

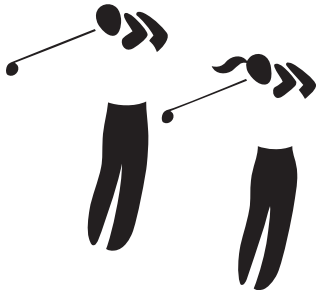

Chantry McMahan, Texas A&M University - Commerce, SR, Kaufman, Texas, Kaufman HS

McMahan captured the individual title at the 2013 UCO Broncho Classic in Edmond, Okla., firing a 1-under 141 and defeating her closest competitor by three strokes. McMahan posted an even-par 71 in round one, then carded a 1-under 70 in round two, the second-lowest round of her career, to win her first collegiate tournament. McMahan now has 13 top-five finishes for her A&M-Commerce career as her 141 over the tournament is the lowest 36-hole total of her career.

OTHER TOP PERFORMERS

Ashley Coy, Texas A&M University - Kingsville, placed first at the Talamonti Shafts Golf Tournament in Houston earlier this week. The junior won the tournament by two shots with a 36-hole score of 156. She opened with an 80 and finished with a 76.

Glory Jangthongsiri, West Texas A&M University, finished tied for second at the Lady Buff Stampede this week. She fired rounds of 74 and 78 for a 152 score as she was the top LSC finisher in the tournament among WT, Midwestern State and Angelo State. It was her third consecutive top two or better finish this season as she entered the week with the nation's best stroke average for Division II. Jangthongsiri paced the Lady Buffs to a third place finish in the tournament.

Jaqueline Strickland, Cameron University, placed 17th at the UCO Classic with a 151 (76-75) score. In three tournaments played she has averaged a 73.5 per round for the Aggies with a pair of top-5 finishes.
