a combined 20 points. ENMU's big men scored just four points in the contest and Cathey-Macklin helped limit WT's Donald Sims to just 10 points in Tarleton's 65-50 win over the Buffs.

WOMEN'S OFFENSIVE

Renata Marquez, Abilene Christian University, JR, Forward, Conroe, Texas, Willis HS

Marquez led ACU to a pair of conference comeback wins this week over Incarnate Word and Kingsville, averaging 19.5 points to go along with eight rebounds, six assists, two blocks and eight steals. She also made 61.9 percent of her shots from the floor, including 4-7 from beyond the arc, and was 9-of-10 from the free-throw line. In addition to scoring 18 points vs. the Cardinals, Marquez also established a new single-game career high with seven steals. She then dropped 21 points on Kingsville in addition to blocking a career high two shots.

WOMEN'S DEFENSIVE

Devin Griffin, West Texas A&M University, JR, Forward, Lubbock, Texas, Coronado HS

Griffin continued her impressive start to 2013 as she tallied her fifth double-double with 17 points and 10 rebounds in the 70-60 upset win at league-leading Tarleton State Saturday. She was 8 of 19 from the field and pulled down 10 rebounds, including nine on the defensive end, along with four assists, one block and two steals. Griffin helped lead the Lady Buff "D" to hold the TexAnns to just 38.5 percent shooting from the field and .182 from beyond the arc. The TexAnns became the ninth-straight team WT has held under 40 percent from the field. In the 72-51 win over Texas A&M-Commerce on Wednesday, Griffin had 22 points and six rebounds and tallied a career-high five blocks against the Lions. She led the team in minutes played averaging 39.5 for the week. Griffin and the Lady Buffs held their opponents to just 55.5 points in the two games and have allowed over 60 points just one time since Dec. 17 - a span of seven games and a 6-1 record since then. Date Men's Offensive

N-13...... Dionelle Rucker, UIW N-20..... Steven Werner, ACU Griffin has helped lead the Lady Buffs to under 31 percent from beyond the arc in the past five games and under 20 percent in the last three for a .288 average for the season.

MEN'S OTHER TOP PERFORMERS

Rodney Blackmon, Eastern New Mexico University, averaged 22.5 points and 6.0 assists in games against Tarleton State and Texas A&M-Commerce this week... Shot 39.0 percent (16-41) from the field and 50.0 percent (12-24) from beyond the arc... Scored 20 points against the Texans including the game-winning three-pointer with 2.2 seconds left in the game to give Eastern New Mexico their first victory over Tarleton since Feb. 2007... Was 7-of-18 from the field and 5-for-11 on three-point shots while dishing out five assists and getting credit for a steal against the Texans... Scored game-high 25 points versus Texas A&M-Commerce while making 9-of-23 shots including 7-of-13 three-point attempts... His seven made three-pointers were the most by a Greyhound player since Jan. 2011... Also had sevens assists, five rebounds and one block against the Lions.

Dionelle Rucker, University of the Incarnate Word, had a pair of strong games for the Cardinals last week. He had 15 points and six rebounds while making 4-of-6 from the field and 6-of-6 from the foul line in a loss at Abilene Christian. He led the team to a 100-83 victory over Angelo State on Saturday. He had 19 points, six rebounds and five assists. He shot 57.9 percent from the field and averaged 17.0 points per game for the week.

Chuck Guy, Tarleton State University, was terrific offensively for the Texans this week, averaging a team-high 15.5 points and dishing out 14 assists in a pair of games. The junior guard shut just under 50 percent from the field as he went 9-for-19 from the floor and he was also 10-for-12 from the charity stripe. He scored a career-high 22 points in Tarleton's 15-point win over WTAMU on Saturday and had six assists to go along with just a pair of turnovers. He was instrumental in the Texans shooting 53.8 percent from the field and scoring 10 more points than the Buffs usually give up to opponents.

Marshall Bonds III, Texas A&M University - Kingsville, had a season-high four blocks for the Javelinas. He has 19 blocks this season has 50 in his career which is tied for third all-time.

Phil Henry, Eastern New Mexico University, averaged 3.0 points, 4.0 rebounds, 2.5 blocks and 1.5 steals per game in two contests this past week... While going scoreless in only four minutes of action against Tarleton State, he had a career-day defensively at Texas A&M-Commerce... In 17 minutes he scored six points on 3-of-6 shooting from field while posting career-highs in rebounds (eight), blocks (five) and steals (three)... The five blocked shots against the Lions are the most by an Eastern New Mexico or opposing player this season.

Abilene Christian

The Wildcats went 1-1 this week. They first defeated Incarnate Word at home, 93-76, for their biggest conference win of the year, but then fell behind early at Kingsville en route to a 74-65 loss. ACU begins its week vs. Angelo State at 8-8 and 2-6 vs. the conference. ACU averaged 79.0 ppg this week on .447 shooting and .385 from the 3-point line, and was .767 from the free-throw line. The Wildcats also out-rebounded the opposition by 36.5-26.5 led by Dosh Simms with 10 rpg. Senior guards Elliott Lloyd and Eric Lawton this week each averaged 17.5 ppg. Steven Werner averaged 16.5 and Simms 14.5 ppg. Lawton's week included single-game career highs in rebounds (7 at Kingsville), assists (9 vs. UIW) and steals (3 vs. UIW). Lloyd's 24 points vs. the Cardinals were a career best as were Simms' 17 points. Simms made 7-of-9 FG vs. the Cardinals.

Angelo State

The Angelo State Rams split a pair of conference games last week after earning a home win over Texas A&M-Kingsville before falling at Incarnate Word. The Rams are now 2-6 in conference play coming into this week where they'll play two games against Abilene Christian. ASU improved to 5-3 at home this season with an 81-67 victory over the Javelinas. Bryan Hammond led ASU in the win with 17 points and five assists. Hammond followed the performance with a 26-point career-high effort against the Cardinals on Saturday.

Cameron

Did not play last week.

Eastern New Mexico

Eastern New Mexico went 1-1 on the week with a win at home against Tarleton State (59-56) and falling on the road to Texas A&M-Commerce (84-77)... The win against the Texans was the first for the Greyhounds since Feb. 2007 and ended a 10-game losing streak to Tarleton... In the past 30 meetings, ENMU is now 2-28 versus the Texans... Junior guard Rodney Blackmon hit the game-winning three-pointer against Tarleton with 2.2 seconds left on the clock... The Greyhounds erased a 15-point deficit with 15:14 left in the game against the Lions... Junior guard Rafael Love and Blackmon combined to score 44 of ENMU's 77 points against Texas A&M-Commerce... The Greyhounds have now lost 11 straight to the Lions... Blackmon made 21 of his 25 points on three-point shots... The seven made three-pointers are the most by an ENMU player since Jan. 2011... Junior forward Phil Henry had eight rebounds, five blocks and three steals, all of which are career-highs, versus Texas A&M-Commerce... The Greyhounds host West Texas A&M on Wednesday night and then travel to Canyon, Texas on Saturday to play the Buffaloes again.

Incarnate Word

The Cardinals went 1-1 during the week dropping a game on the road to Abilene Christian on Tuesday before beating Angelo State, 100-83 at home on Saturday. Dionelle Rucker had a pair of strong games for the Cardinals last week. He had 15 points and six rebounds while making 4-of-6 from the field and 6-of-6 from the foul line in a loss at Abilene Christian. He led the team to a 100-83 victory over Angelo State on Saturday. He had 19 points, six rebounds and five assists. He shot 57.9 percent from the field and averaged 17.0 points per game for the week. Lyn'Dale Brown had 15 points and season high seven steals against Abilene Christian. He now leads the conference with 2.3 steals per game. Teammate Denzel Livingston is second in the LSC with 2.0 steals per game. Andre Corley averaged 17.5 points per game and while shooting 50 percent from the field and knocking

Tarleton State

The Texans snapped a four-game losing streak on Saturday with a 65-50 win over the visiting West Texas A&M Buffs... Tarleton's losing streak had hit four straight on Wednesday with ENMU's waningmoments three-pointer... Despite the 1-1 mark for the week, Tarleton limited opposing teams to just 54.5 points a game and allowed players to just 39.0 percent shooting efforts from the field... Chuck Guy (G, Jr, Fort Worth) led the Texans with 15.5 points this week and a team-high 14 assists... He scored a career-high 22 points in the win on Saturday... For the second time this season, the Texan defense held its opponent to less than 15 points in a first half as WT went just 4-for-20 from the field and scoring just 13 points before the break... The Texans have just one game this week as the team travels to Commerce on Saturday to take on the Lions... Tip-off is set for 4 p.m.

Texas A&M-Commerce

Texas A&M-Kingsville

Texas A&M-Kingsville head coach Pete Peterson picked up the 100th Lone Star Conference win of his career on Saturday as the Javelinas downed Abilene Christian at home...With 24 points on Saturday, Rashad Basey rebounded from his lowest scoring output of the season with. Basey, who was limited to two points on Wednesday as he played just over 10 minutes at Angelo State due to foul trouble, it was just the third time this season that Basey was held to single digits. All three times he has failed to score 10 have resulted in losses for the Javelinas... The Javelinas hit 53.2 percent of their shots on Saturday marking their second-highest percentage of the season. They were 25-of-47 from the field. The Javelinas shot a season-high 54.2% the week before against Eastern New Mexico...Kingsville had its two highest performances for both free throws made and attempted in their past two games. They were 21-of-31 at Angelo State in the midweek contest and 18-of-29 versus Abilene Christian. Amazingly, the Javelinas opponents in each contests had more makes and attempts. The officials in Kingsville's two games called 108 fouls combined - 57 in the contest at Angelo State and 51 against ACU...Through the first 13 games of the season no Kingsville player had been charged with a technical foul this season. Last week, the Hoggies had a player "T"ed up in each game. Adam Mughmaw was called for a technical at Angelo State and Marshall Bonds III against ACU... Marshall Bonds III had a season-best four blocks and the team a season-high eight - against ACU on Saturday. The senior now has 19 this season and 50 in his career. He is tied for third in blocks with former Hoggie Marcus Ford....For the second straight season, A&M-Kingsville will face Incarnate Word in back-toback games. The two teams will meet on Wednesday for IBC Pack the House Night at Kingsville Hampton Inn Court with a second meeting three days later in San Antonio. The Javelinas were swept a year ago but lead the season series 16-11.

West Texas A&M

The Buffs went 1-1 this past week with a win over Texas A&M-Commerce at home before falling to the Texans of Tarleton State on Saturday night in Stephenville. WT is now 11-5 overall with a 3-5 mark in the Lone Star Conference. The Buffs will play the rival Greyhounds of Eastern New Mexico twice this week to turn over their LSC schedule as they travel to Portales on Wednesday before hosting ENMU on Saturday night at the First United Bank Center in Canvon.

OTHER TOP WOMEN'S PERFORMERS

Kirsti Degelia, Midwestern State University, led the Mustangs to victory in their only game of the week and directed MSU into a first-place tie for the Lone Star Conference lead with a 67-53 win at Texas Woman's. The 5-8 junior guard from Denton, Texas/Krum scored 25 points in front of home folks in Denton, recording her third 25-plus game in the last five contests. Degelia shot 75 percent from the floor (6-of-8), hitting both 3-point field goals attempted and 11-of-12 shots from the foul line. She also grabbed seven rebounds, dished out an assist and blocked a shot. Degelia leads the Lone Star Conference in scoring with 17.1 points a game.

Toree Mason, Texas Woman's University, shot 57.1 percent from the floor and led the team in scoring with 18.0 points per game. She led the team with 17 points against Midwestern State and then added a career-high 19 points in a come from behind victory at Cameron. Mason scored nine of TWU's final 14 points in a one-point win against Cameron. On the season she leads the team in scoring with 10.9 points per game. Mason also leads the team in steals.

Casey Land, West Texas A&M University, averaged 17.0 points per game and had her best two games of the season from beyond the arc in two wins over Texas A&M-Commerce and at league-leading Tarleton State, Land went a season-best 8 of 11 from the field and 5 of 7 from beyond the arc for a career-high 21 points in the 72-51 win over Texas A&M-Commerce. She followed that up with a 5 of 8 performance from the field and 3 of 4 from beyond the arc in the upset win at Tarleton State (70-60). Land went 8 of 11 from beyond the arc (.727) for the week as she had just 14 made triples in the previous 15 games. She was 13 of 19 from the field for a team-best .684 average...She had six rebounds for the week to go along with six assists and three steals as she averaged 33.0 minutes per game.

Lauren Holt, Angelo State University, recorded her fourth double-double of the season in a win over Texas A&M-Kingsville. She scored 19 points and grabbed 14 rebound. The Christoval native was the Belles leading scorer in a loss to Incarnate Word. She scored 11 points in 26 minutes. It is the ninth time this season she has scored in double figures.

Nelsha Peterson, Eastern New Mexico University, shot an incredible .917 from the field over two games last week, missing just one of her 12 shots. At Texas A&M-Commerce, she hit all seven of her attempts for 16 points, including 10 points, in a stretch, which cut Eastern's deficit from 23 points to just six. Peterson went four-for-five from the floor against Tarleton State, for eight points and a blocked shot.

Kelsey Smith, Abilene Christian University, tied a single-game career high Tuesday vs. Incarnate Word with six blocks, helping the Wildcats complete a second-half comeback vs. the Cardinals and move into a tie for first place in the conference. Smith also pulled down 12 rebounds - second on the team this week to Sadie Dickinson's 17 - stole two passes and provided three assists. Against Smith and the rest of the ACU defense, UIW and Kingsville averaged 63.0 ppg, combined for just .341 shooting and made only 16-of-50 3-point attempts.

Andrea Carter, Midwestern State University, paced the defensive effort in the Mustangs in their only game of the week, a 67-53 win at Texas Woman's, that helped vault MSU into a first-place tie for the Lone Star Conference lead. The 5-10 sophomore forward from Angleton, Texas picked up her eighth double-double of the season with 13 points and 14 rebounds against the Pioneers, and added two blocked shots and four steals in the game as MSU held TWU to shooting 35.2 percent from the floor (19-of-54), including 19 percent (3-of-16) from the 3-point arc.

Tara Johnson, Eastern New Mexico University, performance helped the Zias limit the opposition to 66 points per game last week. She registered 13 points, five rebounds and three steals in a near upset of Tarleton State and followed with seven caroms at Texas A&M-Commerce. For the week, Johnson went six-for-six from the free throw line.

Ashlyn Green, University of the Incarnate Word, maintained her level of defensive prowess last week with a total of nine steals in two games. She had her first double-double of the season with 11 points, 10 rebounds and five steals in a 76-65 loss at Abilene Christian. She came back with 12 points and four steals while going 6-for-6 from the foul line in a 60-52 win over Angelo State. She averaged 11.5 points, 9.0 rebounds and 4.5 steals per game for the week.

WOMEN'S NOTES (Submitted by LSC SID's)

Abilene Christian

The 12-3 Wildcats matched last year's final win total this week with back-to-back victories over Incarnate Word (76-65) and Texas A&M-Kingsville (76-61). The two wins also pushed ACU into a first-place tie in the conference with Midwestern State and Tarleton State. The Wildcats shot .426 from the floor this week, .383 from 3-point range and made close to 80 percent of their free throws (42-53). Junior forward Renata Marquez led the team in scoring with 19.5 ppg and against the Cardinals established a new career singlegame high with seven steals. She then tied a career high at Kingsville with two blocks. Senior center Kelsey Smith tied a career high with six blocks vs. the Javelinas, Junior guard Savannah Smith also enjoyed a career game at Kingsville with 13 points and 8-of-10 shooting from the free-throw line. The ACU defense held its opposition to 63.0 ppg and .341 shooting (43-126). ACU begins the week on a five-game winning streak and has won eight of its last nine.

Angelo State

The Belles moved to 7-8 and 4-5 in Lone star Conference play. ASU defeated Texas A&M-Kingsville behind double-doubles from Lauren Holt and Haylee Oliver. Holt scored 19 points and grabbed 14 rebounds while Oliver chipped in 12 and collected 10 defensive rebounds. The Belles are the top LSC team in defensive rebounds averaging 29.4 per game. ASU is also second in the league in field goal percentage defense (.356), rebounding margin (+5.7), blocked shots (4.1) and defensive rebound percentage (.709). Haylee Oliver is in the top 10 of the LSC in points (6th), rebounding (4th) and assists (6th). Lauren Holt is the LSC's top shot blocker with 2.1 per game. Sally Walling Brooks is one victory away from winning her 400th career victory.

Cameron

The Aggies fell in their lone game this week on Saturday, Jan. 19 against Texas Woman's, 52-50 in the Aggie Gym. Cameron took control for the majority of the game leading as high as 11 points late in the second half. But the Aggies faded in the final minutes of the game and missed shots at the line let TWU to close the gap and earn a last second win over CU.

Eastern New Mexico

The Eastern New Mexico University women's basketball team registered a strong performance last week, nearly upsetting conference-leading Tarleton State, before almost coming from 23-points down at Texas A&M-Commerce. For the week, the Zias held a .400-.388 edge in shooting percentage and a .281-.261 advantage from three-point range. Next up for ENMU is Rivalry Week, with two contests against West Texas A&M.

Incarnate Word

The Cardinals went 1-1 during the week with a loss at Abilene Christian and a win versus Angelo State at home. She came back with 12 points and four steals while going 6-for-6 from the foul line in a 60-52 win over Angelo State. She averaged 11.5 points, 9.0 rebounds and 4.5 steals per game for the week. Green continues to lead the LSC and is 13th in the NCAA with 3.6 steals per game. Ify Mora set a career high in the win over Angelo State with four blocks. The Cards continue to lead the LSC in points allowed per game. They are holding opponents to 59.3 points per game.

The Mustangs are 12-3 overall, 7-2 in Lone Star Conference action and currently sit in a 3-way tie for the conference lead with wins over Abilene Christian and Tarleton State ... The Red River Rivalry takes center stage this week as Midwestern faces Cameron in Lawton on Wednesday and in Wichita Falls on Saturday as part of the LSC's Rivalry Week ... MSU faces Cameron for the 62nd time on Wednesday, continuing the longest series against any opponent for the Mustangs. MSU holds a 39-22 advantage in the series, including a 14-14 record in Lawton and a 22-6 advantage at Ligon Coliseum ... the Mustangs have won five straight games - the longest winning streak of the season for MSU – and the longest since picking up 10 straight victories in 2011-12 ... Midwestern has played six of its last seven games on the road, posting a record of 5-2 and winning four straight road affairs. The first game against Cameron is in Lawton, that will make the count seven road games in the last eight contests ... Conversely, Saturday's game against CU at Ligon Coliseum marks the start of eight of the last 10 regular season games at home ... Kirsti Degelia continues to lead the LSC in scoring averaging 17.1 points a game, 51st in NCAA Division II ... The 5-8 junior from Denton, Texas/Krum is seventh in the LSC in assists (3.0 per game), sixth in assist/ turnover ratio (1.0), ninth in free throw percentage (.722, 98-of-127), ninth in steals (1.5 per game), 13th in 3-point field goals per game (1.1), 14th in 3-point field goal percentage (.283, 17-of-60) and leads the league in minutes played (34.8) ... Sophomore Andrea Carter of Angleton, Texas is second in the LSC in rebounds (10.7 per game), which is 16th in Division II and second in steals (2.6 per game), which is 65th nationally ... Carter ranks 10th in the LSC in scoring (12.2 ppg), 11th in field goal percentage (.449, 61of-136), and sixth in blocked shots (1.0 bpg). She's second in the LSC and 13th in Division II with eight double-doubles this season ... Sophomore Shatoia

Gober is quietly building up her game.
