LSC BASKETBALL

Lone Star Conference action is in full swing, with the Midwestern State men and Tarleton State women both unbeaten in league play. The Mustangs have won four straight, while the TexAnns have prevailed in their last seven contests.

The LSC men have a 70-51 overall record so far this season. In the NCAA South Central Region, the men's teams are currently 14-14 combined versus Heartland Conference teams and 3-1 opposed to the Rocky Mountain Athletic Conference.

The LSC women are 62-67 overall. The women's squads are currently 15-11 combined versus Heartland teams, and 5-1 against the RMAC, which are the other conferences in the NCAA South Central Region.

The LSC champion will be the regular season winner determined by conference games, while the postseason tournament winner is designated as LSC Tournament Champion and earns the league's automatic berth into the NCAA Championship. The top eight teams in the final conference standings qualify for the postseason tournament set for March 6-9 in Allen, Texas.

PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

MEN'S OFFENSIVE

Donald Sims, West Texas A&M University, SR, Forward, Chester, South Carolina, Chester HS

Sims continued to lead a potent WT offensive as he averaged 24.0 points per game and 14.5 rebounds during the Christmas holiday as the Buffs went 2-0 with wins over Oklahoma Panhandle State and Hillsdale Baptist. Sims, a senior from Chester, S.C., recorded a career high 28 points to go along with 13 rebounds against OPSU on Dec. 29 followed by a 20 point and 10 board performance against Hillsdale Baptist to register his 5th double-double of the season.

MEN'S DEFENSIVE

Corbin Thomas, Midwestern State University, SR, Forward, Chicago, Ill., Seton Academy HS

Thomas averaged 12.7 points and 10 rebounds a game to help LSC-leading Midwestern State to three league road wins over Eastern New Mexico, Abilene Christian and Angelo State as the Mustangs improve to 6-0 in conference for the second straight season. The senior transfer from Missouri State connected 9-of-11 shots from the field to finish with 20 points and eight rebounds against ENMU before going for eight points and eight rebounds to go along with two blocked shots and a steal in a 72-71 win over Abilene Christian. Thomas closed the holiday break by notching his fourth double-double of the season with 10 points and 14 rebounds with a blocked shots in MSU's 65-55 win at Angelo State. Thomas' presence played a key role in the Mustangs defensive effort that limited the opposition 59.7 points and a 36.8 opponent shooting percentage.

WOMEN'S OFFENSIVE

Kiara Wright, Tarleton State University, JR, Center, Pittsburg, Texas, Pittsburg HS

Wright was a dominant force for the TexAnns in their return to LSC action in 2013. The junior center averaged a double-double for week against Texas A&M-Kingsville and Incarnate Word with 19.0 points and 10.0 rebounds. She shot .765 from the floor - missing only four shots in two games at 13-17 - and was an 86 percent free throw shooter. After a 13-point, eight-rebound effort against the Javelinas on Wednesday, she recorded a career-high 25 points at the McDermott Center Saturday against Incarnate Word to go along with her 12 rebounds in the win. She also had six assists, two blocks and a steal for the week.

WOMEN'S DEFENSIVE

Andrea Carter, Midwestern State University, SO, Forward, Angleton, Texas, Angleton HS

Carter averaged 12.0 points, 7.7 rebounds with 4.0 steals and 1.0 blocks for in helping the No. 25 Mustangs to a 2-1 week on the road in Lone Star Conference play. The 5-10 sophomore from Angleton, Texas, chalked up her sixth double-double of the year with 20 points and 10 rebounds at Abilene Christian, while posting 10 points and a team-leading seven rebounds in Midwestern's first win at Angelo State since 1997. Carter also collected five steals in each contest. For the week she shot 47.8 percent from the floor (11-of-23) and 77.8 from the line (14-of-18), while 17 of her 23 rebounds in the three games were defensive boards.

MEN'S OTHER TOP PERFORMERS

Craig Foster, Cameron University, once again led the Aggies in two wins in Lone Star Conference action over Angelo State and Abilene Christian. The junior from Lawton, Okla. Went .500 (12-24) from the field and .466 (7-15) from downtown. Foster averaged 19.5 points in their two games with 3.5 rebounds, and 13 assists. On Wednesday, Jan. 2 against Angelo State, Foster hit six three-pointers for the third time this season, with eight

assists, and had 21 points; it was his fifth 20 point game of the season. After a quiet five points in the first half against ACU, Foster had thirteen second half points with a season high five boards. Foster for the season is top five in the Lone Star Conference in scoring with 16.1 points per game, top two in assists with 5.3 per game, and has 21 steals.

Dakota Rawls, Angelo State University, continues to improve on the offensive side of the court for the Rams in his sophomore season. Rawls turned in his best game of last week with a 20-point effort in the Rams' loss at Cameron and then scored eight points against Midwestern State. For the week he shot 45 percent from the field and went 6 of 6 from the free-throw line. He is averaging 10.6 points per game this season.

Kyle Lantz, Eastern New Mexico University, paced the Greyhounds against Midwestern State, with 11 points and an .800 shooting percentage.

Craig Foster's, Cameron University, defensive presence helped the Aggies come away with a 2-0 week in Lone Star Conference action and limited the opposition to 65.5 points per game, with a 37.6 field goal percentage. On Wednesday's game vs. Angelo State Foster was assigned to guard Antonio Dye who is a top 10 scorer in the LSC. Foster throughout the night kept Dye in check and held him to three points, Dye was averaging 14.7 per game prior to their matchup with CU. On Saturday night against ACU, Foster limited current LSC leading scorer, Eric Lawton only 10 points off of 25 percent shooting (3-12). The 5-11 guard had 18 points, five assists, three steals, a season high five rebounds (one short of a career high) as well against ACU. On Wednesday, Jan. 2, against Angelo State, Foster hit six three-pointers for the third time this season, with eight assists, and had 21 points; it was his fifth 20 point game of the season. The junior from Lawton, Okla. went .500 (12-24) from the field and .466 (7-15) from downtown; Foster averaged 19.5 points in their two games with 3.5 rebounds, and 13 assists. Angelo State

The Rams fell to 1-5 in conference play with a pair of losses last week. ASU opened with a road defeat at Cameron last Wednesday before falling to Midwestern State at home. The Rams led the conference-leading Mustangs by as many as 13 points in the first half but were unable to keep pace with them in the second half. ASU returns to action this week with a pair of non-conference games, first hosting UTPB on Tuesday and then Northwood on Saturday.

Cameron

The Aggie men are on a three game Lone Star Conference winning streak after going 2-0 this week earning a 92-72 win over Angelo State and a 65-59 win against Abilene Christian. Cameron has also won four of their last five regular season games and finished with a lead at the half in nine of their eleven games. Junior guard, Craig Foster once again proved to a presence on the court leading CU with 21 points vs. Angelo State and 18 against ACU. Defense was also a key to the Aggies success keeping two of the LSC's top scorers under ten points and a 37.6 field goal percentage. The win at ACU also snapped a six game road losing streak at dating back to Feb. 1, 2012 at Angelo State. For the season Cameron is holding teams to a 41.6 percent field goal percentage while making 46.8 percent of their shots. Cameron will travel to Tarleton State on Jan. 9 before hosting Texas A&M Commerce on Jan. 12 the Aggie Gym.

Midwestern State

Midwestern State improved to 6-0 in the Lone Star Conference for the second consecutive season and for the third time since joining the league in 1996-97... The Mustangs rolled to LSC titles after winning their first 13 league games in 1999-00 and after winning their first since games last season... MSU has won at least five of its first six LSC games seven times prior to this season and went on to claim LSC championships in six of those seasons (1999, 2000, 2007, 2009, 2010, 2012) with the only exception coming in 2005 when they started 5-1 and finished runner-up in the LSC South to Texas A&M-Commerce... Midwestern State claimed their 50th Lone Star Conference since the start of the 2008-09 season and boast a league-best 50-12 mark (.806) during the span besting Tarleton State (45-15, .750) and West Texas A&M (35-25, .583)... The Mustangs extended the win streak in their series against Abilene Christian to nine games with a 72-71 win over Wildcats Thursday at Moody Coliseum. MSU owns 10-game win streaks over Texas A&M-Commerce and Texas A&M-Kingsville and have also beaten Cameron in nine straight... Midwestern State has overcome eight-point deficits in seven of its 10 wins this season... The Mustangs outrebounded Angelo State by an astounding 31 caroms in Saturday's 65-55 win over the Rams. MSU leads the LSC in rebounding offense (41.0), rebound margin (+9.8) and offensive rebound per game (16.5)... Midwestern has trailed at halftime in nine of 12 games this season, but have owned the second half in every game by an average margin of 11.5... Junior guard Cam Adderley has scored 25 points over the past two games against Abilene Christian and Angelo State -- all in the second half... Senior forward Corbin Thomas notched his fourth double-double of the season with 10 points and 14 rebounds Saturday at Angelo

Tarleton State

The Texans went 2-1 over the last couple of weeks, picking up wins over Ouachita Baptist (74-67) and Texas A&M-Kingsville (52-46) before falling to Incarnate Word (67-72) on the road... The loss to UIW moved Tarleton's record to 0-2 in road games this season... The loss snapped a four-game win streak for the Texans as well... De'Andre Upchurch (G, Jr, Flint, Mich.) led the Texans in scoring as he averaged 12.7 points per game over the last three ball games... Jon Cathey-Macklin (F, Jr, Milwaukee, Wis.) led the team averaging 5.3 rebounds per game and recording a team-high six blocks... Brian Word (G, Sr, Baltimore, Md.) led the defense with nine steals... Tarleton averaged 64.3 points per contest and gave up just 61.7... The Texans shot .436 percent from the field, but went just 11-for-39 from beyond the arc... The team improved its free throw shooting woes though, going 52-for-71 from the stripe over the last three games... The Texans hosts Cameron this Wednesday before returning to the road this Saturday at Northwestern State.

West Texas A&M

The Buffs went 2-0 over the Christmas holiday to improve to 10-2 overall with a pair of non-conference wins at home against Oklahoma Panhandle State and Hillsdale Baptist. The Buffs were led by Donald Sims who averaged 24.0 ppg and 14.5 rebounds per contest in the wins. The Buffs continued to lead the LSC in scoring defense as they gave up a total of 104 points in the two contests. The Buffs return to conference play this week as they travel to San Antonio, Texas on Thursday night for a matchup with Incarnate Word followed by a game at Texas A&M-Kingsville on Saturday.

WOMEN'S OTHER TOP PERFORMERS

Kirsti Degelia, Northwestern State University, led the No. 25 Mustangs to a 2-1 record on the road averaging 20.0 points and 5.7 rebounds. The 5-8 junior from Denton, Texas/Krum scored a career-high 26 points to lead the Mustangs to a 76-62 win at Abilene Christian, MSU's fourth consecutive win over ACU and third straight at Moody Coliseum. She followed that with 19 points and five boards to lead MSU to a 69-59 win at Angelo State, the Mustangs first over the Rambelles in San Angelo since 1997 and first over ASU in the Junell Center/Stephens Arena. For the week, Degelia shot 46.2 percent from the floor (18-of-39), 33.3 percent from the 3-point arc (5-of-15) and 70.4 percent from the foul line (19-of-27) as she took over the Lone Star Conference scoring lead by averaging 16.3 points a game. Degelia also averaged 1.7 assists and 1.7 steals in the three games.

Devin Griffin, West Texas A&M University, helped pace the Lady Buffs to two wins over Oklahoma Panhandle State and a conference win over Texas Woman's. She led the team averaging 18.0 points in the two games as she was a team-high 13 of 22 from the field for a .591 average. She was 3 of 3 from beyond the arc and 7 of 10 from the line. Her three triples in the two games gives her four for the season.

Griffin led the team with three blocks and three steals in the two games as well. The 21 points scored against OPSU were the second-most of the season as she was a season-best 8 of 12 from the field.

Lauren Holt, Angelo State University, averaged 16 points per game in the last two games. She scored 16 points on the road at Cameron and at home against Northwestern State. The junior added 12 rebounds and was the Belles leading scorer. She is the team's third-leading scorer at 11.8 per game.

Ashlee Pierson, Eastern New Mexico University, turned in an 18-point, five-rebound, two-steal performance in Eastern's upset of 25th-ranked Northwestern State. She scored five points over the last 3:54, including the basket which gave ENMU the lead for good. Pierson hit four of her five shots in the second half of the game, for 11 points.

Lakeyescia Griffin, Eastern New Mexico University, turned in a strong performance defensively for Eastern, which limited the opposition to just 54 points and a .327 shooting percentage over two games. She helped to limit 25th-ranked Northwestern State to just 24.2 percent from the floor in the Zias come-from-behind win on New Year's Eve, in which ENMU allowed just two field goals over the final 7:41 of play. She dished out six assists and hit all four free throw attempts against Texas Woman's and helped limit the Pioneers to 29.8 percent from the floor, including 26.3 percent in the second half.

Chontiquah White, West Texas A&M University, helped pace the Lady Buffs to two wins with a 76-63 win over Oklahoma Panhandle State and a 65-51 Lone Star Conference win over Texas Woman's. White averaged 16.5 points for the two game and a team-high 9.0 rebounds per game including her fourth double-double of the year with 21 points and 12 rebounds against OPSU. She tallied one steal against OPSU and helped lead the Lady Buffs to their eighth and ninth games of holding the opposition under 40 percent from the field and Texas Woman's shot a WT opponent season-low 1 of 12 from beyond the arc. The 51 points TWU scored was the second-lowest allowed this season for the Lady Buffs.

Kiara Wright, Tarleton State University, was a top defender for the TexAnn last week in Tarleton's return to LSC play. In games against Texas A&M-Kingsville and Incarnate Word, the junior center anchored the TexAnn defense which allowed opponents to just .381 shooting from the floor. She also averaged a double-double for the week with 19 points and 10 rebounds, including a career-high 25 points and 12 rebound against UIW in San Antonio Saturday. Of her 20 rebounds over the past two games, 13 of them came on the defensive end. She also added six assists, two blocks and a steal.

Haylee Oliver, Angelo State University, averaged 12.5 points and eight rebounds in last week's games. She grabbed 14 defensive rebounds and dished out five assists. She recorded her fifth-straight double-double against Cameron with 16 points and 15 rebounds.

The Belles dropped two Lone Star Conference games this past week to fall to 6-6 overall and 3-3 in LSC play. ASU is currently second in the league in field goal percentage defense, rebounding offense, clocked shots, defensive rebounds and defensive rebounds percentage. The Belles sit third in field

goal percentage, 3-point field goal percentage, rebounding margin and 3-point field goals made. Haylee Oliver continues her strong season and is ranked in the top 10 in three major categories. She is seventh in scoring, fourth in rebounding and sixth in assists. The sophomore also is fourth in 3-point field goal percentage, fifth in 3-point field goals made and second in defensive rebounds. Junior Lauren Holt still leads the LSC in blocked shots at 2.3 per game. Junior Leah LeMaire is seven points away from scoring 500 for her career. Head coach Sally Walling Brooks is two victories away from 400 for her career.

Cameron

The Aggie women split their games this last week beating Angelo State 70-61 and falling to Abilene Christian 90-43. Chelsea Stamp led CU offensively with 17 points against Angelo State and 13 points at ACU. Brittany Harris added a Cameron career high 17 points in their win vs. Angelo State. On Wednesday, Jan. 2, vs. Angelo State, the Aggies shot a season high 70 points off of a season high 45.3 percent shooting from the field. Quietly, Harris is second in the Lone Star Conference in assists with 3.4 per game and Stamp is second in the conference in three-point field goals made at 2.4. Cameron will travel to Tarleton State on Jan. 9 before hosting Texas A&M Commerce on Jan. 12 at the Aggie Gym.

Eastern New Mexico

The Eastern New Mexico University women's basketball team split two games over the break, which included a come-from-behind win over 25th-ranked Northwestern State. Defense highlighted the week for Eastern, with the team limiting the opposition to 54 points per game and holding Northwestern State to just two field goals over the final 7:41 of play. Ashlee Pierson paced Eastern against the Mustangs, with 18 points, including five in the decisive run. This week, the Zias will visit Texas A&M-Kingsville and University of the Incarnate Word.

Midwestern State

The Mustangs are 9-3 overall, 4-2 in Lone Star Conference play ... MSU went 2-1 over the last week in three road games as part of a five-game stretch away from Ligon Coliseum that started Dec. 19. The Mustangs conclude that road swing on Wednesday at Texas A&M-Commerce before hosting league-leading Tarleton State on Saturday ... The Mustangs have played seven of their 12 games away from home thus far this season, including five of their six Lone Star Conference games ... The Mustangs held the No. 25 ranking in the WBCA's USA Today Sports Division II Coaches Poll over the holiday break, it's first-ever Division II national ranking ... The ranking marked the 10th time in the last 14 polls that MSU has received votes in the poll, with MSU receiving votes for five consecutive weeks both this season and in 2011-12. The next poll is to be released on Tuesday (Jan. 8) ... Junior guard Kirsti Degelia of Denton, Texas/Krum now leads the Lone Star Conference in scoring. Thanks in part to her career-high 26 points at Abilene Christian, Degelia now averages 16.3 points a game to lead the league. Degelia leads the LSC in minutes played (34.0 per game) and is eighth in assists (2.83), and 10th in free throw percentage (.755) ... Sophomore forward Andrea Carter of Angleton, Texas, remains second in the LSC in rebounding, averaging 10.5 a contest. She is also second in steals (2.83 per game), ninth in scoring (13.1), sixth in blocked shots (1.0),

ninth in field goal percentage (.491), and 11th in free throw percentage (.750) ... Sophomore Dianna Jones of Hewitt, Texas/Midway leads the LSC in a pair of categories as she is connecting on 29-of-30 free throws for a 96.7 percentage and holds a 1.83 assist/turnover ratio. Jones also is second in the LSC in assists at 3.42 and sixth in steals with 1.83 ... The Mustangs 69-59 win at Angelo State last Saturday marked the first time MSU had beaten the Rambelles in San Angelo since Jan. 23, 1997 (MSU 70, ASU 61). It was the first time MSU beat the Belles in the Junell Center/Stephens Arena as well, however it was MSU's second win in the building with the first being a 68-59 victory over Cameron on March 1, 2002 in the Lone Star Conference Tournament ...

Tarleton State

Tarleton State went 2-0 last week in its return to LSC action. The TexAnns hosted Texas A&M-Kingsville before hitting the road for an LSC Championship rematch against Incarnate Word. Led by the conference's top two scorers Kiara Wright and Peyton Adamson, Tarleton won both games.
